TRIBE HEADLINES

» Cleveland's "magic number" to clinch its third consecutive American League Central title currently stands at 7.

» **FRANCISCO LINDOR** matched his single-season career high by hitting his 33rd home run last night...his six multi-homer games from the first spot of the batting order this season are a Major League single-season record...Lindor's seven leadoff homers are tied with **Grady Sizemore** (7 in 2008) for the club record.

» **JASON KIPNIS** is batting .395 (15-38) over his past 11 games with four homers, four doubles and 14 RBI (T2nd in American League, T3rd in MLB over that span).

» **CARLOS CARRASCO** is 7-4 with a 2.96 ERA (28ER/85.0IP) in 13 road starts, marking the 7th-lowest road ERA in the American League...he is 13 punchouts shy of reaching 200 strikeouts for the third time in his career and 12 strikeouts shy of matching **Mike Garcia** (1095K) for 10th on the Tribe's all-time leaderboard.

YESTERDAY'S RECAP

» The Indians opened their four-game set in Toronto with a 9-4 victory, extending their divisional lead to a season-high 16.5 games.

» The Tribe's "magic number" to clinch the A.L. Central now stands at 7...Minnesota was idle yesterday and faces Kansas City this weekend.

» **FRANCISCO LINDOR** led the Tribe offense, going 4-for-5 with a pair of homers and four RBI...marked his 6th multi-homer game of the season and gave him 33 longballs on the season, matching his single-season career high (33 in 2017).

» **JASON KIPNIS** (1-5) delivered a three-run homer in the top of the 9th inning that broke the game open...**EDWIN ENCARNACION** went 3-for-5 with a run scored against his old team, while **GREG ALLEN** was 2-for-4 with an RBI-double.

» **SHANE BIEBER** picked up his ninth win of the season, allowing four runs (three earned) on seven hits over 6.1 innings of work (1BB, 6K)...marks the most wins by a Tribe rookie since **Mitch Talbot** went 10-13 in the 2010 campaign.

KIP THE BALL ROLLING

» **JASON KIPNIS** put the game out of reach with a three-run homer in the top of the 9th inning, marking his 15th longball of the season.

» Since August 26, Kipnis is batting .395 (15-38) with four homers, four doubles, 14 RBI and eight runs scored...his 14 RBI in that span rank T3rd in MLB (T2nd in American League).

» Kipnis's homer also marked his 100th career homer as a second baseman (103rd overall), moving him into a tie with **Joe Gordon** for the most in franchise history.

OUR FRIENDS IN THE NORTH

» Cleveland is concluding its season series vs. Toronto with a four-game series at Rogers Centre this weekend...the Indians currently hold a 2-2 record this season vs. the Blue Jays.

» The Tribe is outscoring Toronto 37-29 across the four games, with Cleveland plating 33 runs over the last three contests.

» The Indians own an all-time record of 207-207-2 (.500) vs. the Blue Jays, as well as a 19-17 (.528) mark since **Terry Francona** became Tribe manager in 2013...the clubs squared off in the 2016 ALCS, with Cleveland winning the series four games to one.

SECOND-HALF SURGE

» Tribe has posted a 3.32 ERA (146ER/396.1IP) in the second half, marking the 2nd-lowest ERA in the American League (OAK, 3.27) and 4th-lowest in MLB.

» The Indians' 28-17 record (.622) since the All-Star break ranks 3rd-best in the A.L. (BOS - 29-14, .674 & OAK - 29-15, .659)...Cleveland's 243-158 (.606) second-half record since 2013 is the best in MLB, including a league-best 83-37 (.692) mark since 2017.

GREG'S OVER EASY

» **GREG ALLEN** collected his 16th multi-hit game of the season last night, driving in his 17th run with a 6th-inning double...nine of his 17 RBI this year have come with two outs.

» Allen continues to lead all MLB rookies with 14 stolen bases.

Gavin Collins went 2-for-4 with a pair of doubles and drove in Lynchburg's only run.

» **MV Scrappers (Short-A): Best-of-three vs. Tri-City (0-2)** » 9/6: L, 4-8 » Season Completed
Steven Kwan and Clark Scolamiero each had two hits, a double and an RBI...Mahoning Valley has been eliminated.

COOKIE'S IN CANADA

» **CARLOS CARRASCO** is starting on regular four days' rest after making his last start on September 2 vs. Tampa Bay...was handed the loss after allowing five runs on nine hits over 6.1 innings of work (2BB, 9K).

» Carrasco is 3-1 with a 5.60 ERA (22ER/35.1IP) in six career starts (seven appearances) vs. Toronto, including a no-decision on May 3 of this year (5.1IP, 9H, 6R/ER, 3BB, 7K)...he tossed 7.0 shutout innings on three hits on May 9, 2017 in his most recent start at Rogers Centre.

» He has gone 7-4 with a 2.96 ERA (28ER/85.0IP) in 13 road starts this season, good for the 7th-lowest road ERA in the A.L.

» Carrasco enters play tonight with 187 strikeouts, 7th-most in the American League...he sits 13 strikeouts away from reaching 200 strikeouts for the 3rd time in his career, and 12 punchouts shy of matching Mike Garcia (1095 K) for 10th place on the Indians franchise leaderboard.

» He also ranks among American League leaders in wins (T4th, 16), BB/9.0IP (T6th, 1.8) and K/9.0IP (T7th, 10.5).

FRANKIE STRIKES TWICE

» **FRANCISCO LINDOR** hit his 32nd and 33rd home runs of the season last night, matching his single-season career high (also hit 33 in 2017).

» His 1st-inning blast was his seventh leadoff home run of the season, most in the American League and 3rd-most in MLB...led Grady Sizemore (7 in 2008) for the single-season franchise record for leadoff home runs.

» Last night also marked his 6th multi-homer game of 2018, tied with BAL/LAD's **Manny Machado** and OAK's **Khristian Davis** for the MLB lead...all six of those multi-homer contests have come in the top spot of the batting order, setting a new single-season Major League record.

» Lindor has hit 32 homers and driven in 82 runs from the top spot of the batting order, both of which lead MLB...he sits one homer and eight RBI away from matching the club records in those categories (both set by **Grady Sizemore** in 2008).

THE PARROT'S OLD PERCH

» **EDWIN ENCARNACION** is batting .306 (15-49) in 14 games since returning from the Disabled List on August 22, with four homers, 13 RBI and eight runs scored...his 13 RBI over that span rank T5th in the American League.

» He enters play tonight ranked 5th in the American League with 94 RBI...he is six RBI shy of recording his sixth career season with 100 RBI, which would rank 4th-most among active players.

» Encarnacion was a member of the Blue Jays from 2009-16, ranking 3rd in franchise history with 239 home runs and 6th with 679 RBI...in nine games against his former team, he is batting .424 (14-33) with a home run, a double, eight RBI and six runs scored.

STRONG STARTERS

» **SHANE BIEBER**'s outing last night marked Cleveland's 87th quality start of the season, 2nd-most in MLB (Houston - 88)...the rotation's 3.40 ERA ranks 2nd-lowest in the A.L. (HOU - 3.16).

» Tribe starting pitchers have recorded 929 strikeouts this season (2nd in MLB, Houston - 972) and have issued just 212 walks (4th-fewest in MLB)...the rotation's collective 4.38 K/BB ratio is the highest in MLB and currently stands as the best mark by a rotation in MLB history...the 2011 Phillies currently hold the full-season record with a 4.22 K/BB ratio.

» The Indians currently boast four pitchers among the American League top 10 in strikeouts: TREVOR BAUER (4th, 214), COREY KLUBER (6th, 190), CARLOS CARRASCO (7th, 187) and MIKE CLEVINGER (10th, 182).

BOLSTERED BULLPEN

» The Tribe bullpen tossed 2.2 scoreless innings last night, lowering their collective second-half ERA to 3.42, 5th-lowest in MLB.

» Cleveland's left-handed relievers own a 1.39 ERA (7ER/45.1IP) since the All-Star break, 2nd-lowest in MLB.

THIS DAY IN INDIANS HISTORY

2017: The Indians complete a four-game sweep of the Chicago White Sox with an 11-2 victory, setting a new franchise record with their 15th consecutive win...**Erik González** hit a pair of home runs, **Greg Allen** hit his first career longball, and **Edwin Encarnacion** & **Francisco Lindor** added homers of their own...Cleveland would go on to win seven more games in a row, establishing an American League-record 22-game win streak.

TODAY'S START

» The 31-year-old right-hander is set to make his 10th start of the second half in this evening's contest at Toronto...is pitching on regular four days' rest after facing Tampa Bay in his most recent start on September 2 at Progressive Field...took the loss after surrendering five runs on nine hits over 6.1 innings of work (2BB, 9K).

» **Since returning from the Disabled List on July 6, Carrasco has gone 8-3 with a 2.58 ERA (20ER/69.2IP) in 11 starts (12 appearances).**

» Carrasco will be making his second start this season against Toronto as well as the seventh of his career (eighth appearance)...owns a 3-1 record with a 5.60 ERA (22ER/35.1IP) in his previous outings, including 7.0 shutout innings (3H, 0BB, 7K) in his most recent start at Rogers Centre on May 9, 2017.

» Carrasco owns a 5-3 record with a 2.47 ERA (16ER/58.1IP) in nine starts since the All-Star break...owns the 3rd-lowest second-half ERA (min. 40.0IP) in the American League (teammate **Mike Clevinger** is 1st with a 2.32 ERA).

LAST TIME OUT | 2018 HIGHLIGHTS

» Carrasco is starting on regular four days' rest after making his last start on September 2 vs. Tampa Bay...was handed his eighth loss of the season after allowing five runs on nine hits over 6.1 innings of work (2BB, 9K)...**Carrasco has gone 8-3 with a 2.58 ERA (20ER/69.2IP) in 11 starts (12 appearances) since returning from the Disabled List on July 6...he enters play today for the 14th time in the American League with 16 wins.**

» **Improved to 3-0 for the first time in his career as he tossed his 9th career complete game on April 11 vs. Detroit...** held the Tigers to just one run on three hits over 9.0 innings, walking two and striking out six batters...took a no-decision at Estadio Hiram Bithorn against Minnesota on April 18 despite tossing 7.0 shutout innings (3H, 1BB, 7K).

» **Threw his 10th career complete game and his second of 2018 on May 9 at Milwaukee,** holding the Brewers to two runs on five hits in the Tribe's 6-2 win...**Carrasco struck out a season-high 14 batters, one shy of his career high and the most by any Indians pitcher this season...**also helped his own cause at the plate, collecting an RBI-single in the 9th inning...became the first Tribe pitcher with an RBI in his own complete game since **Gaylord Perry** did so on September 22, 1972 vs. New York-AL.

» Earned his 10th win of the season on July 11 vs. Cincinnati after holding the Reds to one run on five hits over 5.0 innings of work...**struck out seven batters to reach 1,000 career punchouts, making him the 12th pitcher with 1,000 strikeouts in an Indians uniform and the 44th active MLB pitcher to reach 1,000.**

STRIKEOUTS RISING

» Despite missing three weeks on the Disabled List, Carrasco enters play today ranked 7th in the American League with 187 strikeouts...since returning from the D.L. on July 6, he has recorded 91 strikeouts, 2nd-most in the American League (HOU's **Justin Verlander** - 94) and T3rd-most in MLB over that span (NYM's **Jacob deGrom** - 96).

» **Carrasco sits 13 punchouts shy of reaching 200 strikeouts for the third time in his career (216 in 2015, 226 in 2017)...he also is 12 strikeouts shy of matching Mike Garcia (1,095 K) for 10th place on the Indians all-time franchise leaderboard.**

» Currently ranks T7th in the American League with 10.5 strikeouts per 9.0 innings...he also is 4th in the A.L. with a 5.67 K/BB ratio and T6th in walks per 9.0 innings (1.8).

» Since the beginning of 2015, Carrasco has amassed 10.15 strikeouts-per-9.0IP, the 3rd-highest total among A.L. pitchers with at least 500.0 innings pitched in that span (**Chris Sale** - 11.70, **Chris Archer** - 10.59, **Corey Kluber** is 4th with 10.00 K/9.0IP).

WELCOME TO THE SECOND HALF

» **Carrasco currently sits 6-2 with a 2.47 ERA (16ER/58.1IP) in eight starts since the All-Star break, marking the 3rd-lowest second-half ERA in the American League (min. 50.0IP) behind teammate Mike Clevinger (2.32) and Chicago-AL's Carlos Rodón (2.38)...he has struck out 75 batters (2nd in A.L., 5th in MLB) and allowed just 10 walks in the second half.**

» Went 8-3 with a 3.12 ERA (33ER/95.1IP) in the second half in 2017...**Carrasco also posted a 5-0 record with a 1.48 ERA (7ER/42.2IP) in September last season.**

VS. TORONTO | A.L. EAST

» Carrasco will be making his 7th career start (8th appearance) against the Toronto Blue Jays tonight, as well as his second this season...owns a lifetime record of 3-1 with a 5.60 ERA (22ER/35.1IP) against the Rays.

» Took a no-decision in Game 1 of the Tribe's doubleheader vs. Toronto on May 3, allowing six runs on nine hits over 5.1 innings of work (3BB, 7K)...his most recent start at Rogers Centre came on May 9, 2017, where he allowed just three hits over 7.0 shutout innings (0BB, 7K).

» Today will also mark Carrasco's sixth start (seventh appearance) this season against an opponent from the A.L. East division, going 3-2 with a 4.99 ERA (17ER/30.2IP) in those outings...earned wins in starts against Baltimore on April 23 & August 17, while he won in relief on July 15 vs. New York-AL.

ON THE ROAD AGAIN

» Owns a 7-4 record with a 2.96 ERA (28ER/85.0IP) through his first 13 road outings this season...**Carrasco threw a complete game on May 9 at Milwaukee, striking out 14 batters while allowing two runs on five hits...**tossed 7.0 shutout innings at Chicago-AL on June 11, walking one and striking out 11 batters.

» In his most recent road start (August 22 at Boston), Carrasco took the loss after allowing six runs (five earned) on eight hits over 3.2 innings of work (1BB, 6K).

» Overall has surrendered three-or-fewer runs in 10 of his 13 road starts this season...currently owns the 7th-lowest road ERA in the American League.

» **Since 2015, Carrasco's 2.63 road ERA is the 3rd-lowest in MLB among pitchers with at least 200.0 road innings,** trailing only Clayton Kershaw (2.28) & Max Scherzer (2.39).

2017 SEASON HIGHLIGHTS

» **Enjoyed the most prolific season of his career, finishing fourth in American League Cy Young voting as he set new career-highs in wins (18), starts (32), innings pitched (200.0) and strikeouts (226)...**Carrasco finished in the A.L. Top 10 in wins (T1st), ERA (3.29, 6th), strikeouts (5th) and innings (8th)...joined Corey Kluber as the first teammates to accumulate 18 wins and 220 strikeouts each since Arizona's Randy Johnson & Curt Schilling in 2002 (6th duo all-time).

» Made his Postseason debut in Game 3 of the ALDS against New York-AL after missing the 2016 playoffs...tossed 5.2 shutout innings on just three hits (3BB, 7K) but took a no decision in the Tribe's eventual 1-0 loss at Yankee Stadium.

CAREER SNAPSHOT

» Right-hander is in his 10th season with the Cleveland organization after being acquired from Philadelphia on July 29, 2009, along with INF Jason Donald, RHP Jason Knapp & C Lou Marson, in exchange for OF Ben Francisco & LHP Cliff Lee.

» Signed 4-year contract extension with Indians thru 2018 on April 7, 2015, including club options for 2019 & 2020 and could cover up to first 3 years of free agency.

» Made his major league debut September 1, 2009 as the Indians starter against the Detroit Tigers at Comerica Park...took the loss after allowing six runs on nine hits (three home runs) with three walks and three strikeouts in 3.0 innings.

» Is in his 15th professional season since signing with Philadelphia as a non-drafted free agent on Nov. 25, 2003...has appeared in parts of nine Major League seasons with Cleveland...missed the entire 2012 season after having right elbow surgery.
