SAN FRANCISCO GIANTS (19-16) vs PHILADELPHIA PHILLIES (19-15)

Tuesday, May 8, 2018 – Citizens Bank Park – 7:05 EDT – Game 35; Home 18

RHP Aaron Nola (4-1, 2.17) vs LHP Derek Holland (1-3, 5.70)

- LAST NIGHT'S ACTION:** The Phillies defeated the San Francisco Giants, 11-0, at Citizens Bank Park ... Starter Zach Eflin (W, 1-0) tossed 6.2 scoreless innings and collected 9 strikeouts ... Odubel Herrera extended his on-base streak in emphatic fashion as he blasted a 3-run home run in the 1st inning ... The Phils would keep adding to their lead as the night progressed with home runs from Cesar Hernandez and Carlos Santana ... Right-hander Seranthony Dominguez made his major league debut with a scoreless 8th inning.
- RAGING BULL:** Odubel Herrera has now reached base safely in a career-best 36 straight games (since 9/27/17), posting a .345/.400/.532 slash line over 155 plate appearances during the streak ... Herrera, who has reached base safely in each of his 32 games to start the season, has the longest on-base streak by a Phillies player in the modern era (since 1900) to begin a season, eclipsing the previous modern-day record held by Jayson Werth in 2010 (26 G) ... His 32 straight games reaching base to begin the season are the most by any major league player since Matt Holliday began the 2015 season reaching base in 45 straight (Elias) ... Herrera has the longest active on-base streak in baseball and the longest by a Phillies player since Jimmy Rollins reached safely in 38 straight from August 23, 2005-April 5, 2006.

- NOLA NIGHT IN SOUTH PHILLY:** The Phillies send Aaron Nola to the hill tonight as he looks to extend his active 13.1-inning scoreless streak (4/27-current) ... It has been almost a full calendar year since the right-hander has failed to complete at least 5.0 innings in a start (last: 5/31/17 at MIA) ... In fact, Nola's streak of 28 consecutive starts of 5.0 innings or more is the second-longest active streak in the majors (best: **CLE's Corey Kluber**, 30 straight), and is one of only four active streaks of 20 or more games (others: **HOU's Gerrit Cole** 27 G & **HOU's Justin Verlander** 24 G) ... Nola is coming off one of the best 25-game spans by a Phillies starter in recent memory: Since June 22, 2017, he has posted a 2.77 ERA (50 ER, 162.2 IP), 1.08 WHIP (132 H, 44 BB) with 172 SO and a .220/.275/.348 slash line ... His 2.77 ERA is the lowest by a Phillies starter over a 25-game span since Cole Hamels posted a 2.67 ERA over 25 starts from August 3, 2014-June 14, 2015 ... Additionally, Nola has gone at least 7.0 innings and picked up the win in each of his last three starts (4/21-current) and if he does so tonight, will become the first Phillies starting pitcher to do so in four straight starts since Hamels, May 8-23, 2015 ... Over his last 14 starts in South Philly, Nola is 11-3 and has posted a 2.21 ERA (24 ER, 97.2 IP) with 112 strikeouts to just 22 walks (5.09 SO/BB ratio).
- CITIZENS BANK SPARK:** Dating back to last season, the Phillies have gone 23-10 in their last 33 games at Citizens Bank Park (9/12-current) and their .697 win percentage over that stretch ranks 3rd in the majors behind the Yankees (.758) and Cubs (.708) ... Philadelphia has plated 182 runs in those 33 games, an average of 5.52 runs per game while posting a combined 3.08 team ERA ... This season, the Phillies have a +36 run differential at home, 2nd among all big league clubs behind only the Yankees (+51).
- RHYS LIGHTNING:** Rhys Hoskins has now reached base safely in 30 of his 33 starts this season, and 21 of his last 23 games overall (since 4/13) ... Since making his ML debut on August 10, 2017, Hoskins has posted a .979 OPS over 357 plate appearances ... That ranks 5th among all National League players with at least 300 plate appearances in that span, trailing only CHI's Kris Bryant (1.026), COL's Nolan Arenado (.996) & Charlie Blackmon (.991), and STL's Tommy Pham (.990) ... For his career, Hoskins has 65 walks to 85 strikeouts, and since his debut, only two other players in the majors have as many walks and as few strikeouts: **CIN's Joey Votto** (72 BB, 47 SO) and **LAA's Mike Trout** (67 BB, 60 SO).
- THEY MIGHT BE GIANTS:** The Phillies and Giants square off for the first time this year, with Philadelphia going 2-0-1 in the last three series matchups ... Philadelphia has won six of their last eight games at home against San Francisco (since 6/7/15) after going just 3-11 against them at Citizens Bank Park from 7/27/11-6/6/15.
- WHAT A RELIEF:** The Phillies have gone 16-10 since April 9 and a big reason why is the bullpen ... In those 26 games, the Phillies pen has posted a 2.34 ERA (23 ER, 88.1 IP) while limiting hitters to a .214 AVG and .623 OPS ... Overall, the Phillies are 13-1 this season when they have a lead after the 6th inning, 14-2 with a lead after the 7th and 15-1 when leading after the 8th.
- ENTER STRANDMAN:** The Phillies bullpen has successfully stranded 32 of their last 36 inherited runners (4/9-current) and their 88.9% strand rate is easily tops in the majors over that stretch (next: SF, 33-39, 84.6 %) ... Overall this season, the Phils pen has stranded 39 of the 51 runners they have inherited and their 76.5% strand rate ranks 4th among all major league bullpens (best: LAA, 80.9 %) ... Individually, **Luis Garcia** has stranded all 12 runners he has inherited.
- PHILLIE SPECIAL:** After getting off to a 1-4 start, the Phillies have gone 18-11 in their last 29 games (4/5-current) and their .621 winning percentage over that span is fifth-best among any major league team (best: BOS & NYY, .714).

LAST START: 5/2 at MIA: W, 7.1 IP, 0 R, 4 H, BB, 7 SO ... Nola vs Urena ... Cesar Hernandez led off the game with a home run and had two hits along with teammates Aaron Altherr (2-4), Maikel Franco (2-4) and Pedro Florimon (2-4).

TONIGHT'S START:

- Streiking:** Has not allowed a run in his last 13.1 innings, the longest scoreless streak by a Phillies player in 2018
- Scoreless Start:** His last start was the second-longest scoreless start of his career at 7.1 innings, with his only one longer coming back on 8/23/15, also at MIA (8.0 IP) ... It was the longest scoreless start by a Phillies starter this season
- Last 11:** In his last 10 starts (since 9/7/17), is 6-2 with a 2.54 ERA (18 ER, 71.0 IP), 1.04 WHIP and 71 SO ... He has allowed 3 runs or fewer in all of those starts and 2 or fewer in 9 of 11
- 2018 NL Starter Rankings:** 2nd in fewest pitchers per IP (14.2), T-2nd in wins (4, T-5th in MLB), 5th in WHIP (0.92), IP (45.2) & HR/9.0 IP (0.39, T-7th in MLB), 6th in ERA (2.17), 9th in lowest OPP AVG (.196)
- Home Body:** Since 6/22/17, Nola is 11-3 with a 2.21 ERA (24 ER, 97.2 IP), 0.91 WHIP and has held opponents to a .191 AVG with 112 SO in 14 starts at home ... He has allowed 2 runs or fewer in 12 of those 14 starts **In that same span (since 6/22/17), Nola ranks 1st among all ML pitchers (min. 75.0 IP) in wins (11) at home, is 2nd in ERA (best: Kluber, 1.27) & IP, 3rd in SO and 5th in lowest OPP AVG ... Nola is the first Phillie to start his season 3-0 or better at home since 2010, when Roy Oswalt won his first 5 games at CBP and Roy Halladay won his first 3**
- A Dominant Stretch:** Has a 2.77 ERA (50 ER, 162.2 IP) and 172 SO since 6/22/17 (25 starts) ... His ERA is 5th among all ML starters with at least 150.0 IP in that span, trailing only Corey Kluber (1.84), Justin Verlander (2.09), Chris Sale (2.65) & Luis Severino (2.72) ... His 172 SO rank 10th among ML starters ... **He has allowed 2 ER or fewer in 21 of 25 starts during that stretch and tossed 6.0 innings or more in 20 of them**
- vs NL East:** 3-4, 4.84 ERA (33 ER, 61.1 IP) in 10 starts

HOME:

- 2018:** 3-0, 2.45 ERA (6 ER, 22.0 IP) in 3 starts
- Career:** 17-12, 3.42 ERA (77 ER, 202.2 IP) in 32 starts

2018 SEASON:

- Surrendered 2 runs or fewer in 8 straight starts from 9/13/17 to 4/21/18, marking the 7th time a Phillies starter has accomplished the feat since 1893 when the current mound distance was established (had a PHI record 10 straight last season)
- Allowed 4 or fewer hits in each of his first 4 starts of the season, the first Phillie to do so in his first 4 starts since 2005 (Rob Tejada, 5)
- Tied a career high with 8.0 IP on 4/10 vs CIN
- Made his first career Opening Day start on 3/29 at ATL ... At 24 years, 298 days old, he was the club's youngest Opening Day starter since Dennis Bennett in 1964 (24 years, 192 days old)

2017 SEASON:

- Ranked 8th among NL starters in SO/9.0 IP (9.86), 9th in SO rate (26.6 %) & 1st pitch strike % (64.4 %) and 10th in SO/BB (3.71)
- Had the most SO (184) ever by a Phillies pitcher who made fewer than 30 starts in a season
- Averaged 9.86 SO/9.0 IP (184 SO/168.0 IP), becoming the 2nd qualifying Phillie with a SO/9.0 IP that high (other: Curt Schilling, 11.29 in 1997 and 10.05 in 1998)
- Led team and set career highs in ERA (3.54), wins (12), starts (27), innings (168.0) and SO (184)
- Had 10 straight starts with 2 or fewer runs allowed (6/22-8/12), the longest such streak by a Phillie since the current mound distance was established in 1893
- His 17.0-inning scoreless streak, 6/27-7/8, was the longest by a Phillies starter in 2017

CAREER:

- Selected by the Phillies in the 1st round (7th overall) of the June 2014 draft out of Louisiana State University ... Was signed by Mike Stauffer ... Originally selected by Toronto in the 22nd round of the June 2011 draft, but did not sign
- His 23.0-inning scoreless streak, 4/22-5/8/16 remains the longest by a Phillies starter since Cole Hamels' 24.2-inning streak, 6/1-21/14
- Was the first player drafted by Philadelphia to make his ML debut the very next season since Pat Combs in 1989
