### BLUE JAYS NOTES:

- Had a walk-off win for the 8<sup>th</sup> time this year, surpassing their 2017 total (7)...Improved to 10-6 in extra-inning affairs and 23-12 in games decided in the final at-bat...Have 10 extra-inning victories in a season for the 10<sup>th</sup> time in team history (last: 2011-13)...Are now 20-12 in one-run contests...Now hold a 3-2 edge in the season series with Cleveland, as well as the all-time advantage at 208-207-2...Are back to .500 here at Rogers Centre (36-36)...Struck out 20 times, their most in a game this year (19 on 5/11 vs. BOS) and 3<sup>rd</sup> most in a game in team history...Was the team's 1<sup>st</sup> ever win while striking out 20+ times.
- MARCO ESTRADA** allowed a pair of runs on 5 hits over 6.0 innings of work...Marked his 10 quality start of the year (last: 8/4 at SEA)...Issued 2 walks while striking out 5 batters.
- KEVIN PILLAR** had the walk-off blast in the 11<sup>th</sup> inning...The solo shot travelled 440 feet...Was his 12<sup>th</sup> HR of the season and his 10<sup>th</sup> at Rogers Centre...Marked his 3<sup>rd</sup> career walk-off hit and his 2<sup>nd</sup> career walk-off HR (also 5/14/17 vs. SEA - 9th).
- ROWDY TELLEZ** doubled in the 5<sup>th</sup> inning and came around to score Toronto's 1<sup>st</sup> run...**Became the 1<sup>st</sup> player with 5-XBH in his first 7 plate appearances (courtesy STATS)**...He then doubled in a run to tie the game, 2-2, in the 7<sup>th</sup>... **Became the 1<sup>st</sup> player (since 1913) with 6 doubles in his first 3 career games...Also tied an MLB record with 6-XBH in his first 3 games** (Chris Dickerson - 6 in 2008: 4-2B, 1-3B, 1-HR)...**Became the first AL rookie to hit 6+ doubles in any 3G stretch since Joe DiMaggio did so in 1936**...Became the 4<sup>th</sup> Blue Jay all-time to begin his career with a 3+ game RBI streak.
- BILLY MCKINNEY** singled in the 8<sup>th</sup> inning...Has reached base in each of his 17 MLB games with a PA...Is now batting .344 (21-for-61) as a Major-Leaguer and has gone 20-for-57 (.351) with 5-2B, 4-HR and 11-RBI as a Blue Jay...Now has a 16G on-base streak since joining Toronto, the 3<sup>rd</sup> longest all-time to start a Blue Jays career.
- RANDAL GRICHUK** doubled and scored in the 8<sup>th</sup>...His 50.8% XBH rate (44/87) was 10<sup>th</sup> highest in the Majors entering tonight...Has now gone 20-for-57 (.351) with 7-2B, 3-HR and 6-RBI over his last 16 games.

### INDIANS NOTES:

- Fall to 2-7 in extra-inning contests this year...Are 1-1 to start the road trip and have now gone 36-33 in away contests this season.
- CARLOS CARRASCO** matched a season high with 14 strikeouts (also 5/9 at MIL)...Allowed 2 runs (1ER) over 8 full frames (6H, 1BB), his longest outing since throwing a complete game on 5/9 at MIL...Became the 3<sup>rd</sup> pitcher with two 14+ SO games this year (Gerrit Cole, Justin Verlander)...Since returning from the DL on 7/6, has posted a 2.43 ERA (21 ER/77.2 IP).
- JAN GOMES** hit a solo homer in the 6<sup>th</sup> inning to put Cleveland ahead, 2-1...Was his 13<sup>th</sup> home run of the season and his 9<sup>th</sup> to come on the road...Marked his 5<sup>th</sup> career HR vs. his former team...Also singled twice and has now gone 30-for-96 (.313) with 5-2B, 3-HR and 9-RBI over his last 26 games.
- JOSE RAMIREZ** opened the scoring with an RBI single in the 5<sup>th</sup> inning...Extended his career high in RBI to 97...Came into tonight tied with Alex Bregman (96) for 3<sup>rd</sup> most RBI in the AL.
- EDWIN ENCARNACION** singled in his 1<sup>st</sup> at-bat...Has now gone 15-for-38 (.395) with 1-2B, 1-HR and 8-RBI in 10 career games vs. Toronto.
- BRANDON GUYER** had a 4<sup>th</sup> inning double...Now has a 5G hitting streak, batting .375 (6-for-16) with 2-2B and 2-RBI over that stretch.
