SAN DIEGO NOTES

- With today's win, the Padres have swept the Mariners for the first time since June 18-19, 2014 in SD.
- **Joey Lucchesi** set career highs with 6.2 IP and 108 pitches thrown, while also recording a career-high-tying nine strikeouts (2x; last: Aug.5 at CHC)... has worked 6.0-innings-or-more in five starts this season, pitching to a 4-0 record with a 1.17 ERA (4 ER, 30.2 IP) in that time...has allowed two earned runs or less in nine of his 12 outings since being reinstated from the 10-day DL on June 20, limiting opponents to a .249 average over that span.
 - His 3.59 ERA over 105.1 IP this season is the lowest mark by a Padres rookie with at least 100.0 IP since Cory Luebke in 2011.
 - Logged his first career RBI.
- **Luis Urias** went 3-for-5, recording his first major league hit with a single in the third inning.
- **Hunter Renfro**e belted his 17th homer of the season and his ninth of August...has 26 RBI in his last 23 games since Aug.4 at CHC, which lead the National League in that time...is riding a six-game hitting streak, the longest active streak on the team (.360, 9-for-25), with a double and three home runs.
- **Eric Hosmer** logged a season-high-tying three hits (8x; last: Aug. 10 vs. PHI)...has hit safely in nine of his last 10 home games since Aug. 12 vs. PHI, batting .359 (14-for-39) with a .381 OBP and a .615 SLG.
- **Manuel Margot** went 3-for-4 and tallied his seventh home run of the season.

SEATTLE NOTES

- **Erasmus Ramirez** allowed a season high seven earned runs in today's outing, the first time he's surrendered seven-or-more runs (earned) since June 16, 2017 at DET, when he allowed eight earned runs...owns a 6-6 record with a 5.61 ERA (54 ER, 86.2 IP) in 14 career interleague starts.
- **Jean Segura** has hit safely in 13 of his 18 contests since Aug. 5, including 10 multi-hit games...is batting .373 (28-for-75) with nine runs scored, two doubles and a triple in that span.
 - Has reached base safely in 15 of his 17 games he has appeared in at Petco Park, going 24-for-68 (.353).
- **Mitch Haniger** is riding a season high 10-game hitting streak, batting .333 (14-for-42) with two doubles and five RBI during that span...leads the American League with 38 hits and 12 doubles in August.
- **Roenis Elias** tossed a career high 5.0 innings of relief, surpassing his previous career high of 4.0 IP as a reliever...logged his first career hit and first at-bat since Aug. 18, 2014.
