Homerless

LHP Sean Newcomb enters tonight's start with a 36.0-inning scoreless streak, the eighth-longest active run in the majors.

RHP Dan Winkler ranks fifth on that list, going 37.1 innings without surrendering a home run.

Chicago RHP Brandon Morrow leads the majors with a 71.0-inning streak, while the only starter with a longer run than Newcomb is St. Louis' Carlos Martinez, who has gone 36.1 innings.

TONIGHT'S GAME: The Braves and Padres continue a three-game set tonight with the second meeting between the clubs this season...San Diego will visit SunTrust Park, June 14-17 for a four-game set to conclude the teams' season series.

A The Braves have lost 15 of their last 17 games at Petco Park, getting outscored 94-44 over this stretch that dates to August 29, 2012...They won consecutive games, June 8, 2016 and June 27, 2017 for their only victories in this span.

A The Braves have hit six total home runs over this 16 game stretch, including none in their last nine games here.

A The only Braves player to homer in San Diego since the start of the 2014 season (13 total games) was Cameron Maybin on August 17, 2015.

A LHP Sean Newcomb earned his first MLB win in his only career start against San Diego...Tossed 6.0 shutout innings here in San Diego on June 27 of last season to lead Atlanta to a 3-0 win...Struck out eight and walked one in his fourth career start.

A RHP Jordan Lyles has not started against the Braves since 2014 while with Colorado (his last appearance was facing one hitter in a relief appearance on July 23, 2016)...In three appearances, two starts, against Atlanta, the right-hander has no decisions and a 2.84 ERA (4 ER/12.2 IP).

DRAFT: The Braves made two selections on Day 1 of the 2018 First-Year Player Draft last night, picking RHP Carter Stewart of Eau Gallie High School in Melbourne, Fla., eighth overall before taking OF Greyson Jenista from Wichita State University 49th.

A The Braves have now selected a pitcher with their first pick in the First-Year Players Draft for four consecutive seasons, taking RHP Kyle Wright in 2017, RHP Ian Anderson in 2016 and LHP Kolby Allard in 2015...Anderson was the last high schooler the Braves drafted in the first round prior to Stewart.

A Jenista is the highest collegiate outfielder drafted by Atlanta since 1991, when the club selected Mike Kelly out of Arizona State University second overall.

A The Braves will pick eighth in each round through the draft's conclusion.

ROSTER MOVE: The Braves today selected the contract of RHP Luke Jackson from Triple-A Gwinnett and placed RHP Julio Teheran on the 10-day disabled list with a right thumb contusion.

A Jackson joins the Braves for the third time this season...He was up from April 4-April 15 and then again from May 6-May 8.

A Jackson is 2-1 with a 1.69 ERA (4 ER/21.1 IP) in 10 games, one start, with Triple-A.

NEWCOMB: LHP Sean Newcomb has won six consecutive decisions, compiling a 2.16 ERA (14 ER/58.1 IP) over the 10-game streak that dates to April 8...The left-hander dropped his season debut before starting his hot stretch.

A Newcomb finished May 5-0 with a 1.54 ERA (6 ER/35.0 IP) and no home runs allowed in six starts.

A His five wins last month were the most in the majors, while he ran his homerless innings streak to 36.0...His 1.54 ERA ranked sixth best in the N.L., while his batting average against of .158 was the lowest in the league among qualifying pitchers.

A He allowed 19 total hits in 35.0 innings last month to become the first Braves player in the last 110 seasons to make at least six starts in a month and allow 19 hits or less...In fact, only one other Braves pitcher ever allowed just 20 hits in six starts during a calendar month: Wade Blasingame in September of 1965...Blasingame allowed 20 hits in 23.2 innings over six starts, but pitched past the fifth inning in just one start that month.

A Removing the starts requirement, only three other pitchers in the last 110 seasons went at least 35.0 innings in a calendar month and allowed 19 hits or less...The first to do so was Frank Allen in 1916 (36.0 innings, 14 hits)...Buzz Capra went 41.2 innings and allowed 18 hits over nine games, three starts, in May of 1974, while Julio Teheran allowed 17 hits in 37.2 innings in June of 2016.

A Since divisional play in 1969, only 14 other major league pitchers made at least six starts in a calendar month and threw 35.0 or more innings with 19 hits or less...The last was San Diego's Drew Pomeranz in May of 2016 (36.0 innings, 18 hits, six starts)..

MARKAKIS: OF Nick Markakis collected two more hits yesterday, running his National League-leading total to 79...Markakis is also tied for the league lead with 18 doubles.

A Among N.L. outfielders, Markakis ranks second in batting average (.331), fourth in runs (38), second in RBI (39), fifth in OPS (.888), and first in walks per strikeout (1.08, 27 walks, 25 strikeouts).

LATE GAME BRAVES: The Braves have scored 110 runs this season in the seventh inning or later, the third most such runs in the majors and the second most in the National League...Only Chicago (116) and Houston (114) have scored more.

A The Braves have hit 25 home runs in these late innings, the most in the National League.

A Dansby Swanson is second in the National League with a .348 late-inning average, trailing only Asdrubal Cabrera (.386) among qualifying players.

A The Braves have a MLB-most 46 last at-bat wins since Brian Snitker was named interim manager on May 17, 2016.

Tonight's Game

- A* Set for his 12th start of the season and the 31st of his career.
- A* Has not allowed a home run in his last 36.0 innings, dating to the bottom of the sixth in his start on 4/26 at CIN...His 36.0-inning run is the second-longest active streak by a starter in the majors, trailing just STL's Carlos Martinez (36.1 IP).
- A* Newcomb's homerless run is the longest by a Braves starter in consecutive turns since Kris Medlen tossed 43.0 consecutive homerless innings over his final six starts in 2013.
- A* David Hale logged 39.1 homerless frames from 9/13/13-6/28/14 as a starter, but surrendered a pair of home runs in relief during that stretch.
- A* Newcomb has allowed just 13 home runs over 162.2 innings since his debut last season, and his 0.72 homers per 9.0 innings in that span rank as fourth fewest in the majors.
- A* Ran his career-best winning streak to six games in his last start, 5/31 vs. WSH... The six-game run dates to his second start of the season, 4/8 at COL, and is the fourth-longest active streak in the majors.
- A* Newcomb's streak is the longest by a Braves left-handed starter since Minor Minor won seven straight from 8/25/12-4/10/13.
- A* Set to make his second career start against the Padres...Tossed 6.0 scoreless innings to beat San Diego in his only other start against them, 6/27/17 at Petco Park, to earn the first victory of his career.

2018 Recap

- A* Finished the month of May 5-0 with a 1.54 ERA (6 ER/35.0 IP) and no home runs allowed...Atlanta went 5-1 in his six starts.
- A* His five wins in the month were most in the majors, while his 1.54 ERA ranked sixth best in the N.L...His batting average against of .158 was the lowest in the league among qualifying pitchers.
- A* Newcomb allowed 19 total hits in 35.0 innings during the month, becoming the first Braves player in the last 110 seasons to make at least six starts in a month and allow 19 hits or less.
- A* Earned his sixth win of the season, 5/31vs. WSH, after holding the Nationals to four hits and two runs in a career high-tying 7.0 innings...Was his first career victory against the Nationals.
- A* Retired 14 of the final 15 batters that he faced.
- A* Faced Miami for the second consecutive turn, 5/19, and allowed four hits and one run over 6.0 innings to earn his fourth consecutive win.
- A* A run-scoring groundout by Bryan Holaday scored Justin Bour with one out in the second inning to snap Newcomb's scoreless streak at 21 consecutive innings...The run was the longest of his career...Newcomb's run was the longest by a Braves pitcher since Julio Teheran in 2016 (23.0 IP), and the longest by a left-handed starter for Atlanta since Paul Maholm in 2013 (25.1 IP)
- A* Tossed 6.0 scoreless innings and allowed a career-low one hit, 5/13 at MIA...The start was his third consecutive scoreless turn.
- A* Became the first Braves pitcher over the last 110 seasons to allow two hits or fewer and no runs in three consecutive starts.
- A* Allowed two hits and three walks over 6.0 scoreless innings, 5/8 at TB...Turned in consecutive scoreless starts for the first time in his career.
- A* Tampa Bay logged just two hits, both of which were singles...Newcomb became the first Braves starter since Greg Maddux (6/27 and 7/2/99) to log consecutive scoreless starts of at least 6.0 innings with two or fewer hits allowed.
- A* Tossed a career-most 7.0 innings, 5/2 at NYM, and held the Mets to just two hits and one walk while fanning eight...The outing was his second scoreless start of at least 6.0 innings in his last five appearances after entering the season with just one such start in his career.
- A* Went 6.0 innings, 4/26 at CIN, and held the Reds to five hits and four runs while striking out seven...All four runs he allowed came in the fifth inning, including three on a home run by Joey Votto.
- A* Earned his first win of the season, 4/8 at COL, after allowing just five hits in 6.0+ scoreless innings...Did not walk a batter for the first time in his career...Pitched into the seventh for the third time in his career after facing two batters to open the inning.
- A* Walked at least one batter in each of his first 20 career games...Since the Braves moved to Atlanta in 1966, only two other pitchers opened their careers with longer streaks of walking at least one batter - Pete Smith (29 games) and Tom Glavine (27 games).
- A* Went 4.1 innings in his season debut, 4/2 vs. WSH...Allowed five hits, six runs (five earned) and four walks to take the loss...Struck out six.
- A* Failed to complete 6.0 innings for the eighth consecutive start, dating to 8/20 of last season...Over that stretch went 3-3 with a 4.73 ERA (21 ER/40.0 IP) and 24 walks.

- A* Selected by the Los Angeles Angels of Anaheim in the first round (15th overall) of the 2014 First-Year Player Draft.

- Has just one hit in his last 18 at-bats...His double in last night's seventh inning snapped a 0-for-16 hitless spell.
- Leads the N.L. in extra-base hits (33), runs (50) and total bases (131)...Is tied for third in home runs (14) and doubles (17), is fourth in hits (67), and is 12th in slugging (.506).
- Ranks second in MLB with nine games with multiple extra-base hits...Is over half way to the Atlanta franchise record for most such games in a season, shared by Chipper Jones and Javy Lopez (17).
- Is hitting .356 (21-for-59) in the first inning this season...His 21 hits and 11 extra base-hits in the first inning are the most in the N.L., while his six home runs are tied for the most in the N.L.
- Set the franchise record for most extra-base hits (22) by the end of April and tied for the second most in MLB history...Broke the Atlanta record of 17 held by Dale Murphy, Chipper Jones and Justin Upton...Finished one shy of Jermaine Dye's 2000 record.
- Hit his first career grand slam, 5/10 at MIA, becoming the youngest Braves player (21 years, 123 days) to hit one since fellow Curaçao native Andruw Jones, 8/31/97 at BOS.

- Hit .277 (26-for-94) in 24 games with the Strippers.
- Became the first Braves player to come off the bench to drive in the eventual game-winning run and collect multiple hits and RBI since 2007, when Matt Diaz went 2-for-3 with four RBI in a 9-8 win vs. PHI on 9/5...Bourjos went 2-for-3, 4/11 at WSH.

- Homered with a runner aboard for his fourth career game-ending home run, Sunday, 6/3 vs. WSH...Also hit a game-ending pinch-home run on 5/28 vs. NYM (G1) for his first home run with the Braves...Since the Braves moved to Atlanta in 1996, the only other Braves player to hit a game-ending pinch-hit home run for his first homer with the team was Keith Lockhart on 5/21/97.
- With Sunday's, 6/3, home run, he became the first player in Atlanta-era history with two pinch-hit game-ending home runs in the same season...In fact, only one Braves player, Brian Hunter, had two such homers over his career...The last major league player with two such homers in a season was Jason Giambi for the 2013 Indians.
- All of Culberson's game-ending RBI have come on home runs and four of his eight career home runs have been game-ending shots.
- Has made 14 starts (7 at 3B, 5 in LF; 2 at SS)...The team is 9-5 when he starts.
- Is 4-for-17 (.235) as a pinch hitter with nine strikeouts and two home runs.
- Acquired from LAD along w/three other players, 12/16/17 in exchange for M. Kemp.
- Played in 10 total postseason games in 2017, including five during the NLCS and five WS contests...Hit a combined .500 (8-for-16) with four extra-base hits.
