NEW YORK YANKEES NOTES

- The Yankees are 2-2 on their six-game homestand...dropped into second place in the AL East, 1.0G behind Boston (W, 4-3, at Washington)...have alternated wins and losses over their last 6G.
 - Are still a Major League-best 31-13 (.705) at home...marked just their fourth loss in 15 home series openers this season.
 - Dropped to 4-4 in extra innings this season...fell to 8-2 when tied after six innings.
 - Are 7-6 in Interleague play this season, including 2-3 at home.
- According to *Elias*, tonight's game marked the third time since the advent of Interleague play in 1997 that the teams with the AL's and NL's best records met this late into the season (Kansas City at St. Louis, 1G on 7/23/15; and Arizona at Seattle, 3G from 7/15-17/01).
- **RF Aaron Judge** (1-for-4, 2BB) hit a solo homer in the first inning for the second straight game...has homered in four of his last 6G...his 23HR are tied with Francisco Lindor for fourth-most in the Majors (J.D. Martinez-25, José Ramirez-24, Mike Trout-24).
 - Is batting .354/.480/.734 (56-for-158) with 39R, 12 doubles, 16HR, 42RBI and 39BB in 44G at home this season...are the Majors' second-most HRs at home (J.D. Martinez-17HR).
 - Has now homered against 21 of the 25 opposing teams he has faced in his career (0HR vs. CHC/CIN/STL/WAS).
- **2B Gleyber Torres** (3-for-4, 2R, 1 double, 1BB) set a career high with 3H, his 18th career multi-hit game...hit his 10th career double in the third...has hit safely in all 4G on the homestand, batting .467 (7-for-15) with 4R, 1 double, 1 triple, 1HR, 4RBI and 2BB.
- **CF Aaron Hicks** (2-for-5) hit a pair of doubles...has 5XBH in the last 2G (2 doubles, 3HR)...marks the first time in his career he has had multiple XBHs in consecutive games.
- **Yankees batters** went 0-for-12 with RISP...marked their most ABs with RISP without a hit this season...entering today, their .250 BA with RISP ranked 14th out of 30 Major League clubs.
- **RHP Jonathan Loaisiga** (4.0IP, 5H, 3ER, 0BB, 3K, 1HR) made his fourth career start and took a no-decision...allowed a solo HR to Camargo in the third and 2R on three consecutive doubles by Markakis/Suzuki/Acuña in the fourth...marked the third time in the last 5G that the Yankees starter failed to reach the fifth inning.
 - Allowed 4XBH (3 doubles, 1HR) in his final 2.0IP tonight after permitting just 1XBH (double) over his first 16.0 career innings.
- **Yankees relievers** threw scoreless innings from the fifth through 10th innings before allowing 2R in the 11th...retired 11 consecutive batters from the second out in the sixth through the third out in the ninth.
- **RHP Jonathan Holder** (2.0IP, 2H, 1K) was scoreless for the 24th time in 25 appearances since being recalled on 4/21...has a 0.29 ERA (30.2IP, 4R/1ER) over that span.
- **RHP Chad Green** (2.0IP, 1K) retired all 6BF...extended his scoreless streak to 14.1IP (9H, 3BB, 17K) over 11 appearances (since 5/25).
 - Marked Holder's and Green's sixth scoreless appearances of at least 2.0IP this season, tied with each other for the team lead.
- **LHP Aroldis Chapman** (1.0IP, 3K) struck out all 3BF in the ninth...threw his fastest pitch of the season at 104.4 mph, ball two to Acuña (per Statcast).
- **RHP Dellin Betances** (1.0IP, 1H, 1BB, 1K) tossed a scoreless 10th...allowed a leadoff single to Johan Camargo in the 10th, snapping his 0-for-29 streak against opposing batters (since Devon Travis's single on 6/6 at Toronto)...also ended stretches of 1-for-45 (since 5/23) and 2-for-63 (since 5/10).
- **RHP David Robertson** (1.0IP, 1H, 2R/1ER, 1K, 1HR) took the loss after giving up Acuña's two-run HR in the 11th...was his first HR allowed to a right-handed batter since Adam Rosales on 6/25/17 w/ Chicago-AL vs. Oakland; faced 182 RHB in between HRs.

ATLANTA BRAVES NOTES

- The Braves improved 4-0 on their current 10-game road trip...at 49-34, have the NL's best record...are now 26-17 on the road this season and 6-5 in Interleague games...moved to a season-high 15 games over .500, the first time reaching that mark since the end of the 2013 season...improved to 3-7 in extra-inning games this season...are 43-12 when scoring four-or-more runs this season.
 - Are now 13-19 all-time vs. the Yankees, including a 3-1 mark at the current Yankee Stadium.
 - Moved to 29-9 when their starting pitcher goes at least 6.0IP.
- **Braves batters** hit three straight doubles in the fourth...lead the NL with 176 team doubles and entered the night with the second-most doubles in the Majors (Boston-180).
- **RHP Aníbal Sánchez** (6.0IP, 6H, 3ER, 2BB, 4K, 1HR, 2WP) is winless in his last three starts...allowed 6H tonight, snapping a seven-start streak of allowing 5H-or-fewer...tied a career high with 2WP (seventh time, last on 4/17/16 with Detroit at Houston)...was his fourth quality start of the season.
 - Has completed at least 6.0IP with 3R-or-fewer in his last five starts vs. the Yankees, going 3-0 with a 3.00 ERA (33.0IP, 11ER) over the span...is 4-0 with a 2.78 ERA (32.1IP, 10ER) in five career starts at Yankee Stadium.
- **LF Ronald Acuña Jr.** (2-for-5, 1R, 1HR, 3RBI, 3K) hit a go-ahead, two-run home run in the 11th...at 20 years, 196 days old, is the youngest Braves rookie to hit a game-winning, extra-inning home run since Andruw Jones (20 years, 3 days) on 4/26/1997 vs. San Diego in the 10th inning...has six game-winning RBI this season, tied for second-most on the team (Ozzie Albies, 8RBI)...was his first career extra-inning home run and third by a Braves player this season (also Ozzie Albies on 6/25/18 vs. Cincinnati in the 11th and Kurt Suzuki on 4/11/18 at Washington in the 11th)...was his second home run in his last three games and third home run in his last six games...tied a career high with 3RBI (second time, also on 5/20/18 vs. Miami)...the Braves are 9-3 this season when he has at least 1RBI.
- **3B Johan Camargo** (2-for-5, 1R, 1HR, 1RBI) hit his first home run since 6/19 at Toronto (39AB)...extended his career-long hitting streak to eight games, batting .361 (13-for-36) with 5R, 2 doubles, 1HR and 6RBI over the span (since 6/24).
- **DH Nick Markakis** (2-for-5, 1R, 1 double) recorded his 35th multi-hit game of the season, tied for the most such games in the Majors this season (also Seattle's Jean Segura)...is just the second Braves batter since 1975 to record 35 multi-hit games through the team's first 83 games in a season (also: Martin Prado-38 multi-hit games in 2010).
 - Hit his 27th double of the season in the fourth...has 142 doubles since the start of the 2015 season, third-most in the Majors over the span (Boston's Mookie Betts-151 doubles and Houston's Jose Altuve-143 doubles).
 - Is hitting .339 (58-for-171) in 43 games on the road this season, the second-highest road batting average in the NL.
- **2B Ozzie Albies** (0-for-4, 1BB, 1K) had his 11-game hit streak snapped...had been the NL's longest active hit streak.
- **RHP Dan Winkler** (1.0IP 1H, 1BB, 2K) tossed a scoreless eighth...has not allowed a run in his last five games (5.0IP).
