DON'T KEEP IT 100: Last night, the Padres snapped their seven-game losing streak and won their 100th game at Wrigley Field in club history (100-140 overall)...SD is 7-11 in the first game of the series on the road (in comparison to their 1-17 record at home in Game 1 of a series)...starter **Robbie Erlin** allowed just one run (earned) on two hits in 5.0 innings of work, claiming his second win of the season...at the plate, **Austin Hedges** and **Manuel Margot** recorded three hits apiece, marking the fourth time in 2018 in which two Padres had three-or-more hits in the same game.

ROSS CAN, YOU DON'T HAVE TO TURN ON THE RED LIGHT: Starter **Tyson Ross** is set to toe the rubber for his fourth-career appearance (third start) at Wrigley Field, where he owns a 2.63 ERA (4 er, 13.2 ip) and a .196 opponent average...at Wrigley, the Cubs have a collective .580 OPS (.305 OBP and .275 SLG) against Ross.

THE 'PEN IS MIGHTIER THAN THE SWORD: The Padres bullpen's 2.39 ERA (14 er, 52.2 ip) since the All-Star break is tied with PHI for the best ERA in the majors... opposing bats are hitting just .211 against them in that time, they're slugging .289 against them (a ML-best) and their 59 strikeouts are second-most to Tampa Bay's 69.

GETTING AHEAD: Friar relievers have thrown a first pitch strike more often than any bullpen in the majors this season with a 63.3 first-strike percentage.

YOU SHALL NOT HOMER: Since the inception of the 2017 season, the Padres have allowed just eight home runs to the Cubs, the fewest of any National League team in that time (though the Padres 12 homers vs. the Cubs rank fourth-fewest of any NL club)...SD's ERA vs. CHC in that time is 3.34 and also ranks second-best in the NL behind LAD's 2.90 ERA.

NL-CENTRALLY LOCATED: The Padres pitching staff has a 3.85 ERA vs. NL Central opposition this season, which is the best ERA they've accrued against any one division...the Cubs .379 SLG against SD this season is the second-lowest among NL teams this years, higher than just MIA's .345 SLG

SEEING IT WELL: Since the beginning of July, Padre hitters have seen an average of 3.95 pitches per plate appearance, which are the second-most in that span of any NL team behind LAD's 4.01 mark.

GALVANIZED: **Freddy Galvis'** career .509 slugging percentage at Wrigley Field (seven doubles, a triple and a homer) is the seventh-highest of any shortstop at Wrigley since 1916, minimum 50 plate appearances.

THE WONDERFUL WORLD OF HOZ: **Eric Hosmer** is riding a nine-game hitting streak since July 23 (.333), which is his longest streak as a Padre...prior to his hitting spree, he hit just .123 in July (9-for-73).

FINDING COMFORT IN THE IVY: Over Padres past 11 games at Wrigley (dating back to July 24, 2014), SD starters are 5-2 (.714), having thrown six quality starts with an ERA of 3.39 (22 er, 58.1 ip).

PADRES ON DECK: Last night for Fort Wayne (A), LHP **MacKenzie Gore** allowed two hits and two walks while striking out eight over 5.0 scoreless innings...for El Paso (AAA), 2B **Luis Urias** went 3-for-5 with a triple, a RBI and a run scored, and RF **Franmil Reyes** went 2-for-5 with a three-run homer and two runs scored...Reyes is hitting .324 for the Chihuahuas with 18 homers.

STARTING PITCHER NOTES

#38 RHP TYSON ROSS (6-8, 4.41) @TysonRoss

TYSON'S TURN: 31-year-old RHP **Tyson Ross** is set to make his 22nd second start of the season today and his first at Wrigley Field since April 18, 2015.

- In his four career appearances (three starts) against the Cubs, he is 1-1 with a 3.05 ERA (7 ER, 20.2 IP) with 31 strikeouts against 11 walks while limiting opposing hitters to a .192 average.
- Has been quality in two of his three starts at Wrigley Field, posting a 1-0 record with a 2.63 ERA

LAST TIME OUT: Did not factor into the Padres' 9-4 defeat on 7/28 vs. ARI, tossing 5.0 IP of four-run ball.

ROAD WARRIOR: Among all pitchers with at least 67.0 IP on the road this season, Ross' .222 opponent average ranks ninth and his 9.31 SO/9 IP ratio ranks eighth.

A GAME OF STREAKS: The Padres won each of his six starts from 5/12-6/9...Ross was 3-0 with a 3.15 ERA (12 ER, 34.1 IP) with three quality starts and three runs or less in all six starts over the stretch.

- Made four consecutive starts on the road from 6/9-26 for the first time in his career, posting a 3.33 ERA and a .209 opponent average.
- The Padres have lost six of Tyson's last nine starts since 7/28...he is 1-5 with a 6.04 ERA (32 ER, 47.2 IP) with 34 strikeouts against 24 walks over the stretch.

ROSS' ARSENAL: Ross has used five pitches this season: four seamer (45%), slider (43.7%), sinker (6.7%), cutter (4.3%) and changeup (0.2%)

SLIDER CENTRAL: Ross has thrown a ML-leading 875 sliders this season, just 27 fewer than his four-seamer (902)...opposing bats have hit just .183 vs. his slider in '18, which is the lowest average against this pitch since opponents hit .141 against his slider in 2013.

SPLITS ON SPLITS: Lefties have hit .294 this year vs. Ross, while righties have hit .175...in his career prior to this season, lefties have hit .260 against him and righties .240.

HELP ME HELP YOU: Two starts ago, Tyson received a season-high seven runs of support his last on 7/22 at PHI, the most he's received since also getting seven in his first outing as a Texas Ranger on 6/6/17 vs. SEA.

- This season, he's received two runs or less in nine of his 21 outings this season and three runs or less in 14 of his 21 outings.
- Tyson's 3.88 run support average is the 16th-lowest among all qualifying ML starting pitchers and sixth-lowest among NL starters.
- His 51 total runs of support (runs scored while he's in the game) are tied for the 11th-fewest among all ML pitchers with at least 110.0 IP and third fewest among all NL starters.

QUALI-TY-SON: Has 11 quality starts in his 21 outings, tying him for the 11th-most in the NL...SD is 8-3 when he has a quality outing and 12-9 overall in games which Ross starts.

CHASE'N HISTORY: Earlier this season on 4/20 at Chase Field, Ross took a no-hitter into the eighth inning behind a career-high 127 pitches, tied for the second-most in a single game this season.

- Has tossed 100-or-more pitches in 11 of his 21 outings this season, including five straight from 5/1-23, the longest stretch of his career and the longest by a Padre since James Shields in '16 (May 2-25).

TOMORROW'S STARTER

JOEY'S UP NEXT: LHP Joey Lucchesi is set to make his 17th start of the season and first of his career against the Cubs and at Wrigley Field tomorrow.
• Allowed a career-high five runs behind a career-high three home runs allowed in 4.1 IP in the Padres' 5-4 loss on 7/20 vs. ARI.
• In his seven starts since 6/20 and being reinstated from the 10-day DL with a right hip strain, he is 2-4 with a 4.55 ERA (15 ER, 29.2 IP), allowing two earned runs or less in five of those outings.
