RECENT REDBIRDS: The Cardinals improved their home stand mark to a perfect 4-0 yesterday with an 8-6 come-from-behind win in 10 innings...the Cardinals began the day in 1st place in the N.L. Central, 1/2-game in front of 2nd place Milwaukee...the Cardinals +30 run differential is 3rd best in the Senior Circuit.

BETTER AT BUSCH: After going 44-37 (.543) at home last season and 38-43 (.469) in 2016, the Cardinals are off to a 11-5 (.688) start at Busch this season (matching Philadelphia for the N.L.'s best home mark) and have won 9 of their last 10 at home, including six straight, matching their longest home win streak (5/31-6/13) for all of 2017.

COMEBACK CARDS: The Cardinals have scored 43 of their 143 runs this season after the 6th inning, including 19 in the 7th inning...they've won 3 games when trailing after 7 innings and 2 games when down after 8...last year, they were 9-61 when trailing after 7 and 3-63 when trailing after 8...they've scored 12 of their 34 total runs in the 7th inning or later during their current six-game home win streak and have won three of those games in walk-off fashion.

PITCHERS HOME WORK: The Cardinals pitching staff is leading the majors with their 2.82 ERA (153.0 IP/48 ER) at home in 16 games and they are the only team in the majors to have allowed fewer than 10 HR's at home, having allowed just 9.

SUNDAY NIGHT BASEBALL: The Cardinals played eight ESPN Sunday Night games in 2017 and are 54-54 all-time on the nationally televised Sunday Night Game of the Week.

FROM ONE TO 100: The Cardinals took a 1-0 lead in the 6th inning last Wed. via the first career home run by pitcher **Carlos Martínez**. **Dexter Fowler** pushed the lead to 3-0 with his 100th career homer in the 7th inning...**Matt Carpenter** tied Tue. night's game at 2-2 in the 9th inning with his 100th career homer.

BOMBIN' BIRDIES: The Cardinals rank T3rd in the N.L. (Colorado 44; Washington 43) with their 39 home runs...through 31 games, the Cardinals have homered in 23 games and are 17-6 in games when they do homer.

AN APRIL FOR THE AGES: **Carlos Martínez** finished the month of April with a 0.54 ERA (33.1 IP/2 ER) the best April ever by a Cardinals pitcher (min. 30 IP) dating to 1913...**Jesse Haines** had a 1.00 April mark in 1927 (36.0 IP/4 ER).

MILESTONE MANAGER: Cardinals Manager **Mike Matheny** managed his 1,000th regular season game with the Cardinals last Tue., becoming only the 4th Cardinals manager (**Tony La Russa**, **Red Schoendienst**, **Whitey Herzog**) to pilot the club in 1,000 or more regular season games...Matheny is 563-440 (.561 win pct.) at the helm, taking the Cardinals to the postseason in 4 of his 6 seasons.

TRIPLES TRIVIA: The Cardinals are the only MLB team without a triple this season...St. Louis' 31-game start to the season without a three-bagger is a franchise high, surpassing their 2015 start of 15 triple-less games...San Francisco went without a triple in a Major League-record first 41 games in 1982.

BULLISH PEN: Cardinals relievers have inherited 64 runners this season (T1st in the N.L. with Atlanta) and have stranded 50, giving them the league's best inherited runners pct. (21.9)...they have .220 Opp. BA with RISP & just one HR allowed...their 23 Holds rank 3rd in the N.L. behind Arizona (28) & Colorado (24).

Cardinals outfielder **Dexter Fowler** played the 2015-16 seasons with Chicago...initially became a Cub via trade by the Astros for pitcher **Dan Straily** and infielder **Luis Valbuena**.

Cardinals pitcher **Luke Gregerson** was born in and resides in nearby Park Ridge, Ill. ...graduated from Morton High School in Berwyn, Ill. ...played college baseball at St. Xavier University (Ill.).

Cubs pitcher **Tyler Chatwood** was teammates in Colorado with **Dexter Fowler** (2012-13) and **Greg Holland** (2017).

Cardinals pitcher **Bud Norris** (July 29, 2009 with Houston), infielder **Matt Carpenter** (June 4, 2011), second baseman **Kolten Wong** (August 13, 2016), pitcher **Luke Weaver** (August 13, 2016) all made their Major League debuts against the Cubs.

Cardinals infielder **Paul DeJong** graduated from nearby Antioch (Ill.) Community High School...played three seasons at Illinois State University (2013-15) while majoring in bio-chemistry and pre-medicine.

Cardinals Assistant Hitting Coach **Bill Mueller** previously served as the Cubs 2014 Hitting Coach...played parts of two seasons with Chicago (2001-02)...traded by the Giants to the Cubs for pitcher **Tim Worrell** (November 18, 2000).

Cubs outfielder **Jason Heyward** played the 2015 season with St. Louis...originally traded by Atlanta with pitcher **Jordan Walden** to St. Louis for pitchers **Tyrell Jenkins** & **Shelby Miller** (November 17, 2014).

Cubs pitcher **Brandon Morrow** was a teammate of **Brett Cecil** in Toronto (2010-14) and **Jedd Gyorko** in San Diego (2016).

Cubs utility man **Ben Zobrist** graduated from nearby Eureka (Ill.) High School.

Cubs pitcher **Steve Cishek** appeared in 27 games with St. Louis during the second half of the 2015 season...originally traded by the Marlins to St. Louis for pitcher **Kyle Barraclough** (July 24, 2015).

Cubs infielder **Efren Navarro** played for the Memphis Redbirds (AAA) during the 2016 season.

Cubs Bullpen Coach **Lester Strode** pitched for the Triple-A Louisville Redbirds (1987-88) in the Cardinals' minor league organization.

Cubs Catching Coach **Mike Borzello** played four seasons (1991-94) in the Cardinals minor league system...originally selected by St. Louis in 1991.

Cubs Director, Player Development **Jaron Madison** previously served as the Cardinals Assistant Director of Scouting from 2008-09.

- Makes his seventh start of the season and the 119th of his career (128th appearance).
- His next win will be the 50th of his career. Is attempting to become the 11th-youngest Cardinals pitcher to reach the 50-win milestone (since 1900).
- Tied for second in the National League in wins (nine others), behind Max Scherzer (6).
- His four-game active win streak is T2nd in the National League (Scherzer currently 5).
- Received 25 runs of support while on the mound; his 6.96 run support average is the 7th-highest mark in the NL (Miles Mikolas is 6th at 6.98).

LAST TIME OUT

- Allowed 2 walks and 2 runs in the 4th inning of 5/1 start vs. White Sox and was on the hook for loss before Cardinals rallied with two 9th inning runs for 3-2 walk-off win.

- Went 4-0 in April for the second time in his career; also did so in 2015 in route to a 17-7 season.
- Won his 4th consecutive start in St. Louis' 9-1 win over the Mets on 4/25 at Busch Std.
- Recorded strikeout No. 600 (Michael Conforto, swinging) in the 1st inning of his 5/25 start vs. NYM...became the 5th youngest pitcher in Cardinals history to reach milestone.
- Opposing left-handed hitters are 14-for-67 (.226) with two doubles, while right-handers are 16-for-60 (.267) with three doubles and two home runs.
- Beat Cincinnati in consecutive starts (4/12 & 4/20), improving to 10-1 lifetime in 16 starts against the Reds.

CAREER

- Of his 118 career starts, 72 have been at least 6.0 innings (66 quality).
- His .613 winning percentage (49-31) over the past six seasons (2013-2018) ranks 11th among National League pitchers.
- Is a lifetime 27-12 with a 3.53 ERA in 61 starts (36 quality starts) at Busch Stadium...his .692 home win pct. ranks 8th in the NL since 2013.
- Earned 2015 Major League All-Star selection (Manager's selection) for the NL.
- Was voted MVP of 2013 National League Championship Series vs. LAD as a rookie.

- Matched single-season career-high (2015) with 30 starts (165.2 IP) while reaching double-digit wins (12) for the second time in his career. Also established a career best 158 strikeouts, 2nd-most on the club.
