NEW YORK YANKEES NOTES

- The Yankees went 4-2 on their six-game homestand...are a Major League-best 33-13 (.717) at home, including 28-8 in 36 games since 4/21.
 - Are 9-6 in Interleague play this season, including 4-3 at home.
 - Are 28G over .500, tying their season high (also 50-22 at the end of play on 6/21)
 - Are 40-5 (.889) when scoring first this season.
 - Are 18-1-2 in their last 21 home series (since 8/31/17), going 47-17 in 64G over that span.
 - Since their only home series loss of the season (1-3 vs. Baltimore from 4/5-8 vs. Baltimore), are 11-0-2 in 13 home series, their longest streak without dropping a series at home since going 20-0-5 over 25 home series from 9/15/97-8/16/98... are 11-0-1 in 12 home series since 4/19.
- LHP CC Sabathia** (6.0IP, 5H, 2ER, 3BB, 5K, 1HR, 2HP) started an earned his sixth win of the season...allowed a solo HR to Camargo in the sixth inning, snapping a four-start homerless stretch (25.2IP from 6/12-29)...in his last five starts (since 6/5), is 4-2 with a 2.09 ERA (38.2IP, 9ER).
 - Marked his 243rd career win, tying Juan Marichal (243) for 53rd place on Baseball's all-time wins list.
 - Tossed 103 pitches, his most in a game since 9/29/16 vs. Boston (105).
- RF Giancarlo Stanton** (1-for-4) hit a three-run HR in the third inning...has homered in back-to-back games for the third time this season.
 - Is hitting .267 (87-for-326) with 51R, 16 doubles, 1 triple, 21HR, 51RBI and 31BB in 83 games this season...in his first 83 games of 2017, owned a .270 (84-for-311) batting average with 54R, 16 doubles, 23HR, 54RBI and 37BB.
 - Is hitting .378 (17-for-45) with 7R, 4 doubles, 3HR, 9RBI and 4BB in his last 11 games (since 6/23).
 - Has 5RBI in his last 2G.
- C Kyle Higashioka** (1-for-3, 1HR) is the second Yankee in franchise history to have his first three Major League hits go for home runs, joining Alfonso Soriano (first 3H were HRs from 9/24/99-4/9/00)...is the first Major League player to have his first three Major League hits go for home runs since Colorado's Trevor Story (first 4H were HRs from 4/4-6/16).
- RF Aaron Judge** (1-for-4) hit a solo HR in the seventh...has 3HR in his last 4G, 4HR in his last 6G and 5HR in his last 8G.
 - Is hitting .316/.415/.608 (25-for-79) with 17R, 5 doubles, 6HR, 12RBI and 14BB in 21G since 6/12.
 - Is batting .355/.478/.735 (59-for-166) with 42R, 12 doubles, 17HR, 43RBI and 40BB in 46G at home this season.
- RHP Chad Green** (1.0IP, 2H) tossed a scoreless seventh inning...has not allowed a run in his last 12 games, posting a career-long 15.1-inning scoreless streak since 5/25 (11H, 3BB, 17K).
- RHP Dellin Betances** (1.0IP, 1H, 2K) tossed a scoreless eighth inning...over his last 17G, has allowed just 3H with 28K (16.2IP, 10BB, 2HP)...his 17-appearance scoreless stretch is the second-longest of his career (18G from 7/8-8/18/15, 20.1IP)...has an active 16.2-inning scoreless streak.
- 2B Gleber Torres** (0-for-2) left the game in the top of the fourth inning with right hip tightness...will undergo a precautionary MRI later today.
- The Yankees have 15 sellouts in 46 gates at Yankee Stadium in 2018...are their most since they had 16 in 2014...have drawn sellouts in six of their last eight home games and eight of their last 11.
- The Yankees are 33-30 on the Fourth of July in the Expansion Era (since 1961)... have won five of their last seven Fourth of July games since 2012 and are 7-3 in their last 10 since 2009... are playing at home on July 4th for the second straight year (lost, 4-1, on 7/4/17 vs. Toronto).
 - Today marked just their second July 4th Interleague matchup (lost to the Mets, 6-4, at Shea Stadium in 2004).
 - To celebrate Independence Day, the Colors were presented by the West Point United States Army Garrison Color Guard and the National Anthem was sung by United States Military Academy Band Vocalist Master Sergeant Mary Kay Messenger...as part of the Yankees' Field of Dreams program, children from TAPS (Tragedy Assistance Program for Survivors) who have lost a parent in combat took the field with the Yankees for the anthem.

ATLANTA BRAVES NOTES

- The Braves fell to 4-2 on their current 10-game road trip...are 26-19 on the road this season...are 13 games over .500, 2G shy of their season high...fell to 7-6-3 in road series this season...fell to 19-10 in day games this season...are now 41-5 when outhitting their opponent this season.
 - Are now 13-21 all-time vs. the Yankees, including a 3-3 mark at the current Yankee Stadium.
 - Fell to 6-7 in Interleague games this season...are 14-9 over their last 23 games in American League parks, including 5-5 this season.
- **RHP Julio Teheran** (5.0IP, 5H, 5ER, 4BB, 10K, 2HR) registered his 10th career double-digit strikeout game and second this season (also 11K on 6/17/18 vs. San Diego)...has given up at least 4ER in three of his last five starts and is 2-3 with a 5.61 ERA (25.2IP, 16ER) over the span...has allowed multiple home runs in four of his last five *road* starts (9HR total).
 - Tied a season high with 4BB (second time, also on 4/9 at Washington)...has issued 3BB-or-more in 12 starts, tied for the most such starts in Baseball this season (also Chicago-NL's Tyer Chatwood).
 - Has received two runs of support or fewer in 12-of-17 starts this season, including eight straight starts (since 5/20 vs. Miami).
 - Is now 6-12 with a 5.51 ERA (127.1IP, 78ER) in 22 Interleague starts.
 - In two career starts vs. the Yankees, is 0-2 with a 12.54 ERA (9.1IP, 13ER).
- **3B Johan Camargo** (1-for-3, 1R, 1HR, 1RBI, 1BB, 1K) hit his second home run in his last three games...extended his career-long hit streak to 10 games and is hitting .357 (15-for-42) over the streak...has scored a run in three straight games
- **2B Ozzie Albies** (3-for-5, 1SB) registered his 100th hit of the season with his fifth-inning single...along with Nick Markakis and Freddie Freeman, are the first Braves trio to each register 100 hits prior to the All-Star Break in franchise history...was his team-high ninth 3+ hit game, tied for fourth-most in the NL.
- **CF Ender Inciarte** (2-for-4, 1R, 1BB, 1SB) stole his 23rd base of the season, setting a career high (previous: 22SB in 2017)...is one of three players to record 20 steals-or-more in each of the last two seasons (also Trea Turner and Dee Gordon).
- **LF/1B Charlie Culberson** (2-for-4) hit two doubles today, tying a career high (second time, also on 4/9/16 at San Francisco with Los Angeles-NL).
- **1B Freddie Freeman** (0-for-1, 1HP) left today's game in the fourth with a right upper arm contusion.
