The Braves tied their season-high total with 19 hits Tuesday night...They also finished with 19 hits on March 31 in a 15-2 win over Philadelphia.

The 19 hits are tied for the most the club has had in Atlanta since 2007, when that team finished with 22 twice: June 27 and August 2.

The Atlanta franchise overall record for hits in a game is 25, done on May 1, 1985 at Cincinnati.

**TONIGHT'S GAME:** The Braves and Mets open a four-game set tonight with the 13th meeting between the teams this season...The Braves will return here September 25-27 for three more games in the penultimate series of the season.

*A* The Braves won all three games in their first trip to New York this season, outscoring the Mets 21-2 and holding their rivals scoreless over the final 18.0 innings of the series.

*A* The Braves have won nine of the 12 games with New York this season...The club has won double-digit games against the Mets in 11 of the last 17 seasons...The franchise record for most wins in a season over the Mets is 14, first set by the 1964 and matched by the 1966 club.

*A* RHP Mike Foltynewicz has never beaten the Mets, going 0-1 with a 7.04 ERA in four career games, three starts...The right-hander did toss 5.0 scoreless innings in his lone start against the Mets this season.

**ROSTER MOVE:** The Braves today activated RHP Kevin Gausman after optioning RHP Wes Parsons to Triple-A Gwinnett postgame last night...Gausman will wear No. 45.

*A* The Braves acquired Gausman and RHP Darren O'Day from the Baltimore Orioles in exchange for minor leaguers RHP Evan Phillips, INF Jean Carlos Encarnación, C Brett Cumberland, LHP Bruce Zimmerman and international signing slots on Tuesday.

*A* Gausman, 27, went 5-8 with a 4.43 ERA (61 ER/124.0 IP) in 21 games, all starts, for Baltimore this season, leading the Orioles staff in starts and innings pitched.

*A* The 6-foot-3, 200-pound native of Centennial, Co., played his entire six-year career in Baltimore, and went 39-51 with a 4.22 ERA (358 ER/763.2 IP) over 150 games, 127 starts, with the Orioles.

*A* The right-hander set career highs in wins (11), innings (186.2) and strikeouts (179) last season, while tying for the major league lead with 34 starts.

**TWO-OUT RUNS:** The Braves scored six times with two outs on Tuesday night, and now have 202 such runs this season, tied for the second most in the National League...Only Milwaukee has scored more with 206.

*A* The Braves also have a two-out slash line of .271/.440/.355, which leads the National League in all three categories.

*A* 1B Freddie Freeman (54 hits) and OF Nick Markakis (50) are first and second in the N.L. in two-out hits.

**LOTS OF GAMES:** The Braves are set to play 26 games in the next 25 days and 42 games over the next 42 days.

*A* The Braves last night had their fifth game rained out at SunTrust Park since the stadium opened last season...They will make up that game against Miami on August 13 with a split doubleheader.

*A* The Braves will also play a split doubleheader on Tuesday in Washington.

*A* The Braves' other postponed home game this season will be made up on August 30 vs. Chicago (NL).

**VS. THE N.L. EAST:** The Braves improved to 31-16 (.660) against the National League East this season with Tuesday's 11-6 win...The club has a +85 run differential against the division this season and have gone 11-2-3 in intradivision series play this season.

*A* Only Boston (.702) and Cleveland (.681) have better intradivision records.

*A* The Braves went 33-43 (.434) against their own division last season, including 11-8 against the Marlins.

*A* The Braves have not had a winning intradivision record since 2014, when they went 40-36...Over the three previous seasons, the club went 103-124 (.454) against the N.L. East.

**WINNING STREAK:** The Braves have won three straight games for the first time since a four-game run, June 29-July 2...Their season-best streak is a five-game run, April 28-May 3.

**ACUÑA JR. LEADING OFF:** OF Ronald Acuña Jr. finished 3-for-5 Tuesday night with his 11th home run of the season, and since moving to the leadoff spot on July 20 in Washington for the first game out of the All-Star break, the rookie is hitting .333 (13-for-39) with three doubles, four home runs, a .422 on-base percentage and a .718 slugging percentage (1.140 OPS).

*A* Acuña Jr.'s drive came in the first inning, and marked the fourth lead-off home run of the season for Atlanta...2B Ozzie Albies has three.

*A* The last Braves club with more than four lead-off homers in a season was the 2014 team, which had five...The Atlanta franchise record is seven, first set by the 1984 team...The 1996 and 2013 teams matched that mark.

**MULTIPLE HOMERS:** The Braves hit three home runs Tuesday, tying their season-high total for SunTrust Park...They also hit three home runs on Opening Day, March 29 vs. Philadelphia.

*A* The Braves hit two home runs in the first game of this series, and have multiple homers in consecutive home games for just the second time this season... They hit two on June 3 vs. Washington and then again on June 12 vs. New York.

#### Tonight's Game

- A* Set to make his 21st start of the season and the 86th of his career...Is his 106th career appearance.
- A* Set to face the Mets for just the fifth time in his career...Is 0-1 with a 7.04 ERA (12 ER/15.1 IP) in four games (three starts) against them.
- A* Tossed 5.0 scoreless innings against them this season, 6/12 at SunTrust Park, allowing two hits and one walk while fanning six...Threw just 73 pitches before exiting with right triceps tightness.
- A* Foltyniewicz has made 89 appearances with Atlanta since the club acquired him in January of 2015, but has pitched just three times against New York while with the Braves...Atlanta has played the Mets 69 times since acquiring Foltyniewicz, and 31 Braves pitchers have made four or more appearances against New York in that span.
- A* Has allowed 18 runs over his last four starts...Allowed just 20 earned runs in his first 16 turns of the season.
- A* Of the 18 runs he has allowed in his last three starts, 16 of them have come in four different innings...Allowed five runs in the third on 7/6 at MIL, five runs in the seventh on 7/11 vs. TOR, three in the first on 7/22 at WSH, and three in the fourth on 7/27 vs. LAD.
- A* In the remaining 19.1 innings, has a 0.93 ERA (2 ER) and has allowed just 18 total baserunners.
- A* Averaging 6.89 hits and 10.66 strikeouts per 9.0 innings...Is one of eight pitchers in the majors allowing fewer than 7 H/9.0 IP with at least 10 SO/9.0 IP.
- A* In the National League, only Foltyniewicz, Max Scherzer (5.93 H, 12.11 SO) and Jacob DeGrom (6.70 H, 10.67 SO) have done so.

#### 2018 Recap

- A* Was selected to his first major league All-Star Game after going 7-5 with a 2.66 ERA (30 ER/101.2 IP) over 18 games to open the season...Fanned 120 batters over 101.2 innings of work.
- A* Tossed a scoreless fourth inning in his All-Star Game debut, retiring José Ramírez, Manny Machado and José Abreu, while walking Aaron Judge.
- A* His 120 strikeouts before the All-Star break are tied for sixth most in Atlanta franchise history...John Smoltz fanned 149 batters in 134.0 innings before the break in 1996 to set the Atlanta franchise mark.
- A* Held the Cardinals scoreless over 5.0 innings, 7/1 at STL...Allowed just one hit and fanned nine.
- A* The start was his 11th of the season allowing one run or fewer, and those 11 starts came in his first 17 turns on the season...The Atlanta franchise record for starts allowing no more than one run is 19, set by Greg Maddux over 34 starts in 2002.
- A* Reinstated from the 10-day disabled list, 6/25, and started vs. Cincinnati...Allowed one hit and one run over 5.0 innings...Missed seven games with right triceps tightness.
- A* Tossed 5.0 scoreless innings, 6/12 vs. NYM, allowing just two hits while fanning six.
- A* Threw a season-low 73 pitches before exiting the game with right triceps tightness...Was placed on the 10-day disabled list, 6/16.
- A* Threw the first shutout of his major league career, 6/1 vs. Washington...Allowed just two hits and struck out 11.
- A* Became the seventh pitcher in Atlanta-era history to throw a two-hitter or better with double-digit strikeouts and the first since Greg Maddux fanned 14 Brewers in a two-hit, 1-0 win on May 2, 2001 at Turner Field.
- A* Was saddled with the loss, 5/21 at PHI, despite allowing one run over 6.0 innings of work...The start was his fourth against Philadelphia this season and the fourth time in which he faced Phillies starter RHP Nick Pivetta.
- A* According to the Elias Sports Bureau, the last time two pitchers faced off for a fourth time in a team's 46th game or earlier was on 5/31/59, when Lew Burdette faced Robin Roberts in the Braves' 44th game and the Phillies' 45th.
- A* Went 5.0 innings and allowed three hits and one unearned run, 5/15 vs. CHI...Walked a season-most five, and struck out a season-most 10.
- A* Was the fourth double-digit strikeout game of his career, and has since tossed one more.
- A* Allowed a season-most nine hits and six runs over 5.0 innings, 5/4 vs. SF...All six runs he allowed came in the second inning.
- A* The outing snapped a 10-start stretch in which he allowed three earned runs or fewer...Went 2-5 with a 3.04 ERA during the run, which started 8/27/17.
- A* Held the Nationals to four hits and one run over 5.1 innings, 4/4 at SunTrust Park...Snapped a career-worst seven-game losing streak.
- A* Went 0-7 with a 7.34 ERA (31 ER/38.0 IP) over the spell, the longest losing streak of his career and tied for the second longest active streak in the majors at the time...The run dated to 8/11/17 at STL and spanned eight total starts.

#### Career Recap

- A* Acquired by the Atlanta Braves along with RHP Andrew Thurman and INF Rio Ruiz from the Houston Astros in exchange for C/OF Evan Gattis and RHP James Hoyt on 1/14/15.

### Ronald Acuña Jr. • OF • 6-0 • 205 • 20 yrs • #13

**Season Long Streak:** 4 games, 6/30-7/3 (7-18, .389, 2 HR)

- Hit leadoff for the first time in his career on 7/20 at WSH, and has hit there since... Is batting .333 (13-for-39) with a .422 on-base percentage with nine runs scored and four homers in 10 games in that role...Has also batted second, fifth, sixth, and seventh and hit a combined .244 (41-for-168).
- Has made starts at all three outfield positions (4 games, 1 start in center field; 47 games, 47 starts in left field; 3 games, 3 starts in right field).
- Became just the seventh Braves player over the last 110 seasons to reach double-digit home runs prior to turning 21...The others were Andruw Jones (26 total), Eddie Mathews (25), Hank Aaron (13), Jason Heyward (11) and Bob Horner (10).
- At 20 years, 214 days, he became the youngest player in baseball's modern era (since 1900) to homer and steal two bases in the same game, 7/20 at WSH.
- Reinstated from the 10-day disabled on 6/28...Went to the DL on 5/28 and missed 28 games with a left knee mild ACL sprain, left knee contusion and lower back contusion.
- Atlanta selected his contract from Triple-A Gwinnett, 4/25,
- Named Minor League Player of the Year by Baseball America and USA Today in 2017.
