**TODAY'S GAME:** The Giants open a three-game series with the St. Louis Cardinals tonight at Busch Stadium having won back-to-back series for the first time since August 24-29...the Giants and Cardinals split a four-game series at AT&T Park from July 5-8...last season, SF went 2-1 in St. Louis.

**ON THE MOUND: LHP Madison Bumgarner** takes the hill tonight after picking up his sixth win of the season in his last outing on Saturday vs. Colorado...in that outing, Bumgarner tossed 6.0 scoreless innings on 64 pitches in the Giants' 3-0 win over Colorado...Bumgarner left the game following the sixth inning after experiencing tightness in his right side following his second at-bat.

**BUMGARNER AT BUSCH: LHP Madison Bumgarner** has not allowed a run in his last 14.2 innings at Busch Stadium including the postseason...his last appearance in St. Louis came in Game 1 of the NLCS on Oct. 11, 2014 when he twirled 7.2 shutout innings against the Cardinals in SF's 3-0 win...is pitching in St. Louis for the first time in the regular season since May 30, 2014 when he blanked the Cardinals over 7.0 innings with 10 strikeouts in a 9-4 Giants' win...is 3-2 with a 3.27 ERA in five regular-season starts at Busch Stadium.

**GIANTS PITCHERS:** Beginning June 1, the Giants have posted a 3.36 ERA, which ranks as the second-best figure in the Majors behind Los Angeles-NL (3.30)...the starting staff has fashioned a 3.48 ERA in that span, the fourth-best in the Majors behind Los Angeles-NL (3.18), Tampa Bay (3.28) and Cleveland (3.44) while the bullpen has combined for a 3.16 ERA, second-best in MLB behind Houston (3.11).

**IN THE 'PEN:** Giants relievers have combined for a 2.65 ERA (10er, 34.0ip) and a .210 opponents' average against in the last 12 games...in fact, SF's bullpen has allowed three runs in their last 16.1 innings pitched for a 1.65 ERA...the Giants' bullpen ERA of 3.59 is fifth-best in the NL behind Chicago (3.30), San Diego (3.50), Arizona (3.53) and Milwaukee (3.59).

**ROAD HOMERS:** The Giants have homered in each of their last 12 road games dating to August 21, tied for the third-longest streak in team history according to *Stats, LLC*...the streak is two shy of the franchise-best mark, set in 1947 (see chart).

**CRAW IN STL: IF Brandon Crawford** is a lifetime .333 (30-90) hitter at Busch Stadium with seven doubles, one triple, one home run and 11 RBI in 24 career games...Crawford is hitting .395 (15-38) with five doubles, eight RBI and eight runs scored in his last 10 games at Busch dating to June 1, 2014.

**BATTER UP:** The Giants scored four runs in Wednesday night's loss to San Diego and have scored four or more runs in three straight games entering play tonight...it's the first time the Giants have scored at least four runs in three consecutive games since June 17-20 when they did so in four straight.

**GIANTS ON FOX:** Please be advised that FOX Sports has selected tomorrow's game at St. Louis...the game has been dropped from the NBC Sports Bay Area TV schedule and the game time has been changed from 4:15 p.m. PT to 10:05 a.m. PT (12:05 p.m. CT)...the FOX talent will be Don Orsillo, A.J. Pierzynski and J.P. Morosi.

**CLOSE CALLS:** The Giants have played 105 games this season that have been decided by just three runs or fewer, the most such games of any MLB team this year...SF is 51-54 (.486) in such contests.

**SCORE AT LEAST FOUR:** San Francisco is 21-63 (.250) when scoring three runs or fewer compared to 51-18 (.739) when plating four-or-more runs.

#### This Date in Giants History: September 21, 2000

The Giants topped the Diamondbacks, 8-7, on this day in 2000 at Pac Bell Park to clinch the NL West...**Ellis Burks** homered and drove in three to lead the Giants offense while **Robb Nen** locked down his 39th save of the season in the victory.

**TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER**

**#40 LHP Madison Bumgarner**  
**6-4, 243, 29 years old (August 1, 1989)**  
**6-6 Record, 3.14 ERA**

- The four-time All-Star (2013-16) takes the mound today for his 20th start of the season...the Giants are 9-10 in his outings this year, going 6-3 at home and 3-7 on the road.
- Last pitched Saturday vs. Colorado when he spun 6.0 shutout innings and allowed five hits while striking out two to earn his sixth win of the season...left the game after the sixth inning after feeling tightness in his right side during his final at-bat.
- Has allowed three runs or fewer in 14 of his 19 starts.
- With today's road start, it's worth noting his home/away splits (*Baseball Info Solutions*)...  
 At home: 1.34 ERA, 2.7 K/BB, .195 BA, .558 OPS  
 On road: 5.02 ERA, 2.1 K/BB, .267 BA, .819 OPS
- Bumgarner has an 1.58 ERA (10er/57.0ip) in innings 1-3 this season, the fourth-lowest ERA in the Majors in innings 1-3 according to *Stats, LLC*...trails Jacob deGrom (1.02), Clay Buchholz (1.50) and Blake Snell (1.55)...Bumgarner has a 4.60 ERA (31er, 60.2ip) through the rest of the game.
- Has been given a total of just 36 runs of support in his 19 starts (2.75 RSA).
- Will face St. Louis for a second time this season after earning the win vs. the Cardinals on July 8 at AT&T Park in the Giants' 13-8 victory...Bumgarner allowed four runs on seven hits in 5.1 innings in the victory.
- Is 3-2 with a 3.27 ERA (12er, 33.0ip) in five career regular-season starts at Busch Stadium...will be making his first regular-season start in St. Louis since May 30, 2014 when he blanked the Cardinals over 7.0 innings while allowing just three hits and striking out 10 in the Giants' 9-4 win.
- His last start in St. Louis came during the 2014 postseason in Game 1 of the NLCS (Oct. 11), a 3-0 Giants' win... shut out the Cardinals over 7.2 innings in that outing while striking out seven and limiting St. Louis to four hits.
- Over his last two starts in St. Louis (including the postseason), Bumgarner has thrown, 14.2 shutout innings while allowing seven hits with 17 strikeouts and two walks.
- Is averaging 7.50 strikeouts per 9.0 innings, the lowest rate of his career since 2010...his 3.14 walks per 9.0 is the highest of his career.
- From 2012-2018, Bumgarner has six seasons (including 2018) with at least 15 starts and an opponents BA w/RISP of .220 or below, the most such seasons of any pitcher in MLB...Clayton Kershaw and Justin Verlander each have five such seasons in that time (*Baseball Info Solutions*).
- Was reinstated from the 60-day DL June 5.
- Missed the Giants' first 60 games with a broken pinkie finger on his left hand, an injury he suffered on his final start in spring training at Scottsdale, Arizona on March 23 after Royals' hitter Whit Merrifield hit a line-drive comebacker off of his left hand.
- Had never been on the DL in his first eight MLB seasons but has now twice been placed on the DL the last two years, missing a total of 135 games...SF is 59-76 (.437) with Bumgarner on the DL.
- His 110 career wins are the third-most in SF-era history (since 1958) behind **Juan Marichal** (238) and **Gaylord Perry** (134).
- Has 32 double-digit strikeout games, the second-most in Giants franchise history behind **Tim Lincecum** (36)... needs 26 strikeouts to match **Gaylord Perry** (1,606) for the fourth-most in SF-era history...is still seeking his first double-digit strikeout game this year (2018 season-high in strikeouts is eight).

**Last Home Run:** Sept. 3, 2017 vs. STL (off RHP Luke Weaver)

**HITTING NOTES:** Is 6-for-39 (.154) with three RBI this year...batted .206 with three homers and five RBI last season...has hit 17 homers in his 10-year career, the most of any active player and the most in Giants franchise history...is the first pitcher to total at least three homers in four consecutive seasons since Earl Wilson achieved the feat in five-straight seasons between 1964 and 1968...has yet to homer in 2018.

**TOMORROW'S STARTER: RHP DERECK RODRIGUEZ**  
**2018: 6-4, 2.30 ERA / Career: 6-4, 2.30 ERA**  
**NOTES:** 26-year-old right-hander is slated to make his 18th Major League start (20th appearance)...the Giants are 9-8 overall when he takes the hill as a starter, going 5-6 at home and 4-2 on the road...has received a total of just four runs of support in his last four starts...last pitched Sunday versus Colorado and allowed three runs (one earned) on five hits in 6.0 innings of a 3-2 loss... has now lost his last three decisions, the longest losing streak of his brief MLB career...has allowed one earned run in each of his last three starts, fashioning a 1.47 ERA (3er, 18.1ip) in that span...last five road starts: 2-0, 1.39 ERA (5er, 32.1ip), .216 average against...has just one road loss this year and that came June 9 at Washington...faces the Cardinals for the second time in his career... last faced them July 6 at AT&T Park and did not factor into the decision after giving up a pair of runs on five hits in 6.1 innings of a 3-2 Giants win...matched up with John Gant.
