RECENT REDBIRDS: The Cardinals posted a 2-1 win last night to open their 6-game, 7-day road trip (SD-4, MIN-2) and snapped a 2-game losing skid as they improved to 6-2 in May...the Cardinals went 5-2 on their just completed home stand, winning the first 5 games (2-0 vs. CWS & 3-0 vs. CHI) before losing 2-straight to Minnesota...the Cardinals began the day in 1st place in the N.L. Central, 1/2-game in front of Milwaukee.

CLOSE COMFORT: Last night's 2-1 win was the Cardinals 8th win by a margin of just one run and their 5th one-run win in the month of May...the Cardinals rank 4th in the majors in one-run wins (BOS-11, MIL & ARI-9)...the Cardinals have won an MLB best six games by a margin of two runs, giving them 14 wins by two runs or less, 2nd only to Milwaukee (15).

TIGHT FITS: Of the Cardinals eight wins by one-run margins, five have been in games during which they scored three or fewer runs...the Cardinals 8 wins by one run are their most in the team's first 35 games since also doing so in 2008.

GYORKO & THE PADRES: Former Padre (2013-15) **Jedd Gyorko** has thrived against his former team the past two seasons, compiling a .500 (18-for-36) batting mark with 7 HR & 16 RBI in 11 games, hitting safely in 9 of the 10 when he's taken an at-bat and collecting a HR and/or RBI in 9 of the games.

LYONS ON D.L./CECIL ACTIVATED: The Cardinals announced prior to tonight's game that they have placed left-handed pitcher **Tyler Lyons** (mid back strain) on the 10-day disabled list, retroactive to May 9, and activated left-handed pitcher **Brett Cecil** (left shoulder strain) from the 10-day disabled list. Cecil, who appeared in one game with the Cardinals on Opening Day, March 29, appeared in two games on a recent injury rehabilitation assignment, working one scoreless inning on May 8 for Springfield (AA) and one scoreless inning for Memphis (AAA) on May 10 at Oklahoma City. Cecil owns a career mark of 43-46 with a 4.17 ERA in 404 career appearances between Toronto (2009-2016) and St. Louis (2017-18). Lyons co-leads the Cardinals with his 18 relief appearances, the last on May 8.

HELPING HAWAII: The Cardinals, in collaboration with **Kolten Wong** and his wife, **Alissa**, announced the team will sell specially-priced \$15 tickets to the Sunday, May 20, game against the Philadelphia Phillies to help those impacted by the Kilauea volcanic eruptions and earthquakes in Kolten's native state of Hawaii. Fans can purchase the specially-priced tickets now at cardinals.com/Hawaii. For every specially-priced \$15 ticket purchased, \$10 will be donated to the Wongs' relief efforts aiding the American Red Cross and local accredited organizations working to rebuild the impacted areas on the Big Island and help the thousands of families who have been displaced due to flowing lava. BOMBIN' BIRDIES: The Cardinals rank T3rd in the N.L. (Washington 48, Colorado 47) with their 43 home runs...through 35 games, the Cardinals have homered in 26 games and are 19-7 in games when they do homer.

SAN DIEGO CONNECTIONS

Infielder **Jedd Gyorko** played parts of three seasons with the Padres (2013-15)...originally selected by San Diego in the 2nd round of the 2010 MLB Draft...traded by the Padres with cash to St. Louis for outfielder **Jon Jay** (December 8, 2015).

Pitcher **Luke Gregerson** pitched five seasons (2009-2013) with San Diego...acquired by San Diego from St. Louis as the player to be named, to complete the December 4, 2008 trade of pitcher **Mark Worrell** in exchange for infielder **Khalil Greene** (March 23, 2009).

Pitcher **Miles Mikolas** pitched parts of two seasons with San Diego (2012-13) and made his MLB debut on May 5, 2012 vs. Miami...originally selected by San Diego in the 7th round of the 2009 MLB Draft...later traded to the Pirates with infielder **Jaff Decker** in exchange for outfielder **Alex Dickerson** (November 25, 2013).

Outfielder **Dexter Fowler** and pitcher **Jordan Lyles** were once traded for one another (December 3, 2013)...Colorado sent Fowler and a player to be named to the Astros in exchange for Lyles and outfielder **Brandon Barnes**.

Pitcher **Bud Norris** signed as a free agent with San Diego (August 11, 2015)...pitched in 20 games during the 2015 season.

Norris and Lyles were Astros teammates for parts of three seasons (2011-13).

Outfielder **Tommy Pham**'s first MLB hit (double) was July 4, 2015 vs. San Diego...hit his first MLB home run the following day off **Ian Kennedy** and had all three RBI in the team's 3-1 win.

Infielder **Greg Garcia** was born in nearby El Cajon, Calif...graduated from Valhalla (Calif.) High School...currently resides in Santee, Calif.

Pitcher **Greg Holland** (2007) and first baseman **Eric Hosmer** (2008) were both drafted and developed by Kansas City...were Royals teammates for parts of five seasons (2011-15).

Pitcher **Tyler Lyons** earned a win in his MLB debut at San Diego (May 22, 2013).

Outfielder **Marcell Ozuna** was a teammate of pitcher **Brand Hand** (2013-15) and catcher **A.J. Ellis** (2017) while in Miami.

Pitching Coach **Mike Maddux** pitched parts of two seasons with San Diego (1991-92)...signed with the Padres as a free agent (March 31, 1991)...later traded by San Diego to the Mets for pitchers **Mike Freitas** and **Roger Mason** (December 17, 1992).

Hitting Coach **John Mabry** played part of the 2000 season with the Padres...originally traded by Seattle with pitcher Tom Davey to San Diego for outfielder Al Martin (July 31, 2000).

Cardinals Hall of Famer and broadcaster **Jim Edmonds** played part of the 2008 season for San Diego (26 games)...traded by St. Louis to San Diego for infielder **David Freese** (December 14, 2007).

Future Cardinals Hall of Famer **Ray Lankford** played parts of two seasons for San Diego (2001-02)...traded by St. Louis with cash to the Padres for pitcher **Woody Williams** (August 2, 2001).

Padres pitcher **Joey Lucchesi** pitched two seasons for Southeast Missouri State Univ. (2015-16).

Hall of Famer **Ozzie Smith** was selected by San Diego in the 4th round of the 1977 MLB Draft...played four seasons with the Padres (1978-81)...later traded by San Diego with pitchers **Al Olmsted** and **Steve Mura** to St. Louis for pitcher **Luis DeLeon**, outfielder **Sixto Lezcano** and shortstop **Garry Templeton** (December 10, 1981).

Padres bench coach and Cardinals Hall of Famer **Mark McGwire** played in parts of five seasons for St. Louis (1997-2001)...broke Roger Maris' single-season home record with 70 in 1998...made three NL All-Star teams (1998-2000)...later served as St. Louis' hitting coach for three seasons (2010-12), where he was a member of the coaching staff that won 2011 World Series...originally traded by Oakland to St. Louis for pitchers **Eric Ludwick**, **T.J. Mathews** and **Blake Stein** (July 31, 1997).

Padres First Base Coach **Skip Schumaker** played eight years in St. Louis (2005-12)...member of 2011 World Series Champion Cardinals...originally selected by the Cardinals in the 5th round of the 2001 MLB Draft...later traded by St. Louis to the Dodgers for infielder **Jake Lemmerman** (December 12, 2012).

Padres broadcaster **Carlos Hernandez** appeared in 17 games for St. Louis in 2000.

Outfielder **Dexter Fowler** (Cubs) started for the National League in the 2016 MLB All-Star Game at PETCO Park, while **Matt Carpenter** (injured) and **Marcell Ozuna** (Marlins) were named as reserves.

- Makes his eighth start of the season and the 26th of his career (30th game).
- Only N.L. West opponent faced this year has been Arizona (4/8) and held the D-Backs to one run over 6.1 innings with three hits in a no decision St. Louis lost 4-1.
- Is lifetime 2-3 with a 3.90 ERA in six career starts vs. N.L. West opponents. Had lost his first three starts from 9/16/16-7/27/17 before winning 2 of his last 3.

LAST TIME OUT

- Surrendered four runs in the 2nd inning and exited after 4.0 innings allowing six hits with a walk and two strikeouts. Cardinals rallied to win in 10 innings on a walk-off home run by Kolten Wong after St. Louis tied the game 6-6 in the 9th inning.

- Limited opposing right-handers to a .208 (15-for72) average against.
- Has allowed just five extra-base hits (2 HR, 2 3B, 2B) among his 35 hits allowed, ranking 13th among National League pitchers in opponent slugging (.341).
- Ranks 5th in the N.L. with his 0.51 HR/9 IP ratio (2 HR/35.1 IP). Last HR allowed was 4/24 vs. NYM (Y. Cespedes).

CAREER

- Averaging 10.15 K/9 IP over his career 132.0 career Major League innings.
- His 149 career strikeouts are 3rd to Rick Ankiel (157) and Shelby Miller (153) for the highest total all-time among Cardinals through their first 29 career games.
- Has three double-digit strikeout games in his first 29 games, trailing only Rick Ankiel (5) and tied with Paul Derringer (3) and Alan Benes (3) on the Cardinals all-time list.
- Won team-leading seven consecutive 2017 starts (8/2-9/20/17), was the 4th-longest in the National League and longest by a MLB rookie in 2017...is the first Cardinals rookie to achieve the feat since Ted Wilks (1944) & Johnny Beazley (1942) (*Elias*).
- Became the fifth rookie pitcher in the last 70 years to allow two runs or fewer over seven consecutive winning starts, joining Fernando Valenzuela (eight straight in 1981), Cal Eldred (1992), Jered Weaver (2006) and Steven Matz (2016) (*Elias*).

2017

- Pitched the majority of the second half of the season with St. Louis, pitching in 13 games (10 starts) over three stints. Was the 7th different Cardinals pitcher to make a start behind the original starting five and Marco Gonzales.
- Struck out 72 over 60.1 IP to average 10.74 K/9 IP, the 5th-highest mark among National League starters (min. 60.0 IP), trailing Robbie Ray (12.11), Max Scherzer (12.02), Rich Hill (11.01) and Dinelson Lamet (10.94).
