WHITE SOX AT A GLANCE

- The Chicago White Sox have lost five of their last six games and seven of nine as they open a seven-game trip tonight in Minnesota ... RHP Lucas Giolito takes the mound for the White Sox, who are tied with Detroit for third place in the American League Central, 2.5 games behind the Twins and Cleveland.
- Following this scheduled four-game series, the White Sox conclude the trip with three games in Oakland (4/16-18) ... following an off day on 4/19, they are home for six games vs. Houston (4/20-22) and Seattle (4/23-25).
- The Sox are coming off a 1-5 homestand vs. Detroit (0-3) and Tampa Bay (1-2), which ended yesterday with a 2-1 victory over the Rays.
- The White Sox went 3-2 on their first trip of the season to Kansas City (2-0) and Toronto (1-2).

TONIGHT'S STORYLINES

- The White Sox lead the major leagues with 14 home runs on the road (three at home).
- The Sox are playing their first night game since 4/4.
- The White Sox are 3-46 (.065) with RISP over the last five games, leaving 45 runners on base in that span.
- Matt Davidson is the first Sox player since Carlos Quentin in 2009 (six) to hit five-plus homers in the team's first 11 games.
- Avisail García batted .443/.487/.671 (31-70) with three home runs and 12 RBI in 18 games vs. Minnesota in 2018 ... García went 18-38 (.474) in nine games at Target Field last season.
- José Abreu owns a .307 (47-153) average with seven home runs and 30 RBI in 36 career games at Target Field.

ROSTER MOVES

- Prior to tonight's game, the White Sox purchased the contract of RHP Chris Volstad from Class AAA Charlotte and transferred LHP Carlos Rodón (shoulder rehab) to the 60-day disabled list.
- Volstad, 31, takes the roster spot of RHP Gregory Infante, who was optioned to Charlotte following yesterday's game ... he made one start with the Knights this season (5 ER/4.2 IP) after posting a 0.00 ERA (14.0 IP) over eight games (one start) this spring.

YESTERDAY'S RECAP

- Matt Davidson hit a two-run homer off Austin Pruitt in the eighth inning as the White Sox ended a five-game losing streak with a 2-1 victory over Tampa Bay.
- With one out in the eighth, José Abreu singled off Pruitt to set up Davidson, who followed with his American-League best fifth home run of the season.
- Four Sox pitchers limited the Rays to four hits ... James Shields posted a no decision despite limiting the Rays to one run on four hits over 6.1 IP ... Shields is 3-0 with a 1.37 ERA (4 ER/26.1 IP) and 29 strikeouts in four career starts against his former team.
- Luis Avilán struck out both batters he faced, Bruce Rondón pitched a 1-2-3 eighth for his first victory with the Sox, and Nate Jones earned his first save despite walking the leadoff hitter in the ninth.
- The White Sox went 0-9 with RISP and left nine runners on base but avoided their first 0-6 start at home since 1948.

ON THE FARM

- RHP Dane Dunning took a no-hitter into the seventh inning, and CF Luis Alexander Basabe went 3-5 with a triple, two RBI and two runs scored to lead Class A Winston-Salem to a 9-0 victory at Myrtle Beach.
- Dunning, ranked by MLB.com as the No. 6 prospect in the Sox organization, allowed two hits with no walks and eight strikeouts over 6.1 IP to improve to 1-0 with a 0.79 ERA (1 ER/11.1 IP) and 16 strikeouts in two starts this season.
- Basabe (Sox No. 14 prospect) is hitting .400 (10-25) with a double, two triples, five RBI, five runs scored and two stolen bases in five games this season.

ABREU IN ELITE COMPANY

- José Abreu is one of three players in major-league history to begin his career with at least four consecutive seasons of 25-plus homers and 100-plus RBI, joining Hall-of-Famer Joe DiMaggio (1936-41) and Albert Pujols.
- Abreu also has joined Al Simmons (11, 1924-34), Pujols (10, 2001-10), Ted Williams (1939-42, '46-49) and DiMaggio (1936-42) as the only players in history to record 100 or more RBI in each of his first four seasons.
- He led the American League with 343 total bases in 2017, joining Albert Belle (399 in 1998), Minnie Miñoso (304 in 1951) and Joe Jackson (293 in 1916) as the only players in Sox history to accomplish that feat.

WHITE SOX VS. MINNESOTA

- The White Sox went 7-12 vs. Minnesota in 2017 (3-6 at Target Field) to fall to 3-12-2 in the last 17 season matchups.
- The Sox batted .232/.295/.385 with a 4.39 ERA (82 ER/166.2 IP) and were outscored, 90-67.
- The White Sox trail the all-time series, 425-473 ... they are 230-218 at home (116-99 at Guaranteed Rate Field) and 195-255 on the road (36-40 at Target Field).
- Chicago is 11-19 in its last 30 games at Target Field.

LOOKING FOR CENTRAL COMMAND

- The White Sox are 2-3 against the American League Central in 2018 after going 33-43 (.434) last season.
- The Sox are 293-380 vs. the AL Central since 2009, posting a losing record every season except 2012 (37-35).

AT THE HELM

- Rick Renteria is in his second season after being named the 40th manager in White Sox history on 10/31/16.
- Renteria was the only Latino manager in the major leagues in 2017 but has been joined by Boston's Alex Cora and Washington's Dave Martinez in 2018.
- He was selected by Pittsburgh in the first round (20th overall) of the 1980 draft ... Cleveland manager Terry Francona (22nd), Oakland executive vice president of baseball operations Billy Beane (23rd) and Toronto manager John Gibbons (24th) were selected in succession later in the first round of that draft.

QUALITY IS JOB ONE

- The White Sox have made a major-league leading 1,319 quality starts since the start of the 2003 season, four more than the Mets and 48 more than Oakland, the next-closest American League team.

TOUGH LUCK LOSER

- RHP Reynaldo López matched his career high with 7.0 IP on Sunday vs. Tampa Bay, allowing one unearned run to lower his season ERA to 0.69 (1 ER/13.0 IP).
- López became the first White Sox starting pitcher since at least 1908 to lose a game in which he threw 7.0-plus IP while allowing two or less hits and one run which was unearned (source: Baseball Reference and STATS LLC).
- López, who was acquired from Washington on 12/7/16 with RHPs Dane Dunning and Lucas Giolito, has thrown at least 6.0 IP in each of his last eight starts dating back to last season ... despite a 1-3 record, he owns a 2.89 ERA (12 ER/37.1 IP) in six career starts at Guaranteed Rate Field.

ROSTER QUICK FACTS

- The Sox 25-man roster includes 13 pitchers (three LHP), two catchers, six infielders and four outfielders ... LHP Aaron Bummer, OF Nicky Delmonico, OF Adam Engel, RHP Carson Fulmer, RHP Lucas Giolito, RHP Gregory Infante, RHP Reynaldo López, RHP Juan Minaya and Moncada made their first career Opening Day roster.

HAWK'S FAREWELL

- Ken "Hawk" Harrelson, who is in his 33rd and final season in the White Sox television booth in 2018, will work primarily Sunday home games this season as well as select other contests.
- Harrelson will serve the organization as a team ambassador throughout the 2019 season, which will mark the beginning of his eighth decade in baseball.

CALL TO THE HALL

- Jim Thome, who played for the White Sox from 2006-09 and serves as a special assistant to the general manager, will be inducted into the Baseball Hall of Fame on 7/29/18.
- Thome, who ranks eighth in major-league history with 612 home runs, received 89.8 percent of the votes to become the fifth former Sox player inducted on the first ballot.
- He will join Chipper Jones, Vladimir Guerrero, Trevor Hoffman Jack Morris and Alan Trammell in the Class of 2018.

PROSPECT PROWESS

- The White Sox minor-league system is rated by *Baseball America* as the fourth-best in baseball.
- The Sox organization features five of *Baseball America's* Top 100 prospects: OF Eloy Jiménez (No. 4), RHP Michael Kopech (No. 11), RHP Alec Hansen (No. 57), OF Luis Robert (No. 58) and RHP Dane Dunning (No. 82) ... Jiménez (No. 4), Kopech (No. 10), Robert (No. 28), Hansen (No. 54), RHP Dylan Cease (No. 71), Dunning (No. 92) and OF Blake Rutherford (No. 99) are ranked in MLB.com's Top 100.

GIOLITO AT A GLANCE

- The 23-year-old makes his third start of the season and second on the road ... is 3-3 with a 2.82 ERA (16 ER/51.0 IP) over his last eight starts since 8/27/17.
- Made his first career Opening Day roster.
- Owns a 3.32 ERA (14 ER/38.0 IP) in six career starts against the American League Central.
- Went 3-2 with a 1.83 ERA (8 ER/39.1 IP) over his final six starts with the White Sox in 2017.
- Lost 10 pounds in the offseason, dropping from 255 to 245.
- Was acquired from Washington on 12/7/16 with RHP Dane Dunning and RHP Reynaldo López in exchange for OF Adam Eaton.

LAST START

- Suffered his first loss of the season on 4/7 vs. Detroit ... allowed five runs on four hits, three walks and three hit batters over 5.2 IP ... gave up a two-run single to Miguel Cabrera in the third inning and a two-run double to Dixon Machado in the sixth ... left with a 5-0 deficit after throwing 94 pitches (49 strikes) ... his three HBP were the most by a Sox starter since Chris Sale on 9/21/16 at Philadelphia (also three) ... Sox lost, 6-1.

2018 NOTES OF INTEREST

- Has limited opponents to a .195 (8-41) average but has issued 5.4 walks per 9.0 IP (7 BB/11.2 IP) ... leads the major leagues with four hit batsmen ... has made one quality start in two outings.

SPRING RECAP

- Went 2-0 with a 2.04 ERA (4 ER/17.1 IP) over four spring starts ... worked 6.1 scoreless IP in his final Cactus League start on 3/20 vs. Texas, allowing two hits with no walks and four strikeouts ... surrendered one run on two hits with eight strikeouts over 4.0 IP on 3/10 at the Cubs.

2017 RECAP

- Made 24 starts with Class AAA Charlotte and seven with the White Sox in his first season in the organization.
- Went 3-2 with a 1.83 ERA (8 ER/39.1 IP), 30 strikeouts, a .177 (25-141) opponents average and 0.94 WHIP over his final six starts ... five of the outings were quality.
- Was recalled on 8/23 and made his White Sox debut that night vs. Minnesota (4 ER/6.0 IP; 3 HR) ... earned his first win with the Sox on 8/27 vs. Detroit, allowing just three hits over 7.0 scoreless IP.
- Allowed one run and struck out a career-high 10 over 7.0 IP on 9/3 vs. Tampa Bay ... became the first Sox pitcher to strike out 10-plus batters within his first three starts with the club since Chris Sale in 2012.
- Received a ND on 9/13 at Kansas City, allowing one run on four hits in 6.1 IP ... became the 15th Sox pitcher to make four-plus straight starts of 5.0-plus IP and four hits or less allowed ... earned the win in his final start on 9/24 vs. Kansas City (1 ER/7.0 IP).
- Began the season with Charlotte ... at the time of his promotion, ranked among the IL leaders in shutouts (2nd), starts (T2nd), strikeouts (3rd), SO/9.0 (4th, 9.37) and IP (7th).
- Went 3-1 with a 1.71 ERA (6 ER/31.2 IP), 28 strikeouts and just two home runs allowed over his final five starts ... threw his first professional no-hitter on 5/25-1 vs. Syracuse (7.0 IP), marking the first no-hitter in BB&T Ballpark history ... was named IL Pitcher of the Week for 5/22-28.
- Entered the season ranked by MLB.com as the No. 12 Prospect in baseball.

DAY AND NIGHT

- Went 3-0 with a 0.99 ERA (3 ER/27.1 IP) and .156 (15-96) opponents average over four afternoon starts in 2017, compared to 0-3 with a 4.50 ERA (9 ER/18.0 IP) and .239 (16-67) opponents average at night.
- Allowed one or no runs in all four of his starts during the day and lasted 7.0 IP three times ... his 0.99 ERA would have led the American League with the required IP.

IT'S ALL ME

- Is one of 35 members of the Taylor Hooton Foundation advisory board, which is recognized as the leader in advocacy against appearance and performance enhancing drug use by the youth of America.
- The advisory board is comprised of at least one member from each of the 30 Major League clubs ... the players will participate in the THF 2018 public service campaign, including "It's All Me" themed PSAs which will appear in MLB's 2018 All-Star Game, League Championship Series and World Series programs.
