TONIGHT'S GAME: The Braves and Mets continue a four-game set tonight with the 14th meeting between the teams this season...The Braves will return here September 25-27 for three more games in the penultimate series of the season.

A The Braves won all three games in their first trip to New York this season, outscoring the Mets 21-2 and holding their rivals scoreless over the final 18.0 innings of the series.

A The Braves have won 10 of the 13 games with New York this season after last night's 4-2 series-opening win...The club has won double-digit games against the Mets in 12 of the last 18 seasons...The franchise record for most wins in a season over the Mets is 14, first set by the 1964 and matched by the 1966 club.

A RHP Aníbal Sánchez has not beaten the Mets since August 26, 2010, while with Florida...The 34-year-old right-hander took a no-decision in his only start against New York this season, allowing four runs, earned, over 4.0 innings in a 7-6 win on May 29 at SunTrust Park.

A RHP Jacob deGrom leads the majors with a 1.82 ERA, but is winless over his last six starts.

VS. deGROM: The Braves have won all four games this season when facing RHP Jacob deGrom, despite the right-hander allowing just two total runs in 25.0 innings over these games...DeGrom owns a 0.72 ERA this year against the Braves, and has struck out 31 while walking just five.

A For his career, deGrom is 5-4 with a 1.80 ERA and four home runs allowed (19 ER/95.0 IP) in 15 starts against the Braves...Atlanta, however, has won nine of those starts.

A Among active pitchers who have thrown at least 95.0 innings against any one opponent, deGrom's 1.80 ERA against Atlanta ranks fourth lowest in baseball...Adam Wainwright has a 1.48 ERA (20 ER/122.0 IP) against Houston, Clayton Kershaw has a 1.60 ERA (55 ER/310.1 IP) against San Francisco and Chris Sale has compiled a 1.61 ERA (18 ER/100.2 IP) against the Yankees.

A 1B Freddie Freeman has 41 plate appearances against deGrom, the most of any player...Freeman is 11-for-38 (.289) with two home runs.

STOLEN BASES: The Braves stole three more bases last night, giving them 61, which is fourth most in the National League.

A The club stole 77 bases all of last season.

A The Braves are on pace for 93 steals this season... Since 2001, the Braves have reached triple digits in steals once, swiping 101 bases in 2012.

A OF Ender Inciarte is tied for fourth in the National League with 23 steals.

ACUÑA JR. LEADING OFF: OF Ronald Acuña Jr. finished 2-for-3 last night with his first career triple and two runs scored...Since moving to the leadoff spot on July 20 in Washington for the first game out of the All-Star break, the rookie is hitting .357 (15-for-42) with three doubles, a triple, four home runs, a .449 on-base percentage and a .762 slugging percentage (1.211 OPS).

A Acuña Jr.'s triple came on the third pitch of the game...According to MLB Statcast, the rookie went home to third in 11.15 seconds, which is the Braves' fourth-fastest time since 2015 and the Braves' fastest this year.

A His overall sprint speed of 29.8 ft/sec is the eighth fastest in the major leagues this season and the fourth quickest in the National League.

VS. THE N.L. EAST: The Braves improved to 32-16 (.667) against the National League East this season with last night's 4-2 win...The club has a +87 run differential against the division this season and have gone 11-2-3 in intradivision series play this season.

A Only Boston (.708) and Cleveland (.681) have better intradivision records.

A The Braves went 33-43 (.434) against their own division last season.

A The Braves have not had a winning intradivision record since 2014, when they went 40-36...Over the three previous seasons, the club went 103-124 (.454) against the N.L. East.

WINNING STREAK: The Braves have won four straight games for the first time since another four-game run, June 29-July 2...Their season-best streak is a five-gamer, April 28-May 3.

A The bullpen has allowed one run over 11.1 innings during this run, compiling a 0.79 ERA, five holds and two saves...They have struck out 12 and walked just one.

A The Braves bullpen has allowed 7.76 hits per nine innings this season, the third-best mark in the National League...They have walked 4.14 per nine, however, fourth most in the league.

MINTER: LHP A.J. Minter closed out last night's game by striking out two in a hitless ninth inning...Minter now has seven saves, the most by a rookie left-hander since Chris Sale finished with eight in 2011 for the Chicago White Sox.

A Minter has never blown a lead in his major league career, going seven-for-seven in save chances and 16-for-16 in hold opportunities.

A According to STATS, LLC., since the save became an official stat in 1969, Minter's streak of 23 saves plus holds without a blown save is the third longest in franchise history...Luis Avilan and Greg McMichael hold the record of 27.

Tonight's Game

- A* Makes his 14th start of the season (15th appearance) and the 276th (299th appearance) of his career.
- A* Makes his 13th career start against New York, and is 4-5 with a 4.34 ERA (36 ER/74.2 IP) against them...Mets batters have hit .293 against him.
 - A* Faced them once this season, 5/29 at SunTrust Park...Allowed five hits and four runs over 4.0 innings...Was reinstated from the disabled list prior to his start after missing 37 games with a right hamstring strain.
 - A* Has made six starts in New York and has factored in every decision, going 2-4 with a 5.45 ERA (20 ER/33.0 IP)...Last pitched here on 8/9/2011.
- A* Has completed at least 6.0 innings in each of his last five starts, four of which have been quality outings...The five-start run of at least 6.0 innings is the eighth-longest active streak in the majors and the longest by an Atlanta starter.
 - A* Sánchez's current streak is the second longest by a Braves starter this season, trailing just a six-start stretch by Sean Newcomb from 4/20-5/19.
- A* Went 4-2 with a 2.60 ERA (19 ER/65.2 IP) in 11 starts (12 appearances) for Atlanta prior to the All-Star break...Is 1-1 with a 5.11 ERA (7 ER/12.1 IP) in two starts after the break.
 - A* For his career, has pitched to a 4.17 ERA in 166 appearances before the All-Star break and a 3.89 mark in 132 games after.
 - A* His 2.60 ERA at the All-Star break this season was the lowest of his career... His previous best was a 2.93 ERA in 2013, when he went on the pace the American League with a 2.57 full-season mark.

2018 Recap

- A* Allowed a season-most five runs (four earned) over 6.1 innings in his last start, 7/26 vs. LAD...Two of the five runs scored following his departure in the seventh inning.
- A* Defeated Washington, 8-5, on 7/20 at Nationals Park...Allowed six hits and three runs over 6.0 innings.
 - A* His 2.11 career ERA (36 ER/153.2 IP) against the Nationals/Expos is the lowest all-time mark by a qualifying pitcher against the franchise.
 - A* His .909 (10-1) winning percentage is also the best mark all-time against the Nationals/Expos (minimum 10 decisions).
- A* Tossed just 4.2 innings, 6/26 vs. CIN, and allowed five hits and two runs to take his second consecutive loss.
 - A* Was removed after throwing just 73 pitches due to cramping in his right calf.
- A* Took his first loss of the season, 6/20 at TOR...Allowed five hits and a season high-tying four runs over 5.0 innings...Set season highs in walks (4) and strikeouts (7).
 - A* The loss snapped a streak of three straight wins to open the season...Opened a season 3-0 for the second time in his career...Won the first four decisions of his major league career to open his rookie campaign 4-0 in 2006.
- A* Won two consecutive starts, 6/9 at LAD (5.1 IP, 2 R) and 6/14 vs. SD (7.0 IP, 0 R)...The wins were the first of his career against each team.
 - A* Entered the stretch winless against just three major league teams, all three of which played in California...Was winless against the Dodgers, Padres and Angels (0-4) before defeating Los Angeles-NL and San Diego in his last two turns.
- A* Allowed a pair of unearned runs over a season most-tying 7.0 innings, 6/3 vs. WSH...Allowed just four total baserunners.
- A* Returned from the disabled list, 5/29, and started that night vs. NYM...Allowed five hits and four runs over 4.0 innings in a no-decision.
 - A* Missed 37 games after suffering a right hamstring strain on 4/18.
- A* Began a rehabilitation assignment with Triple-A Gwinnett on 5/21 and made two rehab starts with the Stripers...Combined to go 0-1 with a 10.80 ERA (8 ER/6.2 IP).
- A* Suffered a right hamstring strain during pregame warmups on 4/18 and was placed on the 10-day disabled list that night.
- A* Snapped a career-long six-game losing streak, 4/13 at CHI...Tossed 6.0 scoreless innings in the Braves' 4-0 shutout of the Cubs.
 - A* Went 0-6 with a 6.51 ERA (34 ER/47.0 IP) during the losing streak, which dated to 8/6/17 at BAL and spanned 11 games (10 starts)...Received just 13 runs of support during the stretch, an average of 1.18 runs per turn.
- A* Made his first start of the season and went 5.0 innings and allowed seven hits and two runs, 4/7 at COL...Atlanta lost 3-2 in the 10th inning.
 - A* Is undefeated in six career starts against the Rockies...Sánchez is one of nine pitchers in history to make at least five starts against the Rockies and log an ERA under 2.00...Only five of those pitchers -- Sánchez, Jacob deGrom, Tom Koehler, Mark Prior and Bill Swift -- have done so without taking a loss

Career Recap

- A* 2018 marks his 13th major league campaign...Played the first six-and-a-half seasons (2006-12) of his career with the Marlins, before spending the last five-and-a-half seasons (2012-17) with Detroit.
- A* Led the American League with a 2.57 ERA in 2013.

Season Long Streak: 4 games, 6/30-7/3 (7-18, .389, 2 HR)

- Hit leadoff for the first time in his career on 7/20 at WSH, and has hit there since...Is batting .357 (15-for-42) with a .449 on-base percentage with 11 runs scored and four homers in 11 games in that role...Has also batted second, fifth, sixth, and seventh and hit a combined .244 (41-for-168).
- Has made starts at all three outfield positions (5 games, 2 starts in center field; 48 games, 47 starts in left field; 3 games, 3 starts in right field).
- Became just the seventh Braves player over the last 110 seasons to reach double-digit home runs prior to turning 21...The others were Andrew Jones (26 total), Eddie Mathews (25), Hank Aaron (13), Jason Heyward (11) and Bob Horner (10).
- At 20 years, 214 days, he became the youngest player in baseball's modern era (since 1900) to homer and steal two bases in the same game, 7/20 at WSH.
- Reinstated from the 10-day disabled on 6/28...Went to the DL on 5/28 and missed 28 games with a left knee mild ACL sprain, left knee contusion and lower back contusion.
- Atlanta selected his contract from Triple-A Gwinnett, 4/25.
- Named Minor League Player of the Year by Baseball America and USA Today in 2017.

- Hitting .362 (47-for-130) since 6/17, the first game he did not start this season... Batting .310 (79-for-255) from the second spot in the lineup.
- Tied for the N.L. lead with 21 first-inning runs scored.
- Has 20 home runs and 11 steals, one of three players in the N.L. to go 20-10 so far (Colorado's Trevor Story and Chicago's Javy Baez).
- Has 54 extra-base hits on the season...The club record is 92 by Hank Aaron in 1959... The Atlanta-era record is 87 by Chipper Jones in 1999.
- Has 12 games with multiple extra-base hits this season, five away from the Atlanta franchise record held by Chipper Jones (1999) and Javy Lopez (2003).
- Homered from both sides of the plate, 7/11 vs. TOR, for his first career multi-homer game...Is the first Braves batter to homer from both side since Nick Swisher (8/22/15).
- Had 20 homers before the All-Star break, most by a Braves batter since 2006, when Andrew Jones also had 20.
- Selected to his first career All-Star Game in his first full major league season...Was invited to attend as a result of player balloting...Became the first Braves second baseman selected since Dan Uggla in 2012, and the first Atlanta position player selected in his first full season since Jason Heyward in 2010...Went 0-1 in the N.L.'s 8-6 loss.

- Since being named the starting third baseman on 5/20, is hitting .267 (56-for-210) with a .340 on-base percentage and 10 home runs in 59 games with an at-bat.
- Leads the team with 33 RBI since the beginning of June, while his eight home runs are one off the team lead of Freddie Freeman...His seven game-winning RBI since his season debut on 4/18 are second most on the club, again trailing Freeman.
- Is hitting .318 (14-for-44) with a .434 on-base percentage in close and late situations.
- Has 35 walks in 311 plate appearances...Walked just 12 times in 256 plate appearances last season.
- Compiled a career-high 10-game hitting streak, 6/22-7/4...Hit .357 (15-for-42) with two home runs and a .429 on-base percentage during his run.
