TRIBE HEADLINES

» The Indians boast five players (Ramírez, Encarnacion, Lindor, Alonso, Brantley) with 60 RBI...they are the only team in MLB claiming five such players (no other team has more than three).

» The Tribe holds a 34-16 record against the A.L. Central this season, posting a 2.64 ERA (132ER/450.0IP) that ranks as the lowest intradivisional mark in MLB.

» FRANCISCO LINDOR has hit 28 of his 29 home runs as the Tribe's leadoff hitter, the most in MLB...he is now the Major League leader in runs scored (99), extra-base hits (67) and multi-hit games (46), while he is tied for the American League lead with 37 doubles.

» COREY KLUBER owns an 8-1 record with a 1.62 ERA (11ER/61.0IP) vs. the A.L. Central division this season, the lowest ERA by an MLB pitcher against a single division (min. 50.0IP)...his 2.01 ERA (20ER/89.1IP) at home is the 2nd-lowest in the American League behind teammate TREVOR BAUER (1.87).

» The Indians hold a 27-10 (.730) record in series finales this season, the 2nd-highest win percentage in MLB (Boston - .778)...Tribe starters are 24-4 with a 2.28 ERA (63ER/248.1IP) in finales.

BALANCED ATTACK - 5 AT 60

» MICHAEL BRANTLEY drove in his 60th run of 2018 with an RBI-groundout in last night's victory.

» Brantley became the fifth Tribe player to reach 60 RBI this season, joining JOSÉ RAMÍREZ (83), EDWIN ENCARNACION (81), FRANCISCO LINDOR (71) and YONDER ALONSO (65).

» Cleveland is the only team in MLB claiming five players with at least 60 RBI (no other team has more than three such players)...this season marks the fastest (113 team games) the Indians have had five players reach 60 RBI since their 1999 campaign (franchise-record 1,009 runs), when they achieved the feat in 100 games (M. Ramírez, R. Alomar, Justice, Sexson, Thome).

YESTERDAY'S RECAP

» The Indians returned to their high-water mark of 13 games over .500, beating the Twins 5-2 in walk-off fashion.

» With the game tied 2-2 in the bottom of the 9th inning, FRANCISCO LINDOR hit a three-run homer to clinch the Tribe victory...marked Cleveland's third walk-off win of the season, along with April 8 vs. Kansas City (Gomes HR) and May 27 vs. Houston (G. Allen HR)...Lindor recorded his third career walk-off plate appearance, as well as his second walk-off homer.

» EDWIN ENCARNACION drove in the first Indians run with a 1st-inning sacrifice fly, while MICHAEL BRANTLEY gave the Tribe a 2-1 lead on a 5th-inning RBI-groundout...YAN GOMES (1-3) extended his hit streak to seven games.

» MIKE CLEVINGER was dominant in a no-decision, holding the Twins to one run on five hits over 7.0 innings of work (1BB, 5K)...lowered his ERA vs. the A.L. Central this season to 2.21 (15ER/61.0IP).

TWIN BILLING

» The Indians are playing their fifth of six series against the Minnesota Twins, as well as their second here at Progressive Field...following this week's four-game set, the clubs will face each other one final time in Cleveland from August 28-30.

» In their first matchup at Progressive Field from June 15-17, Minnesota won two of the three games...overall, the Indians own a 7-8 record vs. the Twins this season, going 3-3 at Progressive Field, 1-1 in Puerto Rico and 3-4 at Target Field.

CENTRAL COMMAND

» Cleveland has gone 34-16 against the A.L. Central, with a record of 10-3-2 in series play...the Indians' .680 intradivisional winning percentage ranks 2nd in the A.L. and MLB (Boston - .737).

» The Tribe has gone 20-5 in divisional home games and 14-11 on the road...Cleveland has won nine of 10 divisional home games and eight of its last 10 divisional road games (since June 14).

» In 50 games vs. the A.L. Central, Tribe pitchers own a 2.64 ERA (132ER/450.0IP), marking the lowest intradivisional ERA in MLB...seven of the Tribe's 12 shutouts this season (T1st in MLB with PIT & CHC) have come against the A.L. Central, and the Indians have allowed three-or-fewer runs in 36 intradivisional games (going 31-5 in those contests).

KLUBER DAY

» COREY KLUBER is coming off a complete-game shutout in his last start, which came August 4 vs. Los Angeles-AL (3H, 1BB, 7K)...he is tied for the MLB lead with two complete games this season, while his 17 complete games since 2014 lead MLB.

» He is set to face the Twins for the third time this year...earned the win on April 17 in Puerto Rico (6.2IP, 5H, 1R/ER, 2BB, 6K) and took the loss on June 15 at Progressive Field (5.0IP, 4H, 4R/ER, 1BB, 3K).

» Kluber holds an 8-1 record with a 1.62 ERA (11ER/61.0IP) in nine starts vs. the A.L. Central this season...marks the lowest ERA by an MLB pitcher against a single division (min. 50.0IP).

» Kluber has also been dominant at Progressive Field, where he has gone 8-3 with a 2.01 ERA (20ER/89.1IP), the 2nd-lowest home ERA in the American League behind TREVOR BAUER (1.87).

» Enters play today leading the A.L. with 1.2 walks per 9.0 innings and a 7.30 K/BB ratio, while he ranks 2nd in daytime ERA (1.66), T2nd in wins (14), 3rd in innings pitched (154.0), 3rd in WHIP (0.92), 5th in ERA (2.63), 7th in opponent batting average (.213) and T9th in strikeouts (146).

FRANKIE KEEPS ROLLING

» FRANCISCO LINDOR's second career walk-off home run last night gave him homers in consecutive games for the sixth time this season...he now ranks 6th in the A.L. with 29 home runs, 28 of which have come in the first spot of the lineup (most in MLB).

» Last night also marked Lindor's 46th multi-hit game of the season, the most in MLB...his 1st-inning double was his 37th of the season, tying Eduardo Escobar (now with ARI) for the American League lead...his 67 extra-base hits are the most in the Major Leagues (JOSÉ RAMÍREZ is T2nd with 65).

» Lindor additionally leads MLB with 99 runs scored this season...he has scored at least one run in each of his last six games and is on pace to score 142, which would surpass Earl Averill's franchise record of 140 in 1931.

STRONG STARTERS

» Cleveland starting pitchers have combined for a 3.40 ERA this season, the 2nd-lowest mark in the American League (Houston - 2.99) and 3rd-lowest in MLB (Los Angeles-NL - 3.35).

» MIKE CLEVINGER's outing last night marked the 72nd quality start by a Cleveland pitcher this season, 2nd-most in the Majors (Houston - 79)...represented the Tribe's 46th start of at least 7.0 innings pitched, the most in MLB.

» Over Cleveland's last 13 games, Indians starters have posted a 1.89 combined ERA (18ER/85.2IP), the lowest mark in MLB since July 25...their 95 combined strikeouts are 2nd in MLB in that span.

SCORE TACTICS

» The Indians currently rank among A.L. leaders in stolen bases (89 - T1st), team batting average (.258 - 2nd), home runs (159 - 2nd), hits (1,007 - 2nd), OPS (.772 - 3rd), runs scored (577 - 3rd) and extra-base hits (391 - T3rd).

» Cleveland's offense has been particularly potent at Progressive Field, as they lead the A.L. with 337 runs scored and 51 steals at home...they also rank 2nd in home runs (87), team batting average (.273), hits (538) and extra-base hits (208 - T2nd) at home.

FINISH THEM OFF

» The Indians enter play today with a 27-10 record in series finales, including a 16-3 mark in home finales...Cleveland's .730 win percentage in finales is 2nd-best in the A.L. (Boston - .778).

» Tribe starting pitchers have excelled in series finales, posting a 24-4 record with a 2.28 ERA (63ER/248.1IP), including wins in 16 of their last 18 decisions.

» Cleveland has won each of its last six series finales overall, as well as each of the last five here at Progressive Field, outscoring opponents 43-10 in those contests.

YAN STREAKING

» YAN GOMES increased his hit streak to seven games with a single last night, one game shy of his season-long eight-game streak from April 8-22...he is batting .292 (7-24) over the streak with a homer, a double, two RBI and four runs scored.
