SAN DIEGO NOTES

- Tonight's game lasted two hours and 13 minutes, the shortest game time for the Padres this season.
- **Jacob Nix** became the fourth Padres pitcher in franchise history to work 8.0-or-more innings without allowing a walk or logging a single strikeout, is the first to do so since Dennis Rasmussen on April 24, 1990 vs. CHC...became the sixth major league pitcher since 2000 to work at least 8.0 innings without recording a strikeout or a walk (Also: Porcello, Lohse, Hunter, Verlander, Pineiro)...improves to 2-2 on the season with a 4.05 ERA (9 ER, 20.0 IP).
 - Is the first pitcher to start two-or-more double plays in a game since Tyler Chatwood with Colorado on July 6, 2017 vs. CIN (started two).
- **Travis Jankowski** belted his first career leadoff homer and the second by a Padre this season (also: Manuel Margot, June 24 at SF)...has hit in 12-straight starts since July 31, the longest hitting streak of his career in consecutive starts (.340, 16-for-47) with four doubles.
- **Hunter Renfro** has 22 RBI in his last 22 games since Aug.4 at CHC, which lead the National League in that time...is riding a five-game hitting streak, batting .381 (8-for-21) with a double and two home runs.
- **Wil Myers** has a .389 batting average, .433 OBP and a 1.044 OPS in his career vs. SEA, his highest marks against any single team.
- **Luis Urías** made his major league debut.

SEATTLE NOTES

- **Félix Hernández** made his 400th career Mariners start tonight, becoming one of just 18 pitchers in the Live-Ball Era to maintain an ERA below 3.50 through their first 400 starts with a single club...tallied a season-high nine strikeouts in tonight's game, and has recorded a quality start in each of his eight contests vs. SD at Petco Park with a 1.63 ERA (11 ER, 60.2 IP) over that time.
 - Owns a 11-4 record with a 2.89 ERA (41 ER, 127.2 IP) in 19 career Interleague starts on the road.
- **Nelson Cruz** recorded his 32nd home run of the year...has a nine-game hitting streak vs. the Padres, going 14-for-35 (.400) with 11 runs scored, a double, four home runs, nine RBI and four walks.
- **Jean Segura** went 2-for-4 tonight and logged his third triple of the season...has hit safely in 12 of his 17 contests including nine multi-hit games since Aug. 5...batting .361 (26-for-72) with seven RBI and two doubles during that span...entered today's game ranked fifth in the majors in multi-hit games.
- **Mitch Haniger** has hit safely in 21 of his 25 games in August, batting .356 (37-for-104) with a .409 OBP and a .577 slugging percentage.
