The Mariners have the 3rd-best team ERA in the month of September with a mark of 3.22 (59 ER, 165.0 IP)...trail Milwaukee (2.52) and Los Angeles-NL (3.15), while ranking ahead of Houston (3.27) and Tampa Bay (3.27).

The Mariners shut out the Rangers, 13-0, last night...marked the 7th time in club history to score at least 13 runs in a shutout win and the first since a 13-0 win on July 2, 2003 at Oakland...Seattle has won, 14-0, 3 times in club history and 13-0 on 4 occasions.

Mitch Haniger has reached base safely (via hit or BB) in 30 of his last 31 games, dating back to Aug. 18...he has collected a hit in 29 of his last 31 games, batting .328 (42x128).

TODAY'S TILT...the Mariners continue their final road trip of the season, an 11-day, 10-game, 3-city jaunt, with the finale (1-1) of 3 games at Texas...began the trip by going 3-1 at Los Angeles-AL and 2-1 at Houston...return home Monday to close out the 2018 season hosting Oakland (3 games) and Texas (4 games)...today's game will be televised on **ROOT SPORTS NW** and broadcast live on **770 KTTH** and the Mariners Radio Network.

ODDS AND ENDS...the Mariners won last night and have won 6 of their last 9 and 7 of their last 12...are 20-19 in their last 39 games since Aug. 9...are 30-38 in their last 68 games since July 4 after winning a season-high 8 straight games, spanning June 25 - July 3...the Mariners are 45-45 in their last 90 games since June 10...Seattle is 71-58 in its last 129 games (4/28-c) and 76-61 over its last 137 games (4/20-c)...Seattle is 24-26 during the day and 61-43 at night...Seattle is 41-33 at Safeco Field, 44-36 on the road.

- **Hit Parade - Mitch Haniger** has hit safely in 11 consecutive games, the 3rd longest active hitting streak in the Majors (Charlie Blackmon-COL, 14, and Whit Merrifield-KC, 13)...during the streak (9/11-c), Haniger is batting .422 (19x45) with 12 runs, 5 doubles, 1 triple, 2 home runs, 6 RBI and 4 walks...he has hit safely in 29 of his last 31 games (8/18-c), including a 17-game hitting streak from Aug. 18 - Sept. 5.
- **Daily Double - Mitch Haniger** has 20 doubles since the All-Star Break, tied for 2nd-most in the Majors (also: Joey Wendle-TB), behind Matt Chapman-OAK (25)...Haniger is the 12th Mariners player in club history (done 16x) with at least 20 doubles after the All-Star Break and the first since Jose Lopez in 2009 (24).
- **Full 90 - Nelson Cruz** (92 RBI) has recorded at least 90 RBI for the 5th consecutive season...so far, he is the 2nd player in the Majors with 90+ RBI in every season since 2014 (also: Edwin Encarnación)...José Abreu (78 RBI) and Albert Pujols (64 RBI) could join this duo.
- **Exist to Assist - Mitch Haniger** has 12 outfield assists this season, tied with Andrew Benintendi-BOS and Billy Hamilton-CIN for the Major League lead...each of Haniger's 12 outfield assists have come as a right fielder, tops by any right fielder in the Majors...Haniger's 12 outfield assists are the most by a Mariners player since **Ichiro Suzuki** also had 12 outfield assists in 2004.
- **Four Score** - the Mariners are 62-19 when scoring 4-or-more runs, but are 23-50 when scoring 3-or-fewer runs.
- **Get Through 8** - the Mariners are 1 of 2 Major League clubs with a 1.000 winning percentage (74-0) when leading after 8 innings this season, joining Oakland (76-0).
- **Division Rivals** - the Mariners are in the midst of playing their final 17 games (6-3) vs. AL West foes...Seattle is 37-31 (.544) vs. the AL West this season (**7-7 vs. TEX**, 10-9 vs. HOU, 11-8 vs. LAA and 9-7 vs. OAK).

IT'S A WONDERFUL WADE...in his last 5 starts (8/25-c), **Wade LeBlanc** is 1-1 with a 1.23 ERA (4 ER, 29.1 IP) with 21 strikeouts and 10 walks...over this span, LeBlanc has limited opposing batters to a .194 (20x103) average against while posting a 1.02 WHIP (10 BB, 20 H, 29.1 IP)...LeBlanc has worked at least 5.0 innings in each of his last 5 starts, including 3 of 6.0+ innings...he has allowed 2 or fewer earned runs in each of his last 5 outings, including 3 starts in which he has allowed 1 or fewer earned runs.

CAREER YEAR...after moving into the Mariners starting rotation on May 3, **Wade LeBlanc** will be making his 26th start of the season today, establishing a single-season career-high (previous: 25, 2010 w/SD)...LeBlanc has already recorded career-best marks this season in innings pitched with 152.0 IP (previous: 146.0, 2010 w/SD) and strikeouts with 119 (previous: 110, 2010 w/SD)...he is currently tied for his most wins in a season with 8 (also: 2010 w/SD).

THE CANÓ SHOW...**Robinson Canó** has recorded 4 consecutive multi-hit games, going 11-for-15 (.733) with 3 runs, 5 doubles, 1 home run and 7 RBI in that span...since Sept. 4, Canó is batting .390 (23x59) with 9 runs, 7 doubles, 3 home runs, 16 RBI, 1 HBP, 6 walks, a .455 on-base percentage and a .661 slugging percentage (1.116 OPS) in 16 games...he has 7 extra-base hits (6 2B, 1 HR) in his last 7 games (9/15-c).

COMING IN HOT...**Mitch Haniger** has hit safely in 42 of his last 48 games, dating back to July 31...during that span, he's batting .337 (67x199) with 35 runs, 20 doubles, 2 triples, 8 home runs, 23 RBI, 2 HBP, 17 walks, a .391 on-base percentage and a .578 slugging percentage (.969 OPS)...**Haniger leads the Major Leagues in hits since July 31**, while also ranking T2nd in doubles, 3rd in extra-base hits, 7th in batting, 9th in OPS and T9th in runs...Mitch went 3-for-5 last night and has 7 multi-hit games in his last 10 contests.

HOME AWAY FROM HOME...with 1 road game remaining this season, the Mariners are 44-36 (.550), tied for the 4th-most road wins in the Majors...the Mariners are tied with Oakland (44-31/.587) and St. Louis (44-34/.564), while trailing Houston (52/22.703), Boston (51-29/.638) and Atlanta (45-30/.600), ...in Mariners club history, the 2018 club is also tied for the 5th-most road wins in a single season (also: 2000, 44-37/.543), trailing 2001 (59-22/.728), 2014 (46-35/.568), 2002 (45-36/.556) and 1997 (45-36/.556).

WHAT A RELIEF...since Sept. 5, Mariners relievers have combined for a 1.40 ERA (9 ER, 58.0 IP), the 2nd-best bullpen mark in the Majors over that span...Seattle trails only Milwaukee (1.32/9 ER, 61.1 IP), while ranking ahead of Colorado (2.52/15 ER, 53.2 IP) and Los Angeles-NL (2.53/15 ER, 53.1 IP)...over this same span (9/5-c), Mariners relievers have recorded 51 strikeouts and 12 walks (1 IBB) while posting a 0.86 WHIP (12 BB, 38 H, 58.0 IP) and limiting opposing batters to a .187 (38x203) average against.

THE EDWIN DÍAZ REPORT...in 71 games this season, **Edwin Díaz** is 56-for-60 (93.3%) in save opportunities with a 2.02 ERA (16 ER, 71.1 IP) with 120 strikeouts and 16 walks...he has limited opposing batters to a .161 (40x249) average against with a 0.79 WHIP (16 BB, 40 H, 71.1 IP)...here are some notes on Díaz's standout season:

- Leads the Major Leagues with 56 saves...Craig Kimbrel-BOS is 2nd with 42.
- Is the 14th pitcher (done 17x) in ML history to record at least 50 saves in a season.
- Is 27-for-30 (90.0%) in one-run save opportunities with a 0.89 ERA (3 ER, 30.1 IP) with 55 strikeouts and 5 walks...the Mariners are 30-0 this season when he enters with a one-run lead.

AS YOU KNOW...**Mike Zunino** hit his 20th home run of the season last night, becoming the 5th Mariners player with at least 20 home runs, joining **Nelson Cruz** (36), **Mitch Haniger** (26), **Ryon Healy** (24) and **Kyle Seager** (22)...**BUT DID YOU KNOW?**...that this marks only the 4th season in club history in which at least 5 Mariners recorded 20+ home runs?...the Mariners last accomplished this feat in 1999 (David Bell, Russ Davis, Ken Griffey Jr., Edgar Martinez and Alex Rodriguez)...a club-record 6 Mariners had 20+ homers in 1997 (Jay Buhner, Davis, Griffey Jr., Martinez, Rodriguez and Paul Sorrento)...in 1996, 5 Mariners reached the 20-home run plateau (Buhner, Griffey Jr., Martinez, Rodriguez and Sorrento).

ABOUT LEBLANC...

- 34-year-old left-hander is making his 31st appearance and 26th start of the season, his 207th career appearance, 105th career start and 4th career appearance (3rd start) against Texas today.
- Signed with Seattle on March 25, 2018 after being released by New York-AL at his request.
- Previously played with Seattle in 2016...acquired on June 22, 2016 from Toronto in exchange for a player to be named later or cash considerations...was traded to Pittsburgh on Sept. 13, 2016 in exchange for a player to be named later or cash considerations.
- Selected by San Diego in the 2nd round of the 2006 MLB First-Year Player Draft.
- Native of Lake Charles, LA...attended Alfred M. Barbe High School.
- Made his Major League debut with the Padres on Sept. 3, 2008 at Los Angeles-NL (L, 4.0,8,5,3,1,HR-2).
- Pitched for the University of Alabama, 2004-06...was 24-9 with a 2.81 ERA (100 ER, 320.1 IP) and 334 strikeouts in 46 career G/45 GS...holds Alabama's all-time record for strikeouts with 334...National Freshman of the Year (*Baseball America*) and SEC Freshman of the Year in 2004 after going 8-4 with a 2.08 ERA (26 ER, 112.2 IP) with 98 strikeouts in 16 G/15 GS while posting 8 complete games, including 2 shutouts.
- Went 2-5 with a 4.23 ERA (21 ER, 44.2 IP) in 8 starts with the Seibu Lions in the Japan Pacific League in 2015.
- Is 9-8-1 with a 3.63 ERA (62 ER, 153.2 IP) in 44 career games (22 starts) in September.

LAST OUTING...did not factor into the decision in his last start, a 4-1 Mariners win at Houston on Sept. 17...allowed just 1 run on 3 hits and 3 walks over 5.1 innings pitched while striking out 5 batters...his 12 starts with 1 or fewer runs allowed is T6th most in the AL (also: Danny Duffy-KC, Corey Kluber-CLE and Masahiro Tanaka-NYY).

FOR STARTERS...since moving into the Mariners rotation on May 3, is 8-4 with a 3.38 ERA (52 ER, 138.1 IP) with 107 strikeouts and 34 walks in 25 starts...the Mariners are 16-9 in those starts...among American League leaders during that span, ranks 6th in WHIP (1.12/34 BB, 121 H, 138.1 IP), 6th in ERA, 9th in BB/9.0 IP (2.21/34 BB, 138.1 IP) and 16th in K/BB (3.15/107 K, 34 BB).

START IT UP...in 33 career starts with the Mariners, is 11-4 with a 3.64 ERA (74 ER, 183.0 IP) with 141 strikeouts and 43 walks...the Mariners are 23-10 in his 33 starts with the club...made 8 starts with Seattle in 2016, going 3-0 with a 4.43 ERA (22 ER, 44.2 IP) with 34 strikeouts and 9 walks.

SCORELESS IN SEATTLE...did not allow a run over 19.0 innings pitched (8/25-9/12), the longest scoreless innings streak among Mariners starters this season.

HE'S A WINNER...made 21 career starts with the Mariners before suffering a loss (6/24/16-7/8/18)...only 1 American League pitcher in the live-ball era had a longer such streak to begin a tenure with a single club (Whitey Ford-NYY, 22, 7/6/50-6/12/53)...among all pitchers in the live-ball era, LeBlanc's streak trailed only Ford and Kirk Rueter-MON (22, 7/7/93-6/15/94)(STATS).

MAKE YOURSELF AT HOME...signed to a contract extension through the 2019 season with annual club options through 2022 on July 3.

THAT'S NEAT!...turned in one of the best starts of his career June 16 vs. Boston, allowing 2 hits and striking out 9 across 7.2 scoreless innings...faced just 1 over the minimum, thanks to a 1st-inning double play...retired 22 straight batters after allowing a leadoff single in the 1st inning, ending with a 2-out single in the 8th...his 7.2 innings and 9 strikeouts were both his most since 2011 with San Diego.

WELCOME (BACK) TO SEATTLE...signed with Seattle on March 25 after being released by New York-AL at his request...became the 43rd player in club history to have spent at least two different stints with the Mariners...Mike Blowers (1992-95, 1997, 1999), Raúl Ibañez (1996-2000, 2004-2008, 2013), Norm Charlton (1993, 1995-97, 2001) and Jeff Nelson (1992-95, 2001-03, 2005) are the only players who spent three separate stints with the Mariners.

2017 SEASON...went 5-2 with 1 save and 4 holds in 50 relief appearances with a 4.50 ERA (34 ER, 68.0 IP), 54 strikeouts and 17 walks with Pittsburgh...held right-handed batters to a .217 (38x175) batting average against with a .270 OBP and a .389 slugging percentage (.658 OPS against).

CAREER...10-year MLB veteran with 7 clubs (San Diego, Miami, Houston, Los Angeles-AL, New York-AL, Pittsburgh & Seattle)...overall, is 38-38-3 with a 4.21 ERA (341 ER, 728.2 IP) in 206 career appearances/104 starts...in 104 career starts, is 30-35 with a 4.27 ERA (269 ER, 567.1 IP) with 401 strikeouts and 181 walks...in 102 career relief appearances, is 8-4-3 with a 4.02 ERA (72 ER, 161.1 IP) with 125 strikeouts and 43 walks...appeared in 11 games (8 starts) with the Mariners in 2016, going 3-0-1 with a 4.50 ERA (25 ER, 50.0 IP).
