CHICAGO CUBS NOTES

KRIS BRYANT (2-for-3, 2B, 2 R, BB, HBP) joins Anthony Rizzo (2017) as the only Cubs players in the last 10 seasons to reach base at least twice in 11 of the team's first 14 games.

© Has reached base in 34-of-69 plate appearances this season (.493 OBP).

BEN ZOBRIST (3-for-3, 3B, 2 RBI, 3 R, 2 BB) recorded his second three-hit game of the season, reached base a season-high five times and scored a season-high three runs.

ALBERT ALMORA JR. (1-for-2, HR, 2 R, RBI, BB) hit his first homer of the season in the first inning ... has scored two runs in each of his last two games.

JAVIER BAEZ (1-for-5, 2B, R, 4 RBI) hit a game-tying three-run double in the eighth inning ... recorded his second four-RBI game of the season ... leads the team with 14 RBI.

KYLE SCHWARBER (0-for-1, R, 2 BB, 2 RBI) drove in two runs in the game, both on bases loaded walks ... one in the sixth inning and one in the eighth inning.

NOTES: The Cubs overcame an eight-run deficit to win for the first time since July 7, 2011 at Washington ... trailed 8-0 in that game before winning 10-9.

© The Cubs won a game despite allowing 10-or-more runs for the fourth time in the last 10 seasons ... last time was September 2, 2017, also vs. Atlanta (14-12 win).

© The Cubs scored nine runs in an inning for the first time since July 30, 2012 vs. Pittsburgh (fifth inning) ... the Cubs scored the nine runs on three hits ... first time scoring at least nine runs on three or fewer hits in an inning since May 19, 1954 against the Dodgers at Ebbets Field (nine runs, three hits, four walks, three errors in that contest) ... thanks to Ed Hartig for his research assistance.

© The eighth inning saw the Cubs score nine runs on three hits, five walks, two hit-by-pitches, one wild pitch and one error ... the Cubs sent 13 batters to the plate in the inning.

© According to STATS Inc., the Cubs are the first team to win by four-or-more runs after trailing by eight-or-more runs since the Blue Jays came back from an eight-run deficit to win 14-9 over the Reds on June 20, 2014.

© The game time temperature of 38 degrees marked the coldest first pitch at Wrigley Field since May 16, 2014 vs. Milwaukee (also 38 degrees).

© José Quintana suffered his shortest start since September 2, 2013 at the Yankees (1.0 IP) ... marked his third-career start of fewer than 3.0 innings.

ATLANTA BRAVES NOTES

SEAN NEWCOMB has posted a 1.59 ERA (2 ER/11.1 IP) in his last two starts.

OZZIE ALBIES (3-for-5, 2B, HR, 2 R, 4 RBI, BB) hit his second-career lead-off home run (also, September 29, 2017 at Miami) ... marked Atlanta's first lead-off homer this season.

© Set a career-high with four RBI ... previous career-high was three RBI, done twice ... had an RBI in each of the first four innings.

© Is batting .409 (18-for-44) with eight doubles, four homers and nine RBI in his last 10 games ... has four-consecutive multi-hit games.

DANSBY SWANSON (3-for-6, 2B, 2 R, 2 RBI) scored a season-high two runs and also drove in a pair ... has doubled in four-straight games.

NICK MARKAKIS (2-for-5, 2B, 2 RBI) has reached base in 13 of 14 games ... has consecutive multi-hit games.

NOTES: The Braves hit four more doubles today, giving them an N.L.-best 37 doubles.

© Kurt Suzuki (2-for-3, RBI, 3 BB) reached base a career-high tying five times ... also accomplished the feat, June 4, 2015 at Boston, going 3-for-3 with two walks.

© Freddie Freeman (2-for-5, R, RBI, BB) has hit safely in four-straight games at Wrigley Field.
