FISH BITES

Miami is wrapping up its home slate with the finale of this four-game series against the Cincinnati Reds today at 1:10 p.m. RHP **Trevor Richards**, who is making his 24th start of the season, is facing Cincinnati for the first time in his career. The Reds are starting RHP Michael Lorenzen, who in seven prior appearances (two starts) against the Marlins has gone 1-1 with a 3.15 ERA; his last start against Miami was on July 9, 2015 here at Marlins Park, taking the loss after allowing two runs, five hits, and four walks, while striking out five, over 6.0 innings. Miami opened the homestand with a two-game split against the Washington Nationals, after returning from a wet and wild 2-7 road trip that saw three postponements due to weather. Miami will close out its 2018 season on the road, beginning with a three-game series in Washington from Monday-Wednesday, followed by a three-game set at Citi Field against the Mets, Friday-Sunday, and a makeup game at Pittsburgh on Monday, October 1.

LAST NIGHT'S RECAP

An eighth-inning Redlegs home run snapped a 19-inning scoreless streak by Marlins pitchers, yet Miami secured the season series against the Reds with a 5-1 win. **Lewis Brinson** broke a scoreless tie in the fourth inning with an RBI single to center field, and **Austin Dean** followed with a two-out single to put Miami on top, 2-0. Miami built on its lead in the sixth, as **Brian Anderson** knocked in **J.T. Realmuto**, and Dean connected for his fourth home run of the season, a two-run shot to left field. Dean and **Magneuris Sierra** both had two hit games. Before leaving with a strained right IT band, **José Ureña** limited Cincinnati to just three hits and a walk, while striking out two, over 5.2 innings, and rank his winning streak to a career-high tying five games.

REASON TO CELEBRATE HERITAGE

With Miami's 5-1 win last night, the Marlins improved to 6-1 on heritage nights this season. The only loss came on Colombian Heritage night on July 27, when the Marlins dropped a 9-1 decision to the Nationals. There is one more Hispanic heritage day this season, Mexican Heritage Day, which is today.

VS. THE REDS

Miami secured the season series win a 5-1 victory over the Reds last night. It is the fourth consecutive season series win for the Marlins over the Reds going back to 2015. Prior to 2015, the Marlins hadn't won a season series since going 4-2 in 2005. In the nine seasons between season-series wins, Miami went 0-6-3. The Marlins the all-time series in South Florida (49-49; 14-10 at Marlins Park), and trail the overall series, 90-111.

UP NEXT

The Marlins and Nationals will square off in a three-game series at Nationals Park beginning tomorrow night at 7:10 p.m. After dropping eight of the first nine games of the season series, Miami has taken five of the last seven to run bring close the gap at 6-10. The two teams last met at Marlins Park, splitting a two-game series from September 17-18. Miami is 3-4 at Nationals Park this season, and 57-69 all-time in D.C. the overall series belongs to Miami, as they lead 128-126 (since 2005).

A LOOK AHEAD TO '19

The Marlins will open 2019 Spring Training with pitchers and catchers reporting to Jupiter on February 13. The first full squad workout is scheduled for February 18, and the first game is slated for Saturday, Feb. 23 against the Cardinals. The Marlins will open their 2019 regular season campaign at home on Thursday, March 28 vs. the Colorado Rockies at 4:10 p.m. Miami's first homestand will run March 28-April 3, with the Rockies (March 28-31) and New York Mets (April 1-3) visiting Marlins Park.

WINDING DOWN AT HOME

Despite a 37-43 record at Marlins Park this season, the Marlins pitching staff has put together one of the finer seasons in recent memory at home. The staff will have accumulated the most innings pitched, finishing with a minimum 769.0, ahead of a 2007 staff that tossed 757.0. Marlins pitchers have allowed just 656 hits to date, which ranks as the seventh-fewest in franchise history. Their 7.77 hits allowed per 9.0 ranks as the second-lowest, behind a mark of 7.54 in 1996. The staff's .235 average against would go down as the second-lowest (.230 in '96), while their 3.60 ERA would end as the seventh-best.

LESS IS MORE

Trevor Richards comes into his start today tied for the fourth-fewest hits allowed in a single season at home in Club history (min. 10 GS). In addition to Richards, **Dan Straily** has also allowed just 50 hits at Marlins Park this season. The Franchise record for fewest hits allowed in a home season (min. 10 GS) is 47, done by Livan Hernandez in 1997. Al Leiter follows in second, surrendering just 48 hits over 12 starts, also in 1997. A.J. Burnett, who gave up just 49 hits over 11 starts in 2004, ranks third, and Josh Beckett (2002), **Wei-Yin Chen** (2018), and Tony Saunders (2004) and are tied for sixth with 51.

HOME IMPROVEMENTS

Since June 8, Miami has gone 27-25 over its last 52 games at Marlins Park. That is a drastic improvement over a 10-18 record over the first 28 games at home. The Marlins have posted a 3.39 ERA (494.0 ip/186 er) over the stretch, which is the fifth-best among National League teams behind the Dodgers (3.05), Giants (3.18), Pirates (3.30), and Brewers (3.36).

ALL AROUND ANDY

Brian Anderson leads all Major League rookies in games (150), at-bats (567), runs (83), and average with RISP (.359); ranks second in hits (152), doubles (32), walks (60), multi-hit games (43), and on-base percentage (.352); ranks third in average (.268) and slugging (.392); ranks tied for fourth in triples (4); and ranks fifth in RBI (60). Last night, he reached 150 games, becoming the sixth rookie in club history to do so; Gaby Sanchez (2010) ranks fifth with 151. His 567 at-bats rank sixth, behind Gaby (572) in fifth. Additionally, his 83 runs scored ranks fifth, behind Chris Coghlan (2009) in fourth with 84 and Quilvio Veras (1995) in third with 86. His average with RISP is up to .359, and would rank as the third-best in club history behind Miguel Cabrera (2003) at .375 and Kevin Millar (1999) at .367.

- Trevor Richards will make his 24th start of the season for Miami in the finale of this four-game set against the Cincinnati Reds. On the season, has posted 3-9 record and 4.95 ERA (112.2 ip/62 er) with Miami. Has also made six starts at Triple-A New Orleans, going 3-2 with a 2.06 ERA (39.1/9).
- Has established professional single-season highs in appearances (29), starts (29) and innings pitched (152.0). He previously had 146.0 innings last season between Single-A Jupiter and Double-A Jacksonville.
- From June 23 to August 8, allowed 15 total runs over 48.0 innings pitched in nine starts for a 2.81 ERA. Has allowed 26 runs over his last six starts covering 26.2 innings.
- From July 8 to August 8, recorded six straight starts with four-or-fewer hits allowed. It tied the second-longest such streak in Marlins history, behind a stretch of eight consecutive games by Dan Straily from April 11-May 20, 2017.
- On August 22 vs. the Yankees, did not receive a decision despite allowing just two runs on three hits and three walks (one intentional), with nine strikeouts, over 5.1 innings. The nine strikeouts are the second-most he has struck out in a Major League game, behind a 10-strikeout performance against the Dodgers on April 25.
- On August 14 at Atlanta, surrendered five runs on a season high 10 hits and two walks, with three strikeouts, over 4.1 innings. Prior to that start, had made six consecutive starts with four-or-fewer hits allowed (22 total).
- Went 2-0 with 0.75 ERA (12.0 ip/1 er) in four Spring appearances (two starts) with Miami. Had contract selected on April 2 and made his Major League debut that night against Boston.
- He went 0-2 with a 4.94 ERA (23.2/13) across five starts in his first stint with the Marlins. Tossed 7.0 shutout innings with just two hits allowed on April 14 vs. Pittsburgh, and tossed 4.2 shutout innings, with a career-high 10 strikeouts, on April 25 at the Dodgers, his final start before being optioned back to NOLA.
- In the Pittsburgh start, became the first Marlins rookie starter to work at least 7.0 innings and allow two or fewer hits since Justin Nicolino on September 26, 2015 vs. Atlanta (7.0 ip, 2 h). He became just the 15th pitcher in Club history to do so (22nd time).
- Allowed two-or-fewer earned runs in each of his six starts after returning to New Orleans. Tossed a career-high 7.1 innings against Round Rock in his first game back, on May 1. Struck out nine batters in that game, a Minor League season-high that he tied on May 26 at Iowa.

- Sandy Alcantara, recalled on September 1, will make his fifth start with Miami this season in the opener of a three-game series against the Washington Nationals. In 19 starts at Triple-A New Orleans, posted 6-3 record and 3.89 ERA (115.2 ip/50 er). Also had three rehab starts at Single-A Jupiter, where he had no record and a 3.97 ERA (11.1/5).
- In September 5 start vs. Philadelphia, held Phillies scoreless on three hits and two walks, while striking out six, over a career-high 7.0 innings. According to the *Elias Sports Bureau*, he is just the seventh pitcher in Marlins' history to allow up to one run over his first two career starts, the third this season. The others were: Andy Larkin (1996-1998); Tommy Phelps (2003); Alex Sanabia (2012); José Fernández (2013); **Jarlin García** (2018); and **Eliesser Hernandez** (2018).
- Surrendered just two runs over 7.0 innings on September 13 at Citi Field against the Mets. Allowed two hits and three walks, while tying a career best with six strikeouts. Has surrendered just eight hits over his first three career starts, marking the second-fewest in Marlins history, trailing only **Jarlin García**, who allowed just five over his first three earlier this season. García also holds the record for fewest hits allowed by a Marlins starter over his first four career starts (10), in front of Brad Hand (13), Sean West (14), and Josh Beckett (14).
