**TODAY'S GAME:** The Giants will try and snap a three-game losing streak as they conclude a brief two-game series with the Seattle Mariners today.

**PITCHING DUEL:** RHP Félix Hernández and **RHP Johnny Cueto** will go head-to-head for the first time in their careers...neither Hernández or Cueto allowed a run in their first starts of the season...Hernández shut out the Indians on two hits in 5.1 innings in a 2-1 win, while Cueto took a perfect game into the 7th inning on the road at Los Angeles-NL but wound up with a no-decision in the Giants' 1-0 victory.

**ON THE MOUND:** Cueto has faced the Mariners twice in his career, going 1-1 with a 2.84 ERA (4er, 12.2ip)...Hernandez has faced the Giants four times, going 3-0 with a 1.86 ERA (6er, 29.0ip).

**PANIK'S SOLO HOMERS: IF Joe Panik** provided the Giants' first run of the game yesterday with a solo home run...it was the Giants' third run in their first five games, all of which were the product of solo homers by Panik...according to *Elias*, the Giants are the first team in MLB history whose first three runs of a season came on solo homers by the same player.

**WITH THE BAT: Panik** has hit safely in each of the first five games this season, batting .421 (8-for-19) with three home runs and three RBI...Panik's .396 batting average (42-for-106) since last Sept. 2 is the highest in MLB.

**IN THE 'PEN:** Giants relief pitchers have blanked the opposition in four of five games this year...all their runs allowed came in one game on Sunday at Los Angeles-NL (six runs in 2.2ip)...in the other four games, the relievers have combined for 13.2-scoreless innings.

**RISPY BUSINESS:** The Giants are just 2-for-31 (.065) with runners in scoring position through their first five games.

**NOTABLE BATTER-PITCHER MATCHUPS: IF Evan Longoria** has the most at-bats against today's opposing starter Félix Hernández, going 7-for-30 (.233) lifetime against the Mariners ace...**IF Pablo Sandoval** is 3-for-8 off Hernández with two home runs.

**AT AT&T PARK:** The Giants went 38-43 (.569) at home last season, their first losing record on the Shores of McCovey Cove since 2008 (37-44)...since AT&T Park opened in 2000, the Giants' .565 home winning percentage (826-635) ranks as the fourth-best among NL teams (STL, .604; LAD, .581; ATL, .567).

**THE FIRST TIMERS:** San Francisco has four players that are making their debut on an Opening Day roster: **RHP Roberto Gomez**, **RHP Pierce Johnson**, **RHP Reyes Moronta** and **RHP Chris Stratton**.

#### This Date in Giants History: April 4, 1994

The Giants opened the 1994 season with an 8-0 shutout win over the visiting Pirates at Candlestick Park...**Matt Williams** hit a pair of home runs while driving in five to pace the offense...**John Burkett** got the Opening Day start and threw 7.0-shutout innings.

**TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER**

**#47 RHP Johnny Cueto**  
**5-11, 229, 32 years old (February 15, 1986)**  
**0-0 Record, 0.00 ERA**

- The two-time All-Star (2014 & 2016) is slated to make his second start of the season.
- Received a no decision in his first start of the year last Friday night at Los Angeles-NL in San Francisco's 1-0 victory...was perfect through 6.0 innings before allowing a leadoff single to Chris Taylor in the 7th, his only hit allowed all night...left in a scoreless game, having thrown 97 pitches.
- In Cueto's 11-year big league career he has only thrown 7.0+ innings while allowing one hit or fewer four times: April 3, 2008 vs. ARI; May 11, 2010 at PIT; May 31, 2013 at PIT; March 30, 2018 at LAD.
- In 25 starts last season he logged 7.0+ innings just seven times.
- Logged 19.0 innings this spring and allowed seven runs (3.32 ERA) with 19 strikeouts in five starts.
- Went 8-8 with a 4.52 ERA (74er, 147.1ip) in 25 starts in 2017...his 25 starts were his fewest in a season since 2013 (11 starts).
- His eight wins marked the second fewest he's had in a season over his career...he recorded five wins over 11 starts in 2013.
- Dealt with a blister on his middle finger last season... was placed on the disabled list on July 15 and missed 45 games with blister issues on his right hand and then suffered a flexor tendon strain in his rehab start with San Jose (A) on July 31...went 2-1 with a 4.26 ERA (15er, 31.2ip) in six starts after coming off the DL on Sept. 1.
- Allowed 22 home runs in 147.1 innings pitched in 2017...his 1.34 homers allowed per 9.0 innings was the highest average of his career since 2008 (1.50).
- Held opponents to a .193 (27-for-140) average with runners in scoring position last year and a .161 clip (10-for-62) with RISP and two outs.
- Has faced Seattle just twice in his career, most recently in 2015 while pitching for Kansas City...is 1-1 with a 2.84 ERA (4er, 12.2ip) in those two starts...has never matched up with Mariners' ace Felix Hernandez.
