NATIONALS NEWS

STREAK SNAPPED

Behind a dominating 10-strikeout shutout performance by **Max Scherzer** (more on that below) the Washington Nationals topped the Atlanta Braves, 2-0, to snap their five-game losing streak on Monday night.

- The Nationals will continue this 10-game homestand tonight against Atlanta (2 G) before welcoming the Colorado Rockies to town for a four-game set starting Thursday.

MAX EFFORT

Max Scherzer tossed his ninth career complete game (fifth career shutout) on Monday night against Atlanta...He capped his evening with a strikeout of **Ender Inciarte**, giving him 10 strikeouts for the second time this season and the 66th time in his career.

- For his career, Scherzer has recorded 19 starts in which he's struck out 10 batters and allowed zero earned runs...Those 19 starts are tied for ninth all-time and second among active pitchers (**Clayton Kershaw** - 23).
- According to *Baseball-Reference.com*, Scherzer is the sixth pitcher to have multiple games with at least 10 strikeouts and zero earned runs allowed in the first 10 games of the season.
- In the seventh inning, Scherzer recorded his first career stolen base and the first stolen base by a pitcher in Nationals history (2005-pres.)...All told, he became the first pitcher in MLB history to throw a shutout, record at least 10+ strikeouts and steal a base in one game since **Nolan Ryan** on May 16, 1984 at PIT.

HARPER'S HOMERS

Bryce Harper clubbed his sixth home run of the season on Sunday, a two-run shot in the first inning off **Matt Harvey**...His six home runs lead Major League Baseball, as do his 16 walks, .553 on-base percentage, .966 slugging percentage and 1.519 OPS...He ranks among National League hitters in RBI (T2nd, 12), and batting average (T7th, .345)

- Of his 10 hits this season, six have been home runs...Moreover, Harper has 16 walks and just five strikeouts through the first 10 games of the season.

APRIL'S POWER

Harper's hot starts are well documented through the course of his career...In 128 April games, he is hitting .324 with 30 doubles, three triples, 39 home runs, 103 RBI, 98 walks and 102 runs scored.

- Harper has posted a .667 slugging percentage and a 1.109 OPS in his career during the month of April (447 at bats)...Both are the best in Major League Baseball history (since 1913)...He is ahead of **Babe Ruth**, who posted a .638 slugging percentage and a 1.090 OPS in 643 career at bats in April.

VOTE FOR PEDRO

Since being recalled on April 2, **Pedro Severino** has reached base safely in 12 of 21 plate appearances (.571 OBP, 6 H, 2 HBP, 4 BB)...In five starts, he is hitting .429 (6-for-14) with two doubles, three RBI, four walks, one stolen base and two runs scored...He has recorded two multi-hit efforts and driven in runs in three of the five starts.

- Severino recorded his first career stolen base on April 7 vs. NYM.

TONY! TONY! TONY!

Anthony Rendon has recorded multi-hit efforts in three of his last four games, going 7-for-14 (.500) with three doubles, one RBI, two walks and one run scored...He has hit safely in nine of 10 games this season.

HOWIE'S DOIN' IT

Howie Kendrick has reached base safely in each of his first nine games of the season...He has hit safely in eight of the games and he was hit by a pitch on April 4 at Atlanta while serving as a pinch hitter...Kendrick has recorded four multi-hit efforts along the way, while five of his 12 hits have been doubles.

NO INHERITANCE TAX

Nationals relievers have inherited 11 runners so far this season, with only one coming around to score (9.1%)...They are one of five teams in Major League Baseball (one of three in the NL) to allow no more than one inherited runner to come around to score in 2018.

STOLEN MOMENTS

Washington stole five bases on Saturday, the most in a game since July 27, 2017 vs. CHI and tied for the fourth most in a single game in Nationals history (2005-pres.)...The Nationals lead MLB with 15 stolen bases.

- Trea Turner** leads the National League (tied for 1st in MLB) with five stolen bases this season.
- Michael A. Taylor** ranks second in the NL behind Turner and is third in MLB with four stolen bases.

NATIONALS HISTORY

April 10 (7-6 on this date)

2014 – For the second time in as many days, a **Jayson Werth** home run proved to be the difference between Washington and Miami. His two-run shot in the third inning off **Tom Koehler** propelled the Nationals to an eventual 7-1 victory over the Marlins. **Stephen Strasburg** fanned 12 batters in 6.2 innings of work and **Ian Desmond** provided some insurance via his second career grand slam to give the Nationals their second series sweep of the 2014 campaign.

ATLANTA BRAVES

Dave Martinez capped his 16-year Major League career with Atlanta in 2001, hitting .287 in 12 games...**Matt Adams** clubbed 19 home runs in 100 games for the Braves in 2017...The Braves made Nationals Pitching Coach **Derek Lilliquist** their first-round selection (6th overall) back in the 1987 Amateur Draft.

THE SERIES

The Nationals went 10-9 against the Braves in 2017...Since 2015, Washington is 41-20 against Atlanta.

DAVE MARTINEZ

Nationals manager **Dave Martinez** was named the seventh field manager in Nationals history on Oct. 30, 2017. He joined the Nationals for what will be his 30th season in professional baseball. A 16-year Major League outfielder, Martinez has been a Major League coach for the last 10 seasons, serving as Cubs manager **Joe Maddon's** bench coach and right-hand man in Chicago (2015-17) as well as Tampa Bay (2008-14). This is the first Major League managerial assignment of Martinez's career.

#37 - STEPHEN STRASBURG - RHP

Tall, powerful right-handed pitcher is a three-time All-Star who is Washington's all-time (2005-present) leader in wins (85) and strikeouts (1,301)... On May 10, 2016, he inked a seven-year contract extension that will keep him with the Nationals through the 2023 season...Is 80-43 with a 3.09 ERA in 174 starts since Sept. 6, 2011, his return from Sept. 3, 2010 right elbow surgery...When starting, Washington is 118-68 (.649) since 2010... Since 2012, he ranks among active pitchers in opp. SLG (3rd, .352), strikeouts per 9.0 IP (4th, 10.46), opp. AVG (7th, .224), strikeouts (7th, 1,185), opp. OBP (7th, .281), strikeout-to-walk ratio (8th, 4.44), and ERA (9th, 3.12).

AGAINST THE BRAVES: Faces the Atlanta Braves for the 28th time...Struck out at least 10 batters in three of his four starts against the Braves in 2017...Struck out 31 batters against just six walks (5.17 SO/BB)...Allowed three home runs to Atlanta in 2017, all in one start (6/12 vs. ATL)

LAST START: Allowed four earned runs on five hits in 6.0 innings of work in Washington's home opener, April 5 vs. NYM.

2018 NOTES

- Opened his 2018 season by tossing 6.1 innings while allowing one earned run as Washington topped Cincinnati, 13-7, on March 31...The lone earned run came via a fourth inning home run by **Scott Schebler**.

2017 NOTES

- Put together a strong first half of the season en route to being named an All-Star for the third time in his career.
- Was a finalist for the National League Cy Young Award...Capped 2017 being named National League Pitcher of the Month in September.
- Ranked third in the National League (4th in MLB) with a career-best 2.52 ERA...Ranked second in the NL in FanGraphs.com WAR (5.6).
- Also ranked in NL in HR/9.0 IP (1st, 0.67), opp. SLG (1st, .317), opp. OPS (2nd, .581), WHIP (3rd, 1.02), opp. OBP (3rd, .265), & opp. AVG (3rd, .204).
- Coupled with Max Scherzer (2nd, 2.51) and Gio Gonzalez (5th, 2.96), Strasburg (3rd, 2.52), helped the Nationals become the first team with three starting pitchers ranking in the top five in the NL in ERA in 21 years (since the 1996 Atlanta Braves), according to the *Elias Sports Bureau*.
- On May 27 at San Diego, he struck out a career-high 15 batters in 7.0 shutout innings.
- On Aug. 19 at San Diego, he returned from a three-week stint on the disabled list...He went 5-1 with a 0.84 ERA (5 ER/53.2 IP) in his final eight starts of the regular season following reinstatement...He racked up 63 strikeouts, allowed just 10 walks and surrendered only one home run.
- All told, went 6-1 with a 0.86 ERA in 10 starts after the All-Star break...Via *Elias*, it was the second-lowest post-ASB ERA in MLB history for any pitcher with at least 10 starts...Jake Arrieta had a 0.75 ERA after the break in 2015.
- Recorded a 35.0 scoreless innings streak from that first start back from the DL in San Diego (Aug. 19) that ran until Sept. 17, when an unearned run ended the historic stretch...It was the longest consecutive scoreless innings streak in franchise history (Nationals/Expos) and, per *Elias*, the longest for any player in the Major Leagues since 2015 (**Greinke**, 45.2 IP; **Kershaw**, 37.0 IP).
- Was dominant in the NLDS...Was saddled with the loss in Game 1 despite striking out 10 batters in 7.0 innings without allowing an earned run (7.0 IP, 3 H, 2 R, BB, 10 SO).
- He pushed aside a virus that had made him ill for much of the week, to rack up 12 strikeouts (re-setting his own Postseason franchise record for single-game strikeouts) over 7.0 scoreless innings in Washington's Game 4 victory.
- Became the second pitcher in MLB Postseason history to record a win with 12 or more strikeouts while his team faced elimination...Via the *Elias Sports Bureau*, the first such pitcher was **Joe Coleman**, who struck out 14 in a shutout to help the Detroit Tigers stave off elimination against the Oakland A's in Game 3 of the 1972 ALCS.
- Also per *Elias*, became just the third pitcher in Major League history to post multiple 10-plus strikeout games and no earned runs in a single Postseason series, joining **Sandy Koufax** (1965 World Series vs. MIN) and **Justin Verlander** (2013 ALDS vs. OAK).
