WHITE SOX AT A GLANCE

- The Chicago White Sox have lost four straight games, eight of nine, 10 of 14 and 17 of 23 as they conclude a six-game, seven-day homestand today with the finale vs. Pittsburgh.
- RHP Reynaldo López, who ranks ninth in the American League with a 2.43 ERA (10 ER/37.0 IP), is scheduled to start for Chicago.
- The White Sox opened the homestand by losing three of four to Minnesota, scoring four runs or less in all three losses.
- The Sox 9-24 (.273) record is the third-worst in baseball ahead of Baltimore (8-27, .229) and Cincinnati (9-27, .250).
- Following today's game and tomorrow's off day, the Sox will take a five-game trip to Wrigley Field and PNC Park (5/11-16).
- The White Sox went 3-4 on their last trip at Kansas City and St. Louis from 4/26-5/2 and 1-5 on their last homestand vs. Houston (0-3) and Seattle (1-2) from 4/20-25.

TODAY'S STORYLINES

- Chicago is a season-high 15 games under .500 ... the club's 9-24 start is its second-worst in club history (8-25 in 1948) ... the Sox worst 34-game win-loss mark was 8-26 in 1948.
- The White Sox 3-14 (.176) home record is the worst in MLB, and their worst 17-game start in Chicago since 1971 (3-14) ... a loss today would give the Sox their worst 18-game home start in franchise history (currently 4-14 in 1948, 1971 and 1986).
- Chicago relievers own a 2.64 ERA (14 ER/47.2 IP) and 38 strikeouts since 4/24 (14 games), tied for the fourth-lowest in MLB during that span ... prior to last night's game, the group owned a 1.69 ERA (8 ER/42.2 IP) since 4/24.
- Reynaldo López has allowed nine runs (six earned) over his last two starts (13.0 IP) after recording a 1.50 mark (4 ER/24.0 IP) in his four outings (three quality starts).
- Yolmer Sánchez is hitting .355/.385/.516 with six doubles, two triples, nine RBI and eight multihit efforts in the last 15 games.

LAST NIGHT'S RECAP

- Pittsburgh erased an early 4-0 deficit by scoring nine runs over the first six innings en route to a 10-6 victory.
- The White Sox scored four times in the first with six of the first seven hitters reaching base ... the Pirates tied the game with four runs in the second and scored three times in the fifth and twice in the sixth to take the lead for good.
- Starter Lucas Giolito received a ND despite allowing four runs on seven hits with two walks over 4.0 IP (98 pitches) ... Chris Volstad (3 ER/1.0 IP) suffered the loss.
- Wellington Castillo recorded his second career multihomer game, José Abreu went 2-4 with two RBI and Yolmer Sánchez went 3-5 with a triple and RBI.
- The Sox suffered their 12th loss after holding a lead, tied with Baltimore and Kansas City for the most in the major leagues.

LOOK AT THOSE NUMBERS!

- Below is a breakdown of key rankings and statistics for today's White Sox starter Reynaldo López:
 - Ranks ninth in the American League in average vs. right-handed hitters (.182) and ninth in ERA (2.43) ... his 2.92 run support average (12 RS/37.0 IP) is tied for the sixth-lowest in the AL.
 - Is 0-1 in two day starts despite owning a 0.75 ERA (1 ER/12.0 IP), 1.54 opponents average (6-39) and .479 OPS.
 - Opponents own the following averages in 2018: .188 (12-64) at Guaranteed Rate Field, .191 (9-47) with runners on base, .148 (4-27) with RISP and .167 (2-12) with RISP/two outs.

STREAKING IN CHICAGO

- The White Sox are trying to avoid losing their sixth consecutive series at Guaranteed Rate Field to start the 2018 season.
- The current five-series home losing streak is the second-longest in franchise history (two-plus games per series) to open a season ... the 1971 Sox lost each of their first six home series.

ONE (RUN) AND DONE

- Chicago has gone 4-9 in one-run games in 2018, tied for the third-most in the major leagues behind Tampa Bay (5-12) and Boston (10-4) ... the nine one-run losses are tied with Cincinnati (4-9) for the second-most in MLB.
- The Sox were 21-23 in one-run games in 2017.

DANNY FARQUHAR UPDATE

- White Sox RHP Danny Farquhar yesterday visited teammates and coaches in the home clubhouse at Guaranteed Rate Field.
- The club announced on Thursday that Farquhar, who suffered a brain hemorrhage from a ruptured aneurysm during a home game on 4/20, has been discharged from RUSH University Medical Center and is resting at home with his family.
- Farquhar's neurosurgeon expects Danny to be able to pitch again in the future, but he will not be medically released to pitch in a competitive game during the 2018 season.

WHITE SOX VS. PITTSBURGH

- Chicago and Pittsburgh play four times this season: two games at Guaranteed Rate Field and two at PNC Park.
- The Pirates swept all four games in the last season series in 2015, outscoring the White Sox by a 20-4 margin ... prior to 2-15, the Sox had won eight of nine games from 2008-19.
- The White Sox and Pirates met in each of the first three years of interleague play (1997-99) and every season from 2006-10.
- The White Sox are 17-14 all-time, going 9-6 at Guaranteed Rate Field and 8-8 on the road (6-5 at PNC Park).

WINDY CITY MEETS THE STEEL CITY

- White Sox manager Rick Renteria was drafted by Pittsburgh in the first round (20th overall) of the 1980 draft.
- Sox RHPs Joakim Soria (29 games) and Chris Volstad (one game) played for the Pirates in 2015.
- Pirates third-base coach Joey Cora was on the Sox coaching staff from 2004-11, and played for the club from 1991-94 ... pitching coach Ray Searage pitched for the Sox from 1986-87.
- Pittsburgh RHP George Kontos is a native of Lincolnwood, Ill., graduate of Niles West H.S. and pitched for Northwestern.

INTERLEAGUE INSIGHT

- The White Sox are 0-3 during interleague play this season with 16 games remaining, including seven more in May.
- The Sox went 6-14 during IL play last season and have not recorded a winning record since 2014 (11-9).
- Chicago is 4-8 over its last eight IL games at home.
- The Sox are 206-180 (.534) all-time during interleague play (since 1997), tied for the fifth-best record in baseball.

BASHING BARONS

- Below is a breakdown of notable performances, accomplishments and rankings from players at Class AA Birmingham:
 - OF Eloy Jiménez, who last night vs. Pensacola homered for the third time in his last five games, is hitting .407 (22-54) with six doubles, five home runs, 16 RBI, 11 runs scored and a .418 on-base percentage during his current 12-game hitting streak ... he ranks second in the Southern League in home runs (seven) and fourth in RBI (21).
 - C Zack Collins leads the SL in walks (22) and ranks fourth in on-base percentage (.442) ... he is hitting .386 (17-44) with two doubles, one triple, three homers, 10 RBI and 17 walks over his last 14 games.
 - C Seby Zavala leads the SL in home runs (eight) and homer/at-bat ratio (12.13) and ranks third in RBI (22).
 - RHP Dane Dunning is tied for third among all minor-league pitchers with 46 strikeouts this season.

DASHING TO THE TOP

- Class A Winston-Salem DH Micker Adolfo is 9-23 (.391) with one home run, five RBI and six walks over seven May games ... he leads the Carolina League in extra-base hits (18), is tied for the lead in home runs (six), RBI (26) and doubles (11), ranks second in slugging pct. (.596) and fifth in in average (.325).
- Winston-Salem OF Blake Rutherford has hit safely in 10 of his last 11 games, batting .319 (15-47) with one double, two triples, one homer and 10 RBI ... ranks third in the CL in average (.330).
- Dash OF Joel Booker is 17-52 (.327) with four doubles, one triple, five RBI and five multihit efforts in his last 13 games ... he ranks fourth in the CL in average (.326) and fifth in OBP (.415).
- OF Luis Basabe ranks second in the CL in extra-base hits (16) and third in slugging percentage (.574)

STOP! THIEF!

- The White Sox lead the American League and rank second in baseball with 31 stolen bases ... the club ranks fourth in the major leagues with an 81.6 (31-38) success rate.
- Tim Anderson (2nd, 10), Leury García (T7th, 6) and Adam Engel (T10th, 5) rank among AL leaders this season.
- The Sox are on pace to steal 152 bases this season ... by comparison, they stole 71 bases in 2017 and 77 in 2016.

NO RISP, NO REWARD

- The White Sox rank 15th in the American League and 29th in MLB with a .208 (55-264) average with RISP this season.
- Chicago is hitting .175 (10-50) with RISP in the last eight games, compared to .305 (18-59) in the previous eight ... the Sox have been limited to two hits or less w/RISP 25 times in 2018.

ON DECK: AT CHICAGO CUBS

- The White Sox continue interleague play with a three-game weekend series vs. the Cubs at Wrigley Field.
- The Sox have lost three straight games and five of the last six overall dating back to 2016 ... the White Sox are 1-4 in the last five games at Wrigley Field, but 8-6 in the last 14 since 2012.
- The White Sox are 1-2-2 in season series since 2013 ... they lead the all-time series, 58-54, going 30-26 at Guaranteed Rate Field and 28-28 at Wrigley Field.
