



# SAN DIEGO PADRES 2018 GAME NOTES

**ROCK AND ROLL:** Under the Friday night lights, the Friars claimed their fourth consecutive win and their fourth shut-out victory of the season, besting the Colorado Rockies 7-0...**Brett Kennedy** worked a career-high 6.0 innings, holding Rockie bats to four hits and no runs while walking and fanning two...he received his first ML victory, the day after **Robert Stock** was credited with his first win...the duo became the first Padres rookies to log their first-career wins in back-to-back games since Clay Condrey and Doug Nickle (Aug. 31-Sept. 1, 2002)...**Luis Urías** hit his first-career home run in the eighth inning, and **Franmil Reyes** and **Wil Myers** added solo shots.

**SERIESLY:** A win tonight would clinch back-to-back home series wins for San Diego (done just once before this season when SD won three straight home series from May 28-June 6 vs. MIA, CIN and ATL).

**BACK AT SEA LEVEL:** The Padres have won three straight games at Petco vs. COL for the first time since they claimed six straight (Sept. 24, 2014-July 18, 2015)...a win tonight would clinch their first series victory at home vs. COL since June 3-5, 2016.

**LET'S MAKE IT FIVE:** The Padres have won four straight games for the first time since July 26-29, 2017...the last time the Friars won five straight dates to May 28-June 2, 2017 (won five consecutive).

**WAKE ME UP BEFORE SEPTEMBER ENDS:** Today, the Padres reinstated RHP **Bryan Mitchell** from the 10-day disabled list (was sidelined with a right elbow impingement on June 20)...Mitchell will get the ball in Game 1 of the brief two-game set @ Arizona on Sept. 3...the Padres now have 26 players on their active roster.

**KINGS OF THE CASTLE:** **Hunter Renfro** finished August as the National League RBI leader with 27...the last Padre to lead or tie for the NL lead in RBI was **Wil Myers** in July of this season (had 23 and tied with CHC Javier Baez and MIL Christian Yelich)...Myers and Renfro became the first Padres to lead or tie for the NL lead in RBI in consecutive calendar months since **Chase Headley** led the NL with 31 RBI in a Aug. 2012 and 30 in Sept. 2012.

**GONE STREAKIN':** **Hunter Renfro** has hit in a career-high eight straight games, batting .333 (12-for-35) since August 23 with two 2B, three HR and nine RBI...**Franmil Reyes** is also riding a career-high six-game hitting spree (.438, 7-for-16 with four HR).

**HAPPY 28TH:** In the Padres past four games since Aug. 28, SD starters have amassed a 0.69 ERA (2 er, 26.0 ip), which is second to just CLE's 0.68 mark for the best ERA in baseball in that time.

**GRAB SOME PINE:** The SD bullpen finished August with 11.60 strikeouts per nine innings, the best mark of any 'pen in the month.

**IT'S A GRAY AREA:** Friars with notable numbers vs. opposing starter **Jon Gray:** **Freddy Galvis** (.278, 5-for-18 with a triple and a homer), **Manuel Margot** (.300, 3-for-10 with a triple and two walks), **Wil Myers** (.348, 8-for-23 with two doubles, one homer and two walks) and **Jose Pirela** (.333, 4-for-12 with one double).

**PADRES ON DECK:** Last night for El Paso (AAA), INF **Ty France** went 2-for-5 with a double, homer and four RBI...for San Antonio (AA), CF **Buddy Reed** was 3-for-4 with a solo homer, and C **Austin Allen** was 2-for-4...for Lake Elsinore (A), CF **Edward Olivares** went 2-for-4 with a double and a solo homer, and LHP **Nick Margevicius** allowed two runs on six hits and no walks with five strikeouts over 7.1 innings.

## STARTING PITCHER NOTES

**#41 LHP Robbie Erlin (3-4, 3.69)**

**HURLIN' ERLIN:** 27-year-old **Robbie Erlin** is set to make his eighth start of the season and 33rd of his career...it'll be his 35th overall appearance this season, having made 27 appearances out of the SD bullpen.

- It will be his seventh appearance against the Rockies this season...only two other hurlers (including reliever Craig Stammen) have made seven appearances against COL this year, while three pitchers have made eight.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Saddled with the loss in his last outing on 8/26 at LAD (4.2 IP, 8 H, 4 ER)...it marked his second-career appearance at Dodger Stadium, with his other outing coming on October 3, 2015 (7.0 IP, 2 ER, 5 H).

**ERLIN'S ARSENAL:** This season, he's relied on five pitches: sinker (30.8%), four seamer (29.6%), curve (19.4%), changeup (17.8%) and slider (2.4%).

**SPIN RATE:** His curveball this season has an average spin rate of 2472 rpm (revolutions per minute), which is the highest spin rate of any pitch in a single season in his career.

**FEW FREE PASSES:** Has walked just nine of the 335 batters he has faced this season...his 0.95 walks per nine innings this season is the third-best mark of any pitcher this year who has made at least 34 appearances.

**HAVE A SEASON:** Between both the majors and minors, his 34 appearances this year are the most in a single season in his career (previous high was 28 in 2010 with the Rangers' single-A affiliate)...his 3.69 ERA is also his lowest in any season in the majors (previous best was his 2.12 ERA, also in 2010).

**RISPY BUSINESS:** In the month of August, opposing bats have hit .318 vs. Robbie with RISP (7-for-22)...in his career, opponents are hitting .290 (53-for-183) with RISP.

**HOT AS SUMMER:** Since July 1, he has posted a 3.11 ERA (13 er, 37.2 IP) with 28 strikeouts against four walks across 12 appearances (five starts)...he has a 1.06 WHIP in that time, and his 7.00 SO/BB ratio is tied for the ninth-best among NL hurlers in that time (with at least 12 appearances).

**GOOD 'PENMANSHIP:** Has worked primarily out of the bullpen this season, making 18 scoreless appearances out of his 27 relief outings and posting a 2.05 ERA (12 er, 52.2 ip) with 44 strikeouts against four walks...Erlin has made five separate long relief outings of at least 3.1 ip, including a career-high scoreless 5.2 ip of relief on May 28 vs. MIA.

**GIVE ME A BREAK:** In his career, Erlin posted a 4.63 ERA (72 er, 140.0 ip) before the All-Star Break...he's settled into a 3.64 mark (38 er, 94.0 ip) in his career post-All-Star Break...this season, he had a 3.83 ERA (23 ER, 54.0 IP) prior to the break, and he's fostered a 3.45 ERA since (12 er, 31.1 ip).

**LONGEST TENURED PADRE:** Erlin was originally acquired by the Pares along with RHP Joe Wieland from the Texas Ranges in exchange for RHP Mike Adams on July 31, 2011...he made his ML debut on April 30, 2013 at CHC...he is the longest tenured pitcher who has appeared for the Padres at the big league level.

**LONG ROAD BACK:** Began the 2016 season with El Paso (AAA) but did not pitch in a game before being called up by SD on April 8, 2016, making three starts before undergoing season-ending Tommy John surgery on his left elbow on May 17, 2016.

## TOMORROW'S STARTER — #63 RHP Jacob Nix (2-2, 4.05) — juicy\_jake33

**NIX'N NOD:** RHP **Jacob Nix** is set to make his fifth-career start and his second against the Colorado Rockies tomorrow...in his last time out (Aug. 28 vs. SEA), Nix tossed 8.1 IP of one-run ball on no strikeouts and no walks, tossing just 79 pitches.

- Has relied on four pitches: four-seamer (64.6%), curve (20%), changeup (13.4%) and slider (2%)...his fastball averages at 93.1 mph, and opposing bats are hitting just .077 against his changeup.
- In his Major League debut on Aug. 10 vs. PHI, he worked 6.0 innings of four-hit, scoreless ball, accruing four strikeouts on two walks and leading the Padres to their 2-0 victory over the Phillies, becoming the first Padre to toss 6.0-or-more scoreless innings in his debut since Odrisamer Despaigne on June 23, 2014 @ SF (7.0 innings).
