**THE TWINS:** The Twins have gone 2-2 through four games on their six-game homestand, going 2-1 vs. Kansas City and 0-1 vs. New York-AL...tonight they will continue the homestand with the second of three vs. the Yankees...after this series, the Twins will make their final roadtrip of the season with four at Kansas City September 13-16, three at Detroit September 17-19 and three at Oakland September 21-23.

**TWINS DROP OPENER WITH YANKEES:** The Twins lost to the Yankees last night at Target Field by a score of 7-2...Kyle Gibson (7-13) was the starter and loser, allowing one run on four hits in 5.2 innings pitched...the bullpen combined to allow six runs on seven hits in 3.1 innings pitched...the offense recorded 10 hits, Logan Forsythe, Jorge Polanco and Robbie Grossman each had two hits.

**TWINS AND YANKEES:** The Twins are playing the sixth of seven games vs. the Yankees this season...the Twins have lost eight straight games against the Yankees, excluding the 2017 AL Wild Card Game...in those eight games, the Twins have been out-scored 58-19 and out-hit 84-57.

☞ Jake Cave was drafted by the Yankees in the 6th round of the 2011 First-Year Player Draft...he played six seasons in New York's minor league system before being traded to Minnesota on March 16, in exchange for right-handed pitcher Luis Gil.

☞ Tyler Austin was drafted by the Yankees in the 13th round of the 2010 First-Year Player Draft...he played parts of three seasons for New York at the major league level prior to getting traded to Minnesota along with minor league right-handed pitcher Luis Rijo on July 30, in exchange for Lance Lynn.

☞ Zack Littell pitched part of 2017 in the Yankees system...he was acquired by the Twins at the trade deadline in 2017 along with left-handed pitcher Dietrich Enns and cash, in exchange for Jaime Garcia.

**MINNESOTA, NICE:** The Twins have gone 41-31 at home this season, compared to 24-47 on the road...the Twins won 41 games at home last season...they have gone 22-11 at Target Field since June 24...since that date, they have the fourth best home winning percentage in the AL (.667), trailing Tampa Bay (.778), Boston (.758) and Oakland (.743).

**ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY:** In 1999, Eric Milton pitched the fourth no-hitter (5 now) in Twins history, against the Anaheim Angels in the Metrodome as the Twins won 7-0...Milton struck out 13 Angels and allowed two to reach via walk, throwing 125 pitches, 81 for strikes...the start time of that game was 11:05 am to accommodate the University of Minnesota football game.

**IT'S A MIRACLE:** The Twins Single-A Affiliate Ft. Myers Miracle beat the Daytona Tortugas by a score of 8-5 last night in Game 4 of the Florida State League Championship to clinch the series 3-1...the Miracle scored five runs in the third inning and took a 5-3 lead thanks to a three-run home run by Ryan Costello...Edwar Colina was the starter and winner for Ft. Myers, allowing three runs (none earned) on three hits and four walks with six strikeouts over 6.2 innings...Ft. Myers outscored Daytona 25-14 in the series...over the four games, Travis Blankenhorn hit .538 (7-for-13) with a double, four RBI and five runs scored while Royce Lewis hit .294 (5-for-17) with five RBI and five runs scored...the Miracle are the second Twins affiliate to win a championship this year, the first being Rookie Elizabethton, who won the Appalachian League title on September 5...it marks their first FSL Championship since 2014.

- ☞ This season, Joe Mauer has an average launch angle of 20.4 degrees on 191 balls in play -- Rank: 2nd lowest among 176 full time hitters in MLB; League Avg: 27.
- ☞ 2.6% of Joe Mauer's plate appearances have lasted only one pitch (12/468 PAs) this season -- lowest in MLB among hitters with at least 213 PA's; League Avg: 10.8%.
