### TRIBE HEADLINES

» Cleveland's "magic number" to clinch its third consecutive American League Central title currently stands at 3.  
» **EDWIN ENCARNACION** became the third Tribe player to reach 30 home runs last night, marking the club's first such trio since the 1999 season...Encarnacion's streak of seven straight seasons with 30-or-more homers is the longest active run in MLB.  
» The Indians have recorded 27 starts this seasons with 10-or-more strikeouts, T1st in MLB and T4th in Major League history.  
» **CARLOS CARRASCO** ranks 3rd in the A.L. with a 2.31 second-half ERA (min. 50.0IP)...he sits seven strikeouts shy of matching **Gary Bell** (1,104) for 9th place on the Tribe's all-time leaderboard.

### YESTERDAY'S RECAP

» The Indians lowered their "magic number" to clinch the A.L. Central to 3 with a 2-0 victory last night at Tampa Bay, evening their three-game set at one contest apiece...marked the Tribe's 15th shutout victory of the season (1st in A.L., 2nd in MLB).  
» Both Cleveland runs scored via solo homer...**YAN GOMES** (2-4) gave the Indians the lead in the top of the 5th inning with his 14th longball of the season...the next inning, **EDWIN ENCARNACION** (2-3) belted his 30th home run, giving the Tribe an insurance run.  
» **JOSH DONALDSON** batted 5th and started at third base in his Indians debut, going 0-for-4 before being lifted in the bottom of the 8th inning.  
» **SHANE BIEBER** turned in the most dominant performance of his MLB career, holding the Rays to just three hits over 6.2 shutout innings...**struck out 11 batters, establishing a new career high**...Bieber became the first Tribe rookie to reach 10 wins since **Mitch Talbot** did so in the 2010 campaign.  
» **BRAD HAND** worked 1.1 scoreless innings in relief (0H, 1BB, 1K), while **CODY ALLEN** (1.0IP, 12H, 0BB, 1K) earned his 27th save (6th in A.L.) and preserved the shutout.

### WINNING WAYS

» Last night's victory gave Cleveland 82 wins this season, clinching their sixth straight season with a record above .500...marks the 5th-longest streak of winning seasons in franchise history.  
» The Tribe's six consecutive winning seasons coincide with manager **Terry Francona's** first six years at the helm...Francona's run of campaigns above .500 is tied for the longest in franchise history by a single manager, matching **Al López** (1951-56) and **Mike Hargrove** (1994-99)...López and Francona are the only Tribe skipper to accomplish the feat at the beginning of their Cleveland tenures.

### GOOSE EGGS

» Last night marked the Indians' 15th team shutout of 2018, marking the most in the American League and 2nd-most in MLB (Chicago-NL has 16).  
» All six Tribe pitchers with 10-or-more starts this season have started at least one of the Tribe's 15 shutouts...**COREY KLUBER** has started four of those contests to lead the club.  
» Cleveland led the Majors in 2017 with 19 shutouts...their 34 blankings since the start of last season are the most in MLB.

### POWER OF 10

» **SHANE BIEBER** became the fifth Indians pitcher to reach the 10-win mark this season, joining **COREY KLUBER** (18), **CARLOS CARRASCO** (16), **TREVOR BAUER** (12) and **MIKE CLEVINGER** (11)...Tribe is the second team in MLB to feature five such pitchers this year, alongside Houston.  
» Cleveland has featured five pitchers with 10+ wins each of the last three seasons (since 2016), the first such streak in franchise history...Tribe is just the fifth team in MLB with a similar three-season streak in the last 50 years, joining Tampa Bay (2010-12), Boston (1977-79), Los Angeles-NL (1976-78) and Cincinnati (1973-76).

### RAYS 'EM UP

» Cleveland is concluding its six-game season series vs. Tampa Bay this afternoon with their final contest at Tropicana Field.  
» In the clubs' first matchup at Progressive Field from August 31-September 2, the Rays won two out of three contests...Tampa Bay holds a 3-2 advantage in the season series despite an even runs scored margin of 17-17.

### THIS DAY IN INDIANS HISTORY

**1954:** In front of 84,587 fans at Municipal Stadium, the largest crowd ever at an MLB game, the pennant-bound Indians sweep a doubleheader vs. the New York Yankees...**Bob Lemon** tossed a six-hit complete game in the Tribe's 4-1 victory in Game 1, while **Early Wynn** also went the distance in the nightcap, a 3-2 Cleveland win.

### COOKIE'S SECOND HOME

» **CARLOS CARRASCO** is starting on four days' rest after making his last start on September 7 at Toronto...**struck out 14 batters (matching a season high) over 8.0 dominant innings, allowing one earned run on six hits in the Tribe's extra-inning loss.**  
» Carrasco faced the Rays earlier this month, taking the loss on September 2 at Progressive Field (6.1IP, 9H, 5R/ER, 2BB, 9K)...**he owns a career record of 4-0 with a 1.11 ERA (4ER/32.1IP) in four career starts (five appearances) at Tropicana Field.**  
» In his most recent start, Carrasco reached 200 strikeouts for the third time in his MLB career...became just the fifth pitcher in club history to record at least three seasons with 200-or-more punchouts...he currently ranks 6th in the A.L. with 201 strikeouts.  
» Carrasco also passed **Mike Garcia** (1,095 K) for 10th place on the Tribe's all-time franchise leaderboard...he enters play today with 1,097 strikeouts, seven shy of **Gary Bell** (1,104) in 9th place.  
» **In 10 starts since the All-Star break, Carrasco has gone 5-3 with a 2.31 ERA (17ER/66.1IP)**...ranks as the 3rd-lowest second-half ERA (min. 50.0IP) in the American League, behind BOS's **David Price** (1.78) and NYY's **Masahiro Tanaka** (2.30).  
» Carrasco has struck out at least six batters in each of his last 12 starts (career-long streak), including three double-digit performances...his 89 strikeouts since the All-Star break lead the American League (T2nd in MLB).  
» Enters play today among the A.L. leaders in wins (T4th, 16), road ERA (T5th, 2.81), BB/9.0IP (T5th, 1.8) and ERA (10th, 3.41).

### PARROT POWER

» **EDWIN ENCARNACION** hit his 30th home run of the season last night (T9th in the American League), reaching the milestone for a seventh consecutive season.  
» **Marks the longest active streak in MLB, and the longest by any player since Miguel Cabrera hit at least 30 homers in every season from 2007-13.**  
» Since the start of 2012, Encarnacion's 261 home runs are the most in MLB over that span.

### 3 FOR 30

» **EDWIN ENCARNACION** became the third Tribe player to reach 30 home runs last night, joining **JOSÉ RAMÍREZ** (37, 3rd in A.L.) and **FRANCISCO LINDOR** (34, T5th in A.L.).  
» They comprise the first trio in the American League to each hit 30 home runs since 2016, when Baltimore, Boston and Seattle each did so.  
» Marks the first time the Indians have had three 30-homer hitters since 1999, and just the fifth time in franchise history.

### FINISH STRONG

» The Indians enter play today with a 34-13 record in series finales...Cleveland's .723 win percentage in finales leads all MLB teams...the Tribe has won 11 of its last 14 series finales overall.  
» Cleveland owns a 14-9 record in road finales, with wins in five of the last seven instances.  
» Tribe starting pitchers have excelled in series finales this season, posting a 29-7 record with a 2.57 ERA (88ER/308.1IP), including wins in 21 of their last 26 decisions.

### KINGS OF K

» **SHANE BIEBER's** outing last night was the Tribe's 27th start of the season with at least 10 strikeouts, extending their single-season franchise record.  
» Cleveland is tied with Houston for the most such starts in MLB this season...the two clubs also rank T4th in Major League history (see chart below).  
» The Indians have combined to strike out 10-or-more batters in 12 of their last 16 contests...the pitching staff's 192 strikeouts in that span leads MLB (Houston is 2nd with 167).

**TODAY'S START**

» The 31-year-old right-hander is pitching on regular four days' rest after making his last start on September 7 at Toronto...**matched a season-high with 14 strikeouts, allowing two runs (one earned) on six hits over 8.0 innings of work in a no-decision...** the performance moved Carrasco past the 200-strikeout milestone for the 3rd time in his career.  
 » **Since returning from the Disabled List on July 6, Carrasco has gone 8-3 with a 2.43 ERA (21ER/77.2IP) in 12 starts (13 appearances).**  
 » Carrasco will be making his second start this season against Tampa Bay as well as the 10th of his career (11th appearance)...owns a 4-4 record with a 3.21 ERA (22ER/61.2IP) in his previous outings, **including a mark of 4-0 with a 1.11 ERA (4ER/32.1IP) in four career starts (five appearances) at Tropicana Field.**  
 » Carrasco owns a 5-3 record with a 2.31 ERA (17ER/66.1IP) in 10 starts since the All-Star break...owns the 3rd-lowest second-half ERA (min. 50.0IP) in the American League and leads the A.L. with 89 strikeouts since the All-Star break.

**LAST TIME OUT | 2018 HIGHLIGHTS**

» Carrasco is starting on regular four days' rest after making his last start on September 7 at Toronto...took a no-decision in the Tribe's extra-inning loss despite allowing just two runs (one earned) on six hits over 8.0 strong innings of work...**matched his season high with 14 punchouts, reaching the 200-strikeouts mark for the third time in his career...** Carrasco has gone 8-3 with a 2.43 ERA (21ER/77.2IP) in 12 starts (13 appearances) since returning from the Disabled List on July 6...he enters play today T4th in the American League with 16 wins.  
 » Improved to 3-0 for the first time in his career as he tossed his 9th career complete game on April 11 vs. Detroit... held the Tigers to just one run on three hits over 9.0 innings, walking two and striking out six batters.  
 » **Threw his 10th career complete game and his second of 2018 on May 9 at Milwaukee,** holding the Brewers to two runs on five hits in the Tribe's 6-2 win...Carrasco struck out a season-high 14 batters, one shy of his career high and the most by any Indians pitcher this season.  
 » Earned his 10th win of the season on July 11 vs. Cincinnati after holding the Reds to one run on five hits over 5.0 innings of work...**struck out seven batters to reach 1,000 career punchouts, making him the 12th pitcher with 1,000 strikeouts in an Indians uniform and the 44th active MLB pitcher to reach 1,000.**

**STRIKEOUTS RISING**

» Despite missing three weeks on the Disabled List, Carrasco enters play today ranked 6th in the American League with 201 strikeouts...**since returning from the D.L. on July 6, he has recorded 105 strikeouts, tied with New York-NL's Jacob deGrom for the most in MLB over that span.**  
 » Marks Carrasco's 3rd career season with 200-plus strikeouts, after previously doing so in 2015 and 2017...he is just the fifth player in Indians franchise history to reach the milestone in three-or-more seasons (with McDowell, Feller, Kluber and G. Perry).  
 » Carrasco has also surpassed Mike Garcia (1,095 K) for 10th place on the Indians all-time franchise leaderboard...he sits seven shy of matching Gary Bell for 9th place (see chart below).  
 » He has struck out at least six batters in each of his last 12 starts, marking a new career-long streak...Carrasco has fanned 10-or-more batters in three of those starts.  
 » Currently ranks T7th in the American League with 10.5 strikeouts per 9.0 innings...he also is 4th in the A.L. with a 5.91 K/BB ratio and T5th in walks per 9.0 innings (1.8).

**WELCOME TO THE SECOND HALF**

» Carrasco currently sits 5-3 with a 2.31 ERA (17ER/66.1IP) in 10 starts since the All-Star break, marking the 3rd-lowest second-half ERA in the American League (min. 50.0IP) behind Boston's David Price (1.78) and New York-AL's Masahiro Tanaka (2.30)...he has struck out 89 batters (1st in A.L., T2nd in MLB) and allowed just 11 walks in the second half.  
 » Went 8-3 with a 3.12 ERA (33ER/95.1IP) in the second half in 2017...Carrasco also posted a 5-0 record with a 1.48 ERA (7ER/42.2IP) in September last season.

**VS. TAMPA BAY | A.L. EAST**

» Carrasco will be making his 10th career start (11th appearance) against the Tampa Bay Rays this afternoon, as well as his second this season...owns a lifetime record of 4-4 with a 3.21 ERA (22ER/61.2IP) against the Rays.  
 » Made one previous start against Tampa Bay this season, which came on September 2 at Progressive Field...took the loss after allowing five runs on nine hits over 6.1 innings of work (2BB, 9K), as the Tribe fell 6-4 to the Rays.  
 » Carrasco has been dominant in five career appearances (four starts) at Tropicana Field, going 4-0 with a 1.11 ERA (4ER/32.1IP)...tossed 8.0 shutout innings in his most recent start at Tampa Bay on August 11, 2017, allowing just two hits and two walks with 10 strikeouts...came within one out of a no-hitter in his July 1, 2015 start at Tropicana Field (8.2IP, 1H, 1R/ER, 2BB, 13K).  
 » Today will also mark Carrasco's seventh start (eighth appearance) this season against an opponent from the A.L. East division, going 3-2 with a 4.19 ERA (18ER/38.2IP) in those outings...earned wins in starts against Baltimore on April 23 & August 17, while he won in relief on July 15 vs. New York-AL.

**ON THE ROAD AGAIN**

» Owns a 7-4 record with a 2.81 ERA (29ER/93.0IP) through his first 14 road outings this season...Carrasco threw a complete game on May 9 at Milwaukee, striking out 14 batters while allowing two runs on five hits...tossed 7.0 shutout innings at Chicago-AL on June 11, walking one and striking out 11 batters.  
 » In his most recent road start (September 7 at Toronto), Carrasco matched his season high in strikeouts, fanning 14 batters over 8.0 innings in a no-decision (6H, 2R/1ER).  
 » Overall has surrendered three-or-fewer runs in 11 of his 14 road starts this season...currently is tied for the 5th-lowest road ERA in the American League.

**2017 SEASON HIGHLIGHTS**

» Enjoyed the most prolific season of his career, finishing fourth in American League Cy Young voting as he set new career-highs in wins (18), starts (32), innings pitched (200.0) and strikeouts (226)...Carrasco finished in the A.L. Top 10 in wins (T1st), ERA (3.29, 6th), strikeouts (5th) and innings (8th)...joined Corey Kluber as the first teammates to accumulate 18 wins and 220 strikeouts each since Arizona's Randy Johnson & Curt Schilling in 2002 (6th duo all-time).  
 » Made his Postseason debut in Game 3 of the ALDS against New York-AL after missing the 2016 playoffs...tossed 5.2 shutout innings on just three hits (3BB, 7K) but took a no decision in the Tribe's eventual 1-0 loss at Yankee Stadium.
