TRIBE HEADLINES

» Recent acquisition **OF LEONYS MARTIN** will report to the Indians this afternoon...to make room for him on the 25-man roster, **OF GREG ALLEN** has been optioned to Triple-A Columbus.

» Cleveland finished July with the MLB lead in several categories, including runs scored (153), stolen bases (26), team OPS (.835), team batting average (.284) and extra-base hits (97, T1st).

» The Tribe holds a 31-15 record against the A.L. Central this season, posting a 2.76 ERA (127ER/414.0IP) that ranks as the lowest intradivisional mark in MLB.

» **JOSÉ RAMÍREZ** was the Major League leader in July with 11 stolen bases, while he finished the month T2nd in MLB with 25 RBI, T2nd with 18 extra-base hits, T4th with 21 runs scored, T4th with 19 walks and T5th with eight homers.

» **FRANCISCO LINDOR** scored an MLB-best 26 runs in the month of July...he leads all MLB players with 44 runs scored and 38 RBI against the A.L. Central this season, while his 15 homers are T1st with **Ramírez**.

WHERE TO WATCH

» Video coverage of this afternoon's game will be broadcast exclusively on Facebook Watch...WTAM and the Indians Radio Network will carry the radio broadcast as usual.

» Former MLB players **Jody Gerut** and **Glen Perkins** will be on the call along with MLB Network's **Scott Braun**...Gerut was a member of the Indians from 2003-2005, finishing 4th in 2003 Rookie of the Year voting with 22 homers and 75 RBI.

» The Tribe's August 30 game vs. Minnesota has also been selected as a Facebook Watch exclusive.

YESTERDAY'S RECAP

» The Indians leveled their series with the Twins at one game apiece, claiming a 6-2 victory last night at Target Field.

» **JOSÉ RAMÍREZ** again led the Tribe offense, going 3-for-4 with a double, two RBI and a stolen base...**EDWIN ENCARNACION** (1-5) drove in three runs, while **FRANCISCO LINDOR** was 2-for-4 with a pair of runs scored.

» **ROBERTO PÉREZ** (2-3, double) and **GREG ALLEN** (3-4) combined for five hits in the eighth and ninth spots of the batting order, with Allen scoring three of Cleveland's six runs.

» **TREVOR BAUER** earned his 10th win of the season, limiting Minnesota to two runs on four hits over 6.1 innings (4BB, 3K)...**BRAD HAND** (1H, 1K) and **CODY ALLEN** (1H, 1BB, 1K) each recorded four outs in scoreless appearances, with Allen notching his 21st save of the season (8th-most in American League).

AN OFFENSIVE MONTH

» **The Tribe finished the month of July with the Major League lead in runs scored (153), steals (26), team OPS (.835), team batting average (.284) and extra-base hits (97, T1st).**

» Cleveland also ranked T2nd for the month in home runs (36), 2nd in team slugging percentage (.485), 3rd in on-base percentage (.351) and 3rd in doubles (54).

» Overall this season, the Tribe is tied with Milwaukee for the MLB lead with 84 stolen bases, while they rank 2nd in runs (547), 2nd in home runs (150) and 4th in extra-base hits (373).

TWIN BILLING

» The Indians are set to wrap their fourth of six series against the Minnesota Twins, as well as their last at Target Field this season.

» The clubs most recently met June 15-17 at Progressive Field, when Minnesota claimed two of three games...the Twins took three of four contests from May 31-June 3 in the teams' only previous matchup in Minnesota this season.

» The Indians own a 4-7 record vs. the Twins this season, going 1-2 at Progressive Field, 1-1 in Puerto Rico and 2-4 at Target Field.

CENTRAL DOMINANCE

» Cleveland has gone 31-15 against the A.L. Central, with a record of 9-3-2 in series play...the Indians' .674 intradivisional winning percentage ranks 2nd in the A.L. and MLB (Boston - .702)...the Tribe has gone 18-4 in divisional home games and 13-11 on the road.

» In 46 games vs. the A.L. Central, Tribe pitchers own a 2.76 ERA (127ER/414.0IP), marking the lowest intradivisional ERA in MLB.

Tyler Freeman went 2-for-3 with a solo homer...Henry Pujols (2-4) doubled and drove in two runs.

COOKIE AT LUNCHTIME

» Right-hander **CARLOS CARRASCO** is set to make his fourth start against the Twins this season, entering with an 0-2 record and a 7.50 ERA (10ER/12.0IP)...tossed 7.0 shutout innings (3H, 1BB, 7K) in a no-decision on April 18 in Puerto Rico, but took losses on June 1 at Target Field (3.2IP, 7H, 6R/ER, 3BB, 2K) and June 16 at Progressive Field (1.1IP, 4H, 4R/ER, 1BB, 2K).

» **Carrasco has posted a 4-0 record with a 2.59 ERA (7ER/24.1IP) in five appearances (four starts) since returning from the Disabled List on July 6...**enters play today T4th in the American League with 12 wins on the season.

» Owns a 3-3 record with a 3.26 ERA (17ER/47.0IP) in 10 starts vs. the A.L. Central this season...he also has gone 5-3 in 10 road starts with a 3.09 ERA (23ER/67.0IP), entering play today with the 9th-lowest road ERA in the American League.

PLAYER OF THE MONTH CANDIDATE

» **JOSÉ RAMÍREZ** concluded his stellar month of July in strong fashion last night, going 3-for-4 with a double, two RBI and a steal.

» **Ramírez batted .322 (29-90) in July, leading MLB with 11 stolen bases while finishing T2nd with 25 RBI, T2nd with 18 extra-base hits, T4th with 21 runs scored, T4th with 19 walks and T5th with eight homers.**

» **Ramírez** also stole his 25th base of the season last night, moving him into a tie with Seattle's **Dee Gordon** for the American League lead...he additionally shares the A.L. home run lead with Boston's **J.D. Martínez**...the only player in American League history to finish a season as the home run and stolen base leader was Hall of Famer **Ty Cobb** with Detroit in 1909 (nine homers, 76 steals).

» **He is the third player in Indians franchise history to hit 30 homers and steal 25 bases in a season, joining Joe Carter in 1987 (32HR, 31SB) and Grady Sizemore in 2008 (33HR, 38SB).**

» **Ramírez is batting .349 (15-43) in 11 games this season vs. Minnesota with five homers, two doubles, seven RBI and eight runs scored...**his five longballs are the most of any player against the Twins this year.

FRANKIE'S FLYING

» **FRANCISCO LINDOR** notched his 42nd multi-hit game of the season last night, tied with Boston's **J.D. Martínez** and Atlanta's **Nick Markakis** for the MLB lead.

» Lindor finished the month of July batting .300 (30-100) with an MLB-high 26 runs scored...he also ranked T2nd in MLB this past month with nine doubles, T4th with 17 extra-base hits, T10th with 21 RBI and T11th with seven home runs.

» He continues to lead Major League Baseball with 92 runs scored this year...he remains on pace to score 141 runs this season, which would surpass **Earl Averill's** franchise record of 140 in 1931.

» Lindor is batting .315 (57-181) in 45 games against the A.L. Central this season...his 15 homers are tied with **JOSÉ RAMÍREZ** for the most by any player vs. the division, while he leads all players outright with 44 runs scored and 38 RBI against the A.L. Central.

ED-WINNING

» **EDWIN ENCARNACION** drove in three of the Tribe's six runs last night, and now ranks 4th in the American League with 76 RBI (**JOSÉ RAMÍREZ** is 3rd with 78).

» He is batting .262 (66-252) since May 2 with 66 RBI, 2nd-most in MLB over that span (Boston's **J.D. Martínez** - 67 RBI).

FINISH STRONG

» The Indians enter play today with a 25-10 record in series finales, including a mark of 5-4 in rubber matches...Cleveland's .714 winning percentage in finales is 2nd-best in the A.L. (Boston - .794).

» **Tribe starting pitchers have excelled in series finales, posting a 22-4 record with a 2.33 ERA (61ER/235.1IP), including wins in 14 of their last 16 decisions.**

BOLSTERED BULLPEN

» The Indians bullpen has continued to excel in the second half of the season, posting a 2.91 ERA (11ER/34.0IP) since the All-Star break which ranks 2nd-lowest in the A.L. (5th-lowest in MLB).

» Over their past eight games, Tribe relievers have combined for a 1.16 ERA (3ER/23.1IP), including six collective scoreless outings.

THIS DAY IN INDIANS HISTORY

2017: The Indians lose a wild contest at Fenway Park, falling 12-10 to the Red Sox...with Cleveland leading 7-5 in the 5th inning, **Austin Jackson** makes one of the season's most memorable catches, leaping over the centerfield wall to rob Hanley Ramírez of a home run...the Tribe clawed back from a 9-5 deficit to take a 10-9 lead in the 9th inning, but Christian Vázquez hit a walk-off three-run homer in the bottom of the frame.

TONIGHT'S START

» The 31-year-old right-hander is set to make his third start of the second half in today's finale at Minnesota...is pitching on regular four days' rest after making his last start on July 27 at Detroit...did not factor into the decision after allowing three runs (one earned) on seven hits over 6.1 innings of work (2BB, 8K) in the Tribe's eventual 8-3 win.

» Carrasco is making his fourth start this season against the Minnesota Twins, as well as the 18th of his career (21st appearance)...owns an 0-2 record vs. the Twins in 2018 with a 7.50 ERA (10ER/12.0IP).

» Has gone 5-3 with a 3.09 ERA (23ER/67.0IP) in 10 starts on the road this season...Carrasco has surrendered three-or-fewer runs in eight of those 10 starts, and currently ranks T9th in the American League in road ERA.

LAST TIME OUT | 2018 HIGHLIGHTS

» Carrasco is starting on regular four days' rest after taking a no-decision on July 27 at Detroit...allowed three runs (one earned) on seven hits over 6.1 innings of work (2BB, 8K) in the Tribe's eventual 8-3 win...**Carrasco has taken the win in each of his last four decisions (three starts, one relief), as well as six of his last seven...he currently ranks T4th in the American League with 12 wins this season.**

» Improved to 3-0 for the first time in his career as he tossed his 9th career complete game on April 11 vs. Detroit...held the Tigers to just one run on three hits over 9.0 innings, walking two and striking out six batters...took a no-decision at Estadio Hiram Bithorn against Minnesota on April 18 despite tossing 7.0 shutout innings (3H, 1BB, 7K).

» **Threw his 10th career complete game and his second of 2018 on May 9 at Milwaukee,** holding the Brewers to two runs on five hits in the Tribe's 6-2 win...Carrasco struck out a season-high 14 batters, one shy of his career high and the most by any Indians pitcher this season...also helped his own cause at the plate, collecting an RBI-single in the 9th inning...became the first Tribe pitcher with an RBI in his own complete game since **Gaylord Perry** did so on September 22, 1972 vs. New York-AL.

» Improved to 8-4 with a win at Chicago-AL on June 11, holding the White Sox scoreless over 7.0 innings of work with just two hits and one walk in the Tribe's 4-0 victory...Carrasco also fanned 11 batters, marking his second straight start with double-digit punchouts after doing so on June 6 vs. Milwaukee (7.0IP, 8H, 1R/ER, 1BB, 10K).

» Earned his 10th win of the season on July 11 vs. Cincinnati after holding the Reds to one run on five hits over 5.0 innings of work...struck out seven batters to reach 1,000 career punchouts, making him the 12th pitcher with 1,000 strikeouts in an Indians uniform and the 44th active MLB pitcher to reach 1,000.

STRIKEOUTS RISING

» Carrasco has struck out 53 batters over his past seven starts, bringing his season total to 128 punchouts...he enters play tonight ranked 15th in the American League in strikeouts despite missing three weeks on the Disabled List.

» Since the beginning of 2015, Carrasco has amassed 10.04 strikeouts-per-9.0IP, the 3rd-highest total among American League pitchers with at least 500.0 innings pitched in that span (Chris Sale, Chris Archer, **Corey Kluber** ranks 4th with 10.03 K/9.0IP).

» Carrasco also owns a 4.83 K/BB ratio since the 2015 season, which ranks 3rd-best in the A.L. in that span (min. 500.0IP) behind Chris Sale (6.27) and **Corey Kluber** (5.58).

VS. MINNESOTA | A.L. CENTRAL

» Carrasco will be making his 18th career start (21st appearance) vs. the Minnesota Twins, as well as his fourth this season...owns a career record of 5-8 vs. Minnesota with a 4.29 ERA (45ER/94.1IP).

» Has gone 0-2 against the Twins this season with a 7.50 ERA...**tossed 7.0 shutout innings on three hits in a no-decision on April 18 at Hiram Bithorn Stadium in Puerto Rico**...took the loss on June 1 at Target Field after allowing six runs on seven hits over 3.2 innings (3BB, 2K)...also lost on June 16 at Progressive Field, departing after 1.1 innings (4H, 4R/ER) with a right elbow contusion (struck by line drive) that sent him to the Disabled List.

» Carrasco has made eight starts against A.L. Central opponents this season, posting a 3-3 record with a 3.26 ERA (17ER/47.0IP)...only one of those three wins has come on the road, when he defeated Chicago-AL on June 11 at Guaranteed Rate Field (7.0IP, 2H, 0R, 1BB, 11K).

ON THE ROAD AGAIN

» Owns a 5-3 record with a 3.09 ERA (23ER/67.0IP) through his first 10 road outings this season...won his first road start of 2018 on March 31 at Seattle (5.2IP, 7H, 5R/ER, 4K) and took a no-decision despite tossing 7.0 shutout innings against Minnesota in Puerto Rico on April 18...**Carrasco threw a complete game on May 9 at Milwaukee,** striking out 14 batters while allowing two runs on five hits...tossed 7.0 shutout innings at Chicago-AL on June 11, walking one and striking out 11 batters.

» Has surrendered three-or-fewer runs in eight of his 10 road starts this season...currently owns the 9th-lowest road ERA in the American League.

» Carrasco was outstanding on the road in 2017, going 11-3 with a 2.65 ERA (31ER/105.1IP) in 17 starts...posted the 2nd-lowest road ERA in the A.L. (min. 75.0IP).

» Since 2015, Carrasco's 2.63 road ERA is the 3rd-lowest in MLB among pitchers with at least 200.0 road innings, trailing only Clayton Kershaw (2.29) & Max Scherzer (2.40).

WELCOME TO THE SECOND HALF

» Carrasco began his second half with a victory on July 21 at Texas (6.2IP, 5H, 2R/ER, 1BB, 8K) and currently sits 1-0 with a 2.08 ERA (3ER/13.0IP) since the All-Star break...went 8-3 with a 3.12 ERA (33ER/95.1IP) in the second half in 2017...**Carrasco also posted a 5-0 record with a 1.48 ERA (7ER/42.2IP) in September last season.**

2017 SEASON HIGHLIGHTS

» **Enjoyed the most prolific season of his career, finishing fourth in American League Cy Young voting as he set new career-highs in wins (18), starts (32), innings pitched (200.0) and strikeouts (226)**...Carrasco finished in the A.L. Top 10 in wins (T1st), ERA (3.29, 6th), strikeouts (5th) and innings (8th)...joined Corey Kluber as the first teammates to accumulate 18 wins and 220 strikeouts each since Arizona's Randy Johnson & Curt Schilling in 2002 (6th duo all-time).

» Went 5-0 with a 1.48 ERA (7ER/42.2IP) and 51 strikeouts in six September starts, finishing the season on a career-best six-decision winning streak.

» Made his Postseason debut in Game 3 of the ALDS against New York-AL after missing the 2016 playoffs...tossed 5.2 shutout innings on just three hits (3BB, 7K) but took a no decision in the Tribe's eventual 1-0 loss at Yankee Stadium.

CAREER SNAPSHOT

» Right-hander is in his 10th season with the Cleveland organization after being acquired from Philadelphia on July 29, 2009, along with INF Jason Donald, RHP Jason Knapp & C Lou Marson, in exchange for OF Ben Francisco & LHP Cliff Lee.

» Signed 4-year contract extension with Indians thru 2018 on April 7, 2015, including club options for 2019 & 2020 and could cover up to first 3 years of free agency.

» Made his major league debut September 1, 2009 as the Indians starter against the Detroit Tigers at Comerica Park...took the loss after allowing six runs on nine hits (three home runs) with three walks and three strikeouts in 3.0 innings.

» Is in his 15th professional season since signing with Philadelphia as a non-drafted free agent on Nov. 25, 2003...has appeared in parts of nine Major League seasons with Cleveland...missed the entire 2012 season after having right elbow surgery.
