TRIBE HEADLINES

- Cleveland's "magic number" to clinch its third consecutive Amer-
- icn League Central title currently stands at 8.

 » Tribe starting pitchers have recorded 25 outings this season with 10-or-more strikeouts, 2nd-most in MLB and matching a singleseason club record (also 25 each in 1968 & 2017).
- » JASON KIPNIS is batting .424 (14-33) over his past 10 games with three homers, four doubles and 11 RBI (T3rd in American League over that span)
- » EDWIN ENCARNACION has batted .393 (11-28) in eight career games vs. Toronto with a homer, a double, eight RBI and five runs scored...he leads Cleveland with 13 RBI since August 22.
- » JOSÉ RAMÍREZ is one stolen base away from becoming the third player in franchise history to log a 30-homer/30-steal season
- (Joe Carter 1987, Grady Sizemore 2008).

 » SHANE BIEBER leads all MLB rookies (min. 70.0IP) with a 5.80 K/BB ratio and a rate of 1.59 walks per 9.0 innings...marks the highest K/BB ratio and the 2nd-lowest walk rate by an Indians rookie (min. 70.0IP) in franchise history.

OUR FRIENDS IN THE NORTH

- » Cleveland will conclude its season series vs. Toronto with a fourgame series at Rogers Centre this weekend...the Indians currently hold a 1-2 record this season vs. the Blue Jays.
- » After Toronto won 8-4 on April 13, a pair of rainouts necessitated a May 3 doubleheader at Progressive Field...the clubs split that twin
- billing, with the Tribe scoring 24 runs across the two contests. » The Indians own an all-time record of 206-207-2 (.499) vs. the Blue Jays, as well as an 18-17 (.514) mark since **Terry Francona** became Tribe manager in 2013...the clubs squared off in the 2016 ALCS, with Cleveland winning the series four games to one.

YESTERDAY'S RECAP

- » The Indians improved to an MLB-best 34-12 in series finales (20-4 at Progressive Field) with a 3-1 victory vs. Kansas City. » Paired with a Twins loss last night, the Tribe's "magic number" to
- clinch the A.L. Central now stands at 8.

 » JASON KIPNIS led the Tribe's 11-hit attack, going 2-for-3 with a double, a stolen base and a sacrifice fly...EDWIN ENCARNACION (2-4) collected an RBI on a fielder's choice...GREG ALLEN (1-4)
- plated the Tribe's first run on an RBI-single in the 2nd inning.

 » COREY KLUBER won his MLB-high 18th game of the season, holding the Royals to one run on two hits over 6.2 dominant innings...Kluber fanned 10 batters, notching his fifth start this season (44th of career) with at least 10 strikeouts
- The Tribe bullpen recorded 2.1 perfect innings of relief from OLIVER PÉREZ (0.1IP, 1K), CODY ALLEN (1.0IP, 2K) and BRAD HAND (1.0IP, 3K), who picked up his eighth save with Cleveland.

KIP THE BALL ROLLING

- » JASON KIPNIS recorded his fifth multi-hit effort in his last 10 games yesterday, going 2-for-4 with a double, a stolen base and an RBI.
- » Since August 26, Kipnis is batting .424 (14-33) with three homers, four doubles, 11 RBI and seven runs scored...his 11 RBI in that span rank T4th in MLB (T3rd in American League).
- » Kipnis's sacrifice fly in the 8th inning marked his 60th RBI of the season, making him the sixth Indians player to reach the milestone this season (Ramírez - 96, Encarnacion - 94, Lindor - 80, Alonso - 76, Brantley - 70)...Cleveland and New York-AL are the only MLB teams with six players at 60-or-more RBI this season.

SECOND-HALF SURGE

- » Tribe has posted a 3.32 ERA (143ER/387.1IP) in the second half, marking the 2nd-lowest ERA in the American League (OAK, 3.27) and 4th-lowest in MLB...Cleveland has allowed three-or-fewer runs
- in 25 of their 44 second-half contests, going 22-3 in those games. » The Indians' 27-17 record (.614) since the All-Star break ranks 3rd-best in the A.L. (BOS 29-14, .674 & OAK 29-15, .659)... Cleveland's 242-158 (.605) second-half record since 2013 is the best in MLB, including a league-best 82-37 (.689) mark since 2017.

- CANADA TAKES BIEBER BACK

 » SHANE BIEBER is set to make his first career start and appearance against the Toronto Blue Jays in tonight's series opener.
 » Bieber is starting on regular four days' rest after making his last outing on September 1 vs. Tampa Bay...took the loss after allowing four runs on nine hits over 5.1 innings of work (0BB, 4K) in the Tribe's 5-3 loss to the Rays.

 » He has walked just 15 batters over his first 15 career Major
- League starts, good for a rate of 1.59 walks per 9.0 innings that leads all MLB rookie pitchers (min. 70.0IP)...currently ranks as the second-lowest rate for an Indians rookie pitcher (min. 70.0IP) in club history, trailing **Tom Brennan** (0.97) in 1982.
- » He has also posted a 5.80 K/BB ratio (87K/15BB), the highest ratio among MLB rookies (min. 70.0IP) and the top single-season
- mark among rookie pitchers in franchise history (min. 70.0IP).

 » Bieber enters play tonight among the American League rookie leaders in a number of categories, including strikeouts (3rd, 87), wins (T3rd, 8), innings pitched (5th, 85.0) and ERA (6th, 4.66).

THE PARROT'S OLD PERCH

- » EDWIN ENCARNACION is batting .273 (12-44) in 13 games since returning from the Disabled List on August 22, with four homers, 13 RBI and seven runs scored...his 13 RBI over that span lead the Indians and rank T4th in the American League.
- » He has collected at least one run batted in seven of his last nine contests, bringing his season total to 94 (5th in American League)...he is six RBI shy of recording his sixth career season with 100 RBI, which would rank 4th-most among active players.
- » Encarnacion was a member of the Blue Jays from 2009-16, ranking 3rd in franchise history with 239 home runs and 6th with 679 RBI...in eight games against his former team, he is batting .393 (11-28) with a home run, a double, eight RBI and five runs scored.

- » COREY KLUBER's outing yesterday marked the Tribe's 25th start this season with at least 10 strikeouts, 2nd-most in MLB (Houston - 26)...with 23 games remaining, Cleveland has already matched its club record (25 each in 1968 and 2017).
- » Tribe starting pitchers have recorded 923 strikeouts this season (2nd in MLB, Houston 972) and have issued just 211 walks (4thfewest in MLB)...the rotation's collective 4.37 K/BB ratio is the highest in MLB and currently stands as the best mark by a rotation in MLB history...the 2011 Phillies currently hold the full-season record with a 4.22 K/BB ratio.
- » The Indians currently boast four pitchers among the American League top 10 in strikeouts: TREVOR BAUER (4th, 214), COREY KLUBER (6th, 190), CARLOS CARRASCO (7th, 187) and MIKE CLEVINGER (10th, 182).

KEEP SCORING

- » The Indians currently rank 3rd in MLB with 699 runs scored... they also rank among the MLB top five in home runs (5th, 185), hits (5th, 1229) and team batting average (5th, .258).

 » Paired with their 559 runs allowed (4th-fewest in American
- League), the Indians' +140 run differential this season is the 4thhighest in MLB

- The Indians currently lead the Major Leagues with 113 stolen bases this season...their 79.6% success rate is 2nd-best in MLB (Los Angeles-AL, 81.9%).
- » Cleveland is seeking to lead MLB in stolen bases for the first time in its 118-year franchise history.
- » JOSÉ RAMÍREZ enters play tonight with 29 stolen bases, one behind American League leaders Whit Merrifield (KC) and Dee Gordon (SEA)...he is one steal away from logging the 3rd season in club history with 30-plus homers and 30-plus steals (Joe Carter - 1987, Grady Sizemore - 2008).
- » GREG ALLEN leads all Major League rookies with 14 stolen bases this season...the last Tribe player to lead MLB rookies in steals was Kenny Lofton (66SB) in 1992.

 » Bieber has posted a 5.80 SO/BB ratio, the top mark among MLB rookie pitchers

this season (min. 70.0IP), as well as the best single-season ratio by an Indians rookie hurler (min. 70.0IP).

» He enters play tonight averaging 1.59 BB/9, the lowest mark among Major League

» He enters play tonight averaging 1.59 BB/9, the lowest mark among Major League rookie pitchers (min. 70.0IP), as well as the 2nd-lowest by an Indians rookie pitcher (min. 70.0IP) since Tom Brennan in 1982 (0.97, min. 70.0IP).

» He has struck out 87 batters in his first 15 career outings, the 4th-most in Indians franchise history, behind Herb Score (120), DANNY SALAZAR (96) and Bob Feller (88).

» Entering tonight's contest, Bieber ranks among the American League rookie pitching leaders in wins (T3rd, 8), strikeouts (3rd, 87), games started (T4th, 15), innings pitched (5th, 85.0), ERA (6th, 4.66) and opponent batting average (T8th, .296).

» Bieber is also averaging 90.1 pitches per start, the 2nd-highest mark among American League rookie pitchers (min. 70.0IP), 7th-highest in MLB...he has thrown 67.3% of his pitches (909/1351) for strikes, the highest strike percentage among MLB rookies

pitches (909/1351) for strikes, the highest strike percentage among MLB rookies (min. 70.0IP).

EASTERN PROMISES

» Bieber is due to face the Toronto Blue Jays for the first time in his career in tonight's contest...will mark his fourth career start and appearance vs. an opponent from the A.L. East, compiling a 2-1 record and 4.82 ERA (10ER/18.2IP) in his three prior starts.

» His prior starts against the division came on July 13 vs. New York-AL, August 21 at Boston and September 1 vs. Tampa Bay.

WALK THIS WAY...OR NOT

» Bieber recorded his fourth walkless start of the season in his last outing on September

1 vs. Tampa Bay and has allowed two-or-fewer walks in each of his first 15 career starts,

» Has also posted a 5.80 SO/BB ratio (87SO/15BB), the highest mark among all Major League rookie pitchers (min. 70.0IP) and the highest single-season mark by an Indians rookie pitcher (min. 70.0IP).

ROAD WARRIOR

» Tonight will mark Bieber's ninth road start of the season and of his career...has yet to lose a road deicision, compiling a 4-0 record and 4.44 ERA (23ER/46.2IP) in eight starts away from Progressive Field

» Bieber's four-decision road winning streak to start his career is the longest such run by an Indians pitcher since CC Sabathia won his first six career road decisions from

2018 CLEVELAND RECAP

» Won his eighth career game on August 26 at Kansas City, becoming the fifth Indians pitcher with eight wins within his first 14 career games in the *Baseball Reference* Play Index era, joining JOSH TOMLIN, Luis Tiant, Vean Gregg and John Farrell.

Notched his seventh career win on August 21 at Boston, becoming the seventh Indians pitcher with seven-or-more wins in his first 13 career appearances in the *Baseball Reference* Play Index era (1908-), and first since **Jeremy Sowers** in 2006.

» Won his sixth career game on August 5 vs. Los Angeles-AL, becoming the sixth Indians pitcher with six-or-more wins in his first 10 career appearances in the *Baseball Reference* Play Index era (1908-), alongside **Luis Tiant** (7), **Herb Score** (6), **CC Sabathia** (6), **Van Gregg** (6) and **Gene Beardon** (6).

» Earned his fifth win on July 13, marking the first Indians pitcher with five wins in his first seven career starts since CC Sabathia did so in 2001.

» Won his fourth career game on July 3 at Kansas City, becoming the third Tribe pitcher in the Baseball Reference Play Index era (1908-) with four wins in his first five career starts, joining John Farrell (1987) and Scott Lewis (2008-09).

» On June 22 vs. Detroit, Bieber became the sixth Indians pitcher since 1908 to record a start with 7.0-or-more shutout innings and four-or-fewer hits allowed within his first three

four-or-fewer hits allowed within his first three career starts, and the first since Scott Lewis did so on September 10, 2008 at Baltimore...at 23.022 years old marked the youngest pitcher in franchise history to achieve that feat, surpassing Ray Benge (23.157), who did so on Sept. 26, 1925 at Philadelphia.

» Bieber fanned a career-high nine Tigers hitters in the June 22 outing, becoming the first Indians pitcher since Luis Tiant in 1964 with six-or-more strikeouts in each of his first three career appearances...his 22 strikeouts combined across his first three career starts tied him with DANNY SALAZAR (also 22) for the 3rd-most strikeouts in a pitcher's first three career appearances in Indians franchise history.
» Earned his first career win in his second career start on June 17 vs. Minnesota...
**Blowed one run on 11 bits in 52 inpings with one walk fanged seven batters become

allowed one run on 11 hits in 5.2 innings, with one walk...fanned seven batters, becoming the fourth pitcher in Indians franchise history to strike out six-or-more batters in each of his first two career starts and first since SALAZAR did so in his first two appearances from July 11 - August 7, 2013.

» Made his Major League debut against the Twins at Target Field on May 31...did not factor into the decision in the Tribe's 9-8 win (5.2IP, 8H, 4R/ER, 2HR, 1BB, 6K)...struck out six batters, including his first career batter faced (**Brian Dozier**), <u>marking the most</u> punchouts in a Tribe pitcher's first Major League start since SALAZAR fanned seven in his MLB debut on July 11, 2013 vs. Toronto.

» Bieber became the first pitcher in Indians franchise history to make his Major

League debut on his birthday, as well as the second player after outfielder Dave Clark on September 3, 1986 at Toronto.

» Bieber compiled a 6-1 record and 1.47 ERA (13ER/79.2IP) in 13 combined starts between AA Akron and AAA Columbus in the 2018 Minor League season.

» Was called up to the Indians on May 31, starting seven times for the Tribe between then and his return to the Clippers on July 14 (5-1, 3.53 ERA, 17ER, 43.1IP).

» Did not allow a run until his fourth start of the year, a career-long scoreless streak of 22.0 innings, dating back to his last start in 2017...overall on the season recorded five scoreless starts and allowed two-or-fewer earned runs in 12 of 13 outings.

» Posted a 3-1 record with a 1.66 ERA (9ER/48.2IP) in eight starts with Columbus, with 47 strikeouts (6BB, 48.2IP)...did not walk a batter from May 3-June 6 (30,1IP).

» Tossed a rain-shortened no-hitter on May 25 at Gwinnett, striking out seven batters and walking none in the 7.0 inning outing...the lone Gwinnett baserunner reached on an error in the bottom of the 3rd...marked the 8th no-hitter in Columbus franchise history.

» Began the season at AA Akron, where he went a perfect 3-0 with a 1.16 ERA (4ER/31.0IP) in five starts prior to his May 3 call-up to Columbus.
