NEW YORK YANKEES NOTES

- The Yankees are 1-1 on their seven-game homestand and have won five of their last six games...are 9-2 in their last 11G...improved to 20-6 vs. the AL Central in 2018...are 46-21 at Yankee Stadium...overcame a four-run deficit...all 5R came via the home run.
 - Marked their seventh "walk-off" win of the season and fourth "walk-off" HR, both first since Giancarlo Stanton's "walk-off" HR on 6/20 vs. Seattle.
- PH Neil Walker** (1-for-1) hit a pinch-hit "walk-off" solo HR on his first pitch seen in the ninth...was his fifth career "walk-off" hit, second as a Yankee (also a single on 5/12 vs. Oakland) and second career "walk-off" HR (also 3/31/14 vs. Chicago-NL w/ Pittsburgh in the 10th inning)...was his first career pinch-hit HR...was the first pinch-hit "walk-off" HR by a Yankee since Brian McCann in the bottom of the 10th inning on 8/24/14 vs. Chicago-AL (off Jake Petricka)...is just the third regular season Yankees pinch-hit "walk-off" HR over the last 30 years (also Jason Giambi on 6/5/08 vs. Toronto off B.J. Ryan in the ninth).
- 3B Miguel Andújar** (1-for-4) hit a two-run HR in the sixth...over his last 45 games, has hit .341 (59-for-173) with 32R, 12 doubles, 10HR and 35RBI.
 - Has 63XBH in his career, the third-most XBH through 126G in Yankees history behind only Joe DiMaggio (84XBH) and Bob Meusel (64XBH)...has 61XBH this season, third-most by a Yankees rookie in franchise history (Joe DiMaggio-88 in 1936 and Aaron Judge-79 in 2017).
- CF Aaron Hicks** (1-for-3, 1BB) hit a game-tying two-run HR in the eighth inning, his first game-tying HR since 8/17/15 at Yankee Stadium w/ Minnesota (has six go-ahead HR this season)...has 22HR this season, extending his career high...has 16HR in his last 62G...has 31BB in 35 games since the All-Star break...has reached safely in 59 of his last 135PA (30H, 28BB, 1HP).
- C Austin Romine** (1-for-3, 1BB) had the Yankees' only hit through the first five innings and has reached base safely in each of his last six games.
- DH Luke Voit** (1-for-4) extended his career-long hitting streak to six games with a sixth-inning single.
- RF Giancarlo Stanton** (1-for-4, 1R) snapped an 0-for-14 stretch with his single to lead off the eighth inning.
- LF Brett Gardner** (1-for-4, 1R) tripled to lead off the sixth inning...was his fifth triple of the season, surpassing his total from 2017 (four).
- RHP Lance Lynn** started and allowed 3ER in 5.2IP (7H, 1BB, 5K, 1WP)...has allowed 8R over his last two starts, with one coming over the first five innings and seven coming in the sixth inning.
 - Held the White Sox hitless in 7AB with runners in scoring position, his best mark since the Red Sox went 0-for-9 with RISP off him on 6/20 vs. Boston w/ Minnesota.
- RHP Dellin Betances** (1.0IP, 2K) struck out Sánchez to lead off the ninth...his AL-record streak of 34 consecutive relief appearances with at least 1K (since 5/29) is tied with Aroldis Chapman for the sixth-longest such streak in Baseball history...has at least 1K in 52-of-54 appearances this season.
 - Has **96K** and needs **4K** to become the first pitcher in Baseball history with at least 100K in relief in five straight seasons (since 2014).
- RHP Jonathan Holder** (2.1IP, 2H, 1ER, 0BB, 1K) matched his season high in innings pitched (also 6/20 vs. Seattle and 6/24 at Tampa Bay)...threw 20-of-24 pitches for strikes.
- In his second rehab game at Triple-A Scranton/WB vs. Syracuse, **C Gary Sánchez** (right groin strain) started at DH and went 1-for-4 with a solo HR.

CHICAGO WHITE SOX NOTES

- The White Sox recorded their fourth "walk-off" loss of the season, snapping their four-game winning streak...are still 10-4 in their last 14 games (since 8/14) and 10-3 in their last 13 road games (since 8/3)...fell to 1-4 vs. the Yankees this season and are now 4-16 in their last 20 games at Yankee Stadium (since 6/30/12).
- **RHP James Shields** (5.2IP, 4H, 2ER, 4BB, 3K, 1WP, 1HR) started and did not record a decision...is 1-8 with a 5.89 ERA (73.1IP, 48ER) in 13 road starts this season...his only win of the road this season came on Opening Day on 3/29 at Kansas City.
 - Tonight marked his 400th career start.
 - Has allowed 12HR in his last seven starts.
 - Is 12-16 with a 4.06 ERA (221.2IP, 100ER) in 34 career starts vs. the Yankees...is 4-9 with a 4.47 ERA (100.2IP, 50ER) in 16 starts in the Bronx.
- **RF Avisail García** (1-for-5) hit an RBI double in the fifth...
- **LF Nicky Delmonico** (2-for-5, 2RBI, 1R) hit a two-run single in the sixth...has hit safely in 10 of his last 12 games.
- **3B Yolmer Sánchez** (2-for-5, 1R, 1RBI, 1SB) hit an RBI single in the sixth...has reached base safely in a career-high 16 consecutive games (since 8/11), batting .290/.405/.403 (18-for-62) with 11R, 4 doubles, 1HR, 3RBI and 10BB.
- **CF Adam Engel** (1-for-4, 1R) is hitting .410/.425/.564 (16-for-39) over his last 11 games (since 8/18).
- **RHP Juan Minaya** (0.0IP, 2H, 2ER, 1HR) allowed a game-tying HR to Aaron Hicks in the eight, snapping his six-game scoreless stretch (6.1IP).
- **RHP Dylan Covey** (1.1IP, 2H, 1ER, 2K, 1HR) surrendered a "walk-off" HR to Neil Walker, recording his 12th loss of the season.
