The Mariners and Blue Jays meet for the 5th (2-2) of 7 games this season... Seattle claimed 2-of-3 earlier this season in Toronto (May 8-10), including James Paxton's no-hitter on May 8... the Mariners are 15-12 vs. Toronto at Safeco Field since 2010:

TONIGHT'S TILT...the Mariners continue a 2-team, 7-day, 7-game homestand with the second of four games vs. the Toronto Blue Jays (0-1)...went 1-2 against Houston to open the homestand...following this series, will embark on a 2-state, 3-city, 10-day, 10-game road trip to Texas (3 G), Houston (4 G) and Oakland (3 G)...tonight's game will be televised on **ROOT SPORTS NW** and broadcast live on **710 ESPN Seattle** and the Mariners Radio Network.

ODDS AND ENDS...the Mariners are 8-15 (7/4-current) since winning a season-high 8-game straight games (6/25-7/3)...the Mariners have won 23 of their last 45 games, 30 of their last 54, 34 of their last 60, 39 of their last 66 and 41 of their last 70...Seattle is 50-34 in its last 84 games, 55-37 over its last 92 games and 60-41 in its last 101 games...Seattle is 20-18 during the day and 43-28 at night...Seattle is 35-22 at Safeco Field, 28-24 on the road.

- **Whiff - Edwin Díaz** has struck out his first batter faced 24 times this season, trailing only Adam Ottavino-COL (25) for most in the Majors...Díaz has struck out his first batter in 45.3% (24x53) of his appearances.
- **As Easy as 1-2-3 - Edwin Díaz** retired the Astros in order in the 9th inning Monday for his 40th save of the season...in 24 of his 40 saves, he has faced the minimum 3 batters in an outing of exactly 1.0 inning, the most such saves in the Majors...Craig Kimbrel-BOS is 2nd with 17 saves of 1.0 inning and 3 batters faced.
- **First Things First - Dee Gordon** is batting .359 (33x92) with 21 runs scored, 3 doubles, 1 triple, 1 walk and 2 HBP when leading off a game this season...his 33 hits to lead off a game are the most in the Majors.
- **Close Games** - the Mariners are 41-17 (.707) this season in games decided by 1 or 2 runs, the highest winning percentage in the Majors...the Mariners are 27-14 (.659) in 1-run games (most 1-run wins in MLB) and 14-3 (.824) in games decided by exactly 2 runs (best 2-run winning percentage in MLB).
- **Four Score** - the Mariners are 44-13 when scoring 4-or-more runs, but are 19-33 when scoring 3-or-fewer runs.
- **Get Through 8** - the Mariners are 1 of 3 Major League clubs with a 1.000 winning percentage (56-0) when leading after 8 innings this season, joining New York-AL (58-0) and Oakland (52-0).
- **Bullpen Bullies - Edwin Díaz** has not allowed an earned run over his last 14.0 innings spanning 14 appearances (6/25-c), while **Alex Colomé** has an active 12.2 scoreless innings streak over 13 games (6/30-c).
- **Milestone - Nelson Cruz** has hit 154 home runs in his Mariners career, currently 8th-most in franchise history...he is only 2 home runs shy of tying Raúl Ibáñez (156) for 7th and 4 home runs away from Alvin Davis (160) for 6th in Mariners club history.

ON A ROLL...dating back to May 17, **Marco Gonzales** is 9-2 with a 2.44 ERA (23 ER, 85.0 IP) in 13 starts, including 9 quality starts...he has limited opponents to a .218 (67x307) average while walking 17 and striking out 70...during this stretch he is tied for Major League lead with 9 wins (also: Zach Greinke-ARI and Jon Lester-CHI), while also 4th in the Majors in ERA (2.44).

CRUZ CONTROL...**Nelson Cruz** is batting .301 (99x329) with 45 runs scored, 18 doubles, 1 triple, 24 home runs, 82 RBI, 3 HBP, 31 walks and 3 stolen bases in 88 career games vs. the Blue Jays...among all active players vs. Toronto, Cruz ranks T3rd in home runs (24), 5th in slugging percentage (.581) and OPS (.945), 6th in RBI (82), T12th in extra-base hits (43), 13th in average (.301) and 14th in hits (99)...his 99 hits vs. the Blue Jays are the 4th-most vs. a single opponent in his career, trailing only Los Angeles-AL (191), Oakland (157) and Houston (103).

THE EDWIN DÍAZ FILE...**Edwin Díaz** recorded his Major League-leading 40th save of the season on Monday...he becomes the 4th pitcher in single-season club history to notch at least 40 saves, joining Fernando Rodney (48, 2014), Kazuhiro Sasaki (45, 2001) and J.J. Putz (40, 2007)...Díaz has 87 strikeouts this season, 3 shy of setting a single-season career-high; he had 89 strikeouts last season after recording 88 punchouts in his rookie campaign of 2016 (appeared in 49 games after being called up to the Majors in June)...with his next strikeout, Díaz will join Dick Radatz (1962-64 w/BOS) as the only primary relievers in Major League history to record at least 88 strikeouts in each of their first 3 seasons.

WHAT A RELIEF...the Mariners lead the Major Leagues in saves (42) and holds (78)...since 1973, only 6 clubs have led the Majors in saves and holds in the same season, most recently the 1992 Oakland Athletics...**Edwin Díaz** leads the Majors with 40 saves, while **Juan Nicasio** is T9th in MLB with 19 holds, and **Alex Colomé** is T11th with 18 holds.

ELECTRIC EDDIE...**Edwin Díaz** leads the Majors with 40 saves, while ranking 2nd among all relievers with 87 strikeouts (Josh Hader-MIL, 99)...of Díaz's 40 saves, 21 have come in 1-run games, most in the Majors this season (Craig Kimbrel-BOS, 12)...his 21 1-run saves are only 2 shy of equaling the Major League single-season record, set by Francisco Rodriguez in 2008 (23)...the Mariners are 48-0 when Díaz enters with a lead this season, including 23-0 when he enters with a 1-run lead...Díaz is 21-for-23 in 1-run save opportunities (91.3%) with a 0.77 ERA (2 ER, 23.1 IP) with 43 strikeouts and 5 walks.

THE HITTING MACHINE...**Jean Segura** has reached base safely in 10 of his last 12 games vs. the Blue Jays, including 7 multi-hit contests, batting .385 (20x52) with 8 runs scored, 6 doubles, 1 RBI, 4 walks and 3 stolen bases...since 2016, Segura's .385 average vs. the Jays is the 4th-highest in the Majors, trailing only Josh Reddick (.404/19x47), Logan Forsythe (.400/26x65) and José Altuve (.387/20x52).

SOUTHPAW STATS...**Kyle Seager** is 2nd in Major Leagues with 30 RBI against lefties this season, trailing only Nolan Arenado-COL (32)...**Dee Gordon** (.315/39x124) and **Jean Segura** (.310/36x116) ranks 11th and 12th respectively in the American League vs. LHP...**Nelson Cruz** has belted 9 home runs off left-handers, T6th in the Majors and 4th in the American League...**Gordon** (4th/39), **Seager** (T5th/38) and **Segura** (T9th/36) each rank among the AL leaders in hits vs. lefties...since 2012, **Cruz** has hit a Major League leading 69 home runs against left-handers, ranking ahead of Giancarlo Stanton (67) and Mark Trumbo (60) for the most in the Majors over that span...**Seager's** 58 home runs off lefties are 4th-most in that span and most by a left-handed batter.

AS YOU KNOW...**Marco Gonzales** is 5-0 with a 1.57 ERA (6 ER, 34.1 IP) over his last 5 starts...**AND AS YOU MAY ALSO KNOW**...since June 29, his 5 wins are tied for the most in the Majors, along with Carlos Carrasco-CLE (5-0), Yovani Gallardo-TEX (5-1), Dallas Keuchel-HOU (5-1), Scott Oberg-COL (5-0) and Max Scherzer-WAS (5-1)...also during this stretch he ranks 3rd in the Majors in ERA (1.57) and 8th in opponents batting average (.198)...**BUT DID YOU KNOW?**...with a win tonight Gonzales would become only the 9th Mariners pitcher (done 11x) to win at least 6 consecutive starts...his 5-game start winning streak is the longest since **James Paxton** recorded a club record-tying 7 wins in 7 starts, July 2-Aug. 4, 2017.

ABOUT GONZALES...

- 26-year-old left-hander is making his 21st start of season, 44th career appearance (36th start) and 1st career start vs. the Blue Jays.
- Acquired by Seattle from St. Louis in exchange for minor league outfielder Tyler O'Neill on July 21, 2017.
- Native of Fort Collins, CO...attended Gonzaga University for 3 seasons (2011-13).
- Originally selected by Colorado in the 29th round of the 2010 MLB Draft out of Rocky Mountain High School (Fort Collins, CO) but did not sign...drafted and signed by the Cardinals with the 19th overall pick in the 2013 MLB Draft out of Gonzaga University...became the highest draft pick in the history of the Gonzaga baseball program.
- Made his MLB debut with Cardinals June 25, 2014 at Colorado.
- Went 2-1 with a 4.50 ERA (3 ER, 6.0 IP) with 4 strikeouts and 2 walks with St. Louis in the 2014 postseason...earned 2 wins in the NLDS vs. Los Angeles, becoming the 4th rookie in postseason history to win 2 games in the Division Series (also: Dave Righetti-NYY, 1981, Jaret Wright-CLE, 1997 and Francisco Rodriguez-LAA, 2002).

LAST START...collected his career-high 5th straight win as the Mariners defeated the Angels 8-5 in Anaheim on July 29...marked his 5th consecutive quality start... allowed 2 runs on 7 hits and 2 walks while striking out 7 batters across 6.0 innings pitched...the Mariners gave him an early cushion by scoring 7 runs in the top of the 1st inning...both runs allowed came on a 2-run home run by Justin Upton in the 5th inning.

HOME SWEET HOME...in 10 starts at Safeco Field this season, is 5-1 with a 2.88 ERA (19 ER, 59.1 IP) with 59 strikeouts and 15 walks...his 2.88 home ERA is 11th-best in the American League.

WHIP IT GOOD...since June 1, has posted a 1.01 WHIP (10 BB, 56 H, 65.2 IP), the 4th-best mark in the Majors, trailing only Chris Sale-BOS (0.77/13 BB, 38 H, 66.0 IP), Jacob deGrom-NYM (0.95/13 BB, 56 H, 73.0 IP) and Max Scherzer (0.96/17 BB, 49 H, 69.0 IP).

LEADERBOARD...among American League leaders, ranks 10th in ERA (3.37), 16th in WHIP (1.16/25 BB, 121 H, 125.2 IP) and 17th in innings pitched (125.2).

THAT'S QUALITY...has 7 starts of at least 6.0 innings pitched and 1 or fewer runs allowed...his 7 such starts are tied for 10th-most in the American League (also: Gerrit Cole-HOU, Mike Fiers-DET, Dallas Keuchel-HOU, Sean Manaea-OAK, James Paxton-SEA, David Price-BOS and Tyler Skaggs-LAA).

IT JUST TAKES ONE...four of his 12 wins have come in one-run games...his 4 wins in one-run decisions are tied for 3rd-most by a starter in the Major Leagues (also: Andrew Heaney-LAA and David Price-BOS), behind **James Paxton** (5) and Blake Snell-TB (5).

PICK YOUR POISON...ranks 1st in the American League/T2nd in the Major Leagues with 6 pickoffs...tied with Julio Tehran-ATL, while trailing only Eric Lauer-SD (10) for the Major League lead.

GAS IN THE TANK...has pitched 6.0-or-more innings in 15 of his last 17 starts and 16 of his 21 starts overall this season...is 11-3 with a 2.72 ERA (33 ER, 109.0 IP) with 22 walks and 92 strikeouts in his last 17 outings, including 11 quality starts...prior to 2018, Gonzales had only reached the 6.0 inning mark in 1 start, on Aug. 30, 2014 vs. Chicago-NL with St. Louis (6.0,3,1,1,2,5).

NO FREE PASSES...has issued just 25 walks compared to 111 strikeouts across 125.2 innings pitched this season...ranks 5th in the AL (8th in MLB) with a 1.79 walks-per-9.0-innings ratio...is 7th in the AL (11th in MLB) with a 4.44 strikeout-to-walk ratio...has issued 1 or fewer walks in 14 of his 21 starts; his 14 such starts are T5th-most in the AL.

GOING THE DISTANCE...tossed 1st career complete game on June 29 vs. Kansas City, allowing just 1 run on 6 hits and 0 walks while striking out 7 batters across 9.0 innings...became the 2nd Mariners pitcher to throw a complete game this season (James Paxton, 2x)...held the Royals scoreless until the 9th inning.

2017 SEASON RECAP...went 1-1 with a 6.08 ERA (27 ER, 40.0 IP) with 32 strikeouts and 11 walks in 11 G (8 GS)...was acquired from STL on 7/21/17 in exchange for minor league outfielder Tyler O'Neill...posted a 5.40 ERA (22 ER, 36.2 IP) with 30 strikeouts and 11 walks in 10 G (7 GS) with Seattle.

BULLDOG ROOTS...played 3 seasons (2011-13) with the Gonzaga Bulldogs, compiling a career record of 26-7 with a 2.34 ERA while recording 9 complete games and 4 shutouts...tallied 278 strikeouts over 303.2 innings of work...became the highest draft pick in the history of the Gonzaga baseball program when he was selected 19th overall by St. Louis in 2013...shared West Coast Conference Player of the Year honors with the Cubs' Kris Bryant (University of San Diego) as a freshman in 2011 and as a junior in 2013...in 2013, earned John Olerud Two-Way Player of the Year honors as well as WCC Co-Player of the Year for the 2nd time in his career.

POSTSEASON GLORY...added to the Cardinals roster for the 2014 National League Division Series vs. Los Angeles-NL...made 3 appearances in the NLDS, going 2-0 with a 0.00 ERA (0 ER, 3.0 IP) with 2 strikeouts and 1 walk...picked up the wins in Game 1 and Game 4 vs. the Dodgers...became the 4th rookie in postseason history to win 2 games in the Division Series (also: Dave Righetti-NYY, 1981, Jaret Wright-CLE, 1997 and Francisco Rodriguez-LAA, 2002)...in the 2014 NLCS vs. San Francisco, went 0-1 with a 9.00 ERA (3 ER, 3.0 IP) with 2 strikeouts and 1 walk in 3 appearances.

ML CAREER...in parts of 4 Major League seasons with St. Louis (2014-15, 2017) and Seattle (2017-c), is 17-8 with a 4.17 ERA (94 ER, 203.0 IP) with 175 strikeouts and 58 walks in 43 games (35 starts)...originally selected by Colorado in the 29th round of the 2010 MLB Draft out of Rocky Mountain High School (Fort Collins, CO) but did not sign...drafted and signed by the Cardinals with the 19th overall pick in the 2013 MLB Draft out of Gonzaga University.
