TRIBE TOP THREE

» **FRANCISCO LINDOR** extended his hit streak to 10 games with another multi-hit effort, going 2-for-4 with a double and a solo homer...he is batting .426 (20-47) over his last 10 contests.

» **JOSÉ RAMÍREZ** belted his 10th home run of the season last night with a solo shot in the 3rd inning...became the fastest switch hitter in franchise history to reach 10 homers, needing just 35 team games.

» **ANDREW MILLER** threw off a mound with batters standing in yesterday as he continues to recover from his left hamstring strain...will receive a strength test tomorrow and could be activated from the 10-day Disabled List as early as Friday.

STRANGE BREW

» The Indians and Brewers square off this afternoon as they conclude their first regular-season matchup since the 2015 season... following these two contests at Miller Park, the Tribe will host Milwaukee at Progressive Field for a similar two-game set on June 5 & 6.

» Cleveland posted a 3-1 record against Milwaukee in their 2015 season series, taking both contests at Progressive Field and splitting a pair of games at Miller Park.

» Since the Brewers left the American League in 1998, the Indians have gone 10-13 (.435) in 23 Interleague matchups between the clubs...in a series that dates back to 1969, the Tribe is 204-207 (.496) all-time against their former divisional rival.

INTERLEAGUE INTERFACE

» This mid-week series marks the Tribe's second set of Interleague contests this season...Cleveland previously hosted the Cubs and split two games at Progressive Field on April 24 & 25.

» The Indians' 20 Interleague matchups this season will all come against the teams of the N.L. Central division...in addition to "home-and-home" series with Milwaukee, Chicago-NL and Cincinnati, Cleveland will host Pittsburgh for three games (July 23-25) and travel to St. Louis for another three (June 25-27).

» Cleveland posted a 6-14 (.300) record in Interleague play last season against Cincinnati and the N.L. West, who were responsible for three of the National League's five playoff teams...despite last season's mark, the Indians have posted a 53-50 (.515) Interleague record under **Terry Francona** (2013-).

YESTERDAY'S RECAP

» The Indians fell, 3-2, at Miller Park in the opener of this two-game set against Milwaukee...marked the Tribe's season-long fourth consecutive loss, and dropped the team below .500 for the first time since April 8 (4-5).

» **JOSÉ RAMÍREZ** put the Tribe on the board with a solo homer in the top of the 3rd inning, his team-high 10th of the season...**FRANCISCO LINDOR** extended his hit streak to 10 games with a leadoff double in the 1st inning and tacked on a solo homer of his own in the top of the 5th...marked Lindor's 9th home run of 2018, as well as his team-best 14th multi-hit game (T4th in American League)... following Lindor's home run, the final 15 Indians batters were retired in order.

» **COREY KLUBER** took the loss after surrendering three runs on a pair of homers, but settled in and did not allow a hit over his last 13 batters faced...overall worked 6.0 innings, extending his season-opening streak to eight consecutive quality starts (longest such streak by an Indians pitcher since **Josh Tomlin** - 9 starts in 2011)...**Kluber has allowed three-or-fewer runs in 20 consecutive starts dating back to August 3, 2017, the second-longest streak by an Indians pitcher in the Baseball Reference Play Index era (since 1908)...Sonny Siebert owns the record with 21 consecutive starts from May 9 - September 10, 1965.**

IT'S (ALMOST) MILLER TIME

» **ANDREW MILLER** continued his rehab from a left hamstring strain, throwing off of a mound with hitters standing in yesterday... has been on the 10-Day Disabled List since sustaining the injury on April 26 vs. Seattle.

» He will receive a strength test on the Tribe's Thursday off-day, and depending on the results of the test, could be activated as early as Friday vs. Kansas City.

STAY HOT, FRANKIE

» **FRANCISCO LINDOR** extended his hit streak to 10 games last night with a double to lead off the game...marks the longest streak by an Indians batter this season and is one of 15 double-digit streaks in MLB this season (four of which are active)...he has recorded a multi-hit game in seven of his last 10 games.

» The reigning American League Player of the Week is batting .426 (20-47) over the streak with five homers, five doubles, 11 RBI and 12 runs scored...he leads all of Major League Baseball in hits and runs over the last 10 days, while he also ranks T1st in the American League (T2nd in MLB) in home runs and 3rd in the A.L. (T5th in MLB) in RBI in the same span.

HANG TEN

» **JOSÉ RAMÍREZ** belted his team-high 10th homer of the season with a solo shot in the top of the 3rd inning...became the seventh batter in the American League to reach double-digits this season, and he enters play today T4th in the A.L.

» In reaching 10 homers in just 35 team games, Ramírez is the fastest Indians batter to reach the milestone since **Mark Reynolds** hit his 10th homer of 2013 in the Tribe's 29th game...he is the fastest switch-hitter in franchise history to reach 10 homers, shattering the record set by **Francisco Lindor** in 2017 (44 team games).

COOKIES AT LUNCHTIME

» **CARLOS CARRASCO** will take the hill for the finale of this two-game set as he makes his eighth start of the 2018 campaign... currently ranks T4th in the American League in wins (4) and T1st in complete games (1).

» Last started for the Tribe on May 3 in Game 1 of the Tribe's doubleheader vs. Toronto...did not factor into the decision after allowing six runs on nine hits over 5.1 innings of work (3BB, 7K).

» Carrasco has made three previous starts on the road this season, going 2-0 with a 2.70 ERA (6ER/20.0IP)...he most recently picked up the win on April 23 at Baltimore, holding the Orioles to one run on six hits over 7.1 innings (2BB, 7K).

» Will be making his first career start and appearance against the Milwaukee Brewers...in 16 career Interleague appearances (12 starts), Carrasco has gone 5-4 with a 3.21 ERA (31ER/87.0IP)... went 0-0 with a 4.38 ERA (6ER/12.1IP) in two starts against the National League in 2017.

» Carrasco will feature in the Tribe's starting lineup this afternoon, and he is a career .083 (1-12) hitter...in his most recent batting endeavor (July 19, 2017 at San Francisco), he drew a walk and came around to score his first career run.

DIGGING THE LONGBALL

» The Indians enter play this afternoon ranking T2nd in the American League and MLB with 50 home runs this season...the Tribe did not hit its 50th homer of 2017 until May 23 (Game #44).

» 80 of the Tribe's 158 runs scored in 2018 have come via home run, and the team is 14-11 with at least one homer this season.

» Cleveland is one of two teams in MLB (New York-AL) boasting four players with at least eight home runs...they and the Yankees are also the only teams in MLB claiming three hitters with nine-or-more longballs.

HOMEWARD BOUND

» The Indians will enjoy their second off-day in a four-day span on Thursday as the team travels back to Cleveland...they will host the Kansas City Royals for the second time this season in a brief three-game homestand from May 11-13.

» Following their weekend at home, the Tribe will embark on another road trip, heading to Detroit (May 14-16), Houston (May 18-20) and Chicago-NL (May 22-23) in an eight-game, 10-day trip.

CENTRAL STANDINGS CHECK

» The Indians enter today below .500 for the first time since sitting 4-5 on April 8...despite this, the Tribe maintains a 0.5-game lead in the A.L. Central over second-place Minnesota (15-17).

» In 2017, the Indians held a .500 record as late as June 14 (31-31) en route to a final mark of 102-60 (.630).

» Cleveland has spent each of the last 18 days in first place.

TODAY'S START

» The 31-year-old right-hander is scheduled to make his eighth start of the 2018 season in this afternoon's finale at Milwaukee...marks the 183rd appearance and 149th start of Carrasco's career.
 » Will be pitching on five days' rest after making his last start on May 3 vs. Toronto...took a no-decision in Game 1 of the Tribe's doubleheader, allowing a season-high six runs on nine hits over 5.1 innings of work (3BB, 7K).
 » Set to make his first career start and appearance against the Milwaukee Brewers...went 0-0 with a 4.38 ERA (6ER/12.1IP) in two Interleague starts last season, and owns a lifetime record of 5-4 with a 3.21 ERA (31ER/87.0IP) against National League teams.

LAST TIME OUT | 2018 RECAP

» Carrasco last started on May 3 in Game 1 of the Tribe's doubleheader vs. Toronto... did not factor into the decision, as he set new season highs in runs allowed (6), hits allowed (9) and walks (3) over 5.1 innings of work...also matched a season best with seven strikeouts.
 » Carrasco made his 2018 debut on March 31 at Seattle, in the Tribe's second game of the season...was touched for five runs on seven hits over 5.2 innings of work (0BB, 4K), but picked up his first win of 2018 as the Indians held on to beat the Mariners, 6-5... earned his second win in the Tribe's home opener on April 6, allowing two runs on five hits over 6.0 innings (1BB, 4K).
 » **Improved to 3-0 for the first time in his career as he tossed his 9th career complete game on April 11 vs. Detroit...** held the Tigers to just one run on three hits over 9.0 innings, walking two and striking out six batters...took a no-decision at Estadio Hiram Bithorn against Minnesota on April 18 despite tossing 7.0 shutout innings (3H, 1BB, 7K).
 » Carrasco enters play tonight T3rd in the American League in wins (4), T1st in complete games (1), 1st in night games ERA (0.77) and 7th in walks per 9.0 innings (1.7).

VS. MILWAUKEE | INTERLEAGUE

» Carrasco will be making his first career regular-season start and appearance against the Milwaukee Brewers...the Brewers are one of six non-Indians clubs that he has not faced in his big-league career.
 » Made one start against Milwaukee in 2018 Cactus League play on March 11 at Good-year...allowed just one hit over 3.0 innings of work, striking out six batters and walking none in his second start of the spring.
 » This afternoon marks Carrasco's first Interleague start of 2018 after posting an 0-0 record with a 4.38 ERA (6ER/12.1IP) in two starts against the National League last season...took a no-decision on May 23 at Cincinnati after allowing four runs on five hits (4BB, 6K) in an eventual 8-7 Tribe win...also did not factor into the decision on July 19 at San Francisco despite posting a quality start (6.0IP, 6H, 2R/ER, 2BB, 6K).
 » In 16 career appearances (12 starts) against National League opponents, Carrasco owns a record of 5-4 with a 3.21 ERA (31ER/87.0IP)...five of his last six Interleague outings have resulted in quality starts.

COOKIE AT THE BAT

» With this afternoon's contest coming at Miller Park, Carrasco will be a member of the starting lineup for the first time this season...he is an .083 (1-12) in 17 career plate appearances, with one walk, one run scored and four successful sacrifices.
 » Both of Carrasco's Interleague starts in 2017 came in National League ballparks, and he went 0-for-4 in five plate appearances...drew a walk and came around to score his first career run on July 19 at San Francisco.

ON THE ROAD AGAIN

» Today will mark Carrasco's 74th career road start (92nd overall appearance)...Carrasco has pitched to a 38-22 record with a 3.14 ERA (164ER/470.1IP) in his road career.
 » Owns a 2-0 record with a 2.70 ERA (6ER/20.0IP) through his first three road outings this season...won his first road start of 2018 on March 31 at Seattle (5.2IP, 7H, 5R/ER, 4K) and took a no-decision despite tossing 7.0 shutout innings in Puerto Rico on April 18...in his most recent start on the road, he earned the win on April 23 at Baltimore after holding the Orioles to one run on six hits over 7.1 strong innings (2BB, 7K).
 » Carrasco was outstanding on the road in 2017, going 11-3 with a 2.65 ERA (31ER/105.1IP) in 17 starts...posted the 2nd-lowest road ERA in the American League (min. 75.0IP) while earning the most away wins for a Tribe pitcher since Cliff Lee (12-3) in his 2008 Cy Young season.
 » Since 2015, Carrasco's 2.54 road ERA is the 3rd-lowest in MLB among pitchers with at least 200.0 road innings, trailing only Clayton Kershaw and Max Scherzer.

2017 SEASON HIGHLIGHTS

» **Enjoyed the most prolific season of his career, finishing fourth in American League Cy Young voting as he set new career-highs in wins (18), starts (32), innings pitched (200.0) and strikeouts (226)...** Carrasco finished in the A.L. Top 10 in wins (T1st), ERA (3.29, 6th), strikeouts (5th) and innings (8th)...joined Corey Kluber as the first teammates to accumulate 18 wins and 220 strikeouts each since Arizona's Randy Johnson & Curt Schilling in 2002 (6th duo all-time).
 » Threw his eighth career complete game on September 6 at Chicago-AL, allowing just one run on three hits with no walks and nine strikeouts...faced just one batter over the minimum in the Tribe's 5-1 victory (Game 14 of the Tribe's 22-game winning streak).
 » Went 5-0 with a 1.48 ERA (7ER/42.2IP) and 51 strikeouts in six September starts, finishing the season on a career-best six-decision winning streak...Carrasco and Corey Kluber simultaneously became the first pitchers to post five wins, 50 strikeouts, and an ERA of 1.50-or-less in a calendar month since Sam McDowell in June 1969 (6-0, 50K, 1.05 ERA; courtesy of ELIAS).
 » Notched his 200th inning in his final start of the year, an 8.1-inning, 14-strikeout performance on September 28 vs. Minnesota...marked a single-game season-high as well as the 2nd-highest total of his career (15, 9/25/2015 at Kansas City).
 » Made his Postseason debut in Game 3 of the ALDS against New York-AL after missing the 2016 playoffs with a broken metacarpal in his right hand...tossed 5.2 shutout innings on just three hits (3BB, 7K) but took a no decision in the Tribe's eventual 1-0 loss at Yankee Stadium.

CAREER SNAPSHOT

» Right-hander is in his 10th season with the Cleveland organization after being acquired from the Philadelphia Phillies on July 29, 2009, along with INF Jason Donald, RHP Jason Knapp & C Lou Marson, in exchange for OF Ben Francisco & LHP Cliff Lee...switched dugouts upon announcement of trade, as AAA Columbus was playing AAA Lehigh Valley.
 » Signed 4-year contract extension with Indians thru 2018 on April 7, 2015, including club options for 2019 & 2020 and could cover up to first 3 years of free agency.
 » Made his major league debut September 1, 2009 as the Indians starter against the Detroit Tigers at Comerica Park...took the loss after allowing six runs on nine hits (three home runs) with three walks and three strikeouts in 3.0 innings.
 » Is in his 15th professional season since signing with Philadelphia as a non-drafted free agent on Nov. 25, 2003...has appeared in parts of nine Major League seasons with Cleveland...missed the entire 2012 season after having right elbow surgery.
