WHITE SOX AT A GLANCE

- The Chicago White Sox have won seven of their last 10 games, 13 of 19 and 18 of 30 as they continue a 10-game, 11-day homestand this afternoon with the opener vs. Detroit.
- RHP Reynaldo López, who is 1-0 with a 2.13 ERA (3 ER/12.2 IP) over his last two starts, is scheduled to start for the Sox.
- The White Sox are 2-2 on the homestand after splitting a four-game series with Boston over the weekend, including an 8-0 victory yesterday on "Hawk Harelson Day".
- Following this three-game series and a day off on Thursday, the Sox conclude the homestand with three games vs. the Angels (9/7-9) before taking a nine-game, 11-day trip to Kansas City (8/10-12), Baltimore (8/14-16) and Cleveland (8/18-20).
- The Sox went 5-2 on their last trip to Detroit (3-1) and New York-AL (2-1) from 8/23-29, including their first series win at Yankee Stadium since 2005.

ROSTER MOVES

- Prior to today's game, the White Sox recalled OF Ryan Cordell from Class AAA Charlotte ... Cordell, who has no major-league experience, will wear uniform No. 49.
- The White Sox active roster increases to 29.

TODAY'S STORYLINES

- The White Sox own a 2.82 ERA (28 ER/89.1 IP) over the last 10 games, the best mark in the American League ... the starters have posted a 2.10 ERA (14 ER/60.0 IP) during that span.
- The Sox are hitting .277/.334/.473 (145-524) with 22 home runs and 85 runs scored over the last 15 games (5.7 R/G).
- The White Sox have lost six straight home games to Detroit, their longest streak since 7/15/79-8/26/80 (six) ... they have not lost seven-plus straight home games vs. the Tigers since 4/25-9/7/36 (nine).
- RHP Reynaldo López owns a 2.08 ERA (3 ER/13.0 IP) in two career home starts vs. Detroit.
- Yolmer Sánchez has reached base safely in a career-high 21 consecutive games (.421 on-base percentage), the longest streak by a Sox player since José Abreu (29) from 8/2-9/2/16.

YESTERDAY'S RECAP

- James Shields combined with three relievers on a five-hitter, and the offense recorded 15 hits as the White Sox defeated Boston, 8-0, to gain a split of the four-game series.
- Shields allowed four hits with two walks and six strikeouts over 6.0 IP, the 23rd time in 29 outings this season he has lasted at least 6.0 IP.
- Caleb Frare pitched a 1-2-3 seventh inning in his major-league debut, striking out two, while Juan Minaya and Héctor Santiago each threw 1.0 scoreless IP to close out Chicago's seventh shutout of the season, second against Boston and first at home vs. the Red Sox since 4/10/94.
- Tim Anderson matched his career high with three extra-base hits, going 3-5 with two doubles, a home run (career-high No. 18), two runs scored and an RBI.
- Rookie Daniel Palka hit his 20th home run of the season, Matt Davidson was 2-4 with a double and two RBI, and Yoán Moncada, Yolmer Sánchez and Adam Engel collected two hits apiece.

WINNING WAYS

- The White Sox have gone 13-6 since 8/14, tied with the Cubs for the second-best record in the major leagues behind Tampa Bay (13-5).
- The Sox are 18-12 since 8/2, moving from 9.0 games behind Detroit into a third-place tie with the Tigers in the AL Central.
- Chicago is 11-6 so far during a stretch of playing 20 straight days from 8/17-9/5, and 8-4 since José Abreu was placed on the disabled list on 8/22.

HISTORICALLY TOUGH STRETCH

- The White Sox just completed a stretch where they went 4-3 over consecutive series at New York-AL and vs. Boston, the best two teams in the majors.
- It marked the first time since 1939 that the Sox played back-to-back series against teams who entered the matchup having played at least 50 games with winning percentages of .630 or better (STATS).

PALKA POWER

- Daniel Palka, who was claimed off waivers from Minnesota on 11/4/17, ranks among the American League rookie leaders in home runs (3rd, 20), RBI (3rd, 54), slugging percentage (5th, .469) and total bases (5th, 161).
- Palka's 20 homers are the second-highest total in White Sox history by a left-handed hitting rookie, trailing only Pete Ward, who hit 22 in 1963.

WHITE SOX VS. DETROIT

- The Tigers lead the season series, 10-6, going 6-0 at Guaranteed Rate Field and 4-6 at Comerica Park.
- The White Sox have won five of their last six games after losing nine of the first 10.
- The Sox are batting .263/.316/.427 (147-558) with a 4.76 ERA (68 ER/141.0 IP) and have been outscored by the Tigers, 72-69.
- The White Sox are 67-98 against Detroit since 2010 (36-44 at Guaranteed Rate Field).
- The Sox trail in the all-time series, 1,055-1,097 ... they are 562-515 in Chicago (125-100 at Guaranteed Rate Field) and 493-582 in Detroit (84-91 at Comerica Park).

TIGER TAMERS

- Wellington Castillo is hitting .478 (11-23) in six career games.
- Matt Davidson owns a .340/.498/.649 (33-97) average with seven home runs and 18 RBI in 27 career games.
- Daniel Palka is hitting .367 (18-49) in 12 career games.
- Omar Narváez is batting .356 (26-73) in 24 career games.

LOOKING FOR CENTRAL COMMAND

- The White Sox are 26-34 against the American League Central in 2018 (12-19 at home), but have won nine of their last 12 games by a combined 67-46 margin.
- The White Sox are 317-411 vs. the AL Central since 2009, posting a losing record every season except 2012 (37-36).

YOUNG GUNS

- Lucas Giolito (24 years old), Michael Kopech (22), Reynaldo López (24) and Carlos Rodón (25) make up four-fifths of the White Sox starting rotation.
- Giolito leads the staff with 10 victories and is 3-0 with a 2.84 ERA (8 ER/25.1 IP) over his last four starts.
- Kopech has allowed one run over 11.0 IP over his first three major-league starts, two of which have been rain-shortened.
- López is 1-0 with a 2.13 ERA (3 ER/12.2 IP) over his last two starts and has combined to go 2-0 with a 1.33 ERA (3 ER/20.1 IP) in three starts this season against Boston and the Yankees.
- Rodón is 5-1 with a 2.11 ERA (15 ER/64.0 IP) and .151 (33-218) opponents average over his last nine starts.

POWER AND SPEED ...

- Tim Anderson (18 HR/25 SB) is one of five players in the major leagues with at least 18 home runs and 25 stolen bases, joining Boston's Mookie Betts and Cleveland's José Ramírez.
- Anderson is attempting to become the first White Sox shortstop to record a 20-HR/20-SB season and could join Alex Rios (2010) and Tommie Agee (1966) as the only players in franchise history to post 20 homers and 30 steals in one season.

... AND IMPROVED GLOVEWORK

- SS Tim Anderson has played 21 consecutive errorless games (82 TC) and owns a .985 fielding percentage (4 E/259 TC) in 71 games since 6/10, the fifth-best mark in the American League.
- By comparison, Anderson posted a .957 (53 E/1,247 TC) fielding percentage over his first 302 career games at shortstop from 6/10/16-6/9/18.

QUALITY AND QUANTITY

- The White Sox have made 1,378 quality starts since the start of the 2003 season, tied with the New York Mets for the highest total in the major leagues and 51 more than Oakland (1,327), the next-closest American League team.

GRAB SOME BENCH

- The White Sox have struck out 1,332 times this season, the most in the major leagues ... the Sox are on pace to strike out 1,575 times, which would break the franchise record of 1,397 set in 2017.
- The White Sox struck out 18 times on Saturday vs. Boston, their most in a nine-inning game since 8/8/97 at Seattle when Randy Johnson fanned 19.

REVOLVING CLOSING DOOR

- A White Sox franchise-record nine different pitchers have recorded at least one save this season, breaking the mark of eight set five times (last 1988) ... source: STATS LLC.
- Only four of the nine pitchers currently are on the active roster, and only LHP Héctor Santiago has been with the club all season.

PROSPECT PROWESS

- The White Sox farm system is ranked No. 3 in baseball according to MLB Pipeline, and includes seven of the Top 100 prospects: OF Eloy Jiménez (No. 3), RHP Michael Kopech (13), OF Luis Robert (25), INF Nick Madrigal (32), RHP Dylan Cease (44), RHP Dane Dunning (64) and OF Blake Rutherford (88).

LÓPEZ AT A GLANCE

- The 24-year-old right-hander is scheduled to make his 28th start of the season, 13th at home and sixth against the Detroit Tigers.
- Is 1-0 with a 4.28 ERA (16 ER/33.2 IP), 30 strikeouts and a .240 (31-129) opponents average over his last six starts.
- Is 0-2 with a 7.07 ERA (22 ER/28.0 IP), 25 strikeouts and a .272 (31-114) opponents average over his last five home starts ... has not recorded a win at home since 6/26 vs. Minnesota.
- Went 3-0 with a 4.62 ERA (13 ER/25.1 IP) over his final four starts of 2017 ... made his White Sox debut on 8/11/17 vs. Kansas City, receiving a no decision after allowing two runs with six strikeouts over 6.0 IP.
- Was named the White Sox Minor League Pitcher of the Month for July 2017 after posting a 2.10 ERA (7 ER/30.0 IP) with 38 strikeouts and a .183 (20-109) opponents average over five starts.
- Was acquired from Washington with RHPs Dane Dunning and Lucas Giolito in exchange for OF Adam Eaton on 12/7/16 ... originally was signed by the Nationals as a non-drafted free agent on 6/21/12.

LAST START

- Earned his fifth win of the season and first since 7/1 at Texas ... allowed one run on five hits over 7.0 IP ... received four runs or more of support for just the eighth time this season.
- Allowed a RBI single to Gleyber Torreyes in the fifth inning.
- Departed with the White Sox leading, 4-1, after throwing 108 pitches (63 strikes) ... Ryan LaMarre hit a RBI double in the second inning, a RBI single in the fourth and a home run in the seventh.

LOW RISP, HIGH REWARD

- Is limiting opponents to a .224 average with RISP (32-143) and .182 mark with RISP/two outs (12-66) this season ... opponents are 53-237 (.224) with RISP and 21-106 (.198) with RISP/two outs in his career.
- His .224 average with RISP is the fifth-lowest among American League pitchers.

HOME NOT SO SWEET HOME

- Is making his 17th career start at Guaranteed Rate Field ... has gone 3-5 with a 4.13 ERA (48 ER/104.2 IP), 75 strikeouts and a .231 (92-399) opponents average in 16 career starts.
 - Is 2-3 with a 4.36 ERA (36 ER/74.1 IP), 53 strikeouts and a .226 (63-279) opponents average in 12 starts this season ... has allowed 14 home runs over his last seven starts at home.
- Received a no decision in his last start on 8/19 vs. Kansas City ... allowed six runs on six hits (three home runs) over 2.0 IP ... has not recorded a win at home since 6/26 vs. Minnesota.

HELP WANTED

- Owns a 3.35 run support average (58 RS/155.2 IP) in 2018, the second-lowest in the American League and third in the majors.
- Has received three runs of support or less in 19 of his 27 starts ... the Sox have scored four runs of supports over his last three starts.
- Received a 7.55 RSA (40 RS/47.2 IP) in eight starts last season.

NO DECISION MADE

- Is third in the American League and tied for fourth in the majors with 13 no decisions this season ... owns a 3.46 ERA (30 ER/78.0 IP) in those starts.
- In his 13 no decisions the Sox have scored a total of 28 runs, including one run twice, two runs three times and three runs once ... the Sox are 5-7 when López receives a no decision.

DAY AND NIGHT

- Is 3-5 with a 4.16 ERA (35 ER/75.2 IP), .227 (64-282) opponents average and .688 opponents OPS in 13 day starts (seven quality) this season ... compared to 2-4 with a 4.84 ERA (43 ER/80.0 IP), .267 (82-307) opponents average and .824 opponents OPS in 14 night starts (six quality).
- Has gone 4-5 with a 4.60 ERA (44 ER/86.0 IP), .235 (76-324) opponents average and .711 opponents OPS in 17 career appearances (14 starts, seven quality) during the day, compared to 9-10 with a 4.63 ERA (83 ER/161.1 IP), .264 (166-628) opponents average and .782 opponents OPS in 29 career games (27 starts) at night.

MAKING HISTORY

- Is the first White Sox pitcher with 6.0-plus IP, two-or-fewer hits allowed, and one-or-fewer runs allowed in each of his first two starts of the season (source: Elias).
- Became the first White Sox starting pitcher since at least 1908 to lose a game in which he threw 7.0-plus IP while allowing two or less hits and one run which was unearned (source: Baseball Reference and STATS LLC) ... the last five pitchers to accomplish this feat:

- Is making his 20th career start against the American League Central ... is 4-5 with a 4.58 ERA (57 ER/112.0 IP), 64 strikeouts and a .270 (118-437) opponents average in 19 career starts.
- Fourteen of his 27 starts this season have come against the American League Central ... is 1-4 with a 5.02 ERA (45 ER/80.2 IP), 54 strikeouts and a .272 (84-309) opponents average ... owns a 3.24 (29 RS/80.2 IP) run support average during those starts ... has received three runs once, two runs twice and zero runs six times ... six of his 14 outings vs. the division have been quality.
- Received a no decision in his last start on 8/24 at Detroit ... allowed two runs on four hits over 5.2 IP ... has tossed at least 6.0 IP in nine of his 14 starts against the division this season.

VS. DETROIT TIGERS

- Is scheduled to make his seventh career start and sixth this season against the Detroit Tigers.
- Has gone 1-1 with a 3.58 ERA (15 ER/37.2 IP), 21 strikeouts and a .248 (34-137) opponents average lifetime and is 0-1 with a 3.23 ERA (11 ER/30.2 IP), 20 strikeouts and a .245 (27-110) opponents average this season.
- Received a no decision in his last start on 8/24 at Detroit ... allowed two runs on four hits over 5.2 IP ... has not recorded a win since 9/16/17 at Detroit.
- Has gone 0-1 with a 2.08 ERA (3 ER/13.0 IP), eight strikeouts and a .234 (11-47) opponents average in two career starts at Guaranteed Rate Field.
