### TRIBE HEADLINES

» **EDWIN ENCARNACION** enters today's ballgame on an 11-game hitting streak, over which he is batting .419 with six homers, four doubles and 15 RBI...the streak is tied for the 3rd-longest active streak in MLB, and represents the 3rd-longest by a Tribe batter in 2018 (**Brantley** - 19 games, May 9-30 & **Lindor** - 15 games, April 29 - May 14).

» **JOSÉ RAMÍREZ** homered last night for his fifth longball in his last nine games...his 19 home runs this season rank T2nd in the A.L. and MLB, and he holds the 3rd-most homers in franchise history through 59 team games (**Albert Belle** - 23 in 1996 & **Rocky Colavito** - 20 in 1959).

» **CARLOS CARRASCO** tossed his 10th career complete game (and 2nd of 2018) in a May 9 start at Milwaukee earlier this season...his 14 strikeouts that afternoon remain the most by an Indians pitcher this season...Carrasco holds a career Interleague record of 6-4 with a 3.09 ERA (33ER/96.0IP).

### YESTERDAY'S RECAP

» The Indians opened their two-game set vs. the Milwaukee Brewers with a 3-2 win...marked the club's sixth consecutive win at Progressive Field, their longest streak of the season.

» In his first at-bat since returning from the Disabled List, **LONNIE CHISENHALL** delivered a two-run single in the bottom of the 2nd inning to give the Tribe a 2-0 lead...**JOSÉ RAMÍREZ** belted his 19th home run of the season with a solo shot in the bottom of the 3rd.

» **EDWIN ENCARNACION** extended his hit streak to 11 games with a double in the bottom of the 8th inning...four of the Tribe's eight hits went for extra bases, as **JASON KIPNIS** and **MICHAEL BRANTLEY** both chipped in doubles for Cleveland.

» **COREY KLUBER** matched the American League lead with his 9th win of 2018, allowing just one run on seven hits over 7.0 strong innings...struck out seven batters and walked none, increasing his career-long walkless streak to 35.1 innings...also increased his A.L. record streak to 25 consecutive starts allowing three-or-fewer runs.

### STRANGE BREW

» The Indians and Brewers are set to wrap their 2018 season series with this afternoon's finale...after splitting a pair of contests at Miller Park on May 8 & 9, the Tribe holds a 2-1 advantage with one game remaining.

» The series in Milwaukee marked the clubs' first regular-season matchup since 2015, when the Tribe went 3-1 in the season series.

» Since the Brewers left the American League in 1998, the Indians have gone 12-13 (.480) in 25 Interleague matchups between the clubs...in a series that dates back to 1969, the Tribe is 206-207 (.499) all-time against their former divisional rival.

### INTERLEAGUE INTERFACE

» This mid-week series marks the Tribe's fourth set of Interleague contests this season, all of which have been two-game series...Cleveland holds a 5-2 record against the National League in 2018, including a mark of 3-1 against Chicago-NL.

» The Indians' 20 Interleague matchups this season will all come against the teams of the N.L. Central division...in addition to "home-and-home" series with Milwaukee, Chicago-NL and Cincinnati, Cleveland will host Pittsburgh for three games (July 23-25) and travel to St. Louis for another three (June 25-27).

» Cleveland has gone 57-50 (.533) vs. the N.L. since 2013, and 194-196 (.497) overall since Interleague play began in 1997.

### HOME COOKING

» Last night's win marked the Tribe's season-long sixth consecutive win at Progressive Field, improving their overall home record to 19-11 (.633), the 3rd-best mark in the A.L. (4th in MLB).

» Cleveland's current run at Progressive Field marks the Tribe's fifth streak of six-or-more straight home wins since the start of the 2016 season, the most in the A.L. over that span and 3rd-most in MLB (LAD - 7, CHC - 6).

» The Tribe's .284 batting average at home ranks 2nd in MLB, while they also sit 2nd with 48 homers, 2nd with 299 hits and 3rd with 120 extra-base hits.

» Indians starters have posted 63 quality starts at home since the start of 2017, the most in the A.L. and T2nd in MLB (WAS - 66).

Todd Isaacs (3-5) delivered a walk-off two-run single...José Vicente went 2-for-5 with a two-run homer.

### BATTERING RAM

» **JOSÉ RAMÍREZ** increased his team-high homer total to 19 longballs with a solo shot in last night's ballgame...he sits T2nd in the American League and MLB, just one behind **J.D. Martínez** (BOS).

» Ramírez has homered in five of his last nine games and is batting .333 (12-36) overall in that stretch...his 19 home runs through 59 team games are the 3rd-most in franchise history, trailing only **Albert Belle** (23 in 1996) and **Rocky Colavito** (20 in 1959) at this juncture of the season.

» He enters play today in the A.L. Top 10 in several other categories, including extra-base hits (37, T1st), OPS (1.026, 4th), total bases, (142, 4th), slugging percentage (.631, 4th), RBI (42, T4th), plate apps. per strikeout (9.3, 5th), walks (35, T5th), runs scored (43, 6th), on-base percentage (.395, T6th) and doubles (18, T8th).

### ED-WINNING

» **EDWIN ENCARNACION** extended his season-long hit streak to 11 games last night with a double in the bottom of the 8th inning...the streak is tied for the 3rd-longest active streak in MLB and is also the 3rd-longest by a Tribe batter this season (**MICHAEL BRANTLEY** - 19 games, May 9-30; **FRANCISCO LINDOR** - 15 games, April 29 - May 14).

» The reigning A.L. Player of the Week is batting .419 (18-43) over his hit streak with six homers, four doubles and 15 RBI.

» Since May 1, Encarnacion is batting .330 (35-106) with 10 homers (T4th in MLB), seven doubles, 21 runs scored and 30 RBI (T1st in MLB)...his 16 homers this season are T6th in the American League.

### COMPLETE COOKIE

» **CARLOS CARRASCO** is set to make his 13th start of the season this afternoon, in his second career start and appearance against the Milwaukee Brewers...previously faced the Brewers in a start at Miller Park on May 9...earned a complete game victory, as he held Milwaukee to just two runs on five hits...Carrasco's 14 strikeouts that afternoon remain the most by an Indians starter this season.

» Carrasco's last start came on June 1 at Minnesota, where he took the loss after allowing six runs on seven hits over 3.2 innings of work (3BB, 2K)...in four starts since his complete game in Milwaukee, he has gone 1-3 with a 6.46 ERA (17ER/23.2IP).

» In 17 career Interleague appearances (13 starts), Carrasco owns a 6-4 record with a 3.09 ERA (33ER/96.0IP)...has not lost an Interleague start since falling on July 27, 2016 vs. Washington.

» Remains one of just two pitchers (also Seattle's **James Paxton**) in MLB with multiple complete games this season, and ranks T10th in the American League with six wins.

### KIP THE BALL ROLLING

» **JASON KIPNIS** went 2-for-3 last night with a double, and has now recorded multi-hit efforts in six of his last 10 contests...he is batting .341 (14-41) in that span with two homers, three doubles, four RBI and five runs scored.

» Kipnis has raised his batting average over 30 points since May 25, and enters play today at his highest clip since April 1.

### HOMER HAPPY

» **Cleveland has slugged 89 home runs this season, which are 3rd-most in MLB (New York-AL - 96, Boston - 90).**

» The Indians are one of just two teams in MLB boasting five players with 10-or-more homers (New York-AL also has five)...three Tribe players currently rank in the American League's Top 10: **JOSÉ RAMÍREZ** (19, T2nd), **EDWIN ENCARNACION** (16, T6th) and **FRANCISCO LINDOR** (14, T9th).

### GOOD NEIGHBORS

» Following this afternoon's game at Progressive Field, the Cleveland Cavaliers will host the Golden State Warriors next door at Quicken Loans Arena in Game 3 of the NBA Finals.

» Today's twin billing at the Gateway Complex will mark the 15th time since the start of the 2015 NBA Playoffs that the Indians will have a home game on the same day as a Cavs home playoff game...the Tribe has gone 7-7 in those previous contests, while the Cavaliers have posted a 13-1 mark.

### THIS DAY IN INDIANS HISTORY

**1997: Sandy Alomar Jr.** goes 4-for-4 in the Tribe's 7-3 win at Boston, matching the MLB record with four doubles...the record-tying performance also served as the 10th game of Alomar's 30-game hitting streak, which lasted from May 25 - July 6 of that season...continues to stand as the second-longest hit streak in Indians franchise history, trailing only a 31-game streak by Hall of Famer **Nap Lajoie** in 1906.
