TRIBE HEADLINES

» The Indians own a 41-21 (.661) record vs. A.L. Central opponents this season (3rd-best in MLB), posting an MLB-low 2.84 ERA against their own division.

» Cleveland also holds a record of 33-12 in series finales (best in MLB)...Tribe starters are 28-6 with a 2.56 ERA in finales.

» **FRANCISCO LINDOR** has homered in consecutive games for the seventh time this season (T2nd-most in MLB)...his 30 homers and 78 RBI out of the first spot of the batting order lead MLB.

» **JOSÉ RAMÍREZ** is one stolen base away from becoming the third player in franchise history to log a 30-homer/30-steal season (**Joe Carter** - 1987, **Grady Sizemore** - 2008).

» **COREY KLUBER's** 2.45 ERA vs. the A.L. Central is 4th-lowest of any player (min. 60.0IP), only trailing three teammates (**Bauer**, **Clevinger**, **Carrasco**)...he also ranks 3rd in the American League with a 2.09 home ERA.

YESTERDAY'S RECAP

» The Indians leveled their series vs. Kansas City at one game apiece with a 9-3 victory last night...paired with a Twins loss, the Tribe's "magic number" to clinch the A.L. Central now stands at 10.

» **FRANCISCO LINDOR** (1-4) put the Tribe on the board with his 6th leadoff homer of the season, his 31st longball overall...**YANDY DÍAZ** went 3-for-4 and belted his first career Major League home run with a solo shot in the 5th inning...Díaz also added a triple, finishing the night with two RBI and three runs scored.

» **JASON KIPNIS** (2 RBI), **MELKY CABRERA** (RBI) and **BRANDON GUYER** (RBI) all contributed multi-hit efforts.

» **MIKE CLEVINGER** earned his 11th win, holding the Royals to one run on three hits over 6.0 strong innings of work...walked one and struck out 10, recording his fifth career outing with 10-or-more strikeouts (all coming this season).

FINISH STRONG

» The Indians enter play today with a 33-12 record in series finales...Cleveland's .733 win percentage in finales leads all MLB teams...the Tribe has won 10 of its last 12 series finales.

» Cleveland owns an 19-4 record in home finales, winning seven of their last eight such contests...additionally, the Indians are 10-5 in rubber matches this season, including a 6-2 mark in Cleveland.

» Tribe starting pitchers have excelled in series finales, posting a 28-6 record with a 2.56 ERA (84ER/295.2IP), including wins in 20 of their last 24 decisions.

CARRASCO HONORED

» Tribe pitcher **CARLOS CARRASCO** will be honored in a pre-game ceremony this afternoon as Cleveland's nominee for the Roberto Clemente Award...this marks Carrasco's fourth consecutive season earning the Indians' nomination.

» Carrasco has created two charitable foundations in the past year: the Carlos Carrasco Children's Foundation in the United States, and Fundación Carlos Carrasco in Venezuela...he also has helped the United Way's "Stuff The Bus With Books" for each of the past four seasons, a campaign that donates thousands of books to children throughout the Cleveland community.

» Fans are encouraged to cast their vote for one of the 30 nominees at mlb.com/clemente21 starting today through September 18.

DIVISIONAL DOMINANCE

» Cleveland has gone 41-21 vs. A.L. Central opponents this season, with a record of 13-4-2 in series play...the Indians' .661 intradivisional winning percentage ranks 3rd in MLB behind Atlanta (42-21, .667 vs. N.L. East) and Boston (45-19, .703 vs. A.L. East).

» The Tribe has gone 24-7 in divisional home games and 17-14 on the road...since June 17, Cleveland has won 13 of its last 16 divisional home games.

» In 62 games vs. the A.L. Central, Tribe pitchers own a 2.84 ERA (175ER/555.0IP), marking the lowest intradivisional ERA in MLB...seven of the Tribe's 14 shutouts this season (T2nd in MLB) have come against the A.L. Central, and the Indians have allowed three-or-fewer runs in 40 intradivisional games (34-6 in those contests).

ROYAL WELCOME

» Cleveland has gone 9-5 this season vs. the Royals, posting a 5-3 record at Progressive Field and a 4-2 mark at Kauffman Stadium...the Tribe is outscoring Kansas City 77-52 in those 14 contests.

» In a rivalry that dates back to 1969, the Indians own an all-time record of 367-333 (.524) vs. the Royals, as well as a 64-45 (.587) mark since **Terry Francona** became Tribe manager in 2013.

» **Lynchburg (High-A): 71-66 (2nd Half: 42-28)** » Today: 6:30 vs. Potomac » Tomorrow: 6:30 vs. Potomac
Justin Garza (5-6, 3.71) will take the hill tonight in Lynchburg's Game 1 matchup vs. Potomac.

» **MV Scrappers (Short-A): 42-33, 1st (+1.5G)** » Today: 6:30 at Tri-City » Tomorrow: 7:05 vs. Tri-City
The Scrappers' best-of-three series vs. Tri-City begins tonight...Games 2 & 3 will be played at Mahoning Valley.

KLUBER DAY

» **COREY KLUBER** has gone 2-1 with a 3.93 ERA (8ER/18.1IP) in three starts vs. Kansas City this season, winning his lone start at Progressive Field on May 13 (7.0IP, 8H, 2R/0ER, 0BB, 4K).

» Kluber is starting on regular four days' rest after making his last outing on August 31 vs. Tampa Bay...earned his 17th win of the season after holding the Rays to just two hits over 7.0 shutout innings (2BB, 8K)...Kluber's 17 wins this season are tied for the Major League lead with NYY's **Luis Severino** and TB's **Blake Snell**.

» He also finished tied for the MLB lead with 18 wins last season...the last pitcher to hold or share the MLB lead in wins for two consecutive seasons was **CC Sabathia** (2009-10)...**Bob Feller** is the only Indians pitcher to do so (1940-41).

» Kluber has gone 8-2 with a 2.45 ERA (20ER/73.1IP) in 11 starts vs. the A.L. Central this year, marking the 4th-lowest ERA (min. 60.0IP) of any player vs. the division behind **TREVOR BAUER** (1.93), **MIKE CLEVINGER** (2.15) & **CARLOS CARRASCO** (2.39).

» He has posted a 9-3 record with a 2.09 ERA (24ER/103.1IP) in 15 starts at Progressive Field this season, good for the 3rd-lowest home ERA in the American League (**Snell** - 1.06, **Bauer** - 1.87).

» Kluber currently leads MLB with 1.30 walks per 9.0 innings...he ranks among American League leaders in innings pitched (186.2), WHIP (0.96, 3rd), daytime ERA (1.98, 3rd), ERA (2.80, 5th), opponent batting average (.222, 8th) and strikeouts (180, 10th).

FRANKIE STRIKES AGAIN

» **FRANCISCO LINDOR** homered for a second straight game last night, giving him 31 homers on the season (T7th in A.L.), two shy of his career high (33 in 2017)...marks his 7th streak of homering in at least two games this season, T2nd most in MLB (OAK's **Khris Davis** has nine such streaks).

» Lindor has collected 30 home runs and 78 RBI from the first spot of the batting order this season, both of which lead MLB.

» His 1st inning home run last night was his 6th leadoff homer of the season, tied with Houston's **George Springer** for most in the A.L. (T3rd in MLB)...he sits one shy of matching **Grady Sizemore's** franchise record for leadoff homers in a season (7 in 2008).

» Lindor is batting .306 (77-252) in 61 games against the A.L. Central this season, leading all players with 19 home runs, 55 runs scored, 49 RBI and 16 doubles (T1st) vs. the division.

KINGS OF K

» **MIKE CLEVINGER's** outing last night marked the Tribe's 24th start this season with at least 10 strikeouts, 2nd-most in MLB (Houston - 26)...Cleveland is one such start away from matching its club record (25 each in 1968 and 2017).

» Tribe starting pitchers have recorded 913 strikeouts this season (2nd in MLB, Houston - 967) and have issued just 210 walks (4th-fewest in MLB)...the rotation's collective 4.35 K/BB ratio is the highest in MLB and currently stands as the highest mark in club history.

» The Indians currently boast four pitchers among the American League top 10 in strikeouts: **TREVOR BAUER** (4th, 214), **CARLOS CARRASCO** (6th, 187), **MIKE CLEVINGER** (9th, 182) and **COREY KLUBER** (10th, 180).

J-RAMMING AT HOME

» **JOSÉ RAMÍREZ** continues to lead the Indians with 96 RBI this season, 3rd-most in the American League...he sits four RBI away from becoming the first Tribe third baseman to record 100 in a season since **Travis Fryman** (106) in 2000.

» 58 of his 96 RBI this season have come at Progressive Field, marking the 2nd-most home RBI in MLB (Boston's **J.D. Martinez** - 64)...Ramirez also ranks T3rd with 58 runs scored and 5th with 19 home runs at home.

» Ramirez enters play today with 29 stolen bases, one behind American League leaders **Whit Merrifield** (KC) and **Dee Gordon** (SEA)...he is one steal away from logging the 3rd season in club history with 30-plus homers and 30-plus steals (**Joe Carter** - 1987, **Grady Sizemore** - 2008).

YANDY REPLAY

» **YANDY DÍAZ** hit his first MLB home run last night in his 244th career plate appearance, marking the longest wait by an Indians batter to start their career since **John McDonald** homered in his 275th plate appearance on September 5, 2002.

» Díaz has hit safely in 11 of his 14 starts this season and is batting .333 (21-63) on the season...he currently holds the 3rd-highest batting average in the A.L. and 5th-highest in MLB among players with at least 60 plate appearances this season.

THIS DAY IN INDIANS HISTORY

1987: Joe Carter leads the Tribe offense in a 15-2 win at Boston, going 4-for-6 with two homers, a double and five RBI...his 4th-inning solo shot gave him 30 home runs on the season, and 11 days later, he would add his 30th stolen base to become the first player in Indians history to record a 30/30 season...**Brook Jacoby** and **Cory Snyder** also joined Carter at the 30-homer mark that year, forming the first such trio in club history.

TODAY'S START

» Kluber is scheduled to make his 29th start of the season in this afternoon's series finale...will mark his 197th career appearance and 192nd start.
 » Will be pitching today on regular four days' rest after making his last start on August 31 vs. Tampa Bay...held the Rays to two hits across 7.0 shutout innings (2BB, 8K) to earn his 17th win of the season.
 » Kluber is due to start against division rival the Royals for the fourth time this season, compiling a 2-1 record and 3.93 ERA (8ER/18.1IP) in his three prior starts.
 » Owns a 1.94 ERA (47ER/218.0IP) at home across the last two seasons, marking the 3rd-lowest home ERA by an Indians pitcher in a two-season span since 1913 (min. 30 GS), behind Hall-of-Famers **Bob Feller** (1.45 ERA, 1946-47) and **Stan Coveleski** (1.92 ERA, 1917-18).
 » Has continued his to dominate opponents at Progressive Field this year, compiling an 9-3 record and 2.09 ERA (24ER/103.1IP)...entering play today, ranks 3rd in the American League in home ERA (4th in MLB), as well as T2nd in wins at home (T2nd in MLB).
 » Owns an 8-2 record and 2.45 ERA (20ER/73.1IP) in his 11 intradivisional starts this season...entering play today, his ERA vs. the A.L. Central is the 4th-lowest mark against the division this season.
 » Kluber has walked just 27 batters in his 28 starts this season, tied with St. Louis' **Miles Mikolas** for the 2nd-fewest among qualified MLB starters this season, behind Texas' **Bartholo Colon** (24)...**Kluber enters play today averaging 1.30 walks per 9.0 innings, the lowest rate in the Majors.**
 » Has also tossed 7.0-or-more innings in 18 starts this season, which is the most among all Major League starting pitchers.
 » Kluber enters play today among the American League pitching leaders in walks-per-9.0IP (1.30, 1st), complete games (2, T1st), wins (17, T1st), innings pitched (186.2, 2nd), ERA (2.80, 5th), opponent batting average (.222, 8th) and strikeouts (180, 10th).

VS. KANSAS CITY | A.L. CENTRAL

» Kluber is due to face Kansas City for the fourth time in today's game...has compiled a 2-1 record and 3.93 ERA (10ER/18.1IP) in his three prior starts.
 » Last faced the Royals on August 25 at Kauffman Stadium...took the loss, allowing five runs on nine hits (one home run), with two walks and six strikeouts.
 » Today will mark Kluber's 12th start against the A.L. Central division this season, posting an 8-2 record and 2.45 ERA (20ER/73.1IP) in his 11 prior starts...entering play today, his ERA vs. the A.L. Central is the 4th-lowest mark against the division this season.

HOMEWARD BOUND

» Today's contest will mark Kluber's 15th home start of the season...is 9-3 with a 2.09 ERA (24ER/103.1IP) in his home outings.
 » Held Tampa Bay to two hits over 7.0 shutout innings (2BB, 8K) in his last home start on August 31...has won his last two home decisions dating back to August 4, posting a 1.57 ERA (4ER/23.0IP) in that three-start span.
 » Enters today's game with the 3rd-lowest home ERA in the American League (4th-lowest in MLB), as well as T2nd in the A.L. and MLB with nine home wins.
 » He has recorded a quality start in 11 of his 15 home starts, which is tied with Houston's **Justin Verlander** for 2nd-most in the A.L.

AND THE SECOND HALF IS UNDERWAY

» Kluber is 5-2 with a 2.76 ERA (17ER/53.0.0IP) in eight second-half starts this season.
 » He owns a 45-18 record and 2.90 ERA (183ER/568.2IP) in his career in the second half...his second-half ERA since the start of 2011 is 5th-lowest in MLB (min. 400.0IP), behind **Clayton Kershaw** (1.71), **Justin Verlander** (2.82), **David Price** (2.85) and **Tanner Roark** (2.87).
 » Since the start of the 2013 season, Kluber has gone 43-13 with a 2.57 ERA (143ER/501.1IP) in 73 second-half starts...in that span, he leads MLB in second-half wins and his second-half ERA is the 2nd-lowest mark (min. 200.0IP), behind **LAD's Clayton Kershaw** (1.70).
 » He posted a 11-1 record and 1.79 ERA (22ER/110.1IP) with 142 strikeouts in 15 starts in the second half last season...led MLB in second-half wins, strikeouts and ERA (min. 80.0IP).

HE CAN GO THE DISTANCE

» Kluber tossed his seventh career complete-game shutout on August 4 vs. Los Angeles-AL, allowing three hits and one walk, while striking out seven batters.
 » Marked his second complete game of the season, after also going the distance in the Tribe's 2-1 Opening Day loss in Seattle...he is tied with four others, including teammate **CARLOS CARRASCO**, for the Major League lead in complete games this year...Kluber's 17 complete games since the start of the 2014 season are the most in MLB, ahead of Los Angeles-NL's **Clayton Kershaw** (14).
 » Kluber needed just 98 pitches to finish his outing on August 4, marking his second career complete-game shutout with less than 100 pitches thrown (also, July 30, 2014 vs. Seattle - 85 pitches)...also tied his 3rd-lowest pitch count in a complete game in his career (also, Aug. 14 at MIN), behind his 91-pitch CG at Seattle on Opening Day of this season and his 85-pitch effort vs. Seattle on July 30, 2014.

2018 RECAP & HIGHLIGHTS

» Kluber was named to the 2018 American League All-Star team, but did not pitch after receiving an injection in his right knee following his July 12 start vs. New York-AL...marked his third career All-Star selection (third consecutive).
 » Enters play tonight with 18 starts of 7.0-or-more innings, the most of any Major League starting pitcher this season.
 » He has recorded quality starts in 22 of his 28 outings this season...entering play today, his 22 quality starts rank T3rd in MLB with **HOU's Justin Verlander** and **PHI's Aaron Nola**.
 » Had his career-long walkless innings streak snapped at 46.1 innings on June 15 vs. Minnesota, after issuing a free pass in the 4th inning...streak marked the longest such run by a Tribe pitcher since **Paul Byrd's** stretch of 48.0 innings from April 26-June 6, 2007...also had his quality start streak snapped at 14, the longest streak of quality starts to begin a season by a Tribe starting pitcher since Hall-of-Famer **Stan Coveleski** began the 1918 campaign with a string of 16 consecutive quality starts.
 » From August 3, 2017 - June 15, 2018, Kluber recorded a string of 26 starts that marked the longest streak in American League history and tied with Philadelphia's **Chris Short** (also 26G from 1967-68) for the 2nd-longest such streak in the *Baseball-Reference Play Index* era (1908-), behind Chicago-NL's **Jake Arrieta** (29G from 2015-16).
 » Tossed his 16th career complete game in his first start of the year on March 29 at Seattle...marked the first Opening Day complete game by a Cleveland pitcher since **Jake Westbrook** on April 4, 2005 at Chicago-AL (1-0 loss), and the first such complete game in MLB since **Clayton Kershaw** threw a complete-game shutout on April 1, 2013 vs. **San Francisco**...struck out eight batters, the 2nd-most by a Tribe starter on Opening Day over the last 14 seasons (2005-18), behind **Justin Masterson** (10K on April 5, 2012 vs. Toronto).
