**TODAY'S GAME:** The Braves and Nationals finish a four-game series today with the 16th meeting between the teams this season...This set marks the Braves' final trip to Washington this season; they will play host to the Nationals for the final three games between the teams, September 14-16.

**A** The Braves have won the last two games of this set and go for the series win today...With a victory, the Braves can finish the season with a winning record at National Park (5-4)...After going 6-4 here last season, it would mark the first time since the park opened in 2008 that the Braves had consecutive winning seasons in Washington...They went 1-19 at Nationals Park from 2015-2016.

**A** RHP Aníbal Sánchez is set to face the Nationals for the fourth time this season...The righty beat Washington with 6.0 innings of three-run ball on July 20 here at Nationals Park, striking out eight... Sánchez is 1-0 with a 1.69 ERA (3 ER/16.0 IP) in three appearances, two starts, against Washington this season.

**A** LHP Gio Gonzalez is scheduled to face Atlanta for the second time this season...The lefty went 7.0 innings and earned a no-decision in a 5-3, 14-inning win over Atlanta on June 2 at SunTrust Park...For his career, Gonzalez is 5-11 with a 5.04 ERA (70 ER/125.0 IP) in 22 games, 22 starts.

**CULBERSON STREAKING:** INF/OF Charlie Culberson finished 2-for-4 with a three home run last night, and has now homered in three consecutive games...The is tied for the longest streak by a Braves player this season; 1B Freddie Freeman also went deep in three straight, June 10-13.

**A** The last Braves player to homer in four straight was C Brian McCann, July 5-8, 2012.

**A** The Atlanta franchise record is five, done five times and last by McCann in 2006...Chipper Jones (2004), Ozzie Virgil (1987), Jeff Burroughs (1977), and Hank Aaron (1966) also homered in five straight.

**CULBERSON VS. THE NATIONALS:** INF/OF Charlie Culberson is hitting .353 (12-for-34) with five home runs in 11 games against Washington this season... Four of those homers have come here at Nationals Park.

**A** His five home runs against the Nationals are the most any one player has hit against Washington this season.

**A** Andruw Jones hit nine against Montreal in 2004 to set the Atlanta franchise record for the most homers in a season against the Nationals/Expos.

**A** The only other Braves players to hit more than five home runs in a season against Washington/Montreal were J.D. Drew (6 in 2004) and Chipper Jones (6 in 2007)...Andruw Jones also hit eight in 2005.

**HOME RUNS:** The Braves hit three more home runs last night, and now have hit 22 in 17 games since the All-Star Game...The club hit three in the final nine games leading into the break.

**A** The Braves have hit 77 home runs on the road this season, tied for the fifth most in baseball and 10 behind the St. Louis Cardinals for the most in the National League...The Braves have hit 1.28 home runs per road game this season.

**A** At home, the Braves have 46 home runs in 51 games, good for an average of 0.90 per game...That ratio is eighth lowest in baseball.

**FREEMAN STREAKING:** 1B Freddie Freeman ran his hitting streak to 10 games last night after collecting a run-scoring single in the seventh inning...Freeman is batting .325 (13-for-40) with a .372 on-base percentage during his run that dates to July 29.

**A** Freeman is the midst of his third double-digit hitting streak of the season...He went 16 games from May 19 to June 3 and then another 10 games from June 5 to June 16.

**A** The only major leaguer with three double-digit hit streaks this season is Houston's Yuli Gurriel...He had a 13-gamer, a 12-gamer and a 11-gamer.

**A** The last Braves player with three double-digit hitting streaks in a single season was Martin Prado in 2011.

**VS. LHP:** The Braves are set to face a left-hander for the second straight game after beating Tommy Milone, 8-3, last night...The Braves are 18-17 in games started by a left-hander this season.

**A** The Braves are hitting .270 (299-for-1,109) against lefties this season, the second-best mark in baseball... Only Colorado at .271 is better.

**A** Among left-handed hitters, 1B Freddie Freeman (.327, 49-for-150) and OF Nick Markakis (.316, 48-for-152) rank second and third in baseball in batting average against left-handed pitchers...Only Milwaukee's Christian Yelich is better.

**DAY GAME:** The Braves are 23-15 (.605) in day games so far this season, the second-best record in the National League...Only Chicago is better at 35-20 (.636)

**A** OF Ronald Acuña Jr. is hitting .333 (23-for-69) with a .587 slugging percentage in daylight this season, while 2B Ozzie Albies is 51-for-158 (.323) with 10 of his 20 home runs in such games.

**DEBUTS:** Two members of the Braves bullpen are looking to make their major league debut: LHP Adam McCreery and RHP Wes Parsons.

**A** The last time the Braves had two pitchers debut in the same game was 2015, when RHP Jake Brigham and RHP Ryan Kelly combined for 4.0 innings in a 6-1 loss to Washington at Turner Field.

#### Today's Game

- A* Makes his 15th start of the season (16th appearance) and the 277th (300th appearance) of his career.
- A* Set for his 25th career start against the Nationals, and his 26th career appearance... Is 10-1 with a 2.11 ERA (36 ER/153.2 IP) in his career, including 1-0 with a 1.69 ERA (3 ER/16.0 IP) in three games (two starts) this season.
- A* His 2.11 career ERA (36 ER/153.2 IP) against the Nationals/Expos is the lowest all-time mark by a qualifying pitcher against the franchise.
- A* His .909 (10-1) winning percentage is also the best mark all-time against the Nationals/Expos (minimum 10 decisions).
- A* Last faced them on 7/20 at Nationals Park, and earned the win after allowing six hits and three runs over 6.0 innings...Fanned eight.
- A* Has completed at least 6.0 innings in each of his last six starts, five of which have been quality outings...The six-start run of at least 6.0 innings is the fifth-longest active streak in the majors and the longest by an Atlanta starter.
- A* Sánchez's current streak is tied for the longest by a Braves starter this season, matching a six-start stretch by Sean Newcomb from 4/20-5/19.
- A* Makes his fifth daytime start of the season...Is 2-1 with a 1.82 ERA (5 ER/24.2 IP) in his first four turns during the day.

#### 2018 Recap

- A* Went 4-2 with a 2.60 ERA (19 ER/65.2 IP) in 11 starts (12 appearances) for Atlanta prior to the All-Star break...Is 2-1 with a 3.93 ERA (8 ER/18.1 IP) in three starts after the break.
- A* For his career, has pitched to a 4.17 ERA in 166 appearances before the All-Star break and a 3.87 mark in 133 games after.
- A* His 2.60 ERA at the All-Star break this season was the lowest of his career... His previous best was a 2.93 ERA in 2013, when he went on the pace the American League with a 2.57 full-season mark.
- A* Allowed a season-most five runs (four earned) over 6.1 innings, 7/26 vs. LAD...Two of the five runs scored following his departure in the seventh inning.
- A* Defeated Washington, 8-5, on 7/20 at Nationals Park...Allowed six hits and three runs over 6.0 innings.
- A* Tossed just 4.2 innings, 6/26 vs. CIN, and allowed five hits and two runs to take his second consecutive loss.
- A* Was removed after throwing just 73 pitches due to cramping in his right calf.
- A* Took his first loss of the season, 6/20 at TOR...Allowed five hits and a season high-tying four runs over 5.0 innings...Set season highs in walks (4) and strikeouts (7).
- A* The loss snapped a streak of three straight wins to open the season...Opened a season 3-0 for the second time in his career...Won the first four decisions of his major league career to open his rookie campaign 4-0 in 2006.
- A* Won two consecutive starts, 6/9 at LAD (5.1 IP, 2 R) and 6/14 vs. SD (7.0 IP, 0 R)...The wins were the first of his career against each team.
- A* Entered the stretch winless against just three major league teams, all three of which played in California...Was winless against the Dodgers, Padres and Angels (0-4) before defeating Los Angeles-NL and San Diego in his last two turns.
- A* Allowed a pair of unearned runs over a season most-tying 7.0 innings, 6/3 vs. WSH...Allowed just four total baserunners.
- A* Returned from the disabled list, 5/29, and started that night vs. NYM...Allowed five hits and four runs over 4.0 innings in a no-decision.
- A* Missed 37 games after suffering a right hamstring strain on 4/18.
- A* Began a rehabilitation assignment with Triple-A Gwinnett on 5/21 and made two rehab starts with the Stripers...Combined to go 0-1 with a 10.80 ERA (8 ER/6.2 IP).
- A* Suffered a right hamstring strain during pregame warmups on 4/18 and was placed on the 10-day disabled list that night.
- A* Snapped a career-long six-game losing streak, 4/13 at CHI...Tossed 6.0 scoreless innings in the Braves' 4-0 shutout of the Cubs.
- A* Went 0-6 with a 6.51 ERA (34 ER/47.0 IP) during the losing streak, which dated to 8/6/17 at BAL and spanned 11 games (10 starts)...Received just 13 runs of support during the stretch, an average of 1.18 runs per turn.
- A* Made his first start of the season and went 5.0 innings and allowed seven hits and two runs, 4/7 at COL...Atlanta lost 3-2 in the 10th inning.
- A* Is undefeated in six career starts against the Rockies...Sánchez is one of nine pitchers in history to make at least five starts against the Rockies and log an ERA under 2.00...Only five of those pitchers -- Sánchez, Jacob deGrom, Tom Koehler, Mark Prior and Bill Swift -- have done so without taking a loss

#### Career Recap

- A* 2018 marks his 13th major league campaign...Played the first six-and-a-half seasons (2006-12) of his career with the Marlins, before spending the last five-and-a-half seasons (2012-17) with Detroit.
- A* Led the American League with a 2.57 ERA in 2013.

**Jesse Biddle • LHP • 6-5 • 220 • 26 yrs • #63**

**Saves/Opp:** 1/2 **Holds:** 6 **1st Batter/Retired:** 38/28 **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 10/3

- Over his last 29 appearances, dating to 5/19, has a 1.87 ERA (7 ER/33.2 IP) with a .158 (18-for-114) opponents' average and six holds...Six of the 29 games have spanned at least 2.0 innings.
- Converted the first save of his career, 8/5 at NYM...Joined Arodys Vizcaino, A.J. Minter, Luiz Gohara, Luke Jackson and Dan Winkler as Atlanta relievers with a save this season.
- Has gone more than 1.0 inning in 11 outings this season, compiling a 0.78 ERA (2 ER/23.0 IP) with 33 strikeouts...Two of his three wins this season have come in outings longer than 1.0 inning.
- Opponents are 3-for-27 (.111) with runners in scoring position, including 1-for-13 (.077) with two outs.
- Right-handed batters have just 13 hits in 94 at-bats (.138) against him...Lefties are hitting .258 with 16 hits (62 at-bats), however since 5/19, left-handed batters are hitting .188 (9-for-48) .
- Set career highs in IP (3.0) and strikeouts (8), 6/2 vs. WSH... Became the first Braves reliever in 110 seasons to strike out at least eight batters in that few innings...MIL's Josh Hader struck out eight in 2.2 IP, 4/30/18 at CIN.

**Brad Brach • RHP • 6-4 • 205 • 32 yrs • #46**

**Saves/Opp:** 11/13 **Holds:** 5 **1st Batter/Retired:** 46/30 **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 15/2

- Has tossed 4.0 scoreless innings with a pair of holds and five strikeouts in four games with Atlanta.
- Atlanta acquired him, 7/29, from the Baltimore Orioles in exchange for an international signing slot...Made his Braves debut, 7/30 vs. MIA, with a scoreless eighth inning to earn his fourth hold of the season.
- Went 1-2 with a 4.85 ERA (21 ER/39.0 IP) in 42 games with Baltimore, converting 11-of-13 save chances.
- Holding right-handed batters to a .284 (29-for-102) average, while lefties are hitting .316/.400/.418 in 91 plate appearances.
- Since 2015, ranked fourth in the American League with 242 appearances.
- The 32-year-old as an eight-year major league veteran, pitching to a career record of 30-21 with a 3.16 ERA (152 ER/432.1 IP) in 397 games prior to Atlanta acquiring him.

- Inherited the bases loaded and fanned the only batter he faced to earn his first hold of the season, 8/8 at WSH.
- Has struck out 33 batters in his 23.1 innings with Atlanta, and has struck out 67 batters in 44.2 combined innings (13.5 SO/9.0 IP) between the Braves and Triple-A Gwinnett.
- Has five outings of at least 2.0 innings this season, and has a 1.35 ERA (2 ER/13.1 IP) with one save in those appearances...Threw a career-most 62 pitches over 3.0 innings, 7/3 at NYY.
- Earned his first win of the season with a scoreless 11th inning, 6/25 vs. CIN...Is 3-0 in his major league career.
- Earned his first career save on 6/5 at SD.
- Signed as a major league free agent, 6/17, his fourth stint with Atlanta this season...Was with the Braves most recently from 6/5 before being DFA'd on 6/13 and outrighted to Gwinnett on 6/14...He elected free agent on 6/15...Also with Atlanta from 4/4 to 4/15 and 5/6 to 5/8.

**Saves/Opp:** 0/0 **Holds:** 0 **1st Batter/Retired:** 0/0 **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 0/0

- Recalled, 8/7, from Triple-A Gwinnett for his first stint on the active roster...His first appearance will mark his major league debut...Had his contract selected on 11/20 of last year.
- Made 35 appearances between Double-A Mississippi and Triple-A Gwinnett this season, combining to go 2-5 with a 3.75 ERA (20 ER/48.0 IP), two saves and 63 strikeouts.
- Has pitched to a 1.35 ERA (2 ER/13.1 IP) and has fanned 21 batters over his last 10 games...Was transferred to Gwinnett on 8/5.
