FISH BITES

Miami opens the month of September with game two of three against the American League's Toronto Blue Jays tonight at 7:10 p.m. LHP **Wei-Yin Chen**, making his 22nd start of the season, is facing the Blue Jays for the fifth time in his career and first time since 2014; he is 1-3 with a 5.40 ERA (21.2 ip/13 er) in his four previous starts against them. The Blue Jays are countering with RHP Marco Estrada, who is making his 11th career appearance, sixth start, against the Marlins; he is 2-2 with a 5.94 ERA (36.1/24) against the Marlins all-time. Miami returned home Wednesday after suffering a two-game sweep at the hands of the Boston Red Sox. Prior to that series, the Marlins split a six-game homestand against the Yankees (1-1) and Braves (2-2). **Programming note:** tonight's game can be heard on 610 WIOD. Additional games moving to WIOD include September 8 vs. Pittsburgh, Sept. 15 vs. Philadelphia, Sept. 22 vs. Cincinnati, and Sept. 29 vs. Mets.

LAST NIGHT'S RECAP

Dan Straily provided eight strong innings, leaving with a 5-1 lead, but Miami couldn't hold down Toronto bats as the Blue Jays came away with a 6-5 win. The Marlins broke open a scoreless game with three runs in the fourth on consecutive RBI singles by **Derek Dietrich**, **Starlin Castro**, and **JT Riddle**. Miami went up 5-0 in the fifth after RBI singles from **J.T. Realmuto** and Castro. Toronto scored its first run in the sixth, and in the ninth loaded the bases with one out and took the lead on a pinch-hit grand slam by Justin Smoak. Castro led Miami's offense with three hits, and Anderson and Dietrich both had two hits apiece. Straily allowed one run on four hits and a walk, with four strikeouts, over a season-high 8.0 innings.

TODAY'S TRANSACTIONS

The Marlins today returned from rehab and reinstated OF **Lewis Brinson** from the 10-day disabled list, reinstated INF **Martin Prado** from the 10-day DL, recalled RHP **Sandy Alcantara**, RHP **Nick Wittgren**, and C **Chad Wallach** from Triple-A New Orleans, selected the contract of RHP **Jeff Brigham** from NOLA, and placed RHP **Pablo López** on the 60-day disabled list with a right shoulder strain.

PUTTING IT TOGETHER

Over their last 15 home games since July 28, the Marlins have posted a 2.62 ERA (141.0 ip/41 er) to mark the lowest ERA among National League staffs (third in MLB) at home in that span. They have limited opponents to a .217 average against, second in the NL and sixth in the Majors. Starters have allowed three-or-fewer runs 13 times, including 10 starts of two-or-less runs allowed, and posted a 2.29 ERA (86.1/22), while the bullpen has allowed 19 earned runs over 54.2 innings pitched for a 3.13 ERA.

HOT CORNER TO THE SIX

The left side of Miami's infield has combined on a .981 fielding percentage (938 TC/18 E), the second-highest combined fielding percentage of any Major League third base/shortstop combo, behind only the Arizona Diamondbacks, who have fielded at a .982 clip (911 TC/16 E). Miami third basemen rank second in the Majors with a .978 fielding percentage (324/7), behind Arizona (.982; 329/6). Among shortstops, Miami's .982 mark ranks fourth in MLB, behind San Diego (.986; 557/8), Arizona (.983; 582/10), and the Angels (.983; 577/10).

ALL AROUND ANDY

Brian Anderson leads all Major League rookies in games (134), at-bats (514), runs (75), average with RISP (.383), and on-base percentage (.362); tied for the lead in hits (143); ranks second in doubles (30), walks (54), and multi-hit games (42); ranks third in RBI (56) and average (.278); is tied for third in triples (3); fourth in slugging (.407); and tied for 12th in HR (10). On the defensive side, he leads all rookie outfielders with a .994 fielding percentage, committing just one error in 176 total chances. He also owns eight outfield assists, most among all ML rookie outfielders and just four off the Major League lead held by Billy Hamilton.

- He is on pace for 171 hits this season, which would rank as the second-most by a National League rookie since 2008, behind Corey Seager's 193 in 2016, and would be 10th-most by an NL rookie since 2000.
- He recorded 109 hits before the All-Star break, tying Rocco Baldelli for the second-most by a Major League rookie since 2003, behind only Hideki Matsui (114 in 2003). He is the only Marlins rookie in franchise history to record 100+ hits prior to the break.
- Anderson recorded 101 hits over his first 92 games of the season. Since 1958, 34 rookies have recorded 100+ hits in 92-or-fewer games and went on to win Rookie of the Year honors, including most recently Aaron Judge (2017), Corey Seager (2016), Carlos Correa (2015), José Abreu (2014), Mike Trout (2012) and Buster Posey (2010). - *Stats LLC*

INTERLEAGUE NOTABLES

The Marlins' 192 Interleague wins all time are the tied with the Mets for second-most among National League clubs, behind only Washington (195), and they have the fifth-best winning percentage (.495; 192-196), behind St. Louis (.511; 180-172), the Mets (.507; 192-187), the Cubs (.506; 178-174), and the Dodgers (.497; 186-188). Miami's offense is the all-time leader among NL clubs in Interleague runs (1,790) and hits (3,529).

POSTSEASON IS AT HAND

Affiliate seasons are concluding and postseason accolades are starting to be handed out. The Marlins had two Southern League Postseason All-Stars announced on Monday, with **Monte Harrison** and **Brian Schales** receiving honors. And yesterday, **Luis Palacios** was named Co-Pitcher of the Year for the Dominican Summer League.

GOING GOLD

In partnership with Stand Up To Cancer (SU2C), MLB and MLB Clubs will raise awareness for the fight against childhood cancer by having Major League players, coaches, umpires and grounds crew members wear gold ribbon decals and wristbands. Childhood cancer is the leading cause of death by disease in children aged 15 and under in the United States. Every year, an estimated 300,000 new cases of cancer affect children under the age of 20 worldwide. Yesterday, Marlins outfielder **Magneuris Sierra** and several Marlins' Better Halves distributed gold caps and visited patients at Holtz Children's Hospital and alex's place at Sylvester Comprehensive Cancer Center in advance of Childhood Cancer Awareness Month, which starts today.

YEAR OF THE FAN SWEEPSTAKES

The Marlins, in partnership with AutoNation, America's largest automotive retailer, will be awarding a prize of a 24-month car lease to a select fan tonight, the 22nd of 25 dates this season where a fan will drive off with a new car. The "Marlins Year of the Fan Sweepstakes, Driven by AutoNation" is open to any eligible fan in attendance at each select home date.
