IT WAS ONLY JUST A DREAM: Last night, the Padres fell 2-1 to the visiting St. Louis Cardinals, dropping Game 1 of the four-game series...the Friars have now posted a 4-9 record in series openers and are 0-8 in series openers at home.

- Starter **Jordan Lyles** made his first start since Sept. 29, 2017 at SF after beginning this season in the bullpen...he worked 5.0 innings, his most since Sept. 22, 2017 vs. COL when he worked 6.0 IP.
- C **Raffy Lopez** belted his second homer of the season, and OF **Franchy Cordero** logged a career-high-tying three hits.

WITH GREAT LAUER COMES GREAT RESPONSIBILITY: Rookie **Eric Lauer** looks to claim his second consecutive victory after earning his first career win in his last outing on May 6 vs. LAD in Monterrey, Mexico, tossing 5.0-shutout innings behind a career-high 102 pitches and five strikeouts...with the win, he became the first and only Padre pitcher to get his first career MLB win in a game played outside the US and Canada...he was just the second starting pitcher to get such a win and the fifth pitcher (starter or reliever) to ever do so.

DID WE JUST BECOME BEST FRIENDS?: SS **Freddy Galvis** and INF/OF **Jose Pirela** are the only two players to have started 39 games, the most in the majors...Galvis also leads the majors in innings played (350.1).

RUNAWAY RAFFY NEVER GOING BACK: C **Raffy Lopez** has reached base safely via hit or walk in a career-high five straight games, slashing .267/.353/.667 with two homers.

KIRB YOUR ENTHUSIASM, I DARE YOU: Reliever **Kirby Yates** has 101 strikeouts with the Padres...he made it to the 100 strikeout mark on Wednesday vs. WSH after throwing just 66.2 innings, reaching the century strikeout mark faster than any other Padre in club history...the top three players with the fewest innings to reach the 100 strikeout mark with the Padres, all-time are Yates (66.2), **Brad Hand** (79.0 ip) and **Dinelson Lamet** (79.2 ip).

A SUBSTANTIAL INHERITANCE: The Padres bullpen has a 21.3 inherited runners scored percent (47 IR, 10 IRS), which is the second-best mark in the NL (behind none other than the STL bullpen's 20.9 percent).

TRIPLE THREAT: SD outfielders have combined to hit the most triples in the NL (seven), just shy of the most the majors (DET's eight)...**Travis Jankowski**, **Manuel Margot** and **Jose Pirela** have two, and **Hunter Renfroe** has one.

KIN OF KEN: Tonight's game continues the four-day weekend celebration of the 20th anniversary of the Padres' 1998 NL Championship team... all fans in attendance will receive a **Ken Caminiti '98** Commemorative Bobblehead, and Nicole and Lindsey Caminiti, his daughters, will throw the Ceremonial First Pitch.

KT: Tomorrow, former Padres player, scout and front office executive, **Kevin Towers**, will be posthumously inducted into the Padres Hall of Fame in a special pregame ceremony... Towers will be honored for his nearly 30 years of service with the Padres, most notably as GM of the club from 1995 to 2009...under Towers, the Padres enjoyed some of the most successful years in its history, including four NL West titles (1996, 1998, 2005 and 2006) and a NL pennant in 1998.

- **Kelley Towers**, Kevin's wife, will throw the Ceremonial First Pitch to former Padres catcher and 98' team alumni **Carlos Hernández** on Saturday.

PADRES ON DECK: Last night, LHP **Logan Allen** (5-1, 2.55 ERA) led San Antonio (AA) to their ninth straight win and allowed one run on four hit with nine strikeouts over 6.2 innings...SS **Fernando Tatis Jr.** was 2-for-4 with a double... for El Paso (AAA), RHP **Luis Perdomo** (3-1, 3.10 ERA) allowed two runs on five hits and a walk with six strikeouts in 6.0 innings...3B **Cory Spangenberg** went 3-for-4 with a double and a grand slam.

STARTING PITCHER NOTES

#46 LHP ERIC LAUER (1-1, 5.79) @e_lauer10

LAUER HOUR: 22-year-old **Eric Lauer** is set to make his fourth career start tonight and his first at Petco Park in Game 2 of this four-game set against the Cardinals.

HISTORIA: Earned his first career win in his last outing on 5/6 vs. LAD in Monterrey, Mexico, tossing 5.0-shutout innings behind a career-high 102 pitches and five strikeouts against one walk in the Padres' 3-0 victory.

- Became the first and only SD pitcher to get his first career MLB win in a game played outside the US and Canada...also just the second starting pitcher to get such a win and the fifth pitcher (starter or reliever) to do so.

PICKOFF ARTISTS: Lauer picked off Andrew McCutchen in the bottom of the third inning on 4/30 at SF...along with fellow rookie lefty **Joey Lucchesi's** three pickoffs so far this season, it's the first time the Padres have had two rookie starters combine for four-or-more pickoffs in the same season since 2009, when **Clayton Richard** and **Josh Geer** combined for six pickoffs.

- The Padres six pickoffs lead the National League and rank tied for first in the majors with the Toronto Blue Jays.

ROCKY DEBUT: Lauer made his MLB debut on 4/24 at COL, working 3.0 IP and allowing seven runs (six earned) on a rain-delayed, 37-degree evening.

- Lauer was just the 27th pitcher to make their big league debut as a starter at Coors Field...20 Rockies have made their big league debut as a starter at Coors, making Lauer just the seventh opponent to do so.
- Only one other Padre has made their ML debut at Coors (Anthony Bass on June 13, 2011)...no other visiting team has made more than one big league starting debut at Coors.

WAVES OF TALENT: Lauer became just the second pitcher of the entire 2016 draft class to make their ML debut, trailing only Lucchesi, who made his big league debut on 3/30 vs. MIL.

- Only Orioles OF **Austin Hays** made it to the show quicker than Lucchesi and Lauer...Hays made his big league debut for the Orioles on September 7, 2017.

THE GOOD ONES MOVE QUICK: The Elyria, Ohio native made just 35 appearances (34 starts) prior to his MLB debut...he has posted a 3.04 ERA (58 ER, 171.2 IP) and a 9-10 record with 188 SO against 51 walks.

- In his three starts for El Paso (AAA) this season he posted a 3.00 ERA (6 ER, 18.0 IP), including a career-high-tying 10 strikeouts on April 15 vs. Las Vegas.

TOMORROW'S STARTER

TYSON'S TURN: RHP **Tyson Ross** is scheduled to make his eighth start of the season in Game 3 of this four-game series against the Cardinals.

- Is 1-1 with a 3.00 ERA (7 ER, 21.0 IP) in his six career appearances (three quality starts) against the Cardinals... it will be his first start against St. Louis since July 2, 2015.
- Allowed a season-high five runs on six hits and three walks in his last outing on 5/7 vs. WSH, tagged with the loss in SD's 8-5 defeat.

- Snapped his career-long 9.1-scoreless inning streak on April 29 vs. NYM...it was the second-longest streak among Padres pitchers this season behind Craig Stammen's 11.1-scoreless inning streak to open the season.
- Recorded career highs in IP (2.2) and strikeouts (five) on April 11 at COL.

- Began the season with a 11.1-scoreless inning streak, the longest by a Padres reliever to start the season since Tim Stauffer tossed 15.1 consecutive scoreless innings to start the 2010 campaign.

- In nine rehab appearances (two starts) for Double-A San Antonio this season, is 1-0 with a 2.51 ERA (4 ER, 14.1 IP) with 22 strikeouts against four walks.
- Sustained a torn patellar tendon in his left knee on July 1 vs. MIN last season and underwent surgery on July 7.
- Acquired by the Padres along with LHP Travis Wood and INF Esteury Ruiz from KC in exchange for LHP Ryan Buchter and RHPs Trevor Cahill and Brandon Maurer on July 24, 2017.

- Yates has become the fastest Padre to reach 100 strikeouts...it took him only 66.2 IP to hit the century mark, 12.1 frames faster than closer Brad Hand, who held the club record previously.
- Has allowed just one earned run in his 13 appearances and 11.1 IP this season (0.79 ERA).
- Is limiting opponents to a .083 batting average (1-for-12) with runners on base and a .132 clip (5-for-38) on the season overall.
- Owns a lifetime 1.00 ERA (4 ER, 36.0 IP) in 37 games at Petco Park and has yet to allow a run in seven games and 6.1 IP at home this season.
- His hometown, Koloa, Hawai'i, was recently struck with nearly 50 inches of rain in 24 hours, flooding the Koloa community...has agreed to match up to \$5,000 to reach his \$10,000 goal to go towards the Hawaii Community Foundation and their relief efforts...donations can be made at youcaring.com/koloa.
