TRIBE TOP THREE

» **FRANCISCO LINDOR** enters play tonight with an active 11-game hit streak...he has an extra-base hit in each of his last nine contests, one shy of the club record set by him last year.

» **ANDREW MILLER** has been activated from the 10-day Disabled List after missing the last 13 games with a left hamstring strain...he is one of two pitchers in MLB this season with 10-or-more appearances and no runs allowed.

» **TREVOR BAUER** has struck out six-or-more batters in each of his first seven starts, the longest season-opening streak by a Tribe pitcher since **Sam McDowell** in 1968.

ROYAL REVIEW

» The Indians and Royals are set to square off this weekend in the second of six regular-season series between the clubs...nine of the 19 games are scheduled to be played here at Progressive Field.

» The clubs previously met this season in a three-game series in Cleveland from April 6-8, with the Tribe taking two of the three contests...the Indians won the home opener, 3-2, and lost the April 7 game, 1-0...on April 8, the Indians won in walk-off fashion, as a two-run homer by **YAN GOMES** gave Cleveland a 3-1 victory.

» Cleveland has posted a 14-8 (.636) record against the Royals since the start of 2017, as well as a mark of 57-41 (.582) since **Terry Francona** became Tribe manager in 2013...the two clubs have combined to win each of the last three A.L. Central titles.

» Dating back to August 18, 2017, the Indians have held Kansas City to two-or-fewer runs in 11 of their last 14 meetings...Cleveland has gone 11-3 in that span with a 1.71 ERA (24ER/126.0IP).

CENTRAL INTELLIGENCE

» The Tribe will begin its fourth series against a divisional opponent tonight, having gone 7-2 in their first nine games against the A.L. Central (6-1 at Progressive Field).

» **Since July 1, 2017, the Indians have posted a 38-10 record (.792) against A.L. Central teams...**in their most recent divisional series, the Tribe split a two-game set with Minnesota in Puerto Rico...the draw snapped the Indians' 14-series win streak against intra-divisional opponents, which was the longest by any team in MLB's divisional era (1969-. *STATS LLC*)...Cleveland has not lost a series against an A.L. Central team since being swept at home by the Minnesota Twins from June 23-25, 2017.

» Tribe pitching has been dominant against the A.L. Central, posting a 1.69 ERA (57ER/304.0IP) in their last 33 divisional games and allowing two-or-fewer earned runs in 26 of those contests.

» The Indians enter this series with a 1.5-game lead in the A.L. Central over second-place Minnesota (15-18)...the Tribe has spent 25 days overall in first place this season and have held the outright lead for each of the last 20 days.

WEDNESDAY'S RECAP

» The Indians snapped their four-game losing streak with a 6-2 win over the Brewers, moving the club back to .500 on the season.

» **CARLOS CARRASCO** allowed just two runs on five hits, as he tossed his MLB-high second complete game of the season...Carrasco fanned 14 batters, marking a season-high for all Indians pitchers...he also helped his cause at the plate with an RBI-single in the 9th inning, becoming the first Tribe pitcher with a hit and an RBI in his own complete game since **Gaylord Perry** did so on September 22, 1972 vs. New York-AL.

» **TYLER NAQUIN** was 2-for-4 on the afternoon and punctuated a four-run 4th inning with a three-run homer, his 2nd of the season... **FRANCISCO LINDOR** extended his hit streak to 11 games with a multi-hit effort of his own, and belted his 10th homer of 2018 with a solo shot in the 7th inning.

THEY'RE GOING THE DISTANCE

» **CARLOS CARRASCO's** complete game on Wednesday was his second of 2018 and the fourth by a Tribe pitcher this season...no other team in MLB has more than two this season, as Cleveland owns four of the 13 complete games thrown this year.

» The Indians are the fastest team to reach four complete games (36 team games) since the 2013 St. Louis Cardinals (35 games)...they are the fastest American League to do so since the 2009 Kansas City Royals (31 games; all four CGs by **Zack Greinke**).

Jonathan Laureano was 1-for-4 with a double and an RBI...Tommy DeJuneas (2.0IP, 2H, 0R, 2K) won in relief.

THIS DAY IN INDIANS HISTORY

1971: Tribe pitcher **Steve Dunning** hits a grand slam in the second inning as the Indians beat Oakland, 7-5 at Cleveland Municipal Stadium...following Dunning's blast, no American League pitcher would replicate the feat until Seattle's Félix Hernández hit a grand slam in an Interleague contest on June 23, 2008 at New York-NL...in four seasons with Cleveland (1970-1973), Dunning hit .202 (24-119) with four homers and 12 RBI.

EXTRA FRANKIE

» **FRANCISCO LINDOR** extended his hit streak to 11 games on Wednesday with a single in the top of the 5th inning...he also homered in the top of the 7th inning to notch his 10th longball of the season and his team-high 15th multi-hit game of 2018

» Lindor has also collected at least one extra-base hit in each of his last nine games, one shy of the club record in the *Baseball Reference Play Index era (1908-)*...Lindor himself holds the record, with a 10-game streak from September 7-16, 2017.

» He is now tied for the team lead in home runs with **JOSÉ RAMÍREZ**...Lindor's eight home runs since April 25 (15 games) are tied with Washington's **Matt Adams** for the most in MLB over that span...the Indians are one of just three teams in MLB boasting two players with at least 10 home runs (also Texas and Washington).

» Lindor enters play tonight ranked T4th in the American League in home runs (10), T2nd in multi-hit games (15), 6th in runs scored (28), T4th in total bases (86), T5th in extra-base hits (21) and 9th in batting average with runners in scoring position (.387).

BAUER TO THE PEOPLE

» **TREVOR BAUER** is set to make his 8th start of 2018 in the opener of this series...enters play tonight with a 2-3 record and a 2.53 ERA, posting quality starts in each of last six outings.

» Last started for the Tribe on May 5 at New York-AL, where he took the loss after allowing four runs (two earned) on two hits over 6.0 innings of work (3BB, 8K)...Bauer retired each of the first 13 batters he faced, before allowing four runs in the 5th on three walks, one hit and a two-run error.

» Bauer will be making his second start against Kansas City this season, following a start at Progressive Field on April 7...took a hard-luck loss after allowing just one run on three hits over 8.0 sharp innings (2BB, 7K) in the Tribe's 1-0 loss to the Royals...in two 2018 starts against the A.L. Central, Bauer has gone 1-1 with a 1.80 ERA (3ER/15.0IP).

» Currently ranks 8th in the American League with 54 strikeouts and 10th with 10.5 strikeouts per-9.0IP...he has struck out at least six batters in each of his first seven starts, the longest season-opening streak by an Indians pitcher since **Sam McDowell** began his 1968 campaign with seven consecutive starts of six-or-more strikeouts.

MILLER'S CROSSING

» **ANDREW MILLER** has been activated from the 10-day Disabled List after missing the past 13 games with a left hamstring strain...in a corresponding move, **TYLER OLSON** has been placed on the paternity list.

» Miller sustained the injury two pitches into his April 26 outing vs. Seattle...he has appeared in 11 games for Cleveland this season, striking out 17 batters over 10.0 scoreless innings...he is one of just two players in MLB this season with no runs allowed and at least 10 appearances (Chicago-NL's **Brian Duensing**: 16 games, 11.2IP).

» In 23 games before Miller's injury, the Cleveland bullpen posted a 2.97 ERA (3rd in American League)...in 13 games since, Tribe relievers have posted a 10.09 ERA (37ER/33.0IP).

NAQ ME PROUD

» **TYLER NAQUIN** extended his season-long hit streak to seven games on Wednesday afternoon with a three-run homer in the Tribe's four-run 4th inning...he enters play tonight one game shy of his career-long hit streak (8 games, April 16-27, 2016).

» Over the streak, Naquin is batting .409 (9-22) with a homer, a double, four RBI and five runs scored.

» His .329 (24-73) average this season leads all qualified Indians batters and ranks 10th in the American League (min. 75 PA).

GOING LONG

» Two home runs were responsible for four of the Tribe's six runs in Wednesday's win at Milwaukee...overall on the season, 84 of the Tribe's 164 runs (51.2%) this season have scored via home run.

» Cleveland's 52 home runs rank 3rd in the American League and MLB (LAA - 55 & TOR - 53)...marks the Tribe's 4th-most home runs in club history through 36 games, as well as their most since 1999, when the team had 55 longballs in its first 36 contests.

TONIGHT'S START

» The 27-year-old right-hander is due to make his eighth start of the season tonight in Cleveland's series opener vs. the Kansas City Royals...will mark his 140th career appearance and 131st start.
 » Will pitch on extended five days' rest after his most recent outing on May 5 at New York-AL...retired the first 13 batters he faced but took his third loss of the season, surrendering four runs (two earned) on two hits, with three walks and eight strikeouts over 6.0 innings.
 » **Holding opponents to a .179 batting average, which currently ranks 5th in the American League...also ranks among the A.L. leaders in strikeouts (54, 8th) and ERA (2.53, 9th).**
 » Tonight will mark his second start of the season vs. the Royals, after falling to them in his first home start of the year on April 7 (8.0IP, 3H, 1R/ER, 1HR, 2BB, 7K).
 » Owns a career 2-4 record and 3.08 ERA (22ER/64.1IP) in 11 starts against the Royals, all as a member of the Indians.
 » **Has allowed three-or-fewer runs in seven of his last eight starts vs. Kansas City, including a complete game on July 28, 2015 at Progressive Field...is 2-3 with a 2.76 ERA (15ER/49.0IP) in those starts.**

LAST TIME OUT

» Bauer took his 3rd loss of the season in his last start on May 5 at New York-AL.
 » **Retired the first 13 batters he faced** before walking three and issuing a single in a 42-pitch 5th inning...tossed 6.0 innings total, allowing four runs (two earned) on two hits, with three walks and eight strikeouts.
 » Has recorded Quality Starts in each of his last six outings...has also struck out at least six batters in each of his last 12 starts, dating back to September 4, 2017, a career-long stretch.

VS. KANSAS CITY | A.L. CENTRAL

» Bauer will make his 12th career start against Kansas City tonight...owns a career 2-4 record and 3.08 ERA (22ER/64.1IP) across his 11 prior starts.
 » His first home outing of the year on April 7 came vs. the Royals...allowed one run on three hits over 8.0 innings, with two walks and seven strikeouts but took the loss as the Tribe fell 1-0.
 » Has dropped his last two starts vs. Kansas City, earlier this season on April 7 and September 15, 2017 (5.1IP, 9H, 4R/ER, 1BB, 6K)...loss in September snapped the Indians 22-game win streak.
 » Makes his second start tonight against an American League Central divisional opponent...faced the Royals on April 7 and Detroit on April 12.
 » Is 1-1 with a 1.50 ERA (3ER/15.0IP) in his two intradivisional starts this season...owns a career 17-17 record and 4.67 ERA (154ER/297IP) in 54 games and 50 starts against the division.
 » Made 12 appearances and 11 starts against the A.L. Central in 2017, finishing the year with a 6-4 record and 4.55 ERA (31ER/61.1IP) against the division...his 13.1 innings pitched against Kansas City were his second-most vs. a divisional opponent last year, behind Minnesota (26.2).

HOMEWARD BOUND

» Makes his fifth home start of the season tonight...has compiled a 2-1 record and 1.91 ERA (6ER/28.1IP) in his four prior starts at Progressive Field.
 » **Entering tonight's game, ranks 8th in the American League in home ERA, as well as 5th with 33 strikeouts at home...**...is holding opponents to a .173 batting average at home, which ranks 6th in the A.L. (min. 3GS at home).
 » In his career is 29-21 with a 4.28 ERA (210ER/441.2IP) in 75 outings (71 starts) at home, across his time with both Cleveland and Arizona...that includes a 28-20 career record and 4.25 ERA (204ER/432.1IP) at Progressive Field.
 » Since the start of the 2015 season, Bauer's 23 home wins rank T5th in the American League and T8th in MLB, among starting pitchers in that timeframe...his 330 home strikeouts rank 5th in the A.L. and 10th in MLB.
 » In 2017, his 10-4 record and 3.93 ERA (45ER/103.0IP) at Progressive Field were markedly better than his numbers away from Cleveland (7-5, 4.54 ERA)...his 10 wins at home were tied with Corey Kluber for the team lead, and T2nd in MLB.

2017 REGULAR SEASON HIGHLIGHTS

» Had a career year in the Indians rotation last year, posting his lowest full-season ERA (4.19) while also recording career highs in wins (17), strikeouts (196), innings pitched (176.1) and strikeouts-per-9.0 innings (10.0)...also struck out six-or-more batters in 22 of his 31 starts, good for 6th in the American League...made one relief appearance, in the 8th inning of the second game of a DH on August 17 at Minnesota (0.2IP, 1H, 1K).
 » **Struck out a career-high 14 batters in 7.0 innings on May 30 vs. Oakland, equaling the highest single-game strikeout total by a Tribe starter last season.**
 » Dominated after the All-Star Break, going 10-2 with a 3.01 ERA (28ER/83.2IP) in his final 15 appearances (14 starts) of the season...his 10 second-half wins ranked T2nd in the A.L. and his 3.01 ERA ranked T5th among A.L. starters (min. 80.0IP).
 » **Won a career-best nine consecutive decisions from July 21 to September 10, spanning 11 starts...**...posted a 2.51 ERA (18ER/64.2IP) in that span...streak marked the longest by an Indians pitcher last season.

2017 POSTSEASON RECAP

» Started Games 1 & 4 for Cleveland of the 2017 ALDS against New York-AL...won the first game at home with 6.2 shutout innings (2H, 1BB, 8K)...eight strikeouts in Game 2 marked his most in a postseason start...took the loss in Game 4 in NYC after allowing four runs (all unearned) over 1.2 innings (4H, 2BB/1BB, 3K).

CAREER SNAPSHOT

» Right-hander is in his sixth season with the Indians organization after being acquired from the Arizona Diamondbacks on December 11, 2012, along with RHP Matt Albers, RHP Bryan Shaw (from Arizona) & Drew Stubbs (from Cincinnati), in a 3-team trade...at time of trade, was ranked as Arizona's No. 1 prospect by *Baseball America* and had just earned Dbacks Minor League Pitcher of the Year honors.
 » Made his Major League debut with Arizona on June 28, 2012, becoming the first player from the 2011 Draft Class to reach the Majors...did not factor into the decision after allowing two runs on five hits in 4.0 innings of work.
 » In 2017, recorded his best Major League season to date in the Tribe rotation, posting career-highs in wins (17), strikeouts (196) and innings pitched (176.1), while recording his lowest full-season ERA (4.19).
 » The 2018 season marks his eighth overall in professional baseball after being selected by Arizona in the first round of the 2011 draft out of UCLA, where he went 38-4 with a 2.36 ERA across three seasons for the Bruins...finished his college career holding a number of school records, including a Pac-10 record with 203 strikeouts in 2011.
 » The Southern California native graduated from Hart High School in Santa Clarita, the same HS that produced Kevin Millar, James Shields, Bob Walk and Todd Zeile.
