THE TWINS: The Twins have gone 1-6 through seven games on their current nine-game roadtrip, going 1-2 against the White Sox, 0-3 against the Cubs and 0-1 against the Brewers...today they will play the second of this three-game series at Milwaukee...after this series the Twins will return home for an 11-game homestand leading up to the All-Star Break...the Twins are now 15-26 on the road and are 5-15 in their last 20 road games.

TWINS SUFFER ANOTHER WALK-OFF DEFEAT: The Twins lost to the Brewers last night at Miller Park by a score of 6-5 in 10 innings...it marked their ninth walk-off defeat this season...Kyle Gibson was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing four runs (3 earned) on eight hits in 5.0 innings pitched...Robbie Grossman hit his first career grand slam in the fifth inning...Jorge Polanco made his season debut, going 0-for-4.

ROSTER MOVE: The Twins announced today that they have recalled left-handed pitcher Gabriel Moya from Triple-A Rochester...Moya, who appeared in five games earlier this season with the Twins, had recently appeared in 20 games for the Red Wings, posting a 1.64 ERA (33.0 IP, 6 ER) with three saves, nine walks and 38 strikeouts...to take the 25-man roster spot for Moya, the Twins have optioned right-handed pitcher Zack Littell to Triple-A Rochester.

IL PLAY, FOR THE RECORD: The Twins have gone 6-10 in Interleague Play this season, going 1-1 at Pittsburgh, 1-2 vs. Cincinnati, 3-1 vs. St. Louis, 1-3 vs. Milwaukee and 0-3 at Chicago...the Twins have four IL games remaining: two at Milwaukee and two vs. Pittsburgh in mid-August...they have won 16 of their last 26 vs. the NL, dating back to August 2...the Twins are 209-189 all-time in Interleague Play, tied for sixth most wins in MLB since IL began in 1997.

- ☞ Eddie Rosario is hitting .360 (36-for-100) with 10 doubles, seven home runs and 16 RBI in his last 24 games vs. NL opponents...he enters today with a 11-game hitting streak vs. NL opponents.
- ☞ Joe Mauer is hitting .320 (281-for-878) in 239 career games in IL Play, with 60 doubles, 22 home runs, 123 RBI and a .400 on-base percentage.

THE BATTLE OF I-94: The Twins are 229-220 all-time against the Brewers (games sine 1970) and have a record against them of 63-51 in Interleague Play...they have won six of their last nine vs. Milwaukee...a loss today would give the Twins their first season-series loss head-to-head since going 2-4 in 2015...the Twins are 107-117 all-time on the road against Milwaukee and 24-24 at Miller Park all-time.

- ☞ Brian Dozier is hitting .326 (44-for-135) with six doubles, seven home runs, 19 RBI, 25 runs scored and a .384 on-base percentage in 32 career games vs. Milwaukee.
- ☞ Eddie Rosario is hitting .323 (20-for-62) with six doubles, four home runs and 10 RBI in 17 career games against Milwaukee.

THE SOCIAL NETWORK: Today's game can be seen exclusively on Facebook Live...this is part of a partnership with Facebook that began with the start of the 2018 season...the agreement allows Facebook to broadcast one mid-week, afternoon MLB game per week...the broadcast team will consist of MLB Network's Scott Braun, Brewers TV man Bill Schroeder and Twins TV man LaTroy Hawkins.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 2010, Jim Thome hit career home runs 573 and 574 at Target Field vs. Tampa Bay, both off Wade Davis...his 574th moved him past Harmon Killebrew, into sole possession of 10th on baseball's all-time home run list.

BALAZOVIC NAMED MWL POW: The Midwest League and MiLB.com announced yesterday that Kernels pitcher Jordan Balazovic has been named the Midwest League Pitcher of the Week for the period ending July 1...Balazovic did not allow a hit or a run over 6.0 innings at Burlington on June 30th...he faced 21 batters in that game, striking out 10 while walking just two in an 11-3 Kernels win...he's pitched in five games for the Kernels this season, posting a 3-1 record and 2.36 ERA...in 26.2 IP, he allowed seven runs and 22 hits with seven walks and 41 strikeouts...he was selected by the Twins in the fifth round of the 2017 First Year Player Draft out of St. Martin Secondary School in Canada...Balazovic joins Alex Kirilloff as the only Kernels to earn MWL weekly honors this season.

LAST START: Odorizzi did not factor in the decision his last start on June 28 at Chicago-AL... he went 6.0 innings and did not allow a run on three hits, walked three and struck out eight...this was his longest start since May 14 vs. Seattle and his fifth start of six or more innings...has not allowed more than one run in any 6.0 inning start... the eight strikeouts were tied for second-most this season with May 3...this was his ninth start without a decision this season.

AGAINST MILWAUKEE: Odo faces the Brewers for the second time this season and just the third time in his career...earlier this year he did not factor in the decision after going 5.2 innings and allowing just one run on five hits in his start on May 20...struck out 10 in this start, a season-high...is 1-0 with a 1.42 ERA (12.2 IP, 2 ER), two walks and 15 strikeouts against the Brewers in his career...has never faced Milwaukee at Miller Park.

BREW CREW ODO: Odorizzi was originally selected by Milwaukee in the first round (32nd overall) of the 2008 First-Year Player Draft...was traded to the Kansas City Royals in a six player deal that sent himself, Lorenzo Cain, Alcides Escobar and Jeremy Jeffress to Kansas City in return for Yuniesky Betancourt, Zack Greinke and cash.

JUNE BUG: Odorizzi has not recorded a win this month and has failed to get out of the fifth inning in four of his five starts in June...is a 3-6 during June in his career with a 4.34 ERA...his 4.34 ERA, .323 OBP and .743 OPS are the highest of any month in his career...his ERA since June 1 is 5.96, ranking eighth highest in the AL during the month among starters with at least five starts.

ON THE FIRST PITCH: Through his 17 starts this season, Odorizzi has allowed a .433 (13-for-30) average on the first pitch against a batter...on the 0-0 count, four of the 11 hits have been home runs and five have been doubles...of pitchers who have faced at least 15 batters who have put the first pitch in play, his average against is tied 11th highest in the AL.

- On the contrary, when Odorizzi gets two strikes on a batter he is holding hitters to a .200 (39-for-195) average.

QUALITY NOT QUANTITY: Over his 17 starts this season, Odorizzi has averaged just over 5.01 innings/start...of starters with at least 17 starts, his 85.2 innings ranks as the fewest in MLB...his 19.1 pitches/inning ranks highest in MLB...he averages 4.37 pitches/batter faced which is most in MLB...though his starts have been on the short side, his 44 earned runs allowed ranks tied for 17th fewest in the American League among pitchers who have started at least 17 games.

PROBLEMS WITH THE LONG BALL: Last season Odorizzi gave up 30 homers in 143.1 IP...in his 28 starts he had only five outings where he did not give up at least one home run...his 1.88 HR/9.0 IP ranked fourth highest in the AL and sixth in MLB...of the 30 HR, 15 were solo shots, eight were two-run shot five three-run homers, and two grand-slams...had five multi-homer games, four of which were at home (Tropicana Field)...he was slightly better on the road than at home last season, giving up 11 homers on the road as compared to 19 at home.

STILL NEED HELP: In Odorizzi's 17 starts in 2018, the Twins offense has supplied 28 total runs, good for a run support average of 3.16 runs per game...his run support average is lowest on the team among starters with at least 12 starts, is sixth lowest in baseball and in the AL.

A BRIGHT START: Odorizzi pitched in his first career Opening Day start and first career start for the Twins...he went 6.0 innings and allowed just two hits, while not allowing a run and striking out seven...only five other times in his career has he notched seven or more strikeouts while not allowing a run in 6.0-plus innings, the first since April 8, 2015 vs. Baltimore...he became the eighth different pitcher to start Opening Day for the Twins in the last 12 seasons.

2017 RECAP:

- In his fourth full professional season, Odorizzi started 28 games and tossed 143.1 innings...with a 10-8 record, this marked his third season of a .500 or better record
- His 7.97 K/9.0 IP ranked T-2nd best in his career (other, 2015 and best, 2014 with 9.32).
- On September 23, if Odorizzi recorded nine strikeouts, a season high, while allowing just one run on three hits in 6.0 innings.

TOMORROW'S STARTER - JOSÉ BERRÍOS (SEASON: 8-6, 3.52 ERA ; CAREER: 25-21, 4.54 ERA)

Berrios will face Milwaukee for the first time in his career tomorrow...is 4-5 with a 3.62 ERA (49.2 IP, 20 ER) in Interleague play in his career...is 1-2 with a 6.75 ERA (14.2 IP, 11 ER) with eight walks and 12 strikeouts against the NL Central this season...his last start came against the Cubs and he lasted 4.1 innings and sacrificed six runs on six hits including two home runs.
