### **CLEVELAND NOTES:**

- The CLEVELAND INDIANS surrendered seven runs in the top of the 9th inning, suffering just their second loss this season when leading after 8.0 innings (also May 6 at New York-AL)...Cleveland's four-game losing streak matches its longest of 2018 (also four games, May 4-8), while the Indians now sit at 28-17 at Progressive Field.
- TREVOR BAUER did not factor into the decision, despite holding the Reds to just three hits over 8.0 shutout innings...Bauer fanned 12 batters, marking his 8th start this season with double-digit strikeouts (T2nd-most in MLB)...per STATS LLC, marked Bauer's seventh consecutive start with at least eight strikeouts and no home runs allowed, representing the 2nd-longest streak in the live-ball era (Pedro Martínez, eight starts, July 1 August 10, 2002)...Bauer remains 2-0 in Interleague play this season with a 0.44 ERA (1ER/20.2IP), tied with Tampa Bay's Blake Snell for the lowest mark in MLB (min. 20.0IP).
  - Bauer currently ranks 3rd in the American League this season with his 168 strikeouts...now sits T3rd in franchise
    history with Sam McDowell (168 in 1968) for strikeouts in the first half, trailing Bob Feller (190 in 1946) and
    another season by McDowell (183 in 1970).
- FRANCISCO LINDOR led off the bottom of the 1st with a solo homer, marking his 8th career leadoff homer...five of those eight have come this season, moving him into a tie with Boston's **Mookie Betts** and Houston's **George Springer** for the most leadoff homers in MLB this season and T2nd-most in franchise history (**Grady Sizemore** 7 in 2008)...his 24 first-half homers are the most by an MLB shortstop since Texas's **Alex Rodríguez** hit 27 in 2002.
  - Lindor continues to lead MLB with 52 extra-base hits (T1st with **José Ramírez**) and 80 runs scored this season...<u>since the first All-Star Game in 1933, he is just the 7th different player in MLB to have 50 extra-base hits and 80 runs scored before the All-Star Break...the last player to do so was **Ian Kinsler** with Texas in 2008.</u>
- JOSÉ RAMÍREZ gave the Indians a 2-0 lead in the 1st inning with his team-high 25th home run of the season...the longball made
   Ramírez the 6th different player in franchise history to hit at least 25 homers before the All-Star break, as well as the first since Travis
   Hafner (25) in 2006...Ramírez also became the 2nd Tribe batter to reach 60 RBI this season (Edwin Encarnacion 62), making
   them the first pair of Cleveland hitters with 60 first-half RBI since Victor Martínez (63) and Travis Hafner (61) in 2004...tacked on a
   double in the 8th inning to match Francisco Lindor at 52 extra-base hits, the most in Major League Baseball.
  - Tonight marked the 9th time this season that Lindor and Ramírez have homered in the same game, which marks the most of any duo in MLB this season and the most-ever by an Indians duo before the All-Star break (STATS LLC).
- TYLER NAQUIN went 2-for-4 with a double and a run scored...he is batting .293 (22-75) in 28 games at Progressive Field this season with five doubles, eight RBI and 10 runs scored.
- **JASON KIPNIS** drew a pair of walks to extend his home on-base streak to 24 games...marks the 3rd-longest active home on-base streak in MLB, behind Boston's **J.D. Martinez** (34G) and Texas's **Shin-Soo Choo** (25G).

## **CINCINNATI NOTES:**

- The CINCINNATI REDS scored seven runs in the top of the 9th inning to erase a 4-0 deficit, marking the club's largest 9th-inning deficit overcome in a win since June 30, 2006 vs. Cleveland (trailed 8-4, won 9-8)...the Reds improve to 10-2 vs. American League opponents this season, tied with Pittsburgh and Milwaukee for the most Interleague wins in MLB.
- SAL ROMANO took a no-decision, allowing four runs (three earned) on five hits over 7.1 innings of work...after allowing two runs each in the 1st and 2nd inning, Romano retired 15 batters in a row before walking **Jason Kipnis** in the bottom of the 7th...marked his first career outing vs. Cleveland, and he remains 2-1 with a 2.84 ERA (10ER/31.2IP) in five Interleague starts this season.
- **JOEY VOTTO** put the Reds ahead with a go-ahead three-run double in the top of the 9th inning...Votto is batting .444 (4-9) with the bases loaded this season, with a grand slam, a triple, two doubles and 14 RBI...his 20 RBI with two outs ranks 3rd on the Reds, behind **Eugenio Suárez** (25) and **Scooter Gennett** (24).
- EUGENIO SUÁREZ singled in the top of the 9th inning to extend his hit streak to 13 games...matches the longest streak of his MLB career, tying a similar 13-game run from June 8-23 of this season...Suárez is batting .373 (19-51) across the streak with three homers, three doubles, 11 RBI and 12 runs scored.
- **JESSE WINKER** was responsible for Cincinnati's first two times on base, drawing a walk in the 2nd inning and singling in the 5th for the Reds' first hit of the evening...the single extended his hit streak to six games, over which he is batting .474 (9-19) with three doubles, four RBI and three runs scored...his 71 hits this season rank 2nd among all N.L. rookies (MIA's **Brian Anderson** 103).
- JOSÉ PERAZA and ADAM DUVALL drove in the first three Reds runs with run-scoring pinch-hits in the 9th inning...Cincinnati's 21 RBI from pinch-hitters this season are 3rd-most in MLB.
