NEW YORK YANKEES NOTES

- The Yankees improved to 4-3 on their final regular season homestand...are 19-13 in their last 32G and 26-17 in 43G since 8/6.
 - Are 66-15 (.815) this season when scoring first.
 - Are 52-27 (.658) at Yankee Stadium in 2018, the second-best home record in the Majors (Boston, 54-21, .720)
 - Are 35G over .500, 1G under their season-high watermark of 36G over .500.
- **LHP CC Sabathia** (6.0IP, 6H, 2ER, 3BB, 5K) earned his 245th career win, tying Dennis Martinez (245) for 51st place on Baseball's all-time wins list...also marked his 128th win as a Yankee, tying Jack Chesbro (128) for 11th place on the Yankees' all-time wins list.
 - Has allowed 2R-or-fewer in seven of his last 10 starts and 12 of his last 18 starts (since 6/5).
 - With tonight's win, became the only active pitcher with at least 20 wins vs. four opponents (also 21 wins vs. Detroit; 21 vs. Kansas City; 20 vs. Minnesota).
 - Snapped a 10-start winless streak vs. the Orioles (6/5/16-8/24/18)...marked his first win vs. Baltimore since 5/4/16 at Camden Yards.
- **SS Didi Gregorius** (1-for-4, 2R, 1HR, 2RBI) hit a two-run HR in the first inning...has reached base safely in each of his last 29 games vs. the Orioles (since 10/2/16), hitting safely in 28 of those 29 games...is batting .402/.450/.684 (47-for-117) with 30R, 12 doubles, 7HR, 27RBI, 10BB, 2HP and 4SB over that span.
 - Has 5HR in his last nine games.
- **CF Aaron Hicks** (2-for-3, 4R, 1HR, 2RBI, 2BB) hit his 25th home run of the season on a two-run shot in the fourth...has 11HR in 31 games as a leadoff hitter this season...has 14HR in 100 games in all other spots.
 - Leads the Majors with 48BB since the All-Star break.
 - Tied his career high with 4R (also 8/12/15 vs. Texas).
- **2B Gleyber Torres** (1-for-3, 1R, 1RBI, 1BB, 1SB) hit an RBI single in the fourth inning...is hitting .450 (9-for-20) with 10RBI and 3BB w/ RISP since 8/19.
 - Since 8/16, is hitting .325 (38-for-117) in 33 games.
- **RF Aaron Judge** (2-for-4, 1 double, 1RBI, 1BB) has reached base safely in each of his last 31 games vs. the Orioles w/ a PA (since 9/3/16)...is one of eight players with as long an on-base streak vs. the O's over the last 25 years (since 1994)...has hit safely in his last 12 games vs. Baltimore (since 9/17/17)...is a career .336 (42-for-125) with 39R, 9 doubles, 13HR, 32RBI and 33BB in 36 games vs. the O's.
- **1B Luke Voit** (1-for-4, 2RBI) is hitting .317/.389/.634 (32-for-101) with 21R, 2 doubles, 10HR, 24RBI and 11BB in 31G since joining the Yankees on 8/2.
 - Has 7RBI in his last three games.
- **DH Andrew McCutchen** (1-for-5, 1R, 1RBI) is batting .346/.485/.692 (9-for-26) with 6R, 1 double, 1 triple, 2HR, 3RBI and 7BB in 7G this homestand.
- **RHP David Robertson** (0.1IP, 1H, 1ER, 1HR) made his 498th appearance as a Yankee, tying Whitey Ford (498) for third place on Yankees' all-time games pitched list.
- **RHP Dellin Betances** (1.0IP, 1H, 1K) recorded his fourth save of the season with a scoreless ninth inning...has recorded at least 1K in 43 consecutive games (since 5/29), the longest such streak by a reliever in AL history and the third-longest in Baseball history behind Aroldis Chapman (49) and Corey Knebel (46)...has at least 1K in 61-of-63 appearances this season.
- **Yankees batters** have hit 249HR this season, tied with the 2000 Astros (249HR) for the sixth-highest single-season HR total in Major League history...trail only the 1997 Mariners (264HR), 2005 Rangers (260HR), 2010 Blue Jays (257HR), 1996 Orioles (257HR), 2016 Orioles (253HR)...are on pace to hit 264HR (the MLB record is 264HR by Seattle in 1997).
 - Have five players with 25HR this season (Giancarlo Stanton-35HR; Didi Gregorius-27HR, Aaron Judge-26HR, Miguel Andújar-25HR, Aaron Hicks-25HR), matching their franchise record (also five players in 2009).
 - Have hit 15HR in the last 7G...have homered in 24-of-27G since 8/24 (47HR total).
 - Have hit 35HR in their last 17 home games (since 8/17), with at least 2HR in 11 of those games.
 - Have hit 26HR in 17G vs. Baltimore, including at least 1HR in each of the last 13 games.
- **Yankees starting pitchers** have allowed 2ER-or-fewer in 11 of their last 13 starts, going 6-3 with a 2.70 ERA (70.0IP, 65H, 23R/21ER, 14BB, 63K, 5HR) over the span.

BALTIMORE ORIOLES NOTES

- The Orioles started their final road trip of the season – a two city, six-game road trip – with a loss...have lost five straight *road* games (since 9/5)...are 3-7 in their last 10 games and 7-15 in their last 22 games...fell to 21-50 vs. AL East foes this season.
 - Fell to 6-11 vs. the Yankees this season...have lost five consecutive games vs. the Yankees (since 8/24)...are now 4-3 at Yankee Stadium this season and 13-24 in the Bronx since the start of the 2015 season.
- **Baltimore batters** had 3HR on the road for the first time since 8/8 at Tampa Bay (also 3HR)...their 8R are the most in a road game since 8/5 at Texas (9R)...eight-of-nine starters recorded a hit and all nine starters reached base tonight.
- **RHP Yefry Ramírez** (3.2IP, 6H, 6ER, 3BB, 3K, 2HR) took a loss in his third straight start...is winless in his last six starts, going 0-4 with a 10.13 ERA (24.0IP, 27ER) in those starts (since 7/31)...has allowed 5ER-or-more in three straight *road* starts.
 - In three starts vs. the Yankees this season, is 0-3 with a 11.37 ERA (12.2IP, 16ER).
- **RF Adam Jones** (1-for-4, 2RBI, 1K) drove in Baltimore's first two runs with a two-out single in the fifth.
- **3B Renato Núñez** (2-for-4, 2R, 1HR, 2RBI, 2K) has three straight multi-hit games *on the road* (since 9/8)...all 6HR this season have come on the road.
- **2B Jonathan Villar** (2-for-5, 1RBI, 1SB) stole his 16th base with Baltimore since being acquired on 7/31...ranks third in the Majors with 16SB since 8/1...combined with his 14SB with Milwaukee earlier this season, reached the 30SB mark for the second time in his career (also 62SB in 2016 with Milwaukee)...his 115SB since the start of 2016 are the fourth-most in the Majors (Billy Hamilton-149SB, Dee Gordon-120SB, Trea Turner-119SB, all entering tonight's play)...despite not playing in a game with the Orioles until 8/2, his 16SB with the team are the most post All-Star break stolen bases by an Oriole since 2007 (Corey Patterson-19SB; Brian Roberts-23SB).
- **CF Cedric Mullins** (2-for-4, 3R, 1BB, 1SB) scored 3R tonight, tying a career high (second time, also on 8/10/18 vs. Boston).
- **LF Joey Rickard** (1-for-2, 1BB) reached base twice tonight...snapped an 0-for-11 streak with his fifth-inning single.
- **RHP Ryan Meisinger** (2.0IP, 1BB, 2K) has not allowed a run in his last four appearances (5.2IP)...opponents are batting .105 (2-for-19) over the span.
