RECENT REDBIRDS: The Cardinals are 38-23 post All-Star Break and 39-23 under manager **Mike Shildt** since he took the post on July 15. The Cardinals have the most wins in the N.L. since the All-Star Break (38), while St. Louis .623 winning percentage ranks 4th in MLB over that period. Entering July 15, the Cardinals had T9th-most wins in the NL (47) and currently have the T4th-most wins (86) in the NL.

FLIGHT PATTERN: The Cardinals posted their 11th walk-off win yesterday, their most since 11 in 2008 and two shy of their single-season record of 13 in both 1991 & 1992...St. Louis enters play today as the N.L.'s 2nd Wild Card, 2.0 games back of Milwaukee and 1.5 games in front of Colorado...the Cardinals are currently in 3rd place in the NL Central, 4.5 games out of first place...the Cardinals have six games (MIL-3, CHI-3) remaining against teams ahead of them in the standings.

EDMUNDO SOSA RECALLED: The Cardinals announced this morning that they have recalled rookie infielder **Edmundo Sosa** from Memphis (AAA). Sosa, 22, a native of Panama City, Panama, who was signed by the Cardinals as a non-drafted free-agent in July of 2012, split the 2018 season between Springfield (AA) and Memphis (AAA). The right-handed hitting Sosa combined to hit .270 with 12 HR's, 30 doubles & 59 RBI in 123 games in the minors this season, starting games at second base, shortstop and third base. Sosa has been assigned uniform no. 63 and would become the 9th Cardinal to make a ML debut this season.

MILES MARKERS: With a win today, **Miles Mikolas** would become the first Cardinals pitcher to win 17 or more games in his first season with the team since **Darryl Kile** won 20 in his first season (2000) with the Redbirds.

EARLY BIRDS: The Cardinals are playing their 57th day game of the season this afternoon, and currently have 60 day games on their schedule...this year is the just the 2nd time since 1985 that the Cardinals will have played 60 or more day games (61 in 2003)...St. Louis is 30-26 in natural lighting this season.

FAN-TASTIC: The Cardinals have surpassed the 3 million mark in season attendance for the 15th-straight season (2004-18) and the 22nd time overall...the Cardinals, Dodgers & Yankees as the only MLB teams to have reached the 3 million mark in attendance this season.

TIE-BREAKERS: In the event of postseason tie-breakers, the Cardinals have won their season series with Los Angeles (4-3) & Colorado (5-2), lead their series with the Cubs (9-7) and are even with Milwaukee (8-8).

WINNING SEASONS: The Cardinals have posted their 11th consecutive winning season, something they'd done just once previously in franchise history, when they compiled 15 consecutive winning seasons from 1939-1953.

THE HUNT FOR A RED OCTOBER: Six of the Cardinals seven remaining games (MIL-3, at CHI-3) are against teams currently in contention for playoff positions...the Cardinals are home for four more (SF-1, MIL-3), then finish out the regular season next weekend at Wrigley Field.

POWER PLAY: St. Louis has homered in 112 of 155 games this season, going 76-36 (.679 win pct.) in those games (10-33 when not homering)...their 76 wins lead the NL & rank 5th in MLB (Yankees, 1st-85)...St. Louis' 201 HR's are 3rd in NL behind the Dodgers (222) & Brewers (203)...**HOMERS AWAY FROM HOME:** St. Louis is an NL-best 41-20 (.672) when homering on the road, and trails only Oakland (123) in road homers (122) among all Major League teams.

FARM SYSTEM: The Cardinals 492-402 (.550) overall organizational record placed them 2nd behind Tampa Bay (539-345; .604) in total wins among all minor league systems this year...Memphis (AAA) won its 2nd-consecutive Pacific Coast League title and the Triple-A National Championship Game and Peoria (A) reached the Midwest League Championship Series.

Willie McGee played four seasons (1991-95) with the Giants...was born in San Francisco...graduated from Harry Ells High School in Richmond, Calif...played college baseball at Diablo Valley College in Pleasant Hill, Calif...resides in Hercules, Calif...worked as an assistant coach for Contra Costa College in San Pablo, Calif. **Harrison Bader** hit his first MLB home run on Sept. 1, 2017 at San Francisco, a two-run blast off **Johnny Cueto**.

Tyson Ross was born in Berkeley, Calif...graduated from Bishop O'Dowd High School in Oakland in 2005...attended the University of California (2006-08), earning All-Pac-10 honors in 2007-08...left Cal ranked third on the Bears' career strikeout list (271)...resides in Oakland, Calif.

Bud Norris was born in Greenbrae, Calif...graduated from San Marin High School in Novato, Calif...played college baseball at Cal Poly, San Luis Obispo.

Adam Wainwright homered on the first pitch of his first career at-bat (May 24, 2006) at AT&T Park, a solo homer off **Noah Lowry**.

Jack Flaherty made his MLB debut (Sept. 1, 2017) at San Francisco...became the 15th youngest Cardinal to make MLB debut in a start at 21 years and 321 days old.

Giants catcher/infielder **Aramis Garcia** was originally selected by the Cardinals in the 20th round of the 2011 MLB Draft out of Pembroke Pines (Fla.) High School, but did not sign.

Giants pitcher **Pierce Johnson** pitched three seasons at Missouri State University (2010-12).

Giants VP of Player Development **David Bell** previously served as a Cardinals assistant hitting coach (2014) and bench coach (2015-17)...played parts of four seasons with St. Louis (1995-98)...traded by Cleveland with catcher **Pepe McNeal** and pitcher **Rick Heiser** to the Cardinals for pitcher **Ken Hill** (July 27, 1995).

Giants Coach & Video Replay Analyst **Shawon Dunston** played parts of two seasons with St. Louis (1999-2000)...signed with the Cardinals as a free agent twice, sandwiched around being traded by St. Louis to the Mets for utilityman **Craig Paquette** (July 31, 1999).

Cardinals Hall of Famer and Giants Outfielder & Baserunning Coordinator **Vince Coleman** played six seasons with St. Louis (1985-90)...was a two-time NL All-Star (1988-89) and the 1985 Rookie of the Year...led the NL in stolen bases in all six seasons...selected by St. Louis in the 10th round of the 1982 MLB Draft.

Giants Community Ambassador and Hall of Famer **Orlando Cepeda** played parts of three seasons with St. Louis (1966-68)...in 1967 with St. Louis, started at first base for the NL in the All-Star Game, recognized as the NL MVP and won the World Series...later traded by the Cardinals to Atlanta for catcher/infielder **Joe Torre** (March 17, 1969).

Giants Special Assistant **Will Clark** played part of his final professional season with St. Louis in 2000...slashed .345/.441/.621 in eight Postseason games with St. Louis...became a Cardinal via trade with Baltimore with cash in exchange for infielder **José León** (July 31, 2000).

Arizona Giants #1 Pitching Coach **Lee Smith** pitched for the Cardinals for parts of four seasons (1990-93)...was two-time NL All-Star (1991-92)...became all-time career saves leader with St. Louis (April 13, 1993)...became a Cardinal via trade with the Red Sox for outfielder **Tom Brunansky** (May 4, 1990)...later traded to the Yankees for pitcher **Rich Batchelor** (August 31, 1993).

Cardinals broadcaster **Bengie Molina** played parts of four seasons with the Giants (2007-10).

TODAY'S GAME

- Makes his 31st start of the season (41st career start) and 68th career appearance.
- Is 3rd in NL (Jacob deGrom, 14.8) in fewest pitches per inning (15.1), the lowest average by Cardinals pitcher since John Lackey (14.3 in 2015).
- Trying to become first Cardinal to post 17 wins in the team's first 156 games since Michael Wacha (17 in 2015) and the first to do so in his first season with the Redbirds since Darryl Kile (19) in 2000.
- Leads the National League in fewest walks/9 IP (1.41). The last Cardinal to lead the NL in walks/9 IP was Joel Piñeiro (1.14) in 2009. Has issued one or fewer walks in NL-leading 23 starts and no walks in 10 starts (T3rd in NL).
- Ranks among NL leaders in wins (16, T3rd), winning pct. (.800, 1st), ERA (3.01, 6th), innings pitched (185.2, 7th), WHIP (1.12, 7th), strikeout/walk ratio (4.55, 5th), baserunners/9 IP (10.42, 7th), HR/9 IP (0.73, 5th), ground ball pct (51.1, 3rd), OPP SLG (.361, 9th) and quality starts (18, T9th).
- Has limited the opposition to 3 runs or fewer in 13 of last 16 starts (2 or fewer in 12).
- Limiting opposing right-handers to a .271 opponent slugging pct, 3th-lowest in the NL and currently 7th-lowest in Cardinals single-season history...Jose DeLeon's .240 from 1989 ranks 1st.
- Pitched 7.0 or more innings in 10 starts (7th in NL) and at least 6.0 innings in 22 of his 30 starts this season (T8th NL).
- 19 of his 67 runs (28%) allowed have come in the 4th inning (5.40 ERA).
- Sports a 16-0 record with six no-decisions (St. Louis is 21-3) when receiving two or more runs of support in a start.
- Ranks 3rd in the National League in home ERA (2.23). All four of his losses this season have come at home, despite allowing three runs or fewer in all four defeats.

LAST TIME OUT

- Picked up his team-leading 16th win of the season in St. Louis' 11-6 win at Atlanta in last Monday's series opener at SunTrust Park.
- Became the first Cardinal to win 16 or more games in his first season with St. Louis since Mark Mulder won 16 games in 2005.

- Was the first Cardinals starting pitcher in franchise history to earn an All-Star nod in his first season after signing as a free agent and the only non-rookie player selected this season who didn't play in the Majors last year.
