FISH BITES

The Marlins continue a 10-game, 11-day road swing with the middle game of this three-game set against the Arizona Diamondbacks tonight at 7:10 p.m. LHP **Caleb Smith**, making his 12th start of the season, is facing Arizona for the first time. The Diamondbacks are countering with RHP Zack Greinke, who in 10 previous appearances (nine starts) against the Marlins has gone 5-0 with a 3.77 ERA (59.2 ip/25 er). Miami came into their current trip off a three-game homestand against the Nationals (0-3). Prior to that series, Miami completed a six-game road trip, going 1-2 against Atlanta and 2-1 against the Mets. This trip, which started in San Diego (1-3), will also see Miami in Arizona (0-1) and St. Louis (3G). The Marlins have gone 15-20 since April 24, after beginning the season 5-17. The Club has won eight of their last 19 road games after starting the year 2-8 away from Miami. The Marlins are in a stretch that will see them play 49 games in 52 days from May 25 to the All-Star Break.

LAST NIGHT'S RECAP

Miami fell behind early and managed just one run in a 9-1 loss to the Diamondbacks. The Marlins lone run came in the seventh, when **Lewis Brinson** singled home **Derek Dietrich**. Dietrich paced the offense, marking his second consecutive three-hit game. **Elieser Hernandez** started for Miami and took the loss, surrendering five runs on five hits with two walks and one strikeout over 3.0 innings. Marlins pitchers allowed six home runs, equaling a Franchise record last done on July 4, 2008 at Colorado.

DOUBLE THREE

Derek Dietrich tallied a career high-tying three hits last night, marking his second consecutive game with three hits. He is the first Marlins player to record consecutive three-hit games this season, and first since J.T. Realmuto from September 19-22, 2017. Dietrich has four three-hit games this season, tied for the most on the Club with Starlin Castro, Realmuto, and Miguel Rojas. - *Stats LLC*

vs. THE D-BACKS

The Marlins won the 2017 series, 4-3, despite dropping two of three in Phoenix. The Marlins are just 26-44 in the Valley of the Sun, and trail the all-time series, 63-80. These two teams will meet again later this month in Miami, from June 25-28.

TODAY'S TRANSACTION

The Marlins today placed RHP **Nick Wittgren** on the 10-day disabled list (retro to June 1) with a right middle finger contusion, and recalled RHP **Tyler Cloyd** from Triple-A New Orleans. In five appearances with Miami this season, Cloyd has no record and 10.80 ERA (13.1 ip/16 er). In two starts with the Baby Cakes, Cloyd has gone 0-1 with a 6.55 ERA (11.0/8).

CLOCKING IN, PUNCHING OUT

Caleb Smith leads all Major League rookies in strikeouts with 69, ahead of Cincinnati's Tyler Mahle (61), and ranks 12th in the NL overall. He ranks fifth in the National League and 12th in the Majors (min. 10 GS) with a strikeout rate of 29.9% (69/231). He trails Max Scherzer (38.7), Patrick Corbin (33.1), Jacob deGrom (32.8), and Kenta Maeda (30.3) in the NL. He owns a swing/miss percentage of 22.2%, fifth-best in the NL (eighth in MLB), behind Scherzer (26.9), deGrom (25.9), Luis Castillo (23.5), and Vince Velasquez (22.5) in the NL.

TOUGH TO HIT

Among National League starters, **Caleb Smith** (6.23) ranks fourth in hits/9.0, behind Max Scherzer (5.54), Carlos Martinez (5.76), and Patrick Corbin (6.09). He is limiting right-handed hitters to a .155 average (22x142), the fourth-lowest average against in the NL (sixth in MLB) behind Josh Hader (.110), Scherzer (.148), and Tyson Ross (.154). In addition, he has limited opponents to a .152 slugging percentage when going through a lineup for the third time this season, the lowest among qualified Major League starting pitchers.

GETTING ON

Out of 57 games played, **Brian Anderson** has reached base safely in 47. He is tied with Bryce Harper for ninth among National League hitters in games safely reaching base, and leads all NL rookies. Freddie Freeman has reached safely in 53 games, followed by Nick Markakis (51), Joey Votto (49), Odúbel Herrera (49), Cesar Hernández (49), Nolan Arenado (49), Trea Turner (48), and Charlie Blackmon (48).

ROOKIE LEADER

Brian Anderson has appeared in all 57 games for the Marlins this season - the only rookie to appear in each of his team's games in 2018. Anderson leads all qualified Major League rookies in games, at-bats (213), runs (30), hits (60), and on-base percentage (.357); tied for the lead in multi-hit games (17); ranks second in average (.282), walks (20), and doubles (13); is tied for third in RBI (24); and fourth in slugging percentage (.380).

- Is tied for second among National League players 25-younger in hits with Trea Turner, behind Ozzie Albies (67).
- Owns three outfield assists in 29 G in RF - his first action at the position in his professional career. Is tied with Cincinnati's Jesse Winker for most assists among MLB rookies.
- His three assists are the most by a Marlins rookie since Marcell Ozuna (8) and Jake Marisnick (5) in 2013.
- Is on pace to record 103 hits before the All-Star Break, which would be the most ever recorded by a Marlins rookie. Alex Gonzalez currently holds the Franchise record with 99 in 1999, while Gaby Sanchez ranks second with 95 in 2010. He is also on pace to record 41 first-half RBI, which would be the sixth-most by a Marlins rookie.

HITTING THE ROAD

J.T. Realmuto is a career .316 hitter on the road, and owns a .330 road avg. (212x643) since 2016, fourth-highest in the Majors over the stretch behind only Houston's Jose Altuve (.382; 283x740), Washington's Daniel Murphy (.337; 187x555) and Cincinnati's Joey Votto (.330; 225x681). As a team, the Marlins have posted the Majors best road average since 2014 with a mark of .260; Kansas City ranks second (.259) and Detroit third (.259).

DRAFT INFO

The 2018 Major League Baseball First-Year Player Draft will take place from June 4-6. Miami will have three selections on the Opening Day of the draft (7:00 p.m., ET, MLB Network & MLB.com), beginning with the 13th overall pick in Round 1. The Marlins will follow in Round 2 with the 53rd overall selection, followed by the first Comp B selection (69th overall) to finish Day 1. Miami holds four picks in the first three rounds of the Draft, tied for the second-most among NL clubs, behind only the Cubs (5). The intervals between selections during round one will last four minutes, followed by one-minute intervals between selections for the remainder of day one. The Draft will resume at 1:00 p.m. (ET) on Tuesday, June 5th, when selections will be made for rounds 3-10, with one minute intervals between selections. Day three of the Draft on Wednesday, June 6th will begin at 12:00 p.m. (ET), featuring picks in rounds 11-40, with no time delay between selections.

Caleb Smith is making his 12th start of the season tonight when the Marlins play the middle game of this three-game series at Chase Field against the D-backs. It will be his first career appearance against Arizona.

Made first career Opening Day roster after going 0-2 with 5.21 ERA (19.0 ip/11 er) in six Spring outings (two starts). Acquired by Miami this offseason, along with INF Garrett Cooper on November 20, from Yankees.

Among pitchers with at least 11 starts, ranks fourth in National League (10th in MLB) with a strikeout rate of 29.9% (69/231). He trails only Max Scherzer (38.7), Patrick Corbin (33.1), and Jacob deGrom (32.8) in the NL.

Also among pitchers with at least 11 starts, ranks third in the NL (seventh in MLB) in hits allowed per 9.0 innings (6.23). Trails only Scherzer (5.54) and Corbin (6.09) in NL. Only José Fernández (5.79) had a better mark for a rookie in Club history (min. 1.0 IP per team game).

Over last seven starts, has gone 4-3 with a 2.21 ERA (40.2 ip/10 er), striking out 47 (10.40 per 9.0). Opponents are batting just .164 (23x140) against him in that time, the lowest mark among NL starters over that span (since April 22, min. 37.0 IP).

Has allowed three-or-fewer runs in nine of his 11 starts this season, and two-or-fewer in six of his last seven, including two games with zero runs allowed (over 7.0 ip on April 29 vs. COL, and over 5.2 ip on May 5 at CIN).

Has five starts with one-or-zero runs allowed, tied for 8th in NL, behind leaders Mike Foltyniewicz and Jacob deGrom (8 each).

Leads all MLB rookies in strikeouts (69), ahead of Tyler Mahle (61) and Shohei Ohtani (57).

Is receiving just 3.20 runs of support during his outings, fifth-lowest mark among National League starters (min. 11 GS). Only teammate José Ureña (2.86), Alex Wood (3.03), Clayton Richard (3.16), and Homer Bailey (3.19) are receiving less run support.

Earned first Major League win on April 29 vs. Colorado. Held Rox scoreless on two hits and a walk, while striking out nine, over a career-best 7.0 innings.

Had a solid outing on April 22 at Milwaukee, despite taking a loss. Limited Brewers to two hits and two runs over 6.0 innings (a career high until his next start), with no walks and a career-high 10 strikeouts. Became 10th Marlins pitcher (17th time) to record as many as 10 strikeouts in a game without issuing a walk, following Dan Straily a year to the day on April 22 at San Diego (14 SO). April 22 was also witness to another such occurrence; José Fernández struck out 14 Braves at Turner Field in 2014.

In first start of season, March 30 vs. Cubs, allowed just one run and four hits with three walks and eight strikeouts over 5.1 innings. Established single-game career highs in innings and strikeouts. Contest went 17 innings, tied for third-longest game by inning in Marlins history.

In fifth professional season in 2017, made combined 28 appearances between three levels in Yankees organization, going 9-2 with 3.24 ERA (119.1 ip/43 er). Opened season with one relief appearance for Double-A Trenton, on April 9, allowing one run and three walks while striking out five over 2.2 innings.

Promoted to Triple-A Scranton/Wilkes-Barre on April 13. Entered rotation for RailRiders and went 8-0 with a 2.07 ERA (87.0 ip/20 er) in 16 appearances (15 starts), including a 7.0-inning complete-game shutout on June 18 at Buffalo, allowing just one hit and two walks, with seven strikeouts.

Earned International League Midseason All-Star honors after leading International League starters in average against (.205), ranking second in ERA (2.20), and third in WHIP (1.02) in first half.

Dan Straily is slated to start the finale of this three-game set tomorrow afternoon at Chase Field. It will mark just his third career start and appearance against the D-backs.

Combined to post 17 strikeouts in 12.0 innings over his two previous starts against Arizona: on July 22, 2016 at Cincinnati (W, 6.0 ip, 8 so), and September 24, 2017 for the Marlins here in Phoenix (ND, 6.0 ip, 9 so). Combined for a 2.25 ERA in those starts (3 er).

Miami had won his first five starts of the season before he suffered a 9-5 loss to the Padres in his last outing, in San Diego on May 29 (5.2 ip, 7 h, 5 r, 4 er, 4 so, hr).

However, did not walk a batter against the Friars, snapping a career-long streak of seven consecutive starts (since September 18, 2017) in which he issued three-or-more free passes.

Allowed four earned runs in his season debut on April 30, but has allowed two-or-fewer in four of his five starts since, posting a 2.93 ERA (27.2 ip/9 er) over that span.

Has held opponents to a .224 average (26x116) with 12 extra-base hits (6 2B, 6 HR) this year, with 23 strikeouts (6.54 per 9.0), but has also issued 17 walks (4.83 per 9.0).
