SAN DIEGO NOTES

- The Padres allowed 19 hits in today's game, the most hits the pitching staff has given up since July 19 at COL, when they gave up 21...the 14 runs given up are also the most the club has allowed since Sept. 16, 2017 at COL (16 runs).
 - The bullpen surrendered three home runs, the most the bullpen has combined to allow in a game this season...the last time they gave up three-or-more home runs was on Sept. 12, 2017 at MIN.
- Bryan Mitchell** tallied five strikeouts, tying his career-high (2x, last: Aug. 11, 2015 at CLE)...has a 16.50 ERA in the first inning this season (11 ER, 6.0 IP) and a 4.33 opponent average...after the first inning, he has a 3.42 ERA (9 ER, 23.2 IP).
- A.J. Ellis** logged his first multi-hit game of the season...is riding a five-game hitting streak against NYM, going 6-for-18 (.33) with a homer and two RBI.
- Christian Villanueva** had his 11-game hitting streak snapped...his streak was the longest by a Padres rookie since Jesus Guzman, who hit in 12 straight games from July 30-Aug. 11, 2011.
- Eric Hosmer** recorded his first three-hit game of the season...his 11 multi-hit games lead the team.
- Travis Jankowski** made his first Major League plate appearance of the season after being recalled today from Triple-A El Paso.
- Manuel Margot** is riding a six-game hitting streak against NYM (all at Petco Park), going 14-for-26 (.538).
- Freddy Galvis** is batting .400 (16-for-40) in his last 12 career games against NYM.
 - Galvis and COL's Trevor Story lead all major league shortstops in games played (28) his 261.2 innings played lead all shortstops.

NEW YORK NOTES

- Today's game was just the second time since 2016 in which the Mets have scored five-or-more runs in consecutive innings...the last time this occurred was on Sept. 25, 2016 vs. PHI (scored six and five runs in the seventh and eighth inning).
- The Mets tallied three stolen bases in an inning for the first time this season...the club did so just once last season on Aug. 25 at WSH.
- Zack Wheeler** recorded a season-high nine strikeouts in today's game...made his fourth career start vs. the Padres and first since July 20, 2014.
- Adrian Gonzalez** logged a season-high five RBI...the last time he had five-or-more RBI in a game was Aug. 22, 2016 (eight RBI)...is batting .317 (108-for-341) with 22 doubles, 19 home runs, 67 RBI and 52 runs scored in 93 games vs. his former team.
- Paul Sewald** made his fifth career plate appearance in today's game and hit his first career sacrifice bunt.
- Yoenis Cespedes** logged his first stolen base of the season...exited today's game with a sore left thumb.
- Jose Reyes** went 2-for-5 with a homer, an RBI and three runs scored.
- Tomas Nido** recorded his first career multi-hit game.
