### MARLINS MINUTE

Miami is playing the final game of this three-game series at the Mets, which is their final game of the 2018 season. Were swept in Washington on the first leg of this final road trip of the season, Monday-Wednesday. Miami is finishing up a 2018 campaign that saw them play the sixth-hardest schedule in the Majors, with opponents combining on a .512 winning percentage. Baltimore played the toughest (.529), followed by Texas (.520), Cincinnati (.515), San Diego (.515), and the Angels (.514).

- **RHP Sandy Alcantara** is making his sixth start of the season and his career today. Is his third start against the Mets, combining to allow just three runs in 12.0 ip in the previous two outings. Will oppose RHP Noah Syndergaard, who is undefeated in seven career starts against the Marlins (5-0, 1.96 era).

### YESTERDAY'S RECAP

The Marlins fell in 13 innings at Citi Field, 1-0. **RHP Trevor Richards** tossed 6.2 scoreless innings in his final start of the year, holding the Mets to six hits and two walks while striking out eight batters. Was his second straight scoreless outing, ending the year with a 15.2 scoreless inning streak. **2B Starlin Castro** (2x4) had Miami's lone multi-hit effort.

### JOSÉ'S HOT HAND

With Friday's win, **José Ureña** went undefeated in his last seven starts of the season, dating back to August 19. Went 6-0 with a 1.80 ERA (45.0 ip/9 er) and 26 strikeouts, holding opponents to a .176 batting average over the stretch. Among Major League starters (min. 37.0 ip), his ERA is tied for sixth-lowest since Aug. 19.

- Finished September 5-0 with a 1.20 ERA (30.0/4). Became the fourth Marlins pitcher to win five games in the month of September, joining Pat Rapp in 1995 (5-0), Aníbal Sánchez in 2006 (5-1), and Javier Vázquez in 2011 (5-0).
- His six-game winning streak to close the year is his longest career winning streak and the longest by a Marlins pitcher since José Fernández won eight straight from April 28-June 5, 2016. It is tied for the third-longest active streak in the NL.
- Went 9-5 with a 3.70 ERA (116.2/48) over his final 21 starts of the season after opening the year 0-7 with a 4.55 ERA (57.1/29) over his first 10 starts.

### MISSED IT BY THAT MUCH

Last night's 1-0 loss at Citi Field was the 43rd 1-0 loss in Franchise history and third this season. Have had six such losses against the Mets, their most against any opponent. It marked the third time the Marlins suffered a 1-0 loss in extra innings - with both other times coming in 2013: Sept. 15, 2013 at Citi Field (12 innings) and July 21, 2013 at Milwaukee.

- The Marlins fell to 9-6 in extra-inning games this season; was just the second extra-inning game on the road in 2018 (also Aug. 18 at Washington, 7-5 win). Marks Miami's most extra-inning games since 2014 (21).

### OH BOY, O'BRIEN!

Hialeah, Fla., native **Peter O'Brien** has reached base safely in 14 of his last 16 games, with hits in 11 of the contests. Has posted a .333 batting average (17x51) with four doubles, four home runs, 10 RBI and seven walks over the 16-game span since September 13. His .565 slugging percentage in September is 10th highest in the National League.

### ALL AROUND ANDY

**Brian Anderson** leads all Major League rookies in games (156), at-bats (590), runs (87), on-base percentage (.357), and average with RISP (.367); ranks second in hits (161), doubles (34), walks (62) and multi-hit games (46); ranks third in average (.273) and slugging (.400); ranks tied for fourth in triples (4); and ranks fifth in RBI (65).

- His 161 hits are the most by a Marlins rookie since Chris Coghlan in 2009 (162) and are tied with Mark Kotsay (1998) for the fourth most ever by a Marlins rookie. Only Hanley Ramirez (185 in 2006), Jeff Conine (174 in 1993) and Dan Uggla (172 in 2006) had more hits in their rookie season with the Club.
- His 87 runs are the third-most all time among Marlins rookies behind Hanley Ramirez (119 in 2006) and Dan Uggla (105 in 2006); His average with RISP is currently tied with Kevin Millar (.367 in 1999) as the second-best by a Marlins rookie in Club history, behind Miguel Cabrera (.375; 2003).

### AGAINST THE METS

Miami is returning to Citi Field for the second time in the last two weeks for this three-game series to close out the season. Miami is 7-11 vs. the Mets this season, but have gone 7-7 after the starting the year 0-4. Are 4-5 in Queens, taking two of three May 21-23 and dropping three of four Sept. 11-13. Are looking to record their second straight on-losing road season series (went 5-4 at Citi Field in 2017). The Marlins are 99-118 all-time in New York, 41-51 at Citi Field, and trail the all-time series 205-226.

### SIX F'S OF FIELDING

The Marlins have committed just 83 errors this season, fifth fewest among NL clubs. Marks the fourth-fewest errors in Club history. Only the 2017 (73), 2015 (77) and 2003 (78) teams committed fewer errors. Miami's current .9857 fielding percentage is fifth highest in the NL and would go down as the fifth-highest in Franchise history, behind 2017 (.988), 2015 (.987), 2003 (.987), and 2013 (.986).

### CAUGHT RED HANDED

Miami catchers have caught 41.2% of attempted base stealers this season, the highest such percentage in the NL and second in the Majors to the Angels (41.8%). Is their fourth-highest caught stealing percentage in Franchise history, trailing the 1994 (46.8), 1997 (42.4) and 1999 (41.6) squads. Marlins catchers have combined to catch 32 runners attempting to steal a base this season, tied with Washington for fourth most among NL teams, and three shy of the Brewers' league lead (35).

### FINISHING ONE SHORT

The Marlins' postponed game against Pittsburgh - originally scheduled to be played on Oct. 1 at PNC Field - has been canceled and will not be made up. This season will mark the fourth time the Marlins will only play 161 games in a season (also 2000, 2008 and 2016).

Sandy Alcantara, recalled on September 1, is making his sixth and final start with Miami this season on Closing Day at Citi Field. In 19 starts at Triple-A New Orleans, posted 6-3 record and 3.89 ERA (115.2 ip/50 er). Also had three rehab starts at Single-A Jupiter, where he had no record and a 3.97 ERA (11.1/5).

Made season debut with Miami on June 29, making his first Major League start against the Mets at Marlins Park. Allowed just one run on three hits with five walks and two strikeouts over 5.0 innings.

The night after his debut, Pablo López made his first career Major League start and also earned a win. The pair became the first set of teammates to earn wins in their first career starts in consecutive days since April 9-10, 2012, when Yu Darvish and Neftali Feliz each made their first career starts with the Rangers. The last National League team to have such a duo was the Reds on April 15-16, 1967 with Gary Nolan and Mel Queen. - *Stats LLC*

Made one start before being placed on the 10-day disabled list with a right axillary infection on July 4 (retro to July 1). Made three rehab starts at Single-A Jupiter, allowing six runs (five earned) over 11.1 innings before being reinstated and optioned to NOLA on August 6.

In September 5 start vs. Philadelphia, held Phillies scoreless on three hits and two walks, while striking out six, over a career-high 7.0 innings. According to the *Elias Sports Bureau*, he is just the seventh pitcher in Marlins' history to allow up to one run over his first two career starts, the third this season. The others were: Andy Larkin (1996-1998); Tommy Phelps (2003); Alex Sanabia (2012); José Fernández (2013); **Jarlin García** (2018); and **Eliesser Hernandez** (2018).

Surrendered just two runs over 7.0 innings on September 13 at Citi Field against the Mets. Allowed two hits and three walks, while tying a career best with six strikeouts. Surrendered just eight hits over his first three career starts, marking the second-fewest in Marlins history, trailing only **Jarlin García**, who allowed just five over his first three earlier this season.

On September 18 vs. Washington, took first career loss after allowing three runs on six hits with a career-high six walks and three strikeouts over 4.0 innings. With six hits allowed, surrendered a total of 14 hits over his first four career starts, equaling Sean West and Josh Beckett for the third fewest hits allowed in first four career starts. **Jarlin García** holds the record for fewest hits allowed by a Marlins starter over his first four career starts (10), in front of Brad Hand (13). - *Elias*

With New Orleans, reached 6.0-innings pitched in 12 of his 19 starts, including six of 7.0-or-more. Tossed season-high 8.0 innings on May 17 vs. Round Rock, limiting Express to two runs on five hits.

At the time of his most recent promotion, ranked seventh in the Pacific Coast League in ERA (3.89). Among PCL leaders, ranked second in average against (.246), third in WHIP (1.25), and fewest baserunners per 9.0 (11.67).
