**THE GIANTS:** Enter today's game having lost three of their last four games and seven of their last 12...the Giants need a victory today to avoid a four-game season series sweep against Houston.

**INSIDE THE SERIES:** Beginning with the 2009 season, the Giants have gone 13-6 (.684) against Houston here in San Francisco, holding the Astros to two runs or fewer in 12 of the 19 games.

**TODAY'S STARTER:** LHP Madison Bumgarner is 2-1 with a 2.74 ERA (7er, 23.0ip) in his past four starts...he's 4-1 with a 2.45 ERA (10er, 36.2ip) over five career starts against the Astros...the last time he faced Houston was in 2015 during which he threw a complete-game with 12 strikeouts.

**BACK AT .500:** The Giants have hovered around the .500 mark all year and are back at .500 with last night's 3-1 defeat...the Giants have spent a total of 67 days either one game below .500, even at .500 or a game above .500, the most of any team this year...according to Stats, LLC., the 67 days are the third-most by the club since moving to San Francisco in 1958, and the most since having a franchise-record 80 such days in 2006...the Giants lead MLB this season with 21 days at .500.

**IN THE 'PEN:** Despite allowing three runs last night, the Giants' bullpen still ranks third in the National League with an ERA of 3.51...only the Diamondbacks (3.04) and Cubs (3.33) have a lower bullpen ERA than San Francisco...in fact, beginning June 1, SF's bullpen ERA of 2.75 is the lowest in the Majors.

**SOLID PITCHING:** Beginning June 1, Giants' pitchers have posted a 3.36 ERA, which ranks as the second-best figure in the Majors over that span, behind the Boston Red Sox (3.28 ERA).

**HOMERS ALLOWED:** Giants pitchers have allowed the second-fewest home runs this season, having allowed 105 homers in 114 games (Cardinals have given up 102 HRs)...of those 105 homers, 43 have come here at AT&T Park.

**IN NEED OF CLUTCH HITS:** San Francisco is hitting .204 with runners in scoring position and two outs this season, which ranks as the lowest figure in the National League and the third-lowest in the Majors (Rangers, .189 & Orioles, .191).

**GIANTS AT HOME:** SF has lost six of their last seven games here at AT&T Park.

**ON THE FARM:** C **Joey Bart** was named the Northwest League's Player of the Month for July after batting .333 and leading the Northwest League in home runs (nine), RBI (24), extra-base hits (18), total bases (65), slugging pct. (.747) and OPS (1.126)...he posted a 10-game hitting streak from July 8-19.

**ON DECK:** The Giants will enjoy their sixth home off day tomorrow before facing the Pittsburgh Pirates for a four-game series starting Thursday night...the Giants have lost 12 of their last 17 games to the Pirates here at AT&T Park.

**Barry Bonds** hit his 756th home run, breaking Hank Aaron's record...the decisive blow came off Washington's Mike Bacsik Jr...Bonds finished the day going 3-for-3 with three runs scored but the Giants lost 8-6.

• The four-time All-Star (2013-16) takes the hill today for his 12th start of the season...the Giants are 5-6 in his outings this year, going 4-2 here at home.

• Needs just one more win for sole possession of fourth-place on the SF-era wins list (see chart on right).

• Earned his fourth win of the season in his last outing on Thursday at Arizona in San Francisco's 8-1 victory... Bumgarner put 10 runners on base in just 5.0 innings, but stranded nine of them...he outdueled Zack Greinke, who had been named NL Pitcher of the Month for July earlier in the day.

• Is averaging 3.65 walks per 9.0 innings, the highest average of his career.

• For the season, opponents are 7-for-60 (.117) with four walks in at-bats ending with his curveball...however, he's allowed five hits against his curve in his last two starts (five against his last 55 curveballs after allowing two with his first 176) (*Baseball Info Solutions*).

• Is holding LH batters to a .225 average against (9x40) with four extra base hits allowed (four doubles)...has given up just one homer to a lefty in his last two seasons (2017-18) (SD's Cory Spangenberg last year).

• Is 4-1 with a 2.45 ERA (10er, 36.2ip) in five career starts against the Houston Astros...has won each of his last four starts against them, going 4-0 with a 1.20 ERA (4er, 30.0ip)...last faced them in 2015, tossing a complete-game, five-hitter with 12 strikeouts on Aug. 11.

• Failed to complete 5.0 innings in his start on July 21 for the first time since April 11, 2015...the 89 straight starts of pitching 5.0-or-more innings was the longest active streak in the Majors and the best by a Giants pitcher since the mound was moved in 1893 (*Elias*).

• Was reinstated from the 60-day DL June 5.

• Missed the Giants' first 60 games with a broken pinkie finger on his left hand, an injury he suffered on his final start in spring training at Scottsdale, Arizona on March 23 after Royals' hitter Whit Merrifield hit a line-drive comebacker off of his left hand.

• Had never been on the DL in his first eight MLB seasons but has now twice been placed on the DL the last two years, missing a total of 135 games...SF is 59-76 (.437) with Bumgarner on the DL.

• Has 32 double-digit strikeout games, the second-most in Giants franchise history behind **Tim Lincecum** (36)... needs 73 strikeouts to match **Gaylord Perry** (1,606) for the fourth-most in SF-era history.

**Last Home Run:** Sept. 3, 2017 vs. STL (off RHP Luke Weaver)

**HITTING NOTES:** Is 2-for-22 (.091) with two RBI this year...had a go-ahead run-scoring single in his last start on Thursday at Arizona off RHP Zack Greinke...batted .206 with three homers and five RBI last season...has hit 17 homers in his 10-year career, the most of any active player and the most in Giants franchise history...is the first pitcher to total at least three homers in four consecutive seasons since Earl Wilson achieved the feat in five-straight seasons between 1964 and 1968.

**THURSDAY'S STARTER: LHP ANDREW SUÁREZ**  
**2018: 4-7, 4.60 ERA / Career: 4-7, 4.60 ERA**

**NOTES:** The 25-year-old left-hander is slated to make his 20th career Major League start...has gone 4-7 with a 4.60 ERA (54er, 105.2ip) in 19 outings, with the Giants going 8-11 in those games...received a losing decision in the Giants' 9-3 loss at Arizona on Saturday...allowed eight runs on 10 hits with two walks, five strikeouts and two home runs allowed over 5.0 innings...the hits and runs allowed were career highs...has a 7.89 ERA (19er, 21.2ip) over his last four starts...has struck out 92 batters while issuing just 26 walks in his first 19 career Major League starts...has faced the Pirates once this season and allowed five runs on seven hits over 4.0 innings and was tagged with the loss.
