**THE TWINS:** The Twins have gone 2-4 through six games on their nine-game roadtrip, going 1-2 in Cleveland and 1-2 in Texas...today the Twins will continue the trip with the first of three at Houston...following Wednesday's finale with the Astros, the Twins will travel to Minneapolis for an off-day Wednesday.

**TWINS THUMPED IN TEXAS:** The Twins lost to the Rangers yesterday afternoon in Texas by a score of 18-4...Gabriel Moya started the game with 1.0 inning followed by six more pitchers to follow...the 18 runs allowed marked the second most this season and the 19 hits marked their four most allowed...the offense recorded eight hits, two from both Robbie Grossman and Jake Cave.

**TWINS AND ASTROS:** The Twins are playing the fourth of six games against the Astros this season...the Twins went 1-5 against the Astros last season, getting swept in three games from May 29-31 at Target Field and winning one of two at Minute Maid Park from July 14-16 at Minute Maid Park...the Twins are 27-27 all-time against the Astros, including a record of 16-18 since the Astros joined the American League in 2013...they have won just three times in their last 12 meetings with the Astros.

☞ Robbie Grossman played for Houston from 2013-15 hitting .240 (160-for-666) with 30 doubles, 11 home runs and 63 RBI in 190 games.

☞ Joe Mauer has hit safely in each of his last 11 games vs. Houston, hitting .326 (14-for-43) in that span.

☞ Jorge Polanco is hitting .343 (12-for-35) in nine career games vs. Houston.

☞ Tyler Duffey was born in Houston and was a 2009 graduate of Bellaire High School, roughly 12 miles southwest of Minute Maid Park...Duffey also pitched for Rice University from 2010-2012.

☞ Kohl Stewart was born in Houston and was a 2013 graduate of St. Pius X High School, roughly eight miles north of Minute Maid Park.

**ABOVE AVERAGE JOE:** Since July 6, Joe Mauer is hitting .304 (58-for-191) with 10 doubles, three home runs, 18 RBI, 14 walks, 25 runs scored and at .350 on-base percentage in 76 games...additionally, he is hitting .412 (28-for-68) with a .500 on-base percentage with runners in scoring position on the season, best in baseball, ahead of J.D. Martinez (.408)...his average with RISP is second highest in club history for a single season, just behind Rod Carew's 1975 mark of .421.

**MAY THE FORS BE WITH YOU:** Logan Forsythe is hitting .313 (31-for-99) with five doubles, 10 RBI, 12 walks and a .404 on-base percentage in 28 games since being traded to Minnesota from Los Angeles-NL on July 31 (for Brian Dozier)...in that span, he has reached safely in 23 of 28 games.

**NO DAYS OFF:** The Twins are 39-25 all-time on Labor Day...they lost on Labor Day last season vs. Tampa Bay at Tropicana Field by a score of 11-3; Brian Dozier hit three home runs...the Twins had just five hits, one being a Brian Dozier homer...Twins haven't won on Labor Day since 2015.

**ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY:** In 2010, after using eight pitchers — including two starters in Scott Baker and Nick Blackburn — the previous day in a 13-inning loss to Detroit, the Twins turned to rookie Matt Fox to start a key game against the Rangers...Fox delivered in his major league debut, pitching 5.2 innings with two runs allowed after being called up from Triple-A Rochester in the middle of the night, helping the Twins win 4-3, separating the Twins lead in the division over Chicago by 6.0 games.

☞ Since July 1, Jake Cave ranks fifth in the AL in games in centerfield (41), trailing Aaron Hicks (51), Adam Engel (50), Kevin Kiermaier (49), and Jackie Bradley Jr. (48).

☞ The Twins have gone 24-44 on the road this season for a .353 winning percentage, the fourth lowest in baseball.

☞ The Twins have gone just 9-17 against the AL West this season.

THAT'S KYLE WITH A K: Gibson has improved his strikeouts-per-9.0 innings rate nearly every year in his career, setting a career-high in 2017 with 6.89 K/9...

KILLING TWO BIRDS WITH ONE STONE: Gibson induced 26 double plays in 2017, ranking third in the AL...his 1.48 GDP/9 ranked fourth in baseball among pitchers who throw more than 150 innings in 2017...

RISP-Y BUSINESS: Gibson has held opponents to a .197 average (26-for-132) with runners in scoring position, fourth best in the AL and seventh best in baseball...

NEED SOME RUNS: Gibson has been given 69 runs of support this year but only has a run support average of 3.79, fourth lowest in the AL...

ROAD WOES: In Gibson's first 11 road starts this year, he was 3-3 with a 2.94 ERA (70.1 IP, 23 ER) with an opponent average of .198 and 70 strikeouts on the road...
