**THE TWINS:** Enjoyed their first off day of the spring yesterday following their 8-1 win over the Red Sox at JetBlue Park on Wednesday...Jake Odorizzi (2-0) was the starter and winner for the Twins allowing one run on three hits and a walk in 3.2 innings...the Twins bullpen combined for 5.1 scoreless innings from Jake Reed (0.1 IP), Zach Duke (1.0 IP), Addison Reed (1.0 IP), Ryan Pressly (1.0 IP), Alan Busenitz (1.0 IP) and John Curtiss (1.0 IP)...the Twins had four players collect multiple hits including Logan Morrison, Max Kepler, Robbie Grossman and Nick Gordon...Eduardo Escobar hit his first home run of the spring and Miguel Sanó collected a double.

**TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER:** José Berríos will be making his third start of the spring today...Berríos has combined in two starts for 3.1 scoreless innings with four hits, no walks and three strikeouts...in his last start he pitched 2.1 innings March 4 vs. Pittsburgh...last spring, he made two starts, posting a 2.25 ERA (4.0 IP, 1 ER) with three walks and six strikeouts...Berríos is entering his second full season with the Twins, having combined to go 17-15, 5.07 ERA (204.0 IP, 115 ER) with 83 walks and 188 strikeouts from 2016-17 with Minnesota...Berríos started the 2017 campaign with the Rochester Red Wings where he made six starts, going 3-0, 1.13 ERA (39.2 IP, 5 ER)...he was recalled on May 13, and finished the season in Minnesota starting 25 games, going 14-8, 3.89 ERA (145.2 IP, 63 ER) with 48 walks and 139 strikeouts...Berríos was drafted by the Twins in the first round (32nd overall) in the 2012 MLB draft out of Bayamon, Puerto Rico.

**TWINS VS. TAMPA BAY:** Today is the third of six meetings between the Twins and Rays this spring...the Twins finished 2017 Spring Training going 3-2-1 against the Rays...in six regular season games in 2017 against the Rays the Twins went 2-4, going 1-2 at home and 1-2 at Tropicana Field...the Twins went 3-4 against the Rays during the 2016 regular season, going 1-3 at Target Field and 2-1 at Tropicana Field...the Twins will host the Rays for three games April 20-22 and travel to St. Petersburg July 12-15 for four...the Twins are 72-76 all-time against the Rays in the regular season.

**MAD MAX:** Max Kepler is in his fifth spring training with the Twins...last season he ranked third on the Twins in doubles (32)...he played 138 games (120 starts) in rightfield last season, ranking fifth most in the AL...last spring Max played in 18 games, hitting .151 (8-for-53) with four doubles...he enters 2018 as one of 43 German-born players to ever play Major League Baseball.

**CATCHING UP WITH CASTRO:** Jason Castro is in his 10th career spring training and second with the Twins...he was signed to a three-year contract by the Twins as a free agent on November 30, 2016...since 2013 he ranks second in the AL in games caught (534), trailing Salvador Perez (665)...during this past offseason, he changed his uniform number from 21 to 15, the number formerly worn by Glen Perkins – 15 was Castro's uniform number during his time with Houston.

**#99 LOGAN MORRISON:** Logan Morrison was signed to a one-year contract February 28 by the Twins...the left-handed hitting Morrison set career-highs with 38 home runs and 85 RBI in 2017 with Tampa Bay...in eight major league seasons with the Marlins (2010-13), Mariners (2014-15) and Rays (2016-17), Morrison has hit .245 (723-for-2953) with 122 home runs, 248 RBI and 382 RBI in 864 games...attended Maple Woods CC in Missouri, the same school as Albert Pujols...has seven career multi-home run games, including three in 2017.

**PLATINUM AND GOLD:** Centerfielder Byron Buxton and second baseman Brian Dozier were each honored with the Rawlings Gold Glove following the 2017 season, a first for each player...additionally, Buxton was presented with the American League Platinum Glove given to the top defender in the AL.

- Buxton and Dozier will be presented with their Gold Gloves during a pre-game ceremony on April 13.

**ROLL CALL:** The Twins have 53 players in camp (15 non-roster)...26 pitchers (3 non-roster), five catchers (5 non-roster), 13 infielders (5 non-roster) and nine outfielders (4 non-roster)...the oldest player in camp is Fernando Rodney (born 3/18/77) at 40-years-old.
