THE GIANTS: Continue their four-game series with the Padres tonight after winning 7-0 last night...SF is in the midst of a 10-game, three-city road trip that also features a three-game series against the Arizona Diamondbacks (Tuesday-Thursday) and a three-game set against the Los Angeles Angels of Anaheim (Friday-Sunday).

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Padres' lone hit last came from LHP Clayton Richard, who singled as a pinch hitter in the 3rd inning...it was the first time in the modern era (since 1900) that a pinch-hitting pitcher got his team's only hit in a game...the last time a team had one hit for a game and a pitcher that did not start got the only hit was June 28, 1935 when Pittsburgh lost to the Cubs, 8-0 (*Elias*).

TONIGHT'S STARTING PITCHER: LHP Ty Blach is making his fourth start of the season...Blach has faced the Padres five times in his career (four starts), going 0-2 with a 3.65 ERA (10er, 24.2ip) in those games...he made his first career start here at Petco Park on Sept. 25, 2016 and surrendered two runs in 3.0 innings of work.

ON THE ROAD: San Francisco pitchers have posted a 2.51 ERA (12er, 43.0ip) on the road this season...the Giants have shut out their opponents in three of five games this season away from home.

LOT'S OF CURVES: Giants hitters have seen a curveball in 17.6 percent of the pitches they have seen this season, which is the highest percentage of any Major League team.

THEY SAY IT'S YOUR BIRTHDAY: Happy Birthday to Giants' **OF Hunter Pence**, who turned 35-years-old today.

POSEY AT THE PLATE: C Buster Posey enters today having hit safely in each of his last 10 games at a .441 clip (15-for-34) with five extra base hits (three doubles, two home runs) and eight RBI...since the start of 2017, this marks Posey's third hitting streak of at least 10 games.

AT PETCO PARK: The Giants are looking for their first series win in San Diego since May 17-19, 2016...since the 2016 All-Star break, SF has gone 0-4-1 in their last five series here at Petco Park.

WITHIN THE WEST: 17 of the Giants' first 19 contests (the only time SF played out of the division was a two-game set vs. Seattle from April 3-4) and 23 of their first 31 games this season are against NL West teams...SF posted a 29-47 (.382) record versus NL West division rivals last year, including a 9-29 (.237) record on the road.

GETTING CLOSE TO COMING BACK: LHP Will Smith (recovering from Tommy John surgery) made his first rehab appearance last night with Class A Advanced San Jose, allowing one run on two hits with one strikeout in 1.0 innings of work (17 pitches)...**RHP Jeff Samardzija** (strained right pectoral muscle) will make a rehab start with San Jose on Saturday, April 14.

RISPY BUSINESS: The Giants are hitting .170 (16-for-94) with runners in scoring position this season, which stands as the second-lowest clip in the Majors.

WITH THE GLOVES: The Giants have committed just four errors this season, tied for the third-fewest among NL clubs...SF has played error-free ball in 10 of their 12 games.

GETTING AHEAD: The Giants are 5-0 this season when scoring first and 1-6 in games their opponent scores first.

This Date in Giants History: April 13, 2012

Matt Cain came one batter shy of a perfect game in beating the Pirates 5 - 0 in the Giants' home opener...Cain settled for a one-hitter, with mound rival James McDonald's 6th-inning single representing the only baserunner.

TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER

#50 LHP Ty Blach
6-1, 213, 27 years old (October 20, 1990)
1-1 Record, 4.11 ERA

- The 27-year-old left-hander enters his third season in a Giants uniform and will take the hill for his fourth start of the season.
- Is 1-1 with 4.11 ERA (7er, 15.1ip) in his first three outings...has held opponents to one run or fewer in two of his three starts.
- Received a no-decision in his last outing this past Sunday in the Giants' 2-1 loss to the Dodgers...threw 6.0 innings, allowing one run on four hits and three walks with one strikeout.
- Has faced the Padres five times in his career (four starts), going 0-2 with a 3.65 ERA (10er, 24.2ip) in those games...made his first career start here at Petco Park on Sept. 25, 2016 and surrendered two runs in 3.0 innings of work.
- Has allowed eight walks compared to just six strikeouts in his first three starts...his 0.75 strikeouts per walk is the lowest in the National League.
- Left-handed batters are 6-for-18 (.333) off him so far this season...in 2017, he held lefties to a .250 clip (43-for-172) with just eight extra-base hits (all doubles).
- Was the Giants Opening Day starter and became the first Giants pitcher to start the season opener other than **Madison Bumgarner, Matt Cain** or **Tim Lincecum** since 2008 when **Barry Zito** was the club's Opening Day starter.
- Finished 2017 with an 8-12 record and a 4.78 ERA (87er, 163.2ip) in 34 games (24 starts)...as a starter went 8-12 with a 4.81 ERA (80er, 149.2ip) in 24 starts...the Giants went 9-15 in his starts and dropped each of his last five games, including seven of his last nine contests.

NOTES: Hit .227 (10-for-44) last season but did have a few highlight games with the bat...recorded his first career homer, drove in three runs and pitched 8.0- innings in the Giants' 11-2 win over the A's on Aug. 3, 2017...became just the third Giants rookie pitcher to drive in at least three runs in a game since the team began playing in San Francisco in 1958, joining Jim Duffalo (four in 1961) and Brad Hennessey (three in 2005) (*Elias*)...walked three times on June 2 at PHI and became the first pitcher in MLB to draw three walks in a game since COL's Aaron Cook on Oct. 1, 2009 vs. MIL...was the first Giants' pitcher to draw three walks in a game since **Ray Sadecki** on Sept. 1, 1969 vs. MON.

TOMORROW'S STARTER: LHP DEREK HOLLAND
2018: 0-2, 4.09 ERA / Career: 69-66, 4.57

NOTES: The 31-year-old left-hander is slated to make his third start in a Giants uniform and the 187th of his career...suffered the loss against the Diamondbacks on April 9 after his start was pushed back due to the Giants rain out on Friday, April 6...threw 6.0 innings, allowing two runs on two hits with eight strikeouts...has faced San Diego once in his career...suffered the loss, as he allowed seven runs (six earned runs) on 13 hits in 5.2 innings of work on June 27, 2009...his 13 hits allowed marked a career-high.
