SAN DIEGO NOTES

- **Luis Perdomo** allowed a season-high two home runs in his third start since being recalled on July 4...before tonight, his sole home run allowed (Max Muncy on April 18 vs. LAD) was the fewest allowed in the NL among pitchers who had made at least six starts this year.
- **Eric Hosmer's** home run in the first inning snapped an 0-for-16 hitless streak and was his first homer since June 12 at STL...was previously batting .074 (4-for-54) since June 30 with two doubles, two walks, three RBI and 17 strikeouts.
- **Carlos Asuaje** extended his hitting streak to four games...since being recalled on July 1, he's hitting .353 (12-for-34) with a .476 OBP.
 - Swiped his first career stolen base tonight.
- **Hunter Renfroe** recorded his second career pinch-hit home run (last: June 3 vs. CIN)...is 6-for-11 (.545) with two homers and eight RBI as a pinch-hitter this year.

CHICAGO NOTES

- **Kyle Hendricks** has worked at least 5.0 innings in 18 of his 19 starts this season and allowed three earned runs or less in 15 of those starts....is 3-1 with a 3.24 ERA (9 ER, 25.0 IP) in four starts at Petco Park and improves to 4-1 in his career against the Padres.
 - Has allowed 17 home runs this season, tying his career-high set in 2015 and 2017.
- **Ian Happ's home run in the second inning was the 2,000th homer hit at Petco Park** (visitors and Padres combined)...is batting .368 (21-for-57) with 14 walks and a .493 OBP in his last 19 games.
- **Jason Heyward** is riding a four-game hitting streak...has a .341 batting average (57-for-167) in his career vs. the Padres, the highest batting average of any qualifying active player (per STATS, Inc.).
- **Javier Baez** recorded a season-high tying five RBI tonight (last: June 26 at LAD) and logged his career-high 25th double of the season, surpassing his previous career-high of 24 done in 2017.
 - Has 19 home runs and 71 RBI in 90 games this season and has a team-leading 29 multi-hit games.
- **Kyle Schwarber** belted his 18th homer of the season...is 12-for-34 (.353) with a .488 OBP and a .676 SLG in his last 12 games.
