SHORT MEMORY: The Padres fell 9-4 last night to the Arizona Diamondbacks, dropping their fourth consecutive game and pushing their season record to 3-6 against the desert nemesis...RHP **Tyson Ross** worked 5.0 innings of six-hit ball, allowing four runs (earned) with eight strikeouts and two walks...Ross collected two hits for the second time in his career (other: Aug. 26, 2015 @ WSH), and he was the only Padre with multiple hits in the contest.

TREVOR TIME: Today, **Trevor Hoffman** will be inducted into the National Baseball Hall of Fame along with Jack Morris, Vladimir Guerrero, Chipper Jones, Jim Thome and Alan Trammell...the ceremony will start at 10:30 PST, it will be broadcast live on MLB Network and a live stream will be available at mlb.com and facebook.com/baseballhall...fans attending today's game will have the opportunity to watch the induction on the video board during the Hoffman Hall of Fame Induction Ceremony In-Park Broadcast...gates will open at 10:00 a.m. to allow fans to arrive at Petco Park before the broadcast begins at 10:30 a.m.



MOVES: Today, the Padres optioned OF **Franmil Reyes** to El Paso (AAA) and reinstated RHP **Jordan Lyles** from the 10-day DL (was placed on July 24 with right elbow inflammation).

LET'S FUEGO: In his five starts since being reinstated from the 10-day DL on June 25, starter **Joey Lucchesi** is 2-2 with a 2.28 ERA (6 ER, 23.2 IP), allowing two earned runs-or-fewer in each of his outings...in that time, opponents have hit just .191 against him, and he hasn't allowed a single home run in those five starts since he gave up two on June 20 vs. OAK.

SO FLY IN JULY: **Wil Myers** has a .659 slugging percentage in the month of July (seven doubles, a triple, seven homers and 21 RBI)...his 21 RBI in the month are second-most in the NL to just MIL's Christian Yelich (23 RBI), and they tie for fourth-most in the majors in that time...Myers' .659 SLG is his highest mark in a month since he slugged .765 in June of 2016.

MARGOTING STREAKING: **Manuel Margot** is riding a career-high nine-game hitting streak, batting .406 (13-for-32) with three doubles, a triple and a home run since July 13...his streak is the second-longest by a Padre this season (behind Christian Villanueva's 11-game spree from April 13-28).

WORLD OF EXTREMES: Before last night's game, the Padres' bullpen had an NL-leading 1.40 ERA since the All-Star break...last night, however, the Friars pen's ERA was pushed to 6.22 since the break, which is now the highest ERA in the NL...last night, SD's pen allowed nine hits, five runs (all earned), two walks, and four doubles...it was the fifth time this season in which they allowed nine-or-more hits in a game.

RISP: In eight games since the All-Star break, the Friar are hitting .302 with RISP, the fourth-highest average in the NL...ARI headlines the ML in that time with a .393 mark.

PADRES ON DECK: Last night for El Paso (AAA), **Francisco Mejia**, the Padres' third-ranked prospect and No. 21 overall by MLB Pipeline, went 3-for-4 with a double...Mejia is hitting .417 for the Chihuahuas since being acquired from Cleveland...for Fort Wayne (A), **Gabriel Arias** went 3-for-3 with a double, and for Tri-City, SS **Owen Miller** went 3-for-4.

DATE IN PADRES HISTORY: On July 29, 2007, at the same time **Tony Gwynn** delivered his induction speech at the National Baseball Hall of Fame in Cooperstown, N.Y., the Padres scored 11 runs in the first inning of an 18-11 win @ HOU.

STARTING PITCHER NOTES

#37 LHP JOEY LUCCHESI (5-5, 3.34)

LET'S GO FUEGO: 25-year-old **Joey Lucchesi** is set to make his 16th start of the season today and second of the second half...it will be his third career start against the Diamondbacks and first against Arizona at Petco Park.

- The D-Backs (thrice) are among the teams Lucchesi has faced multiple times this season, including the Rockies (three times) and Dodgers (twice).

LAST TIME OUT: Tossed 5.1 IP of two-run ball in his last outing on 7/23 at NYM, improving to 5-5 on the season in the Padres' 3-2 victory.

- In his five starts since 6/25 after being reinstated from the 10-day DL with a right hip strain, he is 2-2 with a 2.28 ERA (6 ER, 23.2 IP), allowing two earned runs or less in each of his outings.

SHOWING HE BELONGS: The Padres selected Lucchesi to the Major League roster to start the club's second game of the season on 3/30...he went on to allow three earned runs or fewer in eight of his first nine career outings from 3/30-5/14, posting a 3-2 record with a 3.23 ERA (17 ER, 47.1 IP) and 9.13 SO/9 IP.

- Missed 32 games from 5/14-6/20 with a right hip strain.
- Went 1-3 with a 3.60 ERA (8 ER, 20.0 IP) over his final five starts of the first half, limiting hitters to a .187 average and 9.45 SO/9 IP.
- Allowed just two total hits across his two scoreless starts on 6/25 at TEX (4.0 IP) and 6/30 vs. PIT (5.0 IP).
- Saddled with the loss in consecutive outings for the first time in his career to close out the first half on 7/6 at ARI and 7/11 vs. LAD, despite pitching to a combined 3.86 ERA and a .231 opponent average.

RANKS AMONG THE ROOKS: Among rookies who have made at least 15 starts this season, he ranks third in ERA (3.34) and fourth in opponent average (.232) and SO/9 IP (9.29).

YOU SHALL NOT REACH: Among all pitchers who have made at least 15 starts this season, Lucchesi has allowed the second-fewest baserunners (92) among all starters.

- His 9.29 SO/9.0 IP ratio leads the Padres staff and ranks 15th in the NL.

NO LONG BALLS FOR CHICKS TO DIG: Lucchesi allowed 10 home runs across his first 10 outings from 3/30-6/20.

- Hasn't allowed a home run in his last five starts and 23.2 IP from 6/25-7/23, one of only five pitchers to have not allowed a long ball over that time (min. 23.0 IP).

YOUNG AND THE RESTLESS: Lucchesi has been more effective with fewer days off between starts.

- With four days off, he has a 1.80 ERA with a .225 opponent average in seven starts...with five days off, he has a 3.00 ERA with a .176 opponent average in four starts...with six-or-more days off, he has a 7.02 ERA and a .304 opponent average in three starts.

PICK ME BABY ONE MORE TIME: Lucchesi has recorded three pickoffs and fellow rookie lefty **Eric Lauer** leads the majors with nine...their 12 combined pickoffs are the most by a Padres rookie duo in franchise history.

APPRECIATE THE HELP: His 5.57 run support average leads the Padres staff, ranks 26th among all ML pitchers and 14th among all NL arms (min. 15 games started).

THROUGH 4, UNDER 2.00: Lucchesi logged a 1.66 ERA through his first four starts with a 2-0 record...the last SD pitcher to have a sub-2.00 ERA over his first four MLB starts was **Odrisamer Despaigne** in 2014 (1.35).

FIRST IN HIS CLASS: Made his Major League debut on 3/30 vs. MIL, becoming the first pitcher of the 2016 draft class to make it to the show...he was the second player overall drafted in 2016 to make it to the majors, following only Orioles **OF Austin Hays**....teammate **Eric Lauer** became the second pitcher of the '16 class to make his MLB debut (April 24 at COL)

- Lucchesi made just 39 minor league starts prior to his big league debut, going 11-9 with a 1.99 ERA (40 ER, 181.0 IP) and 204 SO against 36 BB.

LOOK BACK AT IT: The left-hander was named Padres Minor League Pitcher of the Year in 2017 after pitching to a combined 11-7 record with a 2.20 ERA (34 ER, 139.0 IP), 148 SO against 33 BB and a .200 opponent batting average in 24 appearances (23 starts) between Lake Elsinore (A) and San Antonio (AA).

- Began the season with Lake Elsinore and earned California League Mid-Season All-Star honors, pitching to a 6-4 record with a 2.52 ERA (22 ER, 78.2 IP) and 95 SO against 19 BB.
- Promoted to San Antonio on 7/1 where he lowered his ERA, pitching to a 1.79 mark (12 ER, 60.1 IP) while

LAUER HOUR: LHP **Eric Lauer** is set to make his third career start to kick off this brief two-game set against the San Francisco Giants.

- Allowed a career-high-tying six earned runs in his last outing on 7/24 at NYM in SD's 6-3 defeat.
- Over his last 10 starts since 6/2, has allowed three earned runs or fewer in eight of his outings, posting a 3.96 ERA (23 ER, 52.1 IP) and a 4-4 record.
